It may be noted that with the approval

der the Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the Park is coming up.

The Hub is being developed by a special purpose vehicle (SPV) called Angul Aluminium Park Private Ltd (AAPPL), with shareholding of 50.50 per cent and 49.50 per cent between IDCO and NALCO respectively.

It will come up over 450 acres of land, out of which 160 acres is taken up for development in the First Phase.

A wide variety of industries using aluminium conductors, extrusions, castings, foils, powder and paste can be set up at the aluminium park.

NALCO has already agreed to supply 50,000 Tonne Per Annum (TPA) of molten metal for promoting downstream industries coming up in the Aluminium Complex.

Erdogan says Turks, Greeks still at odds on Cyprus

ISTANBUL(KCN): Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan said on Friday that Athens and Greek Cypriots still have "different expectations" on resolving the Cyprus problem from their Turkish counterparts, after crunch talks this week in Geneva.

Erdogan said Turkish Cypriots "are working intensely and bring sincerity", but that the Greek Cypriot Republic of Cyprus and Athens "still have different expectations".

He added in televised comments that a full withdrawal of

Erdogan indicated there were also major differences on the issue of a rotating presidency for any future bizonal united Cyprus divided between Turkish Cypriot and Greek Cypriot entities.

He said it was "unacceptable" that Turkish Cypriots could hold the presidency for just one term while Greek Cypriots had it for four.

He has said previously that there had been discussions on the Greek Cypriots having two terms for

every term granted to the Turkish Cypriots.

"That is fair. If we want a fair and comprehensive peace then this is the way to do it," he said.

Indicating that Ankara was not in the mood for concessions he added: "Apart from this, we told them (in Geneva) that 'no one should expect anything from us'".

Cypriot leaders pledged to forge ahead with efforts to reunite the divided island claiming "real progress" at an unprecedented meeting in Geneva bringing together all the protagonists, including

the three guarantor powers Greece, Turkey, and Britain.

There had been rumours Erdogan himself could attend but in the end the meeting was attended by foreign ministers of the three guarantor powers.

The eastern Mediterranean island has been divided since 1974, when Turkish troops invaded in response to an Athens-inspired coup seeking union with Greece.

Turkish Cypriots made up just 18 per cent of the island's population in 1974, but they currently control more than a third of its territory.

Natarajan Chandrasekaran's final act at TCS

CHENNAI(KCN): With Natarajan Chandrasekaran taking over as Tata Sons chairman on February 21, his stint as head of Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) is set to end on a high note. TCS, India's largest software services firm by revenues, has beaten market estimates by posting a 10.9 per cent year-on-year jump in profits to Rs 6,778 crore for the October-December 2016 quarter — up from Rs 6,110 crore in the year-ago period. The sequential growth was 2.9 per cent. This is a notable achievement for the Chandrasekaran-led firm given the fact that the IT sector as a whole has been going through challenging times. The sector remained one of the worst performers in 2016 bogged down by a fall in demand due to automation as well as the protectionist stance of US President-elect Donald Trump, who reportedly wants to cut down on outsourcing by US companies, and currency volatility, among other factors. Despite this, TCS added two clients in \$50 million revenue category and five clients under the \$10 million category. On TCS' impressive third quarter results, Chandrasekaran said: "The resilience of our business model and strength of our operating strategy has been brought to the fore by our performance in Q3, traditionally a quarter of business that is growing at 30 per cent on an annual basis, TCS continues to build new capabilities in digital technologies, empower employees to enhance agility in business that is growing at 30 per cent on an annual basis, TCS continues to build new capabilities in digital technologies, empower employees to enhance agility in financial officer of TCS who will take over as CEO on February 21. With the earlier order for 55 planes and additional 100 new 737-8 MAX aircraft, the no-frills carrier now has firmed up order for a total of 155 planes, besides purchase rights for 50 B737-8 MAX and wide body aircraft. Announcing the deal here today, SpiceJet Chairman and Managing Director Ajay Singh said the total order of 205 aircraft is valued at "This is one of the largest deals in Indian aviation and the largest for SpiceJet," Singh said. Currently, the budget carrier has 32 next generation B737s and 17 Bombardier Q400s. "We are honoured to build upon more than a decade of partnership with SpiceJet with their commitment of up to 205 airplanes," Boeing Company Vice Chairman Ray Conner said. According to Singh, SpiceJet would explore different options for financing the deal.

Real Madrid late show sets record 40-game unbeaten run

MADRID(KCN): Karim Benzema struck deep into stoppage time as Real Madrid set a new Spanish record by extending their unbeaten run to 40 games in a thrilling 3-3 draw at Sevilla on Thursday.

Holding a 3-0 first leg lead, a Cristiano Ronaldo-less Real looked set for defeat for the first time in eight months as an own goal from Danilo and second-half strikes from Stefan Jovetic and Vicente Iborra saw Sevilla lead 3-1 inside the final 10 minutes.

However, Sergio Ramos's penalty and substitute Benzema salvaged Madrid's run, which now surpasses the 39-game

unbeaten run set by Barcelona last season.

"Possibly they deserved to win the game, but we fought until the end," Real boss Zinedine Zidane told GoTV.

"They deserved more tonight, but the tie is two games and (over the two legs) it is logical that we go through."

Both coaches named weakened sides with one eye on Sunday's crunch top of the table La Liga clash between the two back at the Sanchez Pizjuan.

However, it was Sevilla who settled first as they forced Madrid onto the back foot from the off.

"We had a lot of chances, at least 15 against a team of the stature of Madrid," said Sevilla coach

Jorge Sampaoli.

"We were very close. Unfortunately, we couldn't take our chances to show the difference there was

However, most of the action in the first-half came at the other end as Casilla

Toni Kroos fired inches wide just before the break, but the vital away goal the visitors needed to kill off the tie arrived in

his own area and ran the length of the field barely challenged before slotting below Soria. That left Sevilla needing an unlikely four more goals to qualify, but they continued to pour forward as on-loan Inter Milan forward Jovetic marked his debut by volleying home Escudero's cross six minutes later.

Sampaoli threw on first-team regulars Samir Nasri and Vitolo in search of more goals.

And Madrid's record run appeared to be over when Iborra forced the ball home from close range to make it 3-1 with just 13 minutes remaining.

However, Casemiro was adjudged to have been pushed inside the area by

Matias Kranevitter five minutes later.

Against his former club, Ramos showed remarkable calm to chip the resulting spot-kick down the middle of the goal.

And Benzema provided the final sting in the tale three minutes into added time when he saw off two tired Sevilla challenges before firing low past Soria to seal a 6-3 aggregate win.

Earlier, Celta Vigo and Eibar completed their progress into the last eight having already built-up three-goal first leg leads over Valencia and Osasuna respectively. They will be joined by Atletico Madrid, Barcelona, Alaves, Alcorcon and Real Sociedad in Friday's draw.
