

Cry for rural funds Jay gets BJP support

Bhubaneswar (KCN): Inadequate and interrupted release of funds has seriously dislocated implementation of the flagship program- MGNREGS in Department of Panchayatiraj in Odisha.

Nearly Rs.1000 Crores of funds needed for implementation of the Pro-Poor program is pending clearance with Government of India.

Odisha Government has raised the issue with NITI Aayog recently as the National Institution is taking up the causes of the State Government, feel senior officials.

Repeated requests to release timely and adequate funds have not resulted in improvement of the situation and this has seriously affected implementation of MGNREGS in the State.

At many intervals, the implementation of the major program is stalled because of non-availability of funds as release of Central Share

Mr.Panda in a tweet blamed one or two "Babus" (officers) for the hooliganism in the ruling BJD and hoped party President Naveen Patnaik would definitely take steps after being aware of the incident.

The MP said, "I have been in the party since its inception in 1997. In the first 17 years, we had a policy against hooliganism and infighting. But things have changed in the last three years."

"When some 'Babus' (officers) sitting in AC rooms have started deciding the party activities, it has become a victim of indiscipline. This is not a good sign," he said.

BJD spokesperson and Rajya Sabha MP Pratap Kesari Deb said that the incident is an outcome of lack of communication and misunderstanding.

The Party President will examine the matter. BJD Vice-President and Minister Surjya Narayan Patro described the incident as a local problem. "It will be sorted out locally. The District President of the party, local MP and local MLA will resolve the matter," he said.

However, Union Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas Dharmendra Pradhan criticised the ruling BJD over the attack on the MP.

"There is no democracy in the state," he said. Congress leader Suresh Chandra Routray said such incidents would be explosive in the coming days as the government and the ruling party were functioning in an arbitrary manner


Priyanka Chopra stuns as Victoria Leeds in new Baywatch poster

The major trade union also said that the move was against the national interest and ill-timed as it came when Air India has posted an operating profit for the first time in 10 years since its merger with Indian Airlines.

Ikea acquires land in Bengaluru for setting up store

New Delhi(KCN): Swedish furniture retailer Ikea has acquired land in Bengaluru from the Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation for an undisclosed sum as part of its plans to start retail operations in India.

The 14 acres site in Bengaluru is the third land acquisition by the home furnishing retailer after Hyderabad and Mumbai. Ikea is slated to open its first store in India in Hyderabad early next year.

"The Ikea store in Bengaluru is planned to be around 4.5 lakh square feet and is expected to have more than 5 mil-

lion visitors per year," the company said in a statement.

The company has acquired the land located in Nagasandra on Tumkur road from the Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation.

Commenting on the development, Ikea India CEO Juvencio Maeztu said: "Karnataka is a highly strategic and important market for Ikea. Along with retail stores, Ikea's Purchasing team will also grow local sourcing and engage with local artisan and communities in many projects."

The store would employ 500 to 700 co-workers in which 50 per cent would be

women. Besides, 1,500 people would also be engaged indirectly in services. "Each Ikea store will employ 500-700 co-workers directly and another 1,500 people indirectly in different services.

We are committed to inclusion and diversity and having 50 per cent women in our organisation at all levels is non-negotiable," he said. Ikea, which received government approval in 2013 for its Rs 10,500 crore proposal to open retail stores under 100 per cent FDI, plans to open 25 stores by 2025 in nine Indian cities. "The company in parallel is evaluat-

ing suitable sites in the cities," the company said.

Ikea's first store in Hyderabad will be a massive 4 lakh square feet in size and will include all features of a global Ikea store, including restaurant and play and development area.

In July 2015, Ikea had announced purchase of 13 acre land close to the IT hub in Hyderabad'sHITEC city and bought land in Mumbai in March last year. Presently, Ikea operates 390 stores in 46 countries with a sales volume of 34.2 billion euros.

Private carrier Jet Airways today said it plans to lease 6-8 single aisle aircraft in the fleet this fiscal. The airline has already leased one B-737NG of these planes this fiscal and the rest will be inducted in the fleet by March next year, the Naresh Goyal-promoted carrier said.

The city-headquartered airline currently has 103 aircraft in the fleet, with 69 of them B-737s. "Our new fleet of Boeing B737-Max will come from June next year onwards. This year, we plan to take anything between 6-8 aircraft from the open

duct in the fleet, primarily B 737NGs," Jet Airways Chief Financial Officer and acting CEO, Amit Agarwal said during a post-earnings analysts call here.

"We have already added one (such) aircraft into the fleet," he added. Jet Airways had, in 2015, announced an order for 75 Boeing 737 Max aircraft as a part of its fleet replacement strategy.

Delivery of these planes is to commence from next year. Jet Airways has reported nearly 95 per cent fall in consolidated net profit at Rs 23 crore in the

March 2017 as higher fuel prices and lower fares took a toll on its bottomline.

In fact, if the other incomes of Rs 310.45 crore, which include income from transfer of frequent flyer programme, sale and leaseback income and real estate income are removed, then its a net loss of Rs 287 crore.

The airline plans to reduce debt by USD 200 million by this fiscal, Agarwal said, adding it was cut by Rs 1,900 crore in the last fiscal. "The company has continued to focus on reducing debt despite challeng-

The company has been able to reduce its net debt by Rs 468 crore in Q4FY17 and over all by Rs 1,900 crore during the fiscal 2016-17," the official said. According to Jet Airways, its net debt on balancesheet stood at Rs 9035 crore or USD 1.4 billion at the end of March this year.

India to emerge as economic superpower in 15-20 years: Rajnath

LUCKNOW(KCN): Union Home Minister Rajnath Singh today exuded confidence that India will emerge as economic super power in 15 to 20 years following the steps being undertaken by the Centre to strengthen the economy.

"I cannot speak about a couple of years but on the basis of my limited understanding I can confidently say that no one can stop India from becoming an economic super power in 15 to 20 years if the economy continues to move in the direction it is being taken by the central government", Singh said addressing the meeting of Indian Commerce Association here.

"We can proudly claim that India's economy is progressing the fastest in the world and its GDP growth rate has reached 7.9 per cent...I have full confidence that it will be in double figures in a couple of years", he said.

Investors from world over are coming to India despite slowdown and the highest investment has taken place in India in 2015-2016, he said.

The country has emerged as a favourite

investment destination, he added.



Arsene Wenger signs new two-year contract with Arsenal

London(KCN): Long-serving Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger has signed a new two-year contract, the club announced on Wednesday, ending months of speculation about his future.

Wenger has presided over a gruelling season, which saw his team fail to qualify for the Champions League, but masterminded a stunning FA Cup final win over Chelsea last weekend.

The 67-year-old Frenchman's new deal, which will take his tenure up to 23 years, is believed to have been rubber-stamped during a board meeting on Tuesday.

"I love this club and I am looking forward to the future with optimism and excitement. We are looking at what we do well and how we can be stronger everywhere," Wenger told Arsenal's website.

"This is a strong group of players and with some additions we can be even more successful."

Arsenal said Wenger and chief executive Ivan Gazidis had conducted "a full review of our on and off-the-pitch activities" to identify areas for improvement in view of a title challenge.

Wenger's new contract brings to an end the most traumatic season of his near 21-year Arsenal tenure.

Arsenal missed out on Champions League qualification for the first time in 20 years and were thrashed 10-2 on aggregate by Bayern Munich in the Champions League last 16. 'Absolutely horrendous'

Wenger has come under greater pressure from supporters than ever before, with fans holding 'Wenger Out' placards, boycotting home games and chartering planes to trail banners calling for him to go.

The dissent reached a crescendo during a run of seven defeats in 12 games between late January and early April.

Wenger's switch to a back three enabled Arsenal to end the season in style, winning seven of their last eight league games before toppling Chelsea in last Sunday's FA Cup final.

But he has been deeply hurt by the

In an interview on Arsenal's website, Wenger appealed to fans: "Let's be together to support our players, to support the club and all give our absolute best to be at the level that we want to be."

Arsenal's Wembley win against Chelsea gave them a third FA Cup in four seasons and made Wenger the first manager in history to have won the tournament seven times.

It is now 13 years since the last of his three Premier League title wins, however, while he has presided over a remarkable seven successive last 16 exits in the Champions League.

His key objectives for the close season will be to tie star duo Alexis Sanchez and Mesut Ozil to new contracts and strengthen his squad for the rigours of a Europa League campaign.

Wenger said Arsenal would only look to sign "top, top quality" players and said having a "very heavy squad" meant "we might lose some players".

"We're committed to mounting a sustained league challenge and that will be our focus this summer and next season," he added.
