


BJP protests Rule change

Bhubaneswar (KCN): The State BJP today knocked the door of the State Election Commission to protest the purported change in the rule over election of Zilla Parishad Chairman posts.

It alleged that the change is aimed more at keeping under check the elected BJD representatives due to intra-party squabbles within the ruling BJD than bring in transparency in the election process as claimed by the government.

He said the hurry of the State government in amending the Odisha Zilla Parishad Election Act 1994 has brought to the fore the intra-party squabbles in the ruling party.

"If the Government was so serious why did it not amend the Act after the 2002, 2007, and 2012 panchayat polls," asked BJP Spokesperson, Sajjan Sharma after senior party leader Sameer Mohanty led a delegation to the SEC to handover a memo-



randum earlier in the day.

Mr. Sharma also criticized the notification in this regard yesterday which specified that representatives of different parties will be present during the open ballot election of Zilla Parishad Chairmen instead of the secret ballot system followed in earlier elections. "This move of the ruling party is mainly due to its apprehension about possible defeat in election of Chairmen," Mr. Sharma pointed out.

Odisha's poll violence forces some villages to abandon homes



KORAPUT(KCN): AS many as 50 persons of 14 families of Pallur village under Narayanpatna police limits in the district deserted their homes on Wednesday alleging harassment and boycott by a section of villagers in a post-election related violence.

Sources said two groups of villagers are at loggerheads following the death of a villager, Abilash Bagh, in connection with post-poll violence on February 17. Bagh, a Congress supporter, was killed by a group of

villagers who are allegedly BJD activists over poll related tussle. A few days later, his brother Yudhistir had lodged an FIR at Narayanpatna police station against 19 persons of the rival group. The situation only worsened after the cremation of Bagh and things did not normalise ever since.

The group supporting Bagh family was allegedly harassed and stopped from collecting drinking water from tubewells. In absence of cooperation from

Narayanpatna police, they decided to meet Laxmipur Sub-Divisional Police Officer Hemant Padhi but he too was away at Koraput town on some official work on Wednesday, the villagers alleged.

Fearing more harassment from the rival group, about 50 persons of 14 families have left the village with their belongings and domestic animals.

The SDPO said all villagers are safe and residing with their respective relatives. Padhi, however, said poll violence was not

the reason behind the dispute and they are investigating to get to the root of the issue. Inspector-in-charge of Narayanpatna police station Umesh Sahu said patrolling in the village has been increased and the oustees will come back home by March 17 after a meeting between administration and villagers of both the parties. Action will be taken against the 19 persons after receiving the postmortem report of Bagh, he added.

US economy adds 235,000 new jobs in February: Labor Department

WASHINGTON(KCN): US economy had another strong month of job creation in February, with the manufacturing, health care, mining and construction sectors all adding positions, the Labor Department reported today.

Employers added a net 235,000 new positions for the month, well above an analyst forecast just shy of the 238,000 new positions added in January, official

figures showed. Meanwhile, in another sign that jobs markets are tightening, the already low unemployment rate fell a tenth of a point to 4.7 per cent.

That decline came even as the labor force participation rate rose to 63 per cent, a level not surpassed in almost three years, meaning people who had been on the sidelines are rejoining the labor market. With

February's robust job creation, the world's largest economy has added an average of 209,000 new jobs over the last three months.

The result was sure to boost already high expectations that the central bank will raise its benchmark interest rate next week. The Federal Reserve has sent strong signals this month that it is likely to hike, barring negative surprise in eco-

nomics data. Job creation, unemployment and inflation have all approached the central bank's targets.

Quickening wage gains were also recorded in February, with average hourly earnings rising six cents, or 0.2 per cent, to USD 26.09. In the goods producing sector, payrolls rose by 95,000 new positions, the highest level since March of 2000.

Sensex closes at two year high, retakes 29,000 mark, RIL top mover

MUMBAI(KCN): The markets made a powerful comeback today as the Sensex rallied almost 216 points and reclaimed the 29,000-mark to close at a 2-year high, cashing in on solid gains in index heavy-weight RIL amid mixed global cues.

The all-powerful GST Council approved the final draft of central GST (C-GST) and integrated GST (I-GST) and will take up for approval the state-GST and Union Territory-GST (UT-GST) laws at its next meeting due March 16, which instilled a sense of confidence in investors.

The 30-share barometer remained up throughout and hit a high of 29,070.20, powered by a rally in RIL and other blue-chips. The index ended 215.74 points up, or 0.75 per cent, at 29,048.19 -- its highest closing since March 5, 2015, when it had closed at 29,448.95.

The index has lost 152.04 points over the past two days.

The optimism led to the NSE Nifty gaining 65.90 points, or 0.74 per cent, to end at 8,963.45, a level last seen on March 3, 2015, too when it settled at 8,996.25.

The rupee notched up gains against the dollar, which added to the sunny side.

Reliance Industries came out top on the heap, surging 3.69 per cent and settling at a fresh 9-year high of Rs 1,304.90, after the company announced that the promoters will be reshuffling their shareholding.

RIL has gone up by over 21 per cent after its telecom venture Jio said last month that it will begin charging for data services from April. Dredging Corporation rallied 12.68 per cent to close at Rs 502, largely on reports of possible

Spanish giant Barcelona discovers unlikely hero in Sergi Roberto

BARCELONA(KCN): With the tip of his right foot, Sergi Roberto touched glory.

The 25-year-old Barcelona midfielder with bushy hair and broad, almost goofy grin wasn't supposed to decide the fate of a team stacked with battle-tested stars. But that's exactly what he did.

"When I woke up, I wasn't sure if it hadn't all been a dream," Roberto said the day after he stretched his leg to tap in the winning goal in Barcelona's remarkable 6-1 victory over Paris Saint-Germain.

The dramatic goal in the fifth and final minute of stoppage time Wednesday made Barcelona the first team to overturn a 4-0 first-leg loss in the Champions League.

"I didn't see a thing until the ball went in," Roberto said. "I could see that (Gerard) Pique hadn't reached (the ball) and I threw everything at it. It went in and we all went crazy. We

could feel that the Camp Nou was buzzing. I simply have no words to explain how it felt.

If Barcelona goes on to win a sixth European Cup, it may surpass that in the memory of the team's faithful.

"I had always dreamed of scoring a goal like that, and being a kid from La Masia made it all the more special," Roberto said. "I've worked so long to do something incredible like this for my club."
