

## Three criminal laws framed with spirit of 'citizen first, dignity first and justice first': PM Modi

**Jaipur(KCN):** Prime Minister Narendra Modi Sunday said the three new criminal justice laws were enacted with the spirit of “citizen first, dignity first and justice first” and that the police now need to work with data instead of ‘danda’.

Addressing the 58th conference of Director Generals of Police (DGPs) and Inspector Generals of Police (IGPs) here, Modi exhorted the police to focus on the safety of women to ensure they can work fearlessly

He emphasised that the new criminal laws were framed with the spirit of

“citizen first, dignity first and justice first’ and instead of working with ‘danda’, police now need to work with “data”.

The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and the Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam have been enacted recently to replace the Indian Penal Code-1860, the Code of Criminal Procedure-1898 and the Indian Evidence Act of 1872, respectively.

The prime minister said these new laws were a

paradigm shift in India's criminal justice system. He said a special focus was laid on sensitising women and girls about their rights and protection provided to them under the new laws. Modi said the Indian police should transform itself into a modern and world-class force to realise the vision of a developed India by 2047 — the centenary of India's independence.

# Congress holds seat-sharing talks with Odisha JMM

**Bhubaneswar(KCN):** Congress leaders held a meeting with the functionaries of the JMM's Odisha unit on Sunday and discussed the sharing of seats for the Lok Sabha elections and assembly polls, which are held simultaneously in the state.

The closed-door meeting was attended by JMM's state president Anjani Soren, its Odisha unit in charge Shivaji Moulik, Congress general secretary in charge of Odisha Ajoy Kumar and state Congress president Sarat Pattanayak, among others.

The leaders of the two parties held initial discussions on seat sharing for Lok Sabha elections and assembly polls.

At that meeting, Soren told Congress leaders that she would speak to her brother and Jharkhand CM Hemant Soren,



besides the central committee of JMM, about the seat-sharing talks in Odisha.

Another round of discussion will be held January 10, where it is likely to be finalised which party will fight on how many seats in the state, sources said.

Discussions were also held about Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's visit to Odisha as a part of the 'Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra'.

The JMM's best performance so far in the state has been in the

2004 assembly elections, in which it won four seats. The party drew a blank in the 2019 assembly elections, but it has a significant presence in Mayurbhanj, Sundargarh and parts of Keonjhar district, since the years of the Jharkhand movement. These districts were part of its “greater Jharkhand” demand. The Congress is part of the Hemant Soren government in neighbouring Jharkhand.

## Goa CM Pramod Sawant Offers Prayer At Puri Srimandir

**Puri(KCN):** Goa Chief Minister Pramod Sawant today offered prayer at the Jagannath Temple in pilgrim town of Puri. Accompanied by family members, Sawant visited

Modi for the upcoming consecration ceremony of Lord Ram Lala at the Ram Temple in Ayodhya. He said that the Sanatani people are quite happy with Narendra Modi, who

is working for the development of religious sites including Kashi Vishwanath, Mahakaleswar Temple in Ujjain and the Jagannath Temple in Puri.

Department. 5T Chairman also visited the place where 'Akhayara Bhoomi' work is being undertaken by the Works Department. The 'Akhayara Bhoomi' will commemorate the 1st World Odia Language Conference being held in Bhubaneswar between 3rd to 5th December. A commemorative Arch reflecting the 'Kalingan' style of architecture in Khondalite stones shall also adorn the 'Akhayara

Bohumi'. It shall be an attraction point for the youth reminding them about the rich heritage of our classical Odia language. It was decided to have space for future expansion of the building and to leave the basement for parking for visitors of this cultural convention centre. ST Chairman also suggested planting trees in the space so that the entire campus looks green and install eco-friendly elements.

# Maldivian govt suspends three ministers over 'derogatory remarks' against PM Modi

**Male(KCN):** The Maldivian government Sunday suspended three ministers who posted “derogatory remarks against Prime Minister Narendra Modi as it distanced itself from their comments on social media and said these opinions are “personal and do not represent the views of the Government”. The development came after opposition leaders slammed the “appalling language” used by the officials against the Indian leader. “Government officials who posted derogatory remarks about neighbouring India have been suspended,” state broadcaster PSM News reported, citing the



President's Office. The Maldives government has affirmed its commitment to taking swift action against individuals on social media whose conduct undermines international relations, it added. The Sun Online identified the officials who were suspended over the posts as three

deputy ministers from the Youth Ministry; Malsha Shareef, Mariyam Shiuna and Abdulla Mahzoom Majid. Earlier Sunday, the Maldivian Foreign Ministry said they were aware of the “derogatory remarks on social media platforms against foreign leaders and high-ranking individuals”. “These opinions are

personal and do not represent the views of the Government of Maldives,” it said in a statement, amidst uneasy relations between the Maldives and India after Mohamed Muizzu assumed charge as the new president in November. A row erupted on social media last week when a

minister and some other leaders in the Maldives used derogatory remarks against Prime Minister Modi after he posted a video of him on a pristine beach in Lakshadweep. The Maldivian government said it believes that the freedom of expression should be exercised in a democratic and responsible manner, and in ways that do not spread hatred, and negativity, and hinder close relationships between the Maldives and its international partners. It warned that relevant authorities of the Government will not hesitate to take action against those who make such derogatory remarks.

Dhabaleswar Jhoola pola is one of the longest hanging bridge of the country. A big fair is held on the shukla paksha chaturdashi of the Kartika called Bada-osh. Makar Sankranti, Mahasivaratri are other famous festivals celebrated there.

The temple, located on an island on River Mahanadi, is embellished with stone carvings that date back to the early 10th and 11th century. The serene ambience, in which the temple is situated, inspires spiritual feeling among one and all.

## Sagar Parikrama': Rupala interacts with fisherfolk in Odisha's Ganjam

**Berhampur (KCN):** Union Fisheries Minister Parshottam Rupala kicked off the 11th phase of 'Sagar Parikrama' from the Gopalpur harbour in Odisha's Ganjam district Sunday. 'Sagar Parikrama', which was launched from Mandvi in Gujarat March 5, 2022, is aimed at direct interaction with fisherfolk in their village to understand their issues and to improve their livelihood, he said. Rupala interacted with the fisherfolk in Arjipalli village and handed them



documents related to PM Matsya Sampada Yojana, Kisan Credit Card and group accident insurance scheme. He assured the people that he would help in clearing hurdles for setting up the fishing harbour near Arjipalli. A plot has been identified for the harbor, which would cost Rs500, but the work has not

progressed as clearance has not been given since it is forest land, officials said. Ganjam Zilla Matsya Jivi Forum urged the minister to increase the livelihood support for fisherfolks from Rs15,000 to Rs35,000 when fishing is banned in the region for the breeding of olive ridley turtles. They also urged him to increase the group accident insurance scheme benefit from Rs5 lakh to Rs10 lakh and provide diesel at a subsidised rate for mechanised boats.

After the completion of the 10th phase of 'Sagar Parikrama' at Visakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh Saturday, Rupala arrived at the Gopalpur port by sea on a two-day visit to Odisha. He visited Nairi, Balugaon, Satapada and Puri later in the day. He would visit Paradip, Kendrapara, Dhamara, Chudamani and Chandipur Monday and interact with the fisherfolk there before moving towards West Bengal.

## Odisha: 60-year-old man hacks wife to death

**Bolangir (KCN):** A 60-year-old man in Odisha hacked his wife to death in Patnagarh area of Bolangir district Friday, an official said. The accused has been identified as Krushna Chandra Bag of Brahmapura village. Anjana, 50, was returning home after taking bath in river Mayavati near Patnagarh town when the accused under the influence of alcohol hacked her to death with an axe. "Anjana, who sustained severe head injuries, died on the spot," a police officer said. The accused later fled the spot and also concealed the weapon. He was later arrested from his hideout. "He suspected Anjana of having an extramarital affair. The couple used to fight over petty issues in the past too," he added.

# Income from House Property Part 1

The rental income is taxed under the head ‘Income from house property’ which is computed after allowing payment for municipal taxes, and other permissible deductions. W.e.f. asst. year 2020-21, where a property is held as stock in trade and is not let out, provisions of Sec. 23 relating to assessment of notional rent shall not be applicable for a period of two years from the end of the financial year in which the completion certificate is obtained. We are highlighting relevant provisions for computation of income under the head income from house property. Which Income to be taxed under the head ‘Income from house property’: Rent and other income from any flat, building or land appurtenant thereto received by owner is generally taxed under the head ‘Income from house property’. As per section 22 “House Property” does not include vacant land. Income derived from

a vacant land is charged either under the head “Income from Business or Profession” or under the head “Income from other sources” depending upon its nature. However, if the owner occupies the house property for the purposes of his own business or profession, no tax is to be paid under this head in respect of such property. Here are some decisions: Notional Income from the part of a house property owned by HUF, used for business purposes by a firm, in which HUF was a partner was not assessable to tax - CIT v. H.S. Singhal & Sons [2002] 253 ITR 653 (Del.). Rent or other income derived from the house property is taxed under the head house property even if the house property is kept as stock-in-trade - CWT v. Atma Ram Properties (P) Ltd. [2017] 86 taxmann.com 89 (Delhi); CIT v. Haryana Urban Development Authority [2010] 322 ITR 61 (P&H).

However Gujarat High Court in the case of CIT v. Neha Builders (P) Ltd. [2008] 296 ITR 661 (Guj.): [2007] 207 CTR (Guj.) 231 had held that rent received by a promoter from properly held as stock-in-trade is assessable under the head business and profession. Section 23(5) as amended w.e.f. asst year 2020-21, provides that deemed annual value shall be taxable only after two years from the end of FY in which completion certificate is received. For asst. year 2018-19 and asst. year 2019-20 the moratorium was only for one year. Supreme Court in Rayala Corporation (P.) Ltd. v. ACIT [2016] 72 taxmann.com 149 (SC) : 386 ITR 500 (SC) held that if letting out of properties was the business of assessee, then its income would be chargeable to tax under the head ‘profits and gains of business or profession’ as opposed to ‘income from house property’. Letting out of building with amenities in an Industrial Park or SEZ has been held to be income under the head business and profession and deduction under sec. 80-IA/IB/IC or

10AA are allowable - Velankani Information System Pvt. Ltd 35 taxmann.com 1 (Karn). SLP of the revenue has been dismissed by the Apex Court. CBDT vide its Circular No. 16 dated 25/04/2017 has accepted the above decision and clarified that in the case of an undertaking which develops, develops and operates or maintains and operates an industrial park/SEZ notified in accordance with the scheme framed and notified by the Government, the income from letting out of premises/developed space along with other facilities in an industrial park/SEZ is to be charged to tax under the head ‘Profits and Gains of Business’. Further Delhi High Court in case of Niagara Hotels & Builders Private Limited v. CIT 006 ITR-OL 493 (Del) has held that letting out of terrace for setting up antenna by a hotel is a business income. However letting out of terrace for mobile towers/antenna in a property taxable under the head House Property is taxable under the head House Property- Kohinoor Industrial Premises Co-operative Society Ltd v. ITO [2018] 98 taxmann.com 365

(Mumbai-Trib.). Rent or license fees for letting out hotel building along with furnishing and equipment has been held to be business income - Palmshore Hotels Private Limited v. CIT(A)-1 [2017] 88 taxmann.com 186 (Kerala). Similarly, where the business of assessee closed down and the premises was let out the income was held assessable as business income - Bharat Tiles & Marble (P) Ltd. v. DCIT [2018] 92 taxmann.com 7 (Mumbai - Trib.). Prior to the decision of Supreme Court in the case of Chennai Properties & Investments Limited (Supra) various Courts had held that since a specific head of charge is provided for income from the Ownership of House Property, rent received is to be taxed under house property only. It is immaterial that it is the business of the assessee to let out house properties or rooms. Refer : Commercial Properties Limited v. CIT 3 ITC 23, Ballygunge Bank Ltd. v. CIT [1946] 14 ITR 409 (Cal), Ezra Proprietary Estates Ltd. v. CIT, [1950] 18 ITR 762 (Cal.), Suratee Bazar v. CIT 5 ITC 264; Salisbury House Estate v. Fry HL [1930] 15 TC 266, Alfred v. Whelan 20 TC 321(HL), Bengal Jute Mills Co. Ltd. v. CIT [1949] 17 ITR

308 (Cal), Madras Silk and Rayon Mills (P) Limited v. ACIT 262 ITR 122 (Mad.). However in the case of Raj Dadarkar & Associates v. ACIT [2017] 81 taxmann.com 193 (SC) apex court held that merely because there is an entry in the object clause of the business showing a particular object, would not be the determinative factor to arrive at a conclusion that the income is to be treated as income from business. There must be systematic or organized activity of providing service to the tenants. In the absence of such activities income from letting out of shops in a market was held to be taxable under the head income from house property. Some other cases, where income has been held to be assessable under the head ‘Income from House Property’: (1) Income from own building used partly for business and portions let out on rent - CIT v. Pandyan Bank Ltd. [1969] 71 ITR 707 (Mad) and Rampur Industries Ltd. v. CIT [1971] 82 ITR 23 (AI). (2) Rent from setting up a market - East India Housing & Land Development Trust Ltd. v. CIT [1961] 42 ITR 49(SC). (3) Rent from

letting out of property by assessee having business of constructing & developing houses for sale - S.C. Majumdar v. CIT [1947] 15 ITR 484, 493 (Pat) and East India Prospecting Syndicate v. CIT [1951] 19 ITR 571(Cal); CIT v. Haryana Urban Development Authority [2010] 322 ITR 61 (P&H), Roma Builders (P) Ltd. v. JCIT [2011] 11 ITR (Trib.) 503 (Mum.). (4) Income from property acquired in the course of money-lending business- O.R.M. SP. SV. Firm v. CIT [1960] 39 ITR 327 (Mad), BansilalGangaram v. CIT [1963] 48 ITR 973 (Bom) and Arunachalam Chettiar v. CIT [1945] 13 ITR 183 (Mad). (5) Rent from certain stalls in ‘Mangala Haat’ - CIT v. KanaiyalalMimani [1979] 120 ITR 892 (Cal). (6) Rent from Bustee huts having a minimum life of 5 to 6 years - Tinsukia Development Corporation Ltd. v. CIT [1979] 120 ITR 176 (Cal). (7) Income from market consisting of shops, buildings, godowns etc.- P.V.G. Raju v. CIT [1967] 66 ITR 122 (AP). (8) The assessee, carrying on business of colonisation, built a school premises and let it out on perpetual lease at Re.

1 per year to a trust for running a school. It was held that the estimated net annual value of Rs 5000 was assessable under head House Property - DLF United Ltd. v. CIT [1984] 149 ITR 24 (Del). (9) Where assessee used to let out rooms in a lodging house and income was assessed under the head business & profession and later such assessee let out the building to a bank. Rent from bank is to be assessed under the head house property- Joseph George and Co. v. ITO [2010] 328 ITR 161 (Ker.). (10) The assessee took lease of land having tenants for construction of cinema theatre. On a part of the land, a residential building was constructed and let out to the pre-existing tenants and on the other part the cinema theatre was constructed. It was held that the rental income from letting out of residential building was assessable under the head House Property- N.L. Mehta Cinema Enterprises (P) Ltd. v. CIT [1994] 208 ITR 975 (Bom).

The expo will continue till January 19, 2023. The expo has 60 stalls. Besides, monetary aids were also provided to some (60) weavers of the State in the form of cheques which amounted to Rs 1lakh, 20 thousand.

## Arvind Kejriwal Names Jailed Gujarat MLA As Candidate For Lok Sabha Elections

**Bharuch(KCN):** In line with the preparations for the Lok Sabha elections, Aam Aadmi Party chief Arvind Kejriwal has named jailed MLA Chaitar Vasava as the party's candidate for the Bharuch Lok Sabha seat in Gujarat. The Aam Aadmi Party has started the Lok Sabha election campaign by organising a public rally in Bharuch today. Mr Kejriwal while addressing the rally appealed to the people to ensure the victory of Chaitar Vasava in the Lok Sabha elections. Vasava, MLA from the Dediapada assembly of Bharuch, is in jail. "Chaitar Vasava is in jail but now he will be the candidate for the Bharuch Lok Sabha seat. No other party has yet started the process for its

candidate in Bharuch, but the AAP party announced its candidate in Sunday's meeting," he said. AAP MLA Chetar Vasava is involved in several controversies. He is in jail for the last 2 months. A local court in Dediapada in Narmada district on December 18 sent Chaitar to judicial custody at the end of the three-day police remand in the November 2 case of alleged extortion and assault of forest officials. But now AAP party is making this an opportunity. Mr Kejriwal has said that if MLA Chetar Vasava is not released, then Mr Vasava will fight the election from the jail itself and people will go door to door carrying the candidate's photo to seek votes.

Earlier today, the Delhi Chief Minister also posted on X and said "Chaitra Vasava of the Aam Aadmi Party is a very popular tribal leader. He and his wife have been jailed for several days by the BJP Gujarat government in a fake case. Today I and Bhagwant Mann ji are going to Gujarat. We will meet people in his area and tomorrow we will go to meet him in jail." In the previous Lok Sabha polls, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) secured victory in all 26 seats in Gujarat. However, the AAP opened its account in Gujarat in the state assembly polls, which were held in 2022, with five of its leaders securing a comfortable win.

## 3-day Training Workshop Ends with a Call for Interdepartmental Coordination for Effective and Strategic Assessment of Bio-resources

**KOLKATA,(KCN):** The three-day training workshop organised by the Botanical Survey of India (BSI) for the Indian Forest Service (IFS) officers on "Plant Identification and Nomenclature," nominated by the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change, was successfully completed on January 5, 2024, at the Central National Herbarium, Howrah. The training concluded with a panel discussion on "Improvement in the Working of Forest Departments—Need for Career Development through Training and Improvement of Skills" by experts from different fields. The discussion was attended by Dr. A. A. Mao, Director, BSI; Sri Soumitra Dasgupta, IFS (Retd.) former PCCF & HOFF, Forest Department, West Bengal; Dr. Dhriti Banerjee, Director, Zoological Survey of India; Dr. Sangeeta Dubey, IFS (Retd.), West Bengal; and Prof. Vishwas Chavan, IISER, Berhampur. The experts of the panel session called for enhanced interdepartmental



coordination among the BSI, the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) and the State Forest Departments so as to come up with a more effective and strategic assessment of the bio-resources and to enunciate better monitoring and management practices that will be in alignment with several international conventions, such as CBD, CITES, TRAFFIC, and World Heritage Sites. The panel experts were of the opinion that the researchers should share

the botanical and zoological knowledge of the research organisations with the forest managers. The forest officials also emphasised the need for such training programs more and more in the future to synchronize the development of scientific research with conservation efforts. Shri Dasgupta urged the forest officers to find out the USP of the training programme and share it with their colleagues so that the knowledge gained can be shared with the front-line forest

officials. One of the central ideas of the discussion was to go for conservation of the entire ecosystem and not only the forest since the ecosystem includes landscapes, both macro and micro flora and fauna, soil, and water of a given geographical area. The training programme ended with concluding remarks by Dr. S. S. Dash, Scientist-F and Course Co-Coordinator and In-Charge, Technical Section, BSI HQ. He thanked all the participants for their fervent participation

and attentiveness throughout the workshop. He also welcomed the suggestions shared by the participating forest officials with regard to achieving better efficacy by combining management practices with scientific data. Dr. Dash was hopeful to periodically come up with this kind of workshop for the foresters in the future. The BSI has been able to achieve the desired objectives set for the training program for the IFS officers, said Dr. Dash.

## Align Deliveries With Ram Temple Ceremony: Pregnant Women In UP To Doctors

**Kanpur(KCN):** Several expectant mothers have requested doctors at a government hospital here to have caesarean section deliveries on January 22, on the occasion of the consecration ceremony at the Ram temple in Ayodhya. Seema Dwivedi, acting in charge of the Obstetrics and Gynecology department at Ganesh Shankar Vidyarthi Memorial Medical College, said they have received written requests for 12 to 14 caesarean deliveries in one labour room. "The arrangements are being made for 35 caesarean operations on January 22," Dwivedi

told PTI. The pregnant women and their family members have made the requests to the doctors even if their delivery dates are a few days before or after January 22, considering it an "auspicious" day. The first phase of the Ram temple is nearing completion and Prime Minister Narendra Modi will take part in the consecration ceremony of Ram Lalla's idol on January 22. Ms Dwivedi said expecting mothers often find out an auspicious

date and time from priests and request delivery on that day. She recounted various experiences where she delivered the babies at a scheduled time and date because the mothers and the family members stressed for the delivery to be done on a 'muhurta' (auspicious time) given by the priests. "It is concerning that sometimes the family members even expect us to overlook complications that may arise for the mother and the child by doing so,"

Dwivedi told PTI. "The mothers believe that Lord Ram is the symbol of heroism, integrity and obedience, therefore babies born on the day of the 'pran pratishtha' at the temple will also have the same qualities," she said. Malti Devi (26), a resident of Kalyanpur, whose delivery due date is on January 17, is one of the expectant mothers who have made this request to the doctors at the Kanpur hospital. Ms Devi told PTI that she wants her child to be

born on the day of the consecration ceremony of Ram Lalla's idol at the Ram temple. "I hope that my child will grow up to have success and glory," she said. Psychologist Divya Gupta told PTI that people believe that if a child is born at an auspicious time, it creates a positive impact on the baby's personality. "Sometimes religion and spirituality give a person strength to tackle the stresses of life and have a positive outlook," Gupta added.

## "No Need To Go To New Zealand, Everything Is In Lakshadweep": Minister

**Hyderabad(KCN):** Appealing to the countrymen to visit Lakshadweep, Union Minister G Kishan Reddy on Sunday said, "No need to go to New Zealand or Switzerland" as the Union Territory has a huge tourism potential. ## Mukta Soft In 23 More ULBs

**Bhubaneswar(KCN):** After the success of Mukta Soft Application in two municipal areas of the state, it will be implemented in 23 more municipal bodies. Sharda Prasad Panda, Joint Secretary, Housing and Urban Development has written a letter to the civic bodies concerned in this regard.

Mukta Soft Application is being implemented to make the implementation of Mukhyamantri Karma Tatpar Abhijana (MUKTA) more transparent and punctual. It was first implemented in Dhenkanal and Jatni municipal bodies on an experimental basis. After the success of the application here, it is now set to be implemented in 23 more municipal bodies. These municipal corporations include Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Berhampur, Rourkela and Sambalpur



Municipal Corporations, Puri, Baripada, Kotpad, Jaipur, Keonjhar, Kesinga, Jharsuguda, Jajpur, Paradip, Chhatrapur, Hinjilikatu, Athagarh, Padmapur, Balangir, Phulbani, Boudhgarh, Bhadrak and Balasore.

The Mukta Soft Application allows the payment of the project charges being executed under the scheme immediately. It may be mentioned that while the State Government is implementing the Mukta

Yojana to provide work to the hands of the urban people, priority is being given to women self-help groups and slum development organizations. Therefore, more emphasis is being laid on how they can get their dues immediately after completing the project work.

In the middle of the current financial year, especially by November 20, the details of the Mukta project have been asked to be uploaded in the Mukta Soft

Application. In particular, the projects which have been sanctioned and the work has not started and the projects which have already been implemented and the dues have not been paid by this week have been asked to be uploaded. Apart from this, financial transactions of the project have also been asked to be uploaded on it. This will enable timely monitoring, evaluation and funding of the project.

City Mission Managers of the 23 municipal bodies concerned will act as nodal officers for the immediate implementation of the Mukta Soft Scheme and the 'Help Desk' at SUDA Department will monitor the project work on a daily basis. However, it has been clearly stated that all valid projects should be uploaded by December 10 and 60 per cent of these projects by December 20.

## Pradhan Plea On PM-USHA



**Bhubaneswar(KCN):** Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan wrote a letter to Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik for implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (PM-USHA) in Odisha.

In his letter, Shri Pradhan said the PM-USHA scheme, which was launched in June this year, has been approved till 31st March, 2026 with a total outlay of Rs 12,926.10 crores in continuation of the Scheme of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA). The PM-USHA Scheme is an

important step of Central Government to award implementation the vision of National Education Policy, 2020 to attain higher levels of access, equity, and excellence in the States /UTs higher education system by prioritizing the unserved and underserved areas, to be identified by States / UTs as Focus Districts on the basis of low GER, population of SC/ST, Left-wing affected areas etc., he said.

The scheme will aim at creating new institutions and also transforming existing institutions in the States and UTs, Pradhan stated.

As per the Scheme Guidelines, States / UTs are required to sign an MoU for on-boarding the Scheme for its implementation in respective States / UTs. The MoU contains clauses regarding proper planning, implementation and monitoring of the Scheme.

The Union Minister said commitment on planning and drafting the proposals by the State by aligning it with reforms such as Multiple entry-exit, Academic Bank of Credits, National Higher Education Qualifications Framework (NHEQF), Indian knowledge

systems etc. will lead to better integration between the policies and schemes of the Government for improving higher education in the country.

He appreciated the State for showing active participation in the previous phases of RUSA and has been successful in using the support under the Scheme to improve the higher education scenario in the State. However, an MoU under new phase of Scheme i.e. PM-USHA, is yet to be signed by the State, he expressed concern.

He informed that the process of submission of proposals for grants-in-aid under the PM-USHA Scheme has already started through a dedicated Portal for this purpose launched on 21st October, 2023. Shri Pradhan sought cooperation and continued support from the CM in implementing the PM-USHA Scheme in the State of Odisha. He requested CM to look into the issue for early submission of the MoU so that Odisha State does not miss out on the benefits of the Scheme.

**New Delhi:** Australia have a wide range of options to choose from for David Warner's replacement at the top of their Test batting line-up but if it were up to only Pat Cummins then he isn't in favour of displacing Steve Smith from the middle-order just yet.

Smith, a former captain and one of the greats of the format, threw his hat in the ring to take up a new challenge, telling ABC Grandstand that he was 'pretty keen' to move up the batting order but Cummins isn't convinced just yet to add his most prolific batter to the list of contenders for this highly specialised role.

"I'm pretty happy with [Smith's] output at No.

forte; he wants to get out there straightaway. "I'm happy to do what the team needs, but I do love batting at three; I love the variety of the role. At the moment, it could be anyone. I've

seen the media throwing around Travis Head, throwing around me, [and] obviously the three openers outside of the squad - Cameron Bancroft, Matt Renshaw and Marcus

Harris. Smudge [Smith] seems like the lead frontrunner, the one that really wants it." Australia's selectors are slated to meet on Monday (January 8) when they are likely to pick the squad for the first Test against West Indies as well as choose Warner's replacement. Marcus Harris, Cameron Bancroft and Matt Renshaw are options in the mix, all three of them having opened in Test cricket previously. Travis Head would seem to be a more like-for-like replacement for Warner and bring an attacking edge against the new ball but he ruled himself out of such a move despite performing the

role briefly in India last year, stating that it was a specialist role. A left field option for the team management would be to reintroduce talented all-rounder Cameron Green into the XI as an opener similar to how Shane Watson found himself moving up the order during his career. Green has never batted higher than No. 6 in his 36 Test innings and has never opened in first-class cricket, although he has opened in T20Is for Australia. But it also might be the least disruptive option for the selectors to get him into the Test team given how they've wanted him back as well as the settled nature of the middle

order.  
"It's obviously going to be really hard to replicate Davey and what he's brought to it. I think you look for who is best placed to score runs, really. But I think, in Test cricket, there are some things that remain true - and that is you've got to be putting the pressure on the opposition. You've got to be ticking over the scoreboard. Not always - but most of the time - you've got to keep the scoreboard moving along.  
"There are considerations, but realistically, if anyone is scoring runs in Shield cricket, it's probably a good sign they can do it at the next level," Cummins said.
