


Mekap, Chadha Karana and Deulikaran, who took care of the rituals. They came out of the Ratna Bhandar, which has an inner and an outer chamber, around 5.20pm. “We carried out all the works as per SOP. We first opened the outer chamber of the Ratna Bhandar and shifted all ornaments and valuables kept there to the temporary strong room inside the temple. We have sealed the strong room,” Padhee told reporters. “Then, the authorised persons entered the inner chamber of the treasury. Three locks were there. No lock could be opened with the key available with the district administration. So, as per the SOP, we broke the three locks in the presence of a magistrate, and then, we entered the inner chamber. We inspected the valuables kept in the



Survey of India (ASI) also inspected the condition of the inner chamber, officials said, adding that the entire process was videographed. The idols of the sibling deities of Lord Jagannath, Lord Balabhadra and Goddess Subhadra are at present in the Gundicha temple where they were taken during Rath Yatra July 7. They would be brought back to the 12th-century shrine during the Bahuda

Yatra Monday. Before entering the temple, Padhee said the priority was to ensure the safety of the structure of the treasury, which is located in the basement of the temple. “The inventory work will not start today. It will be done after getting approval of the government on the engagement of valuers, goldsmiths and other experts. After the completion of the repair works, the valuables will be brought back and

then, the process for inventory will be carried out," he added. Six wooden chests with brass interiors were brought to the temple for moving the valuables. The chests, made of teak, were 4.5 feet in length, 2.5 feet in height and 2.5 feet in breadth, an official said.

"The temple authority July 12 had asked us to build 15 such chests. After working for 48 hours, we have completed six chests," said one of the workers who made them.


The treasury was last opened in 1978, and at that time, it took 70 days to prepare the inventory of the valuables, which have been donated to the temple by devotees over centuries, officials said. An attempt was made in 2018 as well to reopen the Ratna Bhandar on the direction of the high court but the original keys could not be found, and eventually, the plan

was abandoned. Padhee said Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) have been formulated for the entire process. “Three SOPs have been formulated. One is related to the reopening of the Ratna Bhandar, the second one is for the management of the temporary Ratna Bhandar, and the third one is related to inventory of the valuables,” he said. The government has decided to prepare a digital catalogue of the valuables in the Ratna Bhandar that will have details such as their weight and make, another official said. As it was apprehended that inside the treasury there were snakes, believed by devotees to be guarding the valuables, snake catchers were called. However, no snake was found there, officials said.

Meanwhile, SOA's Centre for Environment and Climate (CEC) has forecast formation of a low-pressure area over northwest Bay of Bengal (BoB) along the Odisha coast July 15 under the influence of an upper air cyclonic circulation

which may form over the same area the previous day. “These systems may cause moderate to heavy rainfall at many places over coastal and south Odisha with heavy to very heavy rainfall in the southern districts between July 14 and 17,” a CEC bulletin said. The low-pressure system over northwest BoB may intensify into a depression July 18 and 19 and gradually move northwards before crossing north Odisha coast July 20 evening causing heavy to very heavy rainfall in north, western and coastal districts extending up to July 21, it added.



injuries in the head and was declared dead in hospital. The injured policeman is undergoing treatment, but he is out of danger,” a police officer said.

“His supreme sacrifice in the line of duty shall not go in vain. I further extend my sincere condolences to the bereaved family of the deceased soldier, while praying for the speedy recovery of the ones injured during the attack,” Singh said.

Gunshots were reportedly heard in the village Saturday night, too, the officer said.

Additional security forces have been deployed at Mongbung from adjacent hill areas following Sunday’s attack, another official said.

A vehicle belonging to security personnel has been damaged in the gun attack, he added.

Manipur has been rocked by ethnic violence between Meitei and Kuki communities since May last year, which has claimed more than 200 lives.

NEWDELHI,(KCN): Three terrorists were killed as the Army foiled an infiltration bid by a group of heavily armed terrorists across the Line of Control (LoC) in J&K's Kupwara district on Sunday, officials said, adding that firing exchanges were still on in the area. Three terrorists have been killed and their weapons recovered in the ongoing operation along the LoC in the Keran sector of

Kupwara, officials said. "Alert troops of the army noticed the movement of heavily armed terrorists and challenged them, after which the exchange of fire started. The firing exchanges were continuing when last reports came in," an official said. Security forces including the army, paramilitary forces, and the J&K Police are aggressively fighting terrorists, by destroying their

hideouts, and arresting over-ground workers (OGWs) and sympathisers of the terrorists. In a massive security revamp, it was recently decided that all the mountain tops in the Jammu division would be manned by the army and the CRPF to ensure that the terrorists are deprived of the opportunity to carry out hit-and-run attacks on security forces. During the last few months, it was noticed that the terrorists would carry out attacks and then disappear into the densely forested areas in Poonch, Rajouri, Reasi, Doda, Kathua and adjoining districts in the Jammu division.

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi will hear public grievances at the CM's Grievance Cell at Unit 5 here Monday. Registration for the same will start from 8am till 12 O' clock while hearing of pleas will begin at 11am, said a release issued by the Information and Public Relations (I&PR) department.


"It is for the information of the general public that persons having genuine grievances will have to register their names and submit their complaints in writing. The same will be forwarded to the grievance cell for redressal," said a statement from the CMO. Discontinued since 2020 after surge in Covid-19 cases, the Chief Minister's public grievance hearing was revived by Mohan Charan Majhi-led first BJP government in Odisha.

More than 5,000 people from across Odisha, including differently-abled persons, lined up July 1 before the grievance cell to present their problems before the CM. A total of 1,540 people had registered during the first day of hearing while Majhi personally met more than 1,000 people.

The Chief Minister had said that he would continue to listen to grievances from the public every Monday.

Kishanganj(KCN): At least five people, including two children, died and seven others were injured on Sunday when a jeep in which they were travelling collided with a truck near Petbhari village in Bihar's Kishanganj district, police said. The accident took place around 11 am and the identities of those killed are yet to be ascertained. "Five persons, including two children, died on the spot. All seven injured persons have been

Assembly by-poll results need to be reviewed: Chhattisgarh CM Sai

Raipur ,(KCN) : BJP leader and Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Vishnu Deo Sai on Sunday said that the recent Assembly by-poll results, in which the BJP suffered a setback, need to be reviewed. The opposition INDIA bloc won 10 out of 13 seats in the by-polls in seven states and the BJP won only two seats. Sai said that there are different political situations prevalent in the country and in a democracy, the decision lies with the people.

"There are different situations. In a democracy, the decision lies with the people. The results need to be reviewed," he said. Meanwhile, reacting to the bypoll results, Congress leader Sandeep Dikshit said that if the Lok Sabha election schedule had been advanced 6-8 months, the BJP would not have won more than 120 seats. "Right after the look Sabha elections, we have won 12-13 seats in 4-5 states, which clearly indicates that the BJP's graph has been falling. Had the Lok Sabha elections been organised

after 6-8 months, BJP would not have won more than 120 seats," he said. "For the first time, NDA parties are performing better than the BJP in their respective states and the BJP is absolutely relying on them... The BJP has multiple organ failures and is failing in multiple states. It is soon headed to an ICU," he further stated. The results of the assembly by-polls came as a setback for the BJP, where the party won only two of the 13 seats, with the INDIA bloc winning 10 seats and an independent candidate

winning a seat in Bihar. Polling took place on July 10 for the assembly seats in seven states, including Bihar, West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Madhya Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, and Himachal Pradesh. The by-elections were held in one seat of Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Punjab, and Madhya Pradesh, two seats of Uttarakhand, three seats of Himachal Pradesh, and four seats of West Bengal. Uttarakhand witnessed the BJP losing both the two seats and saw the



victory of Congress. In Badrinath, Lakhapat Singh Butola defeated Rajendra Singh Bhandari by a margin of 5224 votes, whereas in Manglaur, Qazi Mohammad Nizamuddin secured victory against the BJP's Kartar Singh Bhadana by a margin of 422 votes. In Himachal Pradesh, Congress secured a win on two out of three seats, where Kamlesh Thakur from Dehra and Hardeep Singh Bawa from Nalagarh secured victory. Ashish Sharma from the BJP secured victory in

Hamirpur. In Punjab, the INDIA alliance's partner, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), secured victory in Jalandhar West. In Tamil Nadu also, INDIA alliance partner DMK secured a win from Vikravandi. In all four seats of West Bengal, the All India Trinamool Congress, which is the partner in the INDIA alliance, secured victory and defeated the BJP. In Bihar, neither the JDU of the BJP-led NDA nor the RJD of the INDIA alliance managed to secure a victory.

Cyber crime culprits arrested

mobile No. 9078206645 and falsely stated him that he is the collection agent of TVS Credit and told him to pay his EMI through phone pay. Being believed he paid EMI of Rs.5000/- through online at nearly GRAHAK SEWAKENDRA on 14.11.23. Further it came to light that the same culprit took away EMIs from customers Mahesh Oram of Kelda and Chandrakanta Rohidas of Katikela. On verification, at the Customer Care Centre where transaction was

made and found that the amount has been deposited in the account of one Jitendra Bhue. As all offences took place under Kolabira P.S. of Jharsuguda district, Area Security Officer of TVS credit Mr. Surya Kumar Panda along with other collection team accompanied the victim customer Sribastab Patel to Kolabira PS and lodged FIR as mentioned above. As the culprit is same, other two fact of offences have also been reflected

in the same FIR. During investigation the FIR named accused has been arrested from his native Katikela under Ambabhona PS of Bargarh district. During interrogation to him and basing on evidence, another accused Birendra Mirdha of Kharselpali PS - Dhama, Dist. Sambalpur also arrested and forwarded in to the Court of SDJM, Jharsuguda and the investigation is under progress.

Budget memorandum to Finance Minister

KOLKATA,(KCN): Narayan Jain , tax advocate, President of Calcutta Citizens' Initiative has written in pre budget memorandum to Finance Minister Nirmala Sitaraman that Taxpayers expect reduced tax burden. The exemption limit should be increased to Rs.5 Lakhs, Tax slabs need to be reviewed. 5 Lakh to 10 Lakh 10 percent, from 10 Lakh to 20 Lakh @20 percent and above



20 Lakh @25 percent. There is no longer justification to continue Surcharge and Cess. FM will do well to do away the same for the sake of

simplicity. It may be noted that the Govt does not justify as to how the education cess has been spent. After all providing education and medical facilities are duties of Govt. The tax under section 115BBE on unexplained cash credit/loans as well as unexplained investment and expenditure used to be charged @30 per cent but was effectively enhanced to 75 per cent plus cess from the time of demonetization from

Asst year 2017-18. Now it is high time to revert to rate of 30 per cent only. CA KN Gupta, Secretary of NGO said the tax structure should be simplified so that it is easier in tax compliance. The threshold limits for tax deduction and collection at source should be significantly revised upwards. TCS rate on foreign travel should be reduced to at best 5 per cent only.

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Maa Tujhe Salaam, India's anthem of pride, was actually created for a father

Cricketers Virat Kohli and Hardik Pandya singing AR Rahman's 'Maa Tujhe Salaam' during the celebrations of India's 2024 T20 World Cup victory will remain etched in our memory. The song by AR Rahman and Mehboob redefined love for the motherland 27 years ago. Here's how it was actually created for a father.

It was a heart-warming sight as Indian cricketers Virat Kohli, Hardik Pandya, and Rohit Sharma led the entire Team India in singing AR Rahman's 'Maa Tujhe Salaam' as a roaring crowd of 33,000 people joined them at Mumbai's Wankhede Stadium. Their heartfelt rendition on July 4 resonated perfectly with the song's poignant lyrics, capturing the collective euphoria of a nation celebrating the 2024 T20 World Cup victory. It was a moment that summarised not just the sporting glory but also the deep-seated emotions of millions across India.

Every year, watching the Republic Day Parade on DD National with the entire family feels complete only after AR Rahman appears on the screen, singing 'Maa Tujhe Salaam' in the end credits. This moment provides a perfect finale to the celebration of the nation's strength, diversity, and pride. The



song beautifully represents the tricolour in our hands and Bharat Mata in our hearts. The song, created 27 years ago, has transcended generations like few others. It has become India's anthem of pride. The three words — Maa Tujhe Salaam — stir up patriotic fervour every time the song, sung by AR Rahman, one of India's most celebrated composers and singers, is belted out. The three words beautifully complement Vande Mataram, praise of the motherland. The song holds a Guinness World record for being performed in the most number of languages. Despite its association with patriotism and motherland, the origins of

it are quite the opposite. It is inspired by a father and created for him. A top ad filmmaker working from Chennai in the late 1980s and early '90s, Bharatbala Ganapathy was inspired by his father V Ganapathy to make the 'Maa Tujhe Salaam' video with AR Rahman. "He was a freedom fighter," Bharatbala told Scroll, while adding, "He told me, 'You generate these big ideas for clients to create empathy for a product. Why don't you do the same for India? Vande Mataram was a war cry for us. Why don't you reintroduce it to a new generation?'" Following his father's suggestion, Bharatbala took a break from filmmaking and spent the next couple of years

creating what has become an ageless composition. He contacted AR Rahman, his long-time collaborator and school friend. His brief to the young singer-composer was simple, yet resounding, "We need to create a song, a sound that, even after 25 years, the new generation can resonate with." He needed a song that could tug familiarly at old hearts, yet connect to new ones. "I needed something to bridge the gap between the freedom fighter and the young," Bala told India Today. Initially, Bharatbala didn't have a vision about how the song would be created. "It was just a challenge that my father posed to me and I jumped into it,

and it took shape," he told Swarajya Magazine. But what helped him was contacting the right man at the right time. Bharatbala contacted AR Rahman at the right time. The singer was trying to break out from the "chains of film music". Rahman, in a 1997 interview with India Today, said, "It's easy making a masti number, but this [Maa Tujhe Salaam] was challenging." With the singer-composer finalised, the next challenge for Bharatbala was to zero in on the lyricist who could write something with a unifying impact on the country's patriotic mood. Rahman introduced lyricist Mehboob, who had written songs for

Bombay (1995), Rangeela (1995), and Daud (1997), to Bala. The song 'Maa Tujhe Salaam' was released in 28 countries simultaneously. The album 'Vande Mataram', of which the song was a part of, sold a whopping five lakh copies in its first week, and it continues to be the largest-selling Indian non-film album internationally. "Making the album was a great experience," Rahman told Nasreen Munni Kabir. It was a song he made with a lot of love. He later also emphasised the key to its success was adding a personal touch by making it for a mother instead of making it for a country. "In all lives, the common factor is, not many people have seen the divine, but we are created through our parents. If we have a sound and love in that life where we get the nurturing of a mother and a father, I think we are stable in mind," he told news agency IANS. "I had this in my mind on how to crack it because I was very objective about it, thinking about whether patriotism would work or not. So, I was like, forget about the country, let's do it as a personal song -- like singing a song for one's mother. That's how it was created," Rahman added.

7. Reasons recorded for initiating search or requisition of books of account and other documents u/s 132A :As per explanation inserted in sec. 132(1) amended by the Finance Act, 2017 with retrospective effect from asst. year 1962-63 and similar explanations inserted in sec. 132(1A) and sec. 132A (w.e.f. 1.10.1975), the reason to believe, as recorded by the Income-tax authority for initiating search proceedings or requisition of books of account, shall not be disclosed to any person or any authority or the Appellate Tribunal. In this connection the decision of the Supreme Court in the case of DGIT (Inv.) v. Spacewood Furnishers Pvt. Ltd. [2015] 374 ITR 0595 (SC) may be referred to, wherein the apex court held that reasons recorded prior to authorizing search need not to be disclosed or communicated to the person against whom the warrant of authorization is issued. No right is conferred on taxpayer of inspection of documents or to a communication

of the reasons for the belief at the stage of the authorization. The Supreme Court observed that “Any such view would be counter-productive of the entire exercise contemplated by Section 132 of the Act” and material may be disclosed only at the stage of commencement of the assessment after search is completed.

Further, the amendment has nullified the decision of ITAT Jodhpur Bench in the case of Shri Parma Ram Bhakar [TS-515-ITAT-2013(JODH)], wherein it was held that search conducted without recording reasons to believe is invalid and quashed the assessment framed in pursuance of invalid search. Reference may also be made to the apex court’s decision in the case of Ess Dee Aluminium Ltd. [TS-625-SC-2016], wherein it has been held that “if the assessment order which is based on the search operations is under challenge, the validity of the search proceedings can also be gone into by the CIT (Appeals)”. 8. Whether

information from CBI that a particular person possesses undisclosed money will constitute information for the purpose of search u/s 132:For a valid search there should be information which provides reason for believing that the person concerned is in possession of money or other assets representing, either wholly or partly income which has not been disclosed by such person and in the absence of such information search cannot be validity authorised. Mere intimation by CBI that money was found in the possession of a person, which according to CBI was undisclosed, without something more did not constitute “information” within the meaning of section 132, on the basis of which a search warrant could be issued, and the search conducted on the basis of such information and the block assessment made pursuant to such search was not valid - UOI v. Ajit Jain & Another [2003] 260 ITR 80(SC): 129 Taxman 74 (SC) : 181 CTR (SC) 22. 9. Whether information that documents, papers, undisclosed cash, jewellery and other assets is likely to be found, can form reason to believe so as to authorise a search u/s 132:Since the exercise of power u/s 132 is a serious invasion upon the rights, privacy and

freedom of the assessee, the power must be exercised strictly in accordance with law and only for the purpose for which the law authorised it to be exercised. The Commissioner or the Director of Investigation must have, in consequence of information, reason to believe that the statutory conditions for exercise of the power to order search exist.



The condition precedent for search and seizure is “reason to believe” u/s 132 of the Act which cannot be equated with “reason to suspect”.The information that documents, papers, undisclosed cash, jewellery and other assets were likely to be found at the residence of the assessee can at best be a “reason to suspect” but does not form any “reason to believe”. Therefore no valid search warrant under such circumstances can be initiated - Mahesh Kumar Agarwal v. Dy. Director of Income Tax & Others [2003] 260

ITR 67 (Cal), Spacewood Furnishers (P) Ltd. & Others v. DGIT (Inv.) & Others [2012] 340 ITR 393 (Bom); Madhu Gupta v. DIT (Inv.) [2013] 350 ITR 598 (Del.); Smt. Kavita Agarwal & Anr v. DIT (Inv.) & Ors. [2003] 264 ITR 472 (All.): 185 CTR (All.) 129. 10. Who can issue authorisation for search:The following authorities are competent to issue authorisation for

search: (i) Director General or Director of Income Tax; (ii) Chief Commissioner or CIT; (iii) Joint Director or Joint Commissioner, as may be, authorised in this behalf by the Central Board of Direct Taxes. (iv) Additional Director and Additional Commissioner have also been empowered to issue authorization for search by the Finance (No.2) Act, 2009 w.r.e.f. 01.06.1994 to 30.09.2009. Similarly, Joint Director or Joint Commissioners have also been empowered to issue authorization for search

w.e.f. 01.10.1998 to 30.09.2009. Similar, amendment has made in respect of cases for requisition of books of accounts u/s 132A. However, w.e.f. 1st October 2009 only those Addl. Director, Addl. Commissioner, Joint Director or Joint Commissioner who have been empowered by CBDT for the purpose of authorising search, can issue search warrants. W.e.f. 11.11.2009, CBDT vide Notification No. 82 of 2009 dated 11.11.2009 [F.No.142/23/2009 S.O. (TPL)(Pt)] has empowered the following officers to issue authorisation u/s 132(1) -All Additional Directors of Income-tax and Joint Directors of Income tax working under the Director General of Income tax (Investigation) and Director General of Income tax (Intelligence).The authorities who are authorised to conduct the search on the basis

of the search warrant are called ‘authorised officers’. These authorities actually carry out the search and seizure operation. 11. Whether a single Search warrant can be issued for search against a group of persons or for two or more individuals:There is no bar in authorizing search of a group of concerns by a single warrant issued u/s 132 - Jose Cyriac v. CIT [2012] 20 taxmann.com 738 (Kerala), Embassy Classic (P.) Ltd. v. ACIT [2012] 20 taxmann.com 291 (Bangalore), Dr. Oswald Anthony v. CIT [2004] 141 taxmann 520 (Pat.). 12. Where search warrant is issued in the name of a person, can other member residing in the same premises be also searched:Where warrant of authorisation indicated premises where search and seizure operation was to be conducted and said premises had not been partitioned by metes and bounds, while searching said premises, search of portions occupied by other person can also be made even though their names were not mentioned in authorisation of search, in such case provisions of section 153C would be attracted - Harbhajan Singh Chadha v. DIT [2015] 58 taxmann.com 21 (Allahabad). 13. Whether

multiple premises of a person can be searched on a single search warrant:Separate search warrant for separate premises is required. Since, the address of the place to be searched is required to be mentioned on the search warrant therefore no search can be conducted on the premises whose address is not mentioned in the search warrant. 14. In which Form search warrant is to be issued:As per Section 132 read with Rule 112, the search warrant is to be issued in Form 45, Form 45A or Form 45B, as the case may be. In case search is initiated as per the provision of Section 132(1), the search warrant is to be issued in Form 45. In case the search is initiated under the proviso to section 132(1) the search warrant is to be issued in Form 45A. In case the search is initiated u/s 132(1A) the search warrant is to be issued in Form 45B. The search warrant should contain the name of the person who is to be searched- Southern Herbals Ltd. v. DIT (Investigation) [1994] 207 ITR 55(Kerala). The address of the premises or place to be searched should be correctly mentioned. It should be signed by the authorized person. It should also bear the seal.

Crocodile nest numbers go down in Bhitarkanika

Kendrapara(KCN): The recently conducted census has registered a fall in the number of crocodile nests this year in the famous Bhitarkanika National Park in Kendrapara district.

A total of 114 estuarine crocodile nests were spotted in four wildlife and forest ranges within Bhitarkanika National Park by the enumerators, Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) of Rajnagar Mangrove (Forest) and Wildlife Division, Sudarshan Gopinath Yadav, said

Friday.

Last year, the Bhitarkanika National Park authority had spotted 122 nests of estuarine crocodiles in the Kanika, Gahirmatha, Mahakalapara, and Rajnagar wildlife and forest ranges under Bhitarkanika National Park, Yadav informed. According to Yadav, the Forest personnel have spotted 102 crocodile nests in the Kanika Forest and Wildlife Range, 10 nests under the Rajnagar Forest and Wildlife Range, and one each at the Gahirmatha

Forest and Wildlife Range and the Mahakalapara Forest and Wildlife Range.

Last year, the Forest personnel had spotted 107 nests of crocodiles in the Kanika Forest and Wildlife Range, 12 nests under the Rajnagar Forest and Wildlife Range, one crocodile nest in the Gahirmatha Forest and Wildlife Range, and two nests in the Mahakalapara Forest and Wildlife Range.

Generally, crocodiles tend to form nests in the same spot or nearby



areas where they previously laid eggs as they are acquainted with the location.

Female crocodiles lay eggs inside the mangrove forest near the water bodies of the park and

guard the eggs until the hatchlings emerge. During the nesting season, crocodiles lay

eggs by creating mound-like nests with mangrove leaves. Hatchlings generally emerge from the nests after about 60 to 70 days.

As female crocodiles in Bhitarkanika National Park grow up to 14 feet, they can lay nearly 45 to 60 eggs. If a female crocodile grows longer than 14 feet, she is likely to lay more eggs, Forest officials said.

As many as 50 eggs from a wild nest were collected from the Kanika Forest and Wildlife Range to be

incubated in captivity under semi-natural conditions at the Crocodile Breeding and Research Centre in Dangamal within Bhitarkanika National Park, the DFO said.

The 49-year-old captive albino, Gori, and the 21-year-old captive female albino, Mali, laid eggs a week ago in their nest and are now guarding the eggs, after a gap of three years, ACFin-charge of the Kanika Forest and Wildlife Range, Manas Kumar Das, said.

Scanty rainfall hits Bhadrak farmers



Tihidi(KCN): Even one month after the onset of monsoon in the state, Kharif farming activities in this block of Bhadrak district are yet to begin, primarily because of inadequate rainfall.

Additionally, the Dasamauja Canal, the only alternative irrigation source, has dried up. As a result, paddy fields in the block look parched with cracked soil, while the plants have turned yellow.

Even as the present crisis has caused despair among the farmers, it is feared that the situation will become worse if it does not rain significantly in the coming weeks.

Paddy is cultivated on around 20,000 hectares in the block. However, due to unfavourable weather conditions before Raja Sankranti, farmers were unable to prepare the fields. They could prepare the fields only after Sankranti. Some farmers even managed to prepare fallow fields for planting rice. It is learnt that around 4,000 hectares of land in various panchayats of the block have been prepared for paddy cultivation.

This year, farmers have sowed improved varieties of rice seeds which they purchased at Rs 750-1,000 for 20 kg pack. However, due to sporadic rainfall and intense heat,

water is quickly evaporating from the soil, causing the fields to crack and the rice plants to turn yellow.

Importantly, the farmers are staring at a situation when they will have to irrigate the land by shelling out extra money if it does not rain sufficiently in the coming days. This is because it will be difficult to pull the paddy seedlings from moderately wet fields for transplanting.

The present situation has also raised concerns about a significant dip in rice production this year. It is unfortunate that at this critical juncture water is not being

released into the Dasamauja Canal to irrigate the fields, said farmers. They have urged the concerned authorities to pay attention to the pressing issue and do the needful at the earliest.

Meanwhile, Block Agriculture Officer Raghunath Pati said that the adverse condition from the beginning of the farming season has disappointed the farmers. "If there is no significant rainfall in the coming weeks, it will lead to a situation where paddy cultivation will be affected and rice production hindered," he said.

be honoured with gallantry award in Delhi on this occasion. Bhanja has been invited to the Kargil Day silver jubilee celebrations at Sarsawa in New Delhi.

Bhanja joined the Indian Air Force in January 1964. He served as the Chief Engineer of the Indian Air Force's advanced aircraft Mirage-2000 which played a crucial role in winning the Kargil war. He was stationed at the Gwalior Air Base. As many as 24 Mirage-2000 fighter jets and
