Mercury Crosses 40 Degree C In Odisha For First Time In This Year

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The maximum temperature crossed 40 Degree Celsius in Odisha for the first time in this year today. Malkangiri recorded the highest maximum temperature of 41 Degree C in Odisha today, said the IMD. The maximum temperature was 40.5 Degree C at Boudh and Titlagarh, 40.2 Degree C at Balangir and 40 Degree C at Nayagarh,



added the IMD. Five places in Odisha—Jharsuguda, Bhawanipatna, Sonepur, Paralakhemundi and Nuapada—recorded the maximum temperature in between 39 Degree C and 40 Degree C.

According to the IMD, nine places in the state—Chandbali, Angul, Keonjhar, Sundargarh, Talcher, Phulbani, Rayagada, Nabarangpur and Rourkela—recorded the maximum temperature in between 38 Degree C and 39 Degree c. The maximum temperature was 37 Degree C at the capital city and 37.6 Degree C at Cuttack, said the IMD.

Nilagiri MLA Sukanta Kumar Nayak, ex- Congress leader Chiranjib Biswal join BJD



Bhubaneswar(KCN): Former Jagatsinghpur MLA and Congress heavyweight Chiranjib Biswal and Nilgiri MLA and former BJP leader Sukanta Kumar Nayak Sunday joined Biju Janata Dal (BJD) at the party headquarters Sankha Bhawan in Bhubaneswar. On the occasion, Biswal, who resigned from the Congress Saturday, said, "I joined BJD after being impressed by the leadership of Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik and his people-oriented programmes for the last 25 years, especially those aimed at benefitting women, youths, farmers and the poor people residing in villages." Biswal is the son of late Congress stalwart Basant Kumar Biswal who had also served as the deputy Chief Minister of Odisha from 1995 and 1999. Biswal was elected to the

state assembly from Tirtol and Jagatsinghpur constituencies on Congress ticket in 2004 and 2014 respectively. Nayak, who had tendered his resignation from the primary membership of the BJP Friday, joined the BJD along with his supporters at party headquarters. "We have been impressed by the ideology of Biju babu (Biju Patnaik) from the beginning of our career but for some reasons and discontent, we left the party in 2019," Nayak said. "After winning the election in 2019 on a BJP ticket, I realised that there is a lack of coordination between my associates and the people running the organisation of the BJP. I thank Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik for allowing me and my supporters to make a comeback to the party," Nayak said.

Senior BJD leaders Pratap Keshari Deb and MP Sasmit Patra were present on the occasion. Meanwhile, Patra Sunday mocked the BJP, saying that the latter could not find enough candidates for the 147 assembly constituencies of the state. Patra said that this is the reason why the party, despite declaring candidates for 21 Lok Sabha seats long back, is yet to announce the list of candidates for assembly constituencies. Responding to Patra, BJP leader Samir Mohanty said, "Declaration of candidates is an internal matter of the party... BJP doesn't need certificate from anyone. He said the party will field able and competent candidates to ensure the end of an inept government ruling the state for 25 years."

BJD's fort crumbling, says Bhartruhari Mahtab BJP's LS candidate for Cuttack LS seat

BHUBANESWAR(KCN): The ruling BJD's fort is crumbling and the party has realised it, said Bhartruhari Mahtab BJP's Lok Sabha candidate for the prestigious Cuttack seat. Bhartruhari on Sunday was accorded a grand welcome at Bhubaneswar airport. He was officially announced as BJP's nominee for the Cuttack Lok Sabha seat. The six-time Cuttack MP recently quit the



ruling BJD after expressing displeasure over the party's functioning and affairs. "It is time for a change. BJD's fort is crumbling

and the party has realised this. This change will happen in June 2024 and it will be proved by the people," said Bhartruhari after his arrival in Bhubaneswar. Bhartruhari Mahtab had joined the BJP on Thursday. Along with Bhartruhari, former BJD MP Siddhant Mohapatra and noted litterateur Padma Shri Damayanti Beshra also joined the BJP at party headquarters in Delhi. The son of Odisha's

former Chief Minister Harekrushna Mahtab, Bhartruhari has been representing the prestigious Cuttack Parliamentary seat since 1998. He had also been BJD's floor leader in Lok Sabha from 2014 to 2019. He emerged victorious as a Parliamentarian for successive six times in 1998, 1999, 2004, 2009, 2014, and 2019. No comments could be obtained from the BJD over Mahtab's comments.

Fighting big battle against corrupt, won't be intimidated by attacks: PM at Meerut rally

Meerut (UP): Lashing out at the opposition INDIA bloc, Prime Minister Narendra Modi Sunday said the attacks on him will not stop the fight against corruption and action will be taken against those involved in graft irrespective of their status. "When Modi is fighting the battle against corruption with full strength, these people have formed the INDI alliance. They think they will intimidate Modi, but for me, my Bharat is my family and I am taking steps to protect it from the corrupt," the prime minister said addressing his first rally in Uttar Pradesh after the announcement of the Lok Sabha election



schedule. Modi's counter-offensive came as the stalwarts of the INDIA bloc held a rally at the Ramlila Maidan in New Delhi in support of AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal and JMM leader Hemant Soren, arrested on graft charges, and accused the prime minister of adopting dictatorial policies. The prime minister said some people are rattled

because he is taking action against corruption. "I am fighting a big battle to save my country from the corrupt. That is why they are behind bars today and not getting bail even from the Supreme Court," Modi said. "The election is a fight between two camps. On one side you have the NDA committed to eradicating corruption, on the other side is the INDI Alliance focused on

protecting corrupt leaders. You have to decide whether corruption should be removed or not," he said at the rally in Meerut. "Corrupt people should listen... No matter how many attacks you make on Modi, this is Modi, he is not going to stop. No matter how big the corrupt person is, action will definitely be taken. The one who has looted the country will have to give it back. This is Modi's guarantee," he said. Raising the Katchatheevu island issue, Modi accused the Congress and the opposition alliance of trying to harm the country's unity and sovereignty.

Odisha Crime Branch busts racket involved in Rs1.04 cr fraud

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The Cyber Crime Unit of Odisha Crime Branch has busted a racket allegedly involved in misappropriation of money to the tune of more than Rs1.04 crores deposited in the ICICI Bank, Dhenkanal Branch during 2021-22, said a CB official Sunday. The Crime Branch (CB) has so far arrested three persons including a couple. The accused were identified as Swagatika Swain (28), her husband Manoj Kumar Sahoo (29), and their associate, Prasant Kumar Sahoo. Swagatika was posted at the Dhenkanal branch of the private bank as the relationship manager while accused Prasant, works as the Deputy Bank Manager. The fraud came to fore when some customers of the bank's Dhenkanal branch complained to the bank authorities about some suspicious unauthorised transactions from their ICICI bank accounts. "The bank had got an internal enquiry done and it was ascertained that fraudulent transactions were carried out in the form of unauthorised overdraft against fixed deposits. Such overdrafts were availed through i-Mobile application, fake investments in mutual funds, pre-closure of FD and misappropriation of premium amounts related to ICICI prudential policy. Swagatika had carried out the alleged disputed transactions for personal gain. All the alleged transactions were done from February 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022," stated the CB official. Later, the Regional Head of the ICICI Bank's Financial Crime Prevention Group lodged a complaint with the Crime Branch in December last year. The CB launched an investigation registering a case (33/23) in this regard.

Worth mentioning, a post-mortem of the tusker's carcass will be carried out tomorrow morning.

BJD Alleges Presence Of Railway Officials At BJP Meeting, Lodges Complaint With CEO



Bhubaneswar(KCN): The ruling Biju Janata Dal (BJD) today moved the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) in Odisha alleging model code of conduct (MCC) violation by three officials of the Indian

Railways' Khurda Division. A BJD delegation led by MPs Sasmit Patra and Sulata Deo lodged a complaint with the CEO, Odisha. In its complaint, the BJD

alleged that three officials of the Indian Railways' Khurda Division were present at a BJP meeting at Badapokharia under Tangi block in Khurda district in violation of the

MCC on March 29. As per the complaint, TTIs Prabhakar Baral and SR Pattnaik and IOW BB Mohanty were present at the BJP meeting, attended by party's Lok Sabha candidate for Bhubaneswar constituency Aparajita Sarangi. "The MCC has clearly stated that no government employee can indulge in any political activity or promote a political party during the elections. The presence of three Railway officials at BJP meeting is a clear violation of MCC," said the BJD in its complaint. The BJD urged CEO Nikunja Bihari Dhal to initiate stern action against the three Railway officials for MCC violation.

A Day After Quitting BJD, Actor-Turned-Politician Akash Dasnayak Joins BJP In Odisha



Bhubaneswar(KCN): A day after quitting the ruling BJD, actor-turned-politician Akash Dasnayak joined the BJP in Odisha on Sunday. Dasnayak, a former MLA from Korei constituency in Jajpur, joined BJP at its Odisha unit headquarters here ahead of the upcoming simultaneous Lok Sabha and Assembly elections in the state. BJP Odisha unit president

Manmohan Samal and other leaders of the party including Sameer Mohanty, Pradeep Panigrahi, Sidhant Mohapatra and Arindam Ray were present on the occasion. Dasnayak had been elected to the Odisha Assembly on a BJD ticket in 2014. He was the chairperson of Mo College initiative of the state government. Dasnayak was also the

star campaigner for ruling Biju Janata Dal (BJD). He had resigned from the ruling party yesterday. Dasnayak had tendered his resignation to BJD supremo and Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik. He had cited 'loss of self-respect' in BJD as the reason behind his resignation from the ruling party. "On hearing the voice of my inner soul, I am

resigning from the primary membership of the Biju Janata Dal for my self-esteem and self-respect of the people of Korei. My life is dedicated to the service of mankind and the people of Korei. I will take further course of action based on suggestions from my supporters and people of Korei," Dasnayak had said in a video message yesterday.

Movie Review: Kho Gaye Hum Kahan Is Compelling Coming-Of-Age Story In Digital Age

"We are so obsessed staring at the screen these days that we didn't realize life has gone past us," laments Ananya Panday's Ahaana in a poignant moment in Arjun V Singh's 'Kho Gaye Hum Kahan.' The hustle of living from one post to another, constant life updates, and the thirst for validation from the many faceless followers on social media are perhaps the story of our lives.

Debutante Director Arjun V Singh takes us into the world of three best friends. Imaad (Siddhant Chaturvedi) is a stand-up comic with a happy-go-lucky attitude towards every situation, including his dating life. If not on stage, he is busy swiping left and right on Tinder, the dating app. Ahaana (Ananya Panday) is Imaad's flatmate, a whiz who is in a long-term relationship with her boyfriend, whom she hopes



to marry. Then there is Neil (Adarsh Gourav), a gym trainer who aspires to have his studio someday. Like any regular 25-year-old, they are following their passion, working hard, and partying harder. Introspection of life happens over several bottles of beer; they keep no secrets from each other, or do they? Even though their parents don't understand their mindset—Imaad's rich father asks him to start working in the family's business, while Neil fails to understand the penny-pinching mindset of his working-class parents, who tell him that he does not know the difference between need and want. Ahaana, a brilliant professional with fancy degrees and medals to her credit, is a pushover who gets walked over by her boss as well as her boyfriend. But we live in a world where FOMO (Fear of Missing Out) is a thing. Keeping it private, keeping it real are passé. If it is not on social media, then it may as well not exist. We have given the rite of passage into our lives to strangers and people we are unlikely to meet since a thumbs up or down from them is what can make or break us. Take Ahaana; her heartbreak after getting dumped by her boyfriend is further amplified when she realizes his new girlfriend has over a million followers.

The unsure Ahana creates a fake account to stalk her boyfriend and starts putting out happy and sexy touched-up pictures of herself on Instagram to prove her life continues to rock. Imaad, on the other hand, who flits from one fling to another, meets an older and wiser woman (Kalki Koechelin), but being commitment-phobic, continues to see other women. Neil, who is dating his client LaLa (Any Singh), an influencer, cannot understand her obsession with filtered images and wanting to be constantly seen.

If a taxpayer is not satisfied with the assessment or Intimation, he can prefer an appeal before the Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals). Here are important issues relating to appeals.

1. Procedure for filing an appeal before CIT(A): Appeal should be filed in Form No. 35 within 30 days of receipt of Assessment Order and Demand Notice, before the CIT (A)/ JCIT (A). The appeals are generally required to be filed online and normally hearings are faceless. The following are required to be filed in appeal: a) Form No. 35 duly filled up, signed and verified b) Original Demand Notice c) Copy of Assessment Order d) Challan for payment of appeal fee.

2. Appeal before Joint Commissioner (Appeals) :As the first authority for appeal, Commissioner (Appeals) are currently overburdened due to the huge number of appeals and the pendency being carried forward every year. In order to clear this bottleneck, a new

authority being Joint Commissioner/Additional Commissioner for appeals has been created w.e.f. 1st April 2023 by the Finance Act, 2023 to handle certain appeal cases involving small amount of disputed demand. Such authority has all powers, responsibilities and accountability similar to that of Commissioner (Appeals) with respect to the procedure for disposal of appeals. However appeal cannot be filed before the Joint Commissioner (Appeals) where an order is passed by or with the approval of an income-tax authority above the rank of Deputy Commissioner.

3. Transfer of Appeal from CIT (Appeal) to JCIT (Appeal) :Section 246(2) provides that where any appeal filed against an order referred to in sub-section (1) is pending before the Commissioner (Appeals), the Board or an income-tax authority so authorised [Principal Director General of Income-tax (Systems) or

the Director General of Income-tax (Systems)] by the Board in this regard, may transfer such appeal and any matter arising out of or connected with such appeal and which is so pending, to the Joint Commissioner (Appeals) who may proceed with such appeal or matter, from the stage at which it was before it was so transferred. This will enable transfer of certain existing appeals filed before the Commissioner (Appeals) to the Joint Commissioner (Appeals). The Principal Director General of Income-tax (Systems) or the Director General of Income-tax (Systems), as the case may be, shall, with the approval of Central Board of Direct Taxes, devise a process to randomly allocate or transfer the appeals, to the JCIT (Appeals).

4. Appeal fee: The appeal shall be accompanied by a fee as under-

- In case total income computed by the A.O. is Rs. 1 lac or less Rs. 250
- In case total income computed by the A.O. is more than Rs. 1 lac but not more than Rs. 2 lacs Rs. 500
- In case total income computed by the A.O. exceeds Rs. 2 lacs Rs.1,000
- In any other

case Rs. 250

- In case of appeals under other direct taxes. Rs. 250

In case the appeal is filed after the expiry of prescribed time of 30 days, the appellate authority is empowered to condone the delay in appropriate cases.

Rule 45 of the Income Tax Rules 1962, mandates compulsory e-filing of appeals, in respect of persons who are required to furnish return of income electronically.

5. Faceless hearing of appeals before CIT (A)/JCIT (A): The Finance Act, 2020 has amended section 250 w.e.f. 1.4.2020 to automate the entire appeal process at the First Appellate level, including the process that follows after filing the appeal, the Central Government is now empowered to notify an e-appeal scheme for disposal of appeal before CIT (Appeals) so as to impart greater efficiency, transparency and accountability by:-

- (a) eliminating the interface between the CIT(A) and the appellant in the course of appellate proceedings to the extent technologically feasible;
- (b) optimising utilisation of the resources through economies of scale and functional specialisation;
- (c) introducing an appellate system with dynamic jurisdiction in which appeal shall be disposed of by one or

more CIT(A).

The CBDT has stated that hearing of all appeals before CIT (A) will be faceless w.e.f. 25th September, 2020. Likewise JCIT (A) has also to dispose off appeal in faceless manner.

6. Whether time taken for making application u/s 270AA for seeking immunity from penalty and prosecution is excluded for computing 30 days from the date of assessment for filing appeal: As per proviso to section 249(2)(b) inserted w.e.f. asst. year 2017- 18, where the assessee makes an application u/s 270AA (seeking immunity from penalty and prosecution), then the period beginning from the date on which such application is made to the date on which the order rejecting the application is served on the assessee, shall be excluded for calculating the 30 days period for filing of appeal before CIT appeal. In this connection it may be mentioned that the above rule applies only in respect of the orders passed on or after 01.03.2016- Ashraf Aziz Kasmaniv. ITO [2018] 92 taxmann.com 283 (Mumbai - Trib.).

7. What are the Appealable Orders under sec. 246 and e-filing scheme for appeals before First Appellate Authority: Section 246, substituted

by the Finance Act, 2023:

As per section 246(1), substituted by the Finance Act, 2023, any assessee aggrieved by orders of an Assessing Officer (below the rank of Joint Commissioner) may appeal to the Joint Commissioner (Appeals) against it. The Appealable Orders are:

- (a) an order being an intimation under sub-section (1) of section 143, where the assessee objects to the making of adjustments, or any order of assessment under sub-section (3) of section 143 or section 144, where the assessee objects to the amount of income assessed, or to the amount of tax determined, or to the amount of loss computed, or to the status under which he is assessed;
- (b) an order of a s s e s s m e n t , reassessment or re-computation under section 147;
- (c) an order being an intimation under sub-section (1) of section 200A;
- (d) an order under section 201;
- (e) an order being an intimation under sub-section (6A) of section 206C;
- (f) an order under sub-section (1) of section 206CB;
- (g) an order imposing a penalty under Chapter XXI; and
- (h) an order under section 154 or section

155 amending any of the orders mentioned in clauses (a) to (g). Notification No. 33/2023 dated 29.05.2023 regarding e-Appeals Scheme, 2023: CBDT has notified e-Appeals Scheme, 2023 vide Notification No. 33/2023 dated 29.05.2023.

8. Powers of Joint Commissioner (Appeals) and Commissioner (Appeals) under sec. 251: In disposing of an appeal, the C o m m i s s i o n e r (Appeals)] shall have the following powers as per section 251(1)—

- (a) in an appeal against an order of assessment, he may confirm, reduce, enhance or annul the assessment;
- (aa) in an appeal against the order of assessment in respect of which the proceeding before the Settlement Commission abates under section 245HA, he may, after taking into consideration all the material and other information produced by the assessee before, or the results of the inquiry held or evidence recorded by, the Settlement Commission, in the course of the proceeding before it and such other material as may be brought on his record, confirm, reduce, enhance or annul the assessment;
- (b) in an appeal against an order imposing a penalty, he may confirm or cancel such order or vary it so as either to enhance or to reduce the penalty;

- (c) in any other case, he may pass such orders in the appeal as he thinks fit.

In disposing of an appeal, the Joint Commissioner (Appeals) shall have the following powers as per section 251(1A)—

- (a) in an appeal against an order of assessment, he may confirm, reduce, enhance or annul the assessment;
- (b) in an appeal against an order imposing a penalty, he may confirm or cancel such order or vary it so as either to enhance or to reduce the penalty;
- (c) in any other case, he may pass such orders in the appeal as he thinks fit.

As per section 251(2), CIT (Appeals) or JCIT (Appeals) shall not enhance an assessment or a penalty or reduce the amount of refund unless the appellant has had a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against such enhancement or reduction. In disposing of an appeal, the CIT (Appeals)] or JCIT (Appeals) may consider and decide any matter arising out of the proceedings in which the order appealed against was passed, notwithstanding that such matter was not raised before CIT (Appeals) or JCIT (Appeals) by appellant.

Advances in Early Detection Methods for Cervical Cancer

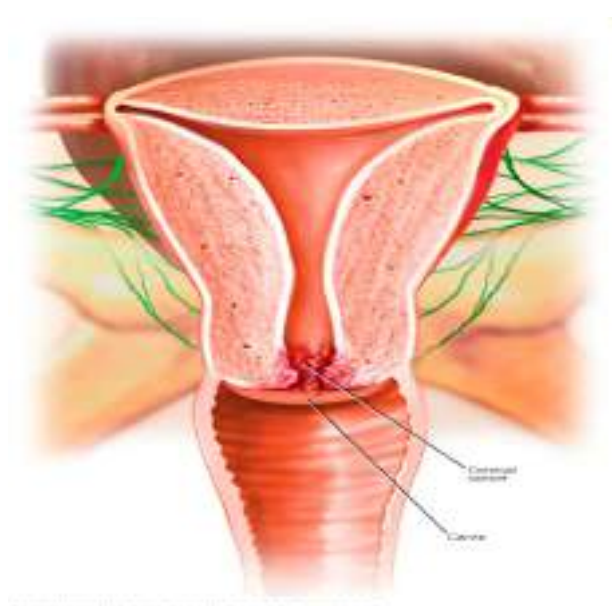

Malignant cells, a name synonymous with fear and anxiety, implies to a group of uncontrolled cell growths that attack and disrupt healthy tissues. Among these, cervical cancer is a foremost concern of women globally. It begins in the cervix, the lower part of the uterus that connects to vagina. Even though there are substantial advancements in the prevention and treatment, cervical cancer remains the fourth most common cancer among the women globally. Around 604,000 women are diagnosed with cervical cancer and 342,000 women die from the disease globally each year.

Understanding Cervical Cancer, types, and warning signs: The cervix is the lower part of the uterus connecting it to the vagina. Cervical cancer is often triggered by the Human papillomavirus (HPV), which ascends from irregular cell growth in the cervix. While most HPV viruses clear on their own, certain strains persists, leading to precancerous changes

and, if left undetected, it potentially progresses to cervical cancer. While cervical cancer is denoted as a single entity, it can be differentiated into diverse types:

- Squamous Cell Carcinoma - Approximately 70-80% of cervical cancers are derived from the squamous cells. These cells are thin, flat cells covering the outer surface of cervix, also known as ectocervix.
- Adenocarcinoma - These cancerous cells are formed in glandular cells, which are positioned deep within the cervix, known as endocervix or cervical canal. This makes up roughly to 20-30% of cervical cancer cases. Adenocarcinomas can at times be more threatening and destructive than squamous cell carcinomas and may spread more quickly.
- Rare types - Melanomas, Sarcomas, and Lymphomas are the rare types of cancer that are less frequent to happen in the cervix compared to other parts of the body. Possible warning signs and



symptoms may include:

- V a g i n a l Bleeding between periods, after menopause or after sexual intercourse
- Pelvic discomfort
- U n u s u a l discharge that may be watery, bloody or have a strong odor
- Unexpected and constant back pain

Key factors that drives the rise of growing cervical malignancy:

- H u m a n papillomavirus (HPV) infection: A sexually transmitted infection is primarily considered as an instrumental aspect for the growth of tumorous cells in the cervix

- Poor immune system: Health illnesses like HIV/AIDS can negotiate the body's capability to combat several infections
- S e x u a l intercourse and multiple sexual partners: Having multiple sexual partners or having intercourse with an infected person increases the chance of HPV exposure.
- Smoking and consumption of Tobacco: Tobacco undermines the immune system and increases the risk of HPV persistence. Diagnosis and Early Detection: Diagnosis and early detection of cervical

cancer at an early stage can substantially enhance the therapy options. Some of the effective methods and elementary screening tools include-

- Pap Test- This test analyses cervical cells for irregularities suggestive of precancerous or cancerous alterations.
- HPV Test- This test detects the presence of HPV, the virus responsible for most of the cervical cancers

Regular check-ups and screening is advised by the healthcare professionals. Some of the advanced diagnostics are offering new avenues for detection of the cervical cancer.

- Colposcopy: Colposcopy is often used in conjunction with the pap tests. This approach involves examination of the cervix in the dubious areas using a magnifying scope.
- Liquid-based Pap Tests: These tests offer improvised precision and ease of interpretation compared to conventional pap stains.

Beyond Diagnosis:

Dietary considerations

- Ensure to have fruits and vegetables rich in antioxidants, these enhance the overall physical condition and well-being
- Foods rich in omega-3 fatty acids can play a paramount role in lowering infections and promoting immune function
- Consume whole grains as much as possible, as these provides fibre and improves hormone balance and helps in detoxification

While innovations in early detection and medications are encouraging, the fight against cervical cancer needs a multi-pronged approach. This involves promoting extensive access to effective screening programs, e n c o u r a g i n g immunisation against HPV, and creating awareness about the prominence of healthy lifestyle choices.

Former Bihar Congress President Quits Party Ahead Of Lok Sabha Polls

"Cross 200-Mark": Mamata Banerjee's Challenge To BJP For 2024 Polls

Patna(KCN): In a setback to the Congress in Bihar ahead of Lok Sabha polls, former state president Anil Sharma on Sunday quit the party, claiming that it was stuck in a "disastrous" partnership with the RJD.

Making the announcement at a press conference here, Anil Sharma also voiced disgust over the recent induction, "with much fanfare", of controversial former MP Rajesh Ranjan alias Pappu Yadav.

"Today, the party leadership is busy with a rally in Delhi where it is talking of the need to save democracy. Sadly, though, no democracy can be seen in the Congress where even our duly elected national president can take no step without consulting Rahul Gandhi or his close aide KC Venugopal," alleged Anil Sharma.

Anil Sharma became the fourth former Bihar Congress president to have quit the party in



nearly a decade. The latest instance was that of Ashok Chaudhary, who quit the party and joined JD(U) in 2018, a few months after a factional feud caused him to give up the state president's post.

Earlier, in 2015, Ram Jatan Sinha had quit the Congress and after a brief stint in JD(U), he has been in political wilderness. The year before saw Mehboob Ali Kaiser joining late Ram Vilas Paswan's LJP which helped him enjoy two consecutive terms in Lok Sabha from

Khagaria. However, Anil Sharma insisted he was cut from a different cloth, stating, "I joined Congress in 1985. In nearly four decades, I held organisational posts twice, as state general secretary and then as state president. Never did I lobby for a ticket or a legislative council berth for myself. Nor have I explored possibilities in any other party before quitting the Congress." About the timing of his step that comes just ahead of the Lok Sabha polls, he said, "I have,

since my state president days, been critical of the tie-up with RJD which has helped them thrive at our expense. In the eyes of the people, we have only ended up being held guilty of supporting the jungle raj of Lalu Prasad and Rabri Devi." Anil Sharma said the last straw came when Pappu Yadav was inducted into the party.

"He was virtually felicitated at the national headquarters. The party is upset that Lalu has thwarted its attempt to give Yadav a ticket. Instead, it should have

thought about many better candidates, who are not getting a chance because Congress leadership cannot assert itself before the domineering ally," he said. Notably, out of the 40 Lok Sabha seats in Bihar, the RJD is contesting 26, leaving nine for Congress and five for three Left parties.

Replying to a question, Anil Sharma said the choice of candidates by the RJD showed "tickets have been put up for sale, without taking into account winnability", and that possibility of a "tacit understanding" with BJP, as is speculated by a section of the media in the case of Mayawati's BSP in adjoining Uttar Pradesh, "can certainly not be ruled out".

Meanwhile, state Congress media cell chairman Rajesh Rathore issued a statement slamming Anil Sharma for trying to make "a cowardly escape" and find "an excuse for falling at the feet of Narendra Modi".



Krishnanagar(KCN): West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Sunday mocked the BJP-led NDA's target of winning 400-plus seats in the Lok Sabha polls and challenged the saffron party to win at least 200 constituencies.

The TMC chief also reaffirmed her refusal to allow the enforcement of the Citizenship Amendment Act in the state and cautioned the people that applying for CAA would turn an applicant into a foreigner and urged them not to apply for it. "The BJP is saying '400 paar', I challenge them to cross the 200-seat benchmark first. In the 2021 West Bengal assembly polls, they aimed for 200 plus seats but had to stop at 77. Some of these 77 have since joined us," she said while campaigning for TMC candidate Mahua Moitra in the Krishnanagar area.

Dubbing the BJP a 'jumla' party, the TMC supremo accused them of "peddling lies" regarding the CAA, stating "Modi's guarantee on CAA is a zero guarantee." "The CAA is a trap to turn legal citizens into foreigners. Once you implement CAA, NRC will follow. We would allow neither CAA nor NRC in West Bengal. Don't fall for the false assurance of the central government. If you

apply, you will be designated as a foreigner for 5 years," Ms Banerjee said while addressing her first rally in the election season after her injury earlier this month.

Reaching out to the Matua community, who are expected to benefit most from the implementation of the CAA, the TMC supremo urged the community to have faith in her, stating she would never allow "anyone to snatch your citizenship." "Matuas, please have faith in me. I will not allow anyone to snatch your citizenship. Do you want that or want to live peacefully? Through CAA, they will snatch everything from you and keep you in a detention camp," she said.

Matuas, originally from East Pakistan, are a weaker section of Hindus who migrated to India during the partition and after the creation of Bangladesh following religious persecution. Since the 90s, political parties have courted the support of the Matuas, whose substantial population and tendency to vote cohesively make them a valuable voting bloc akin to minority groups, particularly in alignment with the BJP's stance on the CAA.

According to the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA), rules of which were notified on

March 13, the government will now start granting Indian nationality to persecuted non-Muslim migrants - Hindus, Sikhs, Jains, Buddhists, Parsis, and Christians - from Pakistan, Bangladesh, and Afghanistan who arrived in India before December 31, 2014.

Praising Moitra for her fight against the BJP, Ms Banerjee said, "Despite Mahua Moitra being elected by you people (electorate), she was expelled unceremoniously." "We have again re-nominated her from this seat. Mahua was expelled as she was most vocal against the BJP in parliament. You people have to ensure her victory with a record margin," she said.

Ms Banerjee criticized the opposition bloc INDIA partners -- CPI(M) and Congress -- for "joining hands with the BJP" in West Bengal.

"There is no INDIA alliance in West Bengal. The CPI (M) and Congress are working for the BJP in Bengal. I have formed this INDIA bloc and gave it this name. After elections we will look into it," she said.

The chief minister urged the voters not to vote for the Left-Congress-ISF alliance candidates in the state as voting for them means "voting for the BJP."

"No Plan To Take Electoral Route," Say Farmers Ahead Of 2024 Polls

New Delhi(KCN): Nearly three decades ago, over a thousand farmers in Tamil Nadu, unhappy with governance policies, filed nominations from a single constituency in the Lok Sabha polls to draw attention to their grievances.

It was also the only time when the Election Commission (EC) had to adapt by issuing a "ballot book" instead of traditional "ballot papers" to accommodate the unexpected 1,033 candidates from Erode district's Modakurichi.

However, farmers from Punjab, who have been camping at the state's border with Haryana for almost two months now, do not think electoral



politics is the way to go. These farmers began a march to Delhi on February 13 to press their demands for a legal guarantee of minimum support price (MSP) for their crops and a farm loan waiver, etc., but were stopped at the Haryana border by security personnel.

The farmers have been camping at the Shambhu and Khanauri points

between Punjab and Haryana since then. All India Kisan Sabha member Krishna Prasad said the farmers are committed to opposing the BJP government and its policies.

"But we do not plan to take that (electoral) route. In the mahapanchayat held in Delhi, we had announced our stance to oppose the BJP and expose its

policies. We are united in this cause," Prasad told PTI. Rashtriya Kisan Mahasangh member Abhimanyu Kohar said, "We have been sitting at the borders since February 13 and we have distanced ourselves from electoral politics. We believe that all parties support farmers when in opposition but when in power, they all become pro-corporate and anti-farmer." When 1,033 farmers from Modakurichi filed nominations for the 1996 Lok Sabha elections, the EC had to print "ballot papers like newspapers" and deploy over four-foot-tall ballot boxes. Voting hours were also extended to accommodate the long

list of candidates.

In that election, DMK's Subbula kshmi Jagadeesan emerged victorious, defeating ADMK's R N Kittusamy. Barring Jagadeesan, Kittusamy and an independent, all candidates lost their deposits. While 88 candidates received no votes, 158 polled just one vote each. The 1996 general elections also saw the highest number of candidates at 13,000. Following this, the EC increased the security deposit amount from ? 500 to ? 10,000. This apparently helped in bringing down the number of contestants per seat to 8.75 in the 1998 Lok Sabha elections.

INDIA Bloc's "5 Demands" To Election Commission At Mega Rally In Delhi

New Delhi(KCN): The INDIA bloc's rally at Delhi's Ramlila Maidan this afternoon, was a massive show of strength where the leaders of all major opposition parties pressed for the release of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Jharkhand's former Chief Minister Hemant Soren. The leaders flagged concerns about the health of the country's democracy, accusing the BJP of decimating the Opposition through the Central investigative agencies. The BJP hit back, declaring that the rally was not about saving democracy as projected but a "save family" and "hide corruption" rally.

Congress's Priyanka Gandhi Vadra listed five demands of the Opposition to the Election Commission that included

the provision of a level playing field before the elections.

Efforts to forcefully scuttle the finances of Opposition parties should be immediately stopped, Ms Gandhi Vadra said, without mentioning the freeze on Congress funds and the latest Income Tax notice. Action by the Enforcement Directorate, CBI and the Income Tax department should also be stopped, she said, reading out the list of demands.

The alliance also demanded a Supreme Court-monitored Special Investigation Team investigate what they called the BJP's "extortion" of funds through the electoral bonds scheme.

The "Loktantra Bachao Rally", the leaders said, is a mark of the INDIA bloc's commitment to

fighting, winning, and saving democracy in India.

"If the BJP wins these fixed elections and changes the Constitution, the country will be on fire," declared Congress's Rahul Gandhi. "You have to decide if you want democracy or dictatorship... Those who support dictatorship need to be kicked out of the country," added party chief Mallikarjun Kharge.

"A new energy in the politics of India has been born today... Today, the slogan for independence is being raised here... It is our independence that our Constitution and our republic are protected. We will gain this independence," said CPM's Sitaram Yechury. Punjab Chief Minister and senior Aam Aadmi



Party leader Bhagwant Mann declared that Arvind Kejriwal was not a man but an ideology. "You can arrest Arvind Kejriwal, but how will you arrest his ideology? In which jail will you send the lakhs of Kejriwals that are born in India?" he said, reiterating the party stance on the arrest of the Chief Minister, which

took place on the eve of the general elections in the country. Mr Kejriwal's wife Sunita Kejriwal and Hemant Soren's wife Kalpana Soren were also present at today's rally.

The arrest has brought together the Opposition bloc, which was making more headlines recently over its differences than

its unity.

A case in point was Trinamool Congress chief Mamata Banerjee's decision to go it alone in Bengal instead of the agreed-upon sit-sharing formula. She even said that her membership of INDIA bloc was on hold and she would review the matter after the election. Her party MP Derek

O'Brien, however, staunchly declared today that Trinamool "very much was, is and will be part of the INDIA alliance". "This is a fight of BJP versus democracy," he added. The rally also comes on a day Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged off the BJP campaign in Uttar Pradesh. Samajwadi Party chief Akhilesh Yadav, though, appeared unfazed. Appearing at the rally, Mr Yadav said, "These people are giving the slogan of '400 Paar'. If you are going to win more than 400 seats, then why are you scared of the AAP leader".

"You have sent elected Chief Ministers to jail. Not just the Indians but the whole world is criticising it," he said, without explicitly mentioning the comments

that have come on the subject from the United Nations, United States and Germany.

BJP spokesperson Sudhanshu Trivedi told reporters that the Opposition rally was meant to hide their acts of corruption.

"The Congress is supporting those who have looted the country as Congress has also looted throughout their tenure. From the days of Pandit Nehru, the Jeep scam to the Bofors scam; the coal scam to the commonwealth scam and the 2G scam. All these happened while Congress was in power," said Union Minister Pralhad Joshi.

"In Ramlila Maidan, those who put dots in between the name of this country and speak about saving the nation.

Sales struggle leaves marigold growers helpless

Sambalpur(KCN): Farmers in Sambalpur district are showing interest in cultivating vegetables and other cash crops while the paddy yield is not as profitable as before. A few years ago in Sanatanpali block, farmers were earning handsomely by cultivating flowers. Seeing this, the farmers of surrounding areas showed interest in floriculture. Many farmers have grown flowers this year in Thakurmali, Baham, Kabrapali, Paikamal, Ghenupali, Jayantpur as

well as Sanatanpali. In particular, marigold cultivation has doubled over the past years. However, the farmers have expressed concern about flower sales and market. Nirakar Pradhan, who started flower cultivation in Sanatanpali, says, "This year, marigold has been cultivated on about 10 acres of land in the village." In the past years, at this time, marigold flowers were being sold at ₹50 per kg in the market. This year, however, due to more production, the shopkeepers are paying

30 rupees per kg. He said with frustration that he had to face a lot of trouble while getting back outstanding amounts from the flower retailers. Flower growers of other villages have also complained about the same. While Sambalpur market is the only option for selling flowers, owing to increased supply, the shopkeepers are exploiting the farmers and buying at lower prices. However, even after 10 years of the government's



announcement, the construction of a state-of-the-art market terminal at Nildunguri could not go ahead. Apart from this, ways to export flowers to other states and abroad

could also be opened, said the local flower growers. On the other hand, Manbodh Barik, director of the Sabuja Sanatanpali Farmers Producer Company

Limited which consists of more than a thousand farmers in Sanatanpali, said that the district administration was advised to build a 'model mandi' in the

village. But that has not happened yet, which is why the growers are forced to go to distant Sambalpur to sell flowers. Due to this, they have to face many hurdles and resort to distressed sales. Finding no other way, the farmers are selling flowers on behalf of the Farmers Producer Company. There are about 70 flower growers in the area with daily production of over 1,000 kg marigolds. But it is not enough to send flowers out in one vehicle. If more flowers are produced, arrangements can be made for export to other

states and big cities. This is why a 'model market' is necessary, the farmers said. Horticulture department official Sushree Mousumi said, "After increasing the production of chilli in the district, arrangements are being made to sell it with the help of ORMAS. While marigold production is increasing in the district, farmers are selling the flowers on their own initiative. If the farmers inform us about the problems in flower sale, we will discuss with the ORMAS and the district administration and try to make arrangements."

Andhra's 'power ploy' to hold elections in Kotia



Pottangi(KCN): The neighbouring Andhra Pradesh has been continuously trespassing into the disputed region of Kotia panchayat under Pottangi block of Koraput district and taking various steps to influence the local residents. With the general elections being around the corner, Andhra Pradesh officials are

now trying to provide power supply to the residents in Kotia and make voters participate in the Andhra election process. In this process, the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Department has supplied digital meters to the villagers of Tala Ganjeipadar village. Earlier, Andhra Pradesh had set up infrastructure in the region to provide power services to the

villagers. They have also provided digital meters to around 39 beneficiaries after filling the forms. However, after getting information about the development, the local block officials intervened and asked the AP officials to go back. Left with no option, the AP officials returned. On the other hand, Odisha government has provided digital meters to

only a few households in the villages and the local administration has not taken any serious steps so far to provide electricity services to the residents. However, Andhra has already set up its infrastructure to provide electricity to the households in the region. Informing about the development, a villager said that Andhra officials have taken steps to attract voters and influence the people of the area as the general elections are drawing closer. The first phase of general elections will be held in both Koraput and Andhra Pradesh April 13. The Andhra government is desperately trying to hold elections in the disputed Kotia region. However, no officials of the district administration in Koraput were available for comments.

People will vote for me to elect Modi as Prime Minister: BJP's Jual Oram


Sundargarh(KCN): Senior BJP leader and former Union minister Jual Oram, who is contesting from the Sundargarh LS seat for eight times in Odisha, Saturday said the people will vote for him to elect Prime Minister Narendra Modi to build a 'Viksit Bharat' (developed India). Oram, who is pitted against BJD's Dilip Tirkey, Saturday said he has been fighting from the Sundargarh LS seat since 1991, and he was elected five times by the people of his constituency, between 1998 and 2019, except in 2009. "In the 2009 elections, I was defeated because of my fault. There was some issue in election management," he said. The MP said he visited 50 panchayats and met people on the 'Viksit Bharat' programme and found that PM Modi's guarantee is working on the ground and people have accepted Modi as their prime minister. "So we will win this election as people want to make Modi the Prime Minister," he asserted. Stating that more than



Rs 5,000 crore fund remained unspent in Sundergarh district, the BJP leader alleged that the BJD government is not working to develop the tribal-majority district. Not only in Sundergarh, the Odisha government has also failed to provide basic drinking water facilities to the state's rural population. While piped water supply connection reached more than 80 per cent of rural households in many states, the performance of Odisha is very poor, since half of its population has been deprived of the facility, he alleged. As the state government is not cooperating for 'political' reasons, the

projects, which should have been completed in a year, are taking more than three years to get completed, Oram pointed out. "The BJD government has misled the people that they are giving rice to the people and grabbed the votes. When PM Modi announced free rice for all ration card holders for five years, people of Odisha now realized that Modi is giving them the rice," the MP said. Speaking about development works done by the NDA government, he said that rural roads, electricity and telecom connectivity have been enhanced across the country during

the past 10 years. The Centre has initiated a lot of development work in his constituency, he said. The Bimalgarh-Talcher new railway line project has been taken up, an international hockey stadium has been constructed, a new airport was built in Rourkela, and the Vande Bharat train service has also been introduced in Rourkela, Oram pointed out. Odisha has 21 Lok Sabha seats and 147 Assembly constituencies. The Lok Sabha and state assembly elections will be held simultaneously in four phases on May 13, 20, 25 and June 1.
