

## PRESIDENT OF INDIA LAUNCHES INDIA'S FIRST HOME-GROWN GENE THERAPY FOR CANCER

NEW DELHI, (KCN): The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu launched India's first home-grown gene therapy for cancer at IIT Bombay today (April 4, 2024).

Speaking on the occasion, the President said that the launch of India's first gene therapy is a major breakthrough in our battle against cancer. As this line of treatment, named "CAR-T cell therapy", is accessible and affordable, it provides a new hope for the whole of humankind. She expressed confidence that it will be successful in giving new lives to countless patients.

The President said that CAR-T cell therapy is considered to be one of the most phenomenal



advances in medical science. It has been available in the developed nations for some time, but it is extremely costly, and beyond the reach of most patients around the world. She was happy to note that the therapy being launched today is the world's most affordable CAR-T cell therapy. She

said that it is also an example of the 'Make in India' initiative; a shining example of the 'Atmanirbhar Bharat'. The President was happy to note that India's first CAR-T cell therapy is developed through collaboration between the Indian Institute of Technology, IIT Bombay and Tata Memorial Hospital in association with industry partner ImmunoACT. She said that this is a praiseworthy example of academia-industry partnership, which should inspire many more similar efforts. The President said that IIT Bombay is

renowned, not only in India but across the world, as a model of technology education. In the development of CAR-T cell therapy, technology is not only being put in the service of humanity, but partnerships have been with an eminent institution from another field as well as with industry. This has been made possible by the focus IIT, Bombay has placed on research and development over the last three decades. She said that with the knowledge base and skills of the faculty and students of IIT Bombay and other similar institutions, India as a whole, would benefit greatly from the technological revolution underway.

## Odisha govt declares holidays for its employees on voting days

Bhubaneswar (KCN):

The Odisha government Thursday announced localised public holidays in respective constituencies during the four-phased Lok Sabha and assembly polls. Elections in the state will be held May 13, May 20, May 25 and June 1.

"The government of Odisha has been pleased to declare holiday for the employees of the state government offices and magisterial courts (executive) on May 13 (Monday), May 20 (Monday), May 25 (Saturday) and June 1 (Saturday) for the offices located within the

parliamentary constituencies and assembly segments coming within those parliamentary constituencies in order to

Sundergarh, Bolangir, Kandhamal and Aska MP constituencies along with 35 assembly seats coming under these LS seats will vote on May 20.

In the third phase, slated for May 25, six parliamentary constituencies — Sambalpur, Keonjhar, Dhenkanal, Cuttack, Puri, and Bhubaneswar — will go to polls. On the same day, polling will also be held for 42 assembly constituencies coming under these LS seats.

In the final phase scheduled June 1, the remaining six constituencies — Mayurbhanj, Balasore, Bhadrak, Jajpur, Kendrapara, and Jagatsinghpur — will vote along with 42 assembly segments.

## 'Water Bell' introduced in Odisha schools for drinking water breaks



Bhubaneswar (KCN): Wary of the heat wave conditions in Odisha as forecast by weathermen, the School and Mass Education department

has directed all schools to strictly implement a water bell system to keep students and teachers hydrated.

The department issued a

letter on Thursday to the district education officers and the block education officers to ensure the implementation of the system this summer.

As per the direction, a bell will be rung thrice during school hours — at 8.30 am, 10 am and 11 am to remind students that they should drink water to stay hydrated amid heat wave and sultry conditions.

Usually, the rise in temperatures can trigger dehydration, which can affect nutrient transport, joint health and energy levels in the body. Amid heat wave conditions, proper intake of water regulates temperature and organ function in the body.

The system is also aimed at encouraging students to inculcate the habit of drinking water even after school hours.

## Punjab police with central forces chalks out strategy to ensure free and fair polls

Chandigarh (JAG MOHAN THAKEN), April 4, 2024: Giving a call for greater synergy and teamwork between BSF and Punjab Police, Spl DGP Arpit Shukla exhorted both forces to work as one team to ensure free and fair elections in the border state.

The Special DGP accompanied by IG Frontier Headquarters, BSF Jalandhar Dr Atul Fulzele was holding a joint coordination meeting with the senior officers of Punjab Police, BSF, CRPF, ITBP, Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and other central agencies to review security arrangements at the



drugs from across the border.

He said that being positioned at the first line of defence, the BSF needs to be more alert to prevent smuggling and infiltration bids by militants, terrorists or smugglers. He also

ordered to enhance the number of Police personnel deployed on night patrolling along the international border.

The Spl DGP advised the BSF to use drone detection technology to counter the Drone operations at Punjab

borders, which have emerged as the new modus operandi to smuggle drugs from across the border. He also directed all the SSPs of border districts to conduct regular meetings with Village Level Defence Committee (VLDC) members and sensitise field staff and VLDC members to keep a strict vigil on the movement of drones.

As per the information, there were 325 drone sightings across the border in 2023, of which 118 drones

were successfully recovered. Similarly, 26 drones have been recovered in 2024 so far.

Sharing details on security arrangements for the upcoming Lok Sabha Elections, Spl DGP Arpit Shukla said that security has been beefed up across the state and Punjab Police has mobilised 75 percent from district police and 50% police force from other units for deployment during elections.

He said that the Punjab Police have already laid well-coordinated strong inter-state naks at all the sealing points of 10 border districts in the state to stop the menace

of liquor and drug smuggling. The 10 inter-state border districts include Pathankot, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Fazilka, Ropar, SAS Nagar, Patiala, Sangrur, Mansa, Hoshiarpur and Bathinda.

He said that the 25 companies of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) have been deployed in vulnerable districts of the state to instil confidence among the general public as well as to dominate sensitive and hyper-sensitive areas in the state. The 25 companies include five coys of Central Reserve Police Forces (CRPF), 15 coys of Border Security Force (BSF) and five coys of Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP).

# Heat wave in Odisha to continue, IMD advises precautions during election rallies

**Bhubaneswar, (KCN):** The grueling heat wave, which is presently sweeping many parts of the state, is expected to continue for three more days with day temperature very likely to increase up to three degrees Celsius. It being the election season, the weather department has advised people to avoid exposure to the sun during gatherings, political rallies and meetings.

The regional centre of the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has

issued a yellow warning to six districts. The warning will remain in force till April 6. The districts that have been issued yellow warnings are Bolangir, Keonjhar, Boudh, Malkangiri, Nayagarh and Angul. Similarly, a yellow warning on account of an expected rise in night temperature has been issued to four districts till April 6.

These districts are Bolangir, Kandhamal, Bhadrak and Boudh. As the blistering heat wave is predicted to singe Odisha for more than three days

three days, the IMD has cautioned people against exposing themselves to the sun for extended hours. People have been advised to stay indoors. However, people may heave a sigh of relief.

after April 6 when the temperature is expected to plummet by two to four degrees Celsius informed IMD. “The ongoing heat wave conditions are expected to continue for three more days. It will continue till April 6. Thereafter, it is likely that the temperature will decrease by two to four degrees Celsius. During these three days, people are advised to stay indoors and avoid exposing themselves to the sun,” said IMD’s regional director Monorama Mehta.

## 'Crew' box office Day 6: Kareena Kapoor film remains steady, earns Rs 41 crore



The box office collection of 'Crew' has stabilised after a good opening weekend in the theatres. As per an industry tracker's early estimates, the film added another Rs 3.25 crore on Wednesday, April 3, bringing the total net domestic collection to Rs 40.70 crore. The makers of 'Crew' shared on Wednesday that after five days, the Kareena Kapoor, Tabu and Kriti Sanon-led film amassed a total of Rs 77.33 crore globally. They are yet to update the film's sixth-day worldwide collection. In India, the film's gross box

office collection is Rs 44.25 crore. On Wednesday, the film had an overall 11.60 per cent Hindi occupancy, with night shows registering the maximum footfall. 'Crew' began its run at the ticket windows on March 29 (Friday) with an earning of Rs 9.25 crore. The number grew over the next two days as it earned Rs 9.75 crore on Saturday and Rs 10.5 crore on Sunday. It also passed the crucial first Monday test by adding Rs 4.2 crore to its total collection. 'Crew' is Kareena's first hit since 2019. Her last release, 'Laal Singh

## Encourage People From Manipur Living Outside To Vote In State: Delhi Meitei Forum

New Delhi (KCN): A civil society group based in Delhi and run by working professionals from Manipur has appealed to people from the crisis-hit state who are living across the country to return home, if they can, to participate in the electoral process in the world's largest democracy.

Manipur has two Lok Sabha seats - Inner Manipur, and a reserved seat, Outer Manipur. The Lok Sabha elections will be held in the state that's recovering from ethnic clashes between the Kuki-Zo tribes and the Meiteis, and where over 45,000 people are still living in relief camps. "We would like to appeal to everyone from Manipur, from all communities, who are living outside the state to go to Manipur and cast their vote in this Lok

Sabha election," the civil society group Delhi Meitei Forum (DMF) said in a statement.

"Travel to Manipur is expensive, so we understand that's a roadblock. However, whoever can afford to go to Manipur should participate in the electoral process in the world's largest democracy," said the DMF, which has been proving aid and other humanitarian relief to internally displaced people in Manipur.

"Choosing a good leader is the need of the hour more than ever, a leader who can solve the Manipur crisis and bring peace for all communities," a key member of the DMF said.

The DMF said it is a "completely independent group" working for the well-being of the Meitei community, and asked

other civil society groups not to include its name as a partner or a member in their activities. DMF sources said they have seen some groups using the DMF name as a partner in their communication to the authorities, which should not be done to avoid legal issues. Another group, the Delhi Meitei Coordinating Committee (DMCC), had in a statement said it has written to the Chief Justice of India, the Chief Election Commissioner, and other constitutional authorities to defer the Lok Sabha elections in Manipur. The DMCC had mentioned the DMF is part of the D M C C "conglomeration", which DMF sources said is simply wrong. The Inner Manipur constituency will see a massive electoral battle among candidates who all have wide acceptance among the public, leaving voters spoilt for choices. The BJP has fielded Manipur Education Minister and former Indian Police Service

officer Thounaojam Basanta Kumar Singh, and the Congress has fielded Angomcha Bimal Akojam, who is a professor in Delhi's Jawaharlal Nehru University. This would be Mr Akojam's first electoral contest. Maheshwar Thounaojam of the Republican Party of India (Athawale) is also giving a spirited fight. The BJP is not contesting in Outer Manipur, but supporting Kachui Timothy Zimik, a candidate of the BJP's ally Naga People's Front (NPF). The Congress has fielded Alfred Kanngam S Arthur in this constituency. The entire Inner Manipur constituency and some areas under Outer Manipur will vote on April 19. The remaining areas under Outer Manipur will vote on April 26. Votes will be counted on June 4.

## PM Modi Sets Ambitious India Economic Goals For Probable 3rd Term

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi, confident of winning the national election starting this month, has set an ambitious target of roughly doubling the economy and exports this decade, according to a government document seen by news agency

Reuters. PM Modi has highlighted economic growth as one of his biggest achievements in election rallies and has "guaranteed" making the economy the third-largest in the world from fifth now if he wins a third term in a row as

polls predict. He has already asked officials to finalise plans by around May to expand the economy to \$6.69 trillion in nominal terms by 2030, from around \$3.51 trillion currently, according to the October document. Though short on concrete details of

how to achieve that, it has been a basis for officials' meetings. When he took office for a second term five years ago, PM Modi promised to take the economy to \$5 trillion by the current fiscal year, but partly due to COVID-19 related disruptions, meeting that

target is virtually impossible now. For the next six years, PM Modi's goal is to raise per capita income to \$4,418 from around \$2,500, the document says, without specifying the spending or reforms needed to achieve that.

## Sunita Kejriwal Reads Out Jailed Husband's Statement, Background Raises Eyebrows

New Delhi (KCN): When Arvind Kejriwal's wife, Sunita, delivered another message from the jailed chief minister to the people of Delhi on Thursday, what stood out was the background in her video statement. In all her addresses so far, the backdrop had portraits of legendary freedom fighter Bhagat Singh and the Father of the Indian Constitution, BR Ambedkar, but there was a new addition between them in the latest video - a picture of Arvind Kejriwal with bars in front of him to

signify his imprisonment. "Mr Kejriwal has sent a message to all of you from jail: I am in prison but no person in Delhi should have to suffer because of that. Every MLA should visit their constituencies every day and ask people if they are facing any problems. They should sort those problems out. I am not just talking about solving problems related to the government, we should attempt to solve their other problems too. The 2 crore people of Delhi are my family. No one should be unhappy. God

bless them all. Jai Hind," Ms Kejriwal said in Hindi. The photo of the AAP chief in the message was also noted by the BJP, which accused Mr Kejriwal of attempting to mislead the people of Delhi. "It is very regrettable that the portrait of a corrupt person, Arvind Kejriwal, was hanging between those of Bhagat Singh ji and Babasaheb Ambedkar ji. Earlier, the husband used to lie in front of the camera. Now that he is in jail, he is making his wife lie. The

public is not going to be misled by the AAP," BJP Delhi President Virendra Sachdeva posted in

Hindi on X. After Mr Kejriwal's arrest by the Enforcement Directorate

people of Delhi and also during the 'Save Democracy' rally on Sunday, which was a show of strength by the opposition INDIA bloc. In his first message two days after his arrest, Mr Kejriwal had said, "There are several forces within and outside India that are weakening the country. There is no jail that can keep him behind bars for long. I will come out soon and keep my promises."

During Sunday's rally, the chief minister's wife had read out his six guarantees to the people of Delhi ahead of the

Lok Sabha polls and said the people of India were standing with her jailed husband. The AAP chief has been sent to judicial custody till April 15, and the Delhi High Court is hearing a petition filed by him against his arrest. The court had reserved its judgment in the case on Wednesday. In a separate hearing seeking Mr Kejriwal's removal as the chief minister after his arrest, a bench of the high court dismissed the petition on Thursday and said that democracy should take its own course.

# Labourers suffer as crusher units flourish

**Jajpur(KCN):** Lives of the labourers working at the various crusher units (registered and majority unregistered) are full of uncertainty. Not only do they suffer financial losses, in terms of wages, but they are also deprived of other benefits. This is because the owners of the crusher units have tacit understanding with officials of the district administration and the police, sources said. Labourers work in the most hazardous and pitiable conditions in these crusher units without having any insurance coverage for their lives.

As a result, while owners fill up their coffers, the labourers go home almost empty-handed, sources alleged. Sources informed that over 50 crusher units are operating in the district of which only 12 are registered. Even registered ones flout rules with impunity and do not follow any labour laws. Most of the

crusher units and black stone quarries operate in areas under Jenapur police limits in this district. Most of them violate Sections 21, 22, 23, 24, 30, 31, 36 and 85 of the Factory Act.

Sources said that if any labourer dies while working in the crusher units, the owners usually hush up the matter with the help of the administration and the police. At the most, a meagre sum of Rs 50,000 to Rs 1,00,000 is paid to the family of the worker as compensation. Sources

pointed out that labourers working at the illegal crusher units are deprived of government benefits in case of mishaps. According to a recent report of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) there are around 372 registered

crusher units in Odisha. These units have been permitted to employ a maximum of 7,108 labourers. However, in reality those employed at the registered and unregistered crusher units far exceed the permissible numbers. The crusher units in this district are a case in point. According to a report dated January 30, 2024, there are 12 registered units employing 227 people. However, in reality this is not the case. The district alone has 30 mega crushers while the number of small units is more than 40. Hence one can easily imagine the number of labourers working in these units. All units must provide personal protective equipment (PPE) to the labourers as per Section 62-H of the Odisha Factory Rules-1950. However, most of the crusher units do not provide any protective equipment to labourers. If a complaint is lodged, police tend to look the other way. Recently, a labourer from West Bengal died and another sustained injuries while working at the 'Shiba Shakti Stone Crusher Unit' near a black stone quarry March 17. It has been alleged that the owner hushed up the matter by paying a meagre compensation to both families. Police also did not initiate any action against the errant owner as no official complaint was lodged. Sources also pointed out that despite repeated complaints to the district administration about illegal crusher units, no action has been taken till date.

## Biramitrapur bandh peaceful



**Rourkela(KCN):** The call for a dawn-to-dusk bandh in Biramitrapur town passed off peacefully Wednesday with no untoward incidents being reported. Even though most of the shops remained closed, other commercial establishments remained open. Educational institutions also remained open, but most of the

students stayed away. The bandh was called as a mark of protest against the violence that erupted Monday night in Biramitrapur. During the clash, two persons, identified as Mahabir Sharma and Deepak Sharma, were stabbed and suffered injuries. Both are undergoing treatment at the Rourkela General Hospital here and their condition is stated to be stable, officials said. The clash could have escalated, but did not do so because of prompt intervention by the police. The main accused in the stabbing incident is still absconding, police said. However, two people have so far been arrested and a few others

have been detained for questioning, police informed. They added that some more arrests will be made in the next couple of days. It should be stated here that there was no formal call given for the bandh by any party. It was word of mouth passed on by people protesting against the stabbing of the two youths. Biramitrapur police station IIC Bandana Patra affirmed that the bandh had gone peacefully. "This was a suo moto bandh call and it was peaceful," Patra said. "Even though the bandh was called for 12 hours, normalcy returned by around 1.00pm. However, we are maintaining continuous vigil over the situation," Patra added.

# "I was almost embarrassed with our first half of the game today" - Ponting

**New Delhi:** Unacceptable and embarrassed were the words Ricky Ponting chose to use to describe their bowling performance following Delhi Capitals' 106-run loss to Kolkata Knight Riders in Visakhapatnam. On a day where the Knight Riders registered the second highest total in the IPL - 272/7 - Rishabh Pant ended up being fined INR 24 Lakhs for the Capitals' second over-rate offence this season and head coach Ponting sought to quickly fix their shortcomings.

"It's pretty hard to assess right now. I mean I was almost embarrassed with

our first half of the game today," said Ponting at the post-match press conference. "To concede that many runs...we bowled 17 wides and it took us two hours to bowl our overs as well, so we were two overs behind again, which means the guys bowling last two overs only get to bowl with four fieldsmen outside the circle. "Lot of things happened in this game that were unacceptable and a lot of things we will talk as a group tonight that we have to fix immediately to go forward in the competition. There will be some good open discussions in the

changing room for sure." It didn't help the Capitals that skipper Pant did not take the review on a couple of occasions. The first time was in the fourth over, off the fourth ball from Ishant Sharma who was confident that Narine (batting on 24 at that stage) had edged the ball. But Pant was very late to signal to the umpire as the time had run out by then. Narine scored 26 in that over and went on to hit a 39-ball 85 that set the platform for the Knight Riders' massive total. Shreyas Iyer was batting on 3 when Rasikh Salam thought he had dismissed him caught-behind in the

15th over but Pant again did not opt for the review. "I haven't had a chance to talk to Rishabh about

those. I mean, obviously, Rishabh hasn't heard them, other fielders and bowlers did hear

something on both occasions. But look, at the end of the day, they are little things. There are other bigger concerns for us with the way we bowled, some of the field placings we had set and just how long it's taking us to get around," said Ponting, who was more critical of the over-rate. "We can't afford to do that, no other team is doing that. We have been two overs down two games in a row, that's more than 10 minutes down going into the last couple of overs of a bowling innings. It probably didn't cost us today because they'd have gotten 250 anyway

but going forward in the tournament, it will definitely cost us something if we can't fix it." As many as 88 runs were scored in the powerplay which set the base for the Knight Riders. Ponting said after the kind of start they got, it was only about trying to minimise the damage for the remainder of the innings, which the Capitals failed to do. "The start didn't help. Even thinking about the first ball of the game. They got off to a flying start in the powerplay, they were 90 maybe at the end of first six overs. So that phase is not ideal. If that happens at the start of a

game, you are always trying to fight your way back into the game. They didn't allow us to do that today. They were relentless, the way they kept going at us after that start." I thought the youngster at No.3 (Angkrish Raghuvanshi) played really well and that allowed Russ (Andre Russell) and all those guys to play the way they always play. And they had wickets in hand, so they can keep going hard. They did lots of things really well but we got to be really critical of ourselves, on our own performances, and we got to look at ways to get better for the next game," Ponting said.

## Dhananjaya lauds fast bowlers after series win



**New Delhi:** Sri Lankan skipper Dhananjaya de Silva said on Wednesday that he is very satisfied with the performances of his pace unit as they proved they can be successful even on dead wickets. Sri Lanka swept away the hosts in the two-match series after earning a 192-run win in the series concluding second Test and their fast bowlers played a big part in it grabbing 37 wickets altogether.

"As a captain I think more than going with a spinner on a dead wicket, I like to play a more aggressive brand of cricket, and go with fast bowlers. That's why we went with three quicks. Our bowlers don't need to have grass on the track to get wickets, and they proved that," Dhananjaya told

reporters on Wednesday after the win.

"To get a wicket is really hard here. It's very hot with the sun, and there was not a lot of life in the pitch, so we had to work very hard. Because of our batters' talents, we were able to have a massive first-innings lead. That was very advantageous for our bowlers.

"To have a series like this where the fast bowlers win for us is a big morale boost for the team. There are areas in which we have to improve, and we will touch those up. But we will fix these and as that tour gets close, we'll be 100% ready. We're very satisfied with the win. There are many areas for us to improve, and I've talked about those with the team and the

coaches are working towards that. If we can learn day by day and raise our game by 1%, we can make winning a habit."

The skipper once again stressed on the need to be aggressive in these conditions to keep pushing for wickets. "Sometimes you have to be a little aggressive. In a country like this where you're playing in heat, sometimes some players get lethargic. But if in the field me or someone else dives around a little bit and makes a good stop, everyone gets a little boost. I'm trying to keep the other 10 players in the game. I'm not saying I need to be harsh, but I do think you need to have a bit of aggression when you lead."

Dhananjaya added that there is no rivalry between them following the in-famous timed out incident involving Angelo Mathews. "I don't think so. There's no rivalry. It's just a match between two nations. The game should be with the spirit, and should play hard. It happens in every match, not just against Bangladesh," he concluded.

## AIFF closes investigation into alleged physical assault of women players by EC member

**New Delhi:** The All India Football Federation (AIFF) on Wednesday said it has closed the investigation into its suspended executive committee member Deepak Sharma for his alleged physical assault of two women players in Goa as the victims "do not wish to pursue the matter any further." "The AIFF would not be in a position to continue the investigation as any complaint and/or further information regarding the alleged incident has been denied by the concerned individuals. "In view of the above, the investigation was concluded as withdrawn," the AIFF

investigated the alleged harassment case recently, was "not in a position to continue the investigation as the alleged victim and the other party do not wish to pursue the matter any further." "The AIFF would not be in a position to continue the investigation as any complaint and/or further information regarding the alleged incident has been denied by the concerned individuals. "In view of the above, the investigation was concluded as withdrawn," the AIFF

said in the statement. Two footballers of Himachal Pradesh-based Khad FC, taking part in the Indian Women's Football (IWL) League second division, had alleged that Sharma, the owner of the club, had barged into their room and physically assaulted them on the night of March 28.

On Saturday, the AIFF asked Sharma to refrain from football-related activities till the conclusion of a probe by a panel into his alleged incident. Sharma was arrested by Goa police

after the host state association lodged a complaint and later released on bail. Before that, the Emergency Committee of the AIFF comprising president Kalyan Chaubey, vice-president N A Haris and treasurer Kipa Ajay, on Monday took stock of the complaints received from the players against Sharma.

Thereafter, a meeting of AIFF member associations was held on Monday night and "Sharma was called and heard for a few minutes before he was advised to

leave the meeting." In the complaint sent to the AIFF, the two players said, according to sources, that Sharma was mostly in an inebriated state and they were "scared for their lives." Sports Minister Anurag Thakur had also asked the AIFF to take "quick" and "strong legal action" against the official.

On Tuesday, the AIFF also dissolved the three-member committee formed on March 30 to probe the incident, and instead referred the matter to its Disciplinary Committee.

## IPL 2024: Rishabh Pant fined Rs 24 Lakh for 2nd consecutive over-rate offence

**New Delhi:** DC skipper Rishabh Pant has been fined 24 Lakh rupees for maintaining a slow-over rate for the second consecutive time in IPL 2024 during their loss to KKR on April 3, Wednesday in Vizag. Pant wasn't the only one fined as the rest of the playing XI was also given penalties for the offence during the match. The game saw DC suffer their third loss of the season.

While Pant shone with the bat for Delhi along

with Tristan Stubbs, the rest of the side failed to deliver as KKR scored 272 for 7 in 20 overs. This was the second highest score in the history of the IPL and set up a tough chase for DC.

The home side would eventually have their innings come to an end at 166, thus handing KKR a 106-run win.


The BCCI released a statement after the game revealing that Pant was penalised as DC

## The curious case of Shaheen's captaincy ouster



**New Delhi:** Babar Azam is back in the saddle but leading the white-ball side is unlikely to be a smooth ride for the star Pakistan batsman. Complicating matters is the discontent of his spearhead, Shaheen Afridi. Having previously led Pakistan in the T20I series against New Zealand, Afridi was expected to retain the captaincy. However, the reins have now been curiously handed over to Babar for the upcoming Twenty20 World Cup in the US and West Indies. Shaheen had captained Pakistan in merely five T20Is at a time when the selectors were trying out a few players. The

unfavourable 1-4 result that went against Pakistan notwithstanding, he was evicted after just one series at the helm. The transfer of leadership is never smooth and seamless in Pakistan cricket and it is no different this time. Speculations abound that Shaheen's removal from the Twenty20 captaincy may have political undertones. With the Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) under the stewardship of new chairman Mohsin Naqvi, who is purportedly having the backing of the country's new administration, Afridi's allegiance to the previous regime may have

become the last straw. Whispers suggest that Afridi's proximity to the previous political regime may have played a role in the decision, highlighting the inherent connections between politics and cricket in Pakistan.

"It is always the case in Pakistan cricket. When a new chairman comes, he changes the captain. Since the days of Imran it has been like this. After Imran, Javed Miandad came," Rashid Latif told Cricbuzz, discussing the topic.

"Then came Wasim Akram, Waqar Younis, Shoaib Afridi and the list goes on. It is unfair on Shaheen to be stripped of captaincy but that is the

reality here. When a new chairman comes, more often than not the captaincy is changed." Former Pakistan captain and prime minister Imran Khan had earlier praised Lahore Qalandars for appointing Shaheen as

the captain of the franchise, and the pacer had even gone to meet the then Prime Minister. "Yes, Imran Khan actually appreciated our decision to appoint Shaheen as captain of Lahore Qalandars and said he believes that the fast bowlers are better cricket captains than batsmen as they are more aggressive by nature and results oriented," Sameen Rana, the owner of the Qalandars told Cricbuzz, recalling their meeting with Imran. "He also told Shaheen to continue doing what he is doing and never change. He believed that Shaheen had the potential to

become a great of the game."

If the controversy has played out in full public view, the PCB cannot be free of blame. The board put out a statement without apparently consulting the player. "It was an absolute honour to captain Pakistan's national cricket team. As a team player, it is my duty to back our captain, Babar Azam. I have played under his captaincy and have nothing but respect for him," Shaheen was quoted as saying by the PCB.

The player has reportedly denied making such a statement. It has been suggested that he wanted to take up the matter with the PCB chief. After both met at Kakul, where the team is undergoing fitness camp under the vigil of the Pakistani army, the PCB released a picture of them shaking hands. But it could only be an uneasy truce. The PCB chairman also met Babar and the newly-appointed selectors. The next step is the selection of the squad for the upcoming five-match home series against New Zealand followed by the World Cup in the run-up to which the Pakistan side has a couple of engagements in Ireland and England. Where Shaheen features in all this will be a point of immense interest.
