

Odisha CM asks BMC to prepare Rs200crore plan to mitigate urban flooding in Bhubaneswar



to make provision for another Rs 200 crore fund in this regard. Majhi directed the Water Resources Department to take steps on a war-footing for immediate repair of the weak riverbanks and embankments in the state.

The Urban Development Department has been directed to clear the drains in the urban areas so that the floodwaters can smoothly get discharged through drains during heavy rainfall.

In addition to this, a long-term action plan will be prepared with technical support from IIIT Delhi to mitigate flooding in Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and other urban areas, he said. The CM directed the officials concerned to operationalise 24/7 control rooms in district headquarters and other offices during monsoon. He asked the health department to stock enough anti-snake venom in all health centres as more instances of snakebites are reported during monsoon. The CM said that people can get advanced information about calamities through the Satark mobile application. In view of possible flooding in the state, Majhi asked the Special Relief Commissioner (SRC) to coordinate with all the departments to reduce the impact.

Couple dead, three injured as car rams into stationary truck in Odisha

Jajpur(KCN): A man and his wife were killed, while three others were critically injured, after the car they were travelling in rammed into a stationary truck on NH-16 in Odisha's Jajpur district Thursday, police said.

The incident happened in the early hours near a petrol pump on the outskirts of Panikoili Bazar within the limits of Panikoili police station when the car was on its way to Balasore from Cuttack, the police said.

Police suspect the car's driver possibly lost control of the vehicle and hit the stationary truck from behind. The deceased, identified as Binod Behari Jena and his wife Sumitra Jena, were residents of the Sorora area in the Balasore district. Immediately after the accident, locals and fire department officials reached the spot to rescue all five occupants of the car, including the driver. A police team also reached the accident spot to join the rescue operation.

'All official work to be done in Odia': CM Majhi bats for promotion of language, heritage

Bhubaneswar(KCN): All official work of the Odisha government will be conducted in the Odia language, Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi announced Thursday. The Chief Minister, who had been functioning from the state guest house since being sworn in June 12, moved to the CMO at Lok Seva Bhawan Thursday, where he received a warm welcome from his Cabinet Ministers, state Chief Secretary Manoj Ahuja and other senior officials. Majhi entered his

language. The Odisha Sahitya Akademi, Odisha Sangeet Natak Akademi and Lalit Kala Akademi will be restructured and steps will be taken to augment their working capabilities, he said. “The Odissi Research Centre will be made effective and quality research on Odia asmita will be encouraged. Efforts will be made to promote reading habits among the people by expanding the library movement,” he said. A translation academy will be established for

Majhi added. He called upon the people to give suggestions as to what else needed to be done for Odia asmita. They can submit their proposals to the government in the coming days, he added. The Chief Minister made several announcements for the promotion and propagation of the Odia language, art, culture, and heritage in the state. Majhi said that the Odia Anubad (Translation) Academy and Odia Asmita (Pride) Bhawan will be established in the



chamber and, amid the chanting of Vedic hymns by priests, occupied the Chief Minister's chair in the presence of Deputy Chief Ministers Kanak Vardhan Singh Deo and Pravatī Parida, along with several other ministers.

Speaking to reporters, Majhi said, "Apart from tangible development, emphasis will be laid on cultural development. Importance will also be given to the promotion and preservation of Odia 'asmita' (pride)."

Majhi said he has issued instructions to the officers to ensure that all files put forth before him are in Odia language. He said all government work would be done in the Odia language. If needed, the Odisha Official Language Act will be amended.

The chief minister announced that a language commission will be set up for the promotion of the Odia

the promotion of the Odia language and literature while a mechanism will be put in place for the use of technology for the development of the Odia language, Majhi said.

Odisha Language Bhawan and Odia Asmita Bhawan will also be set up, he said.

To promote the art and culture of each district, Sanskruti Bhawan will be set up in all districts of Odisha, he said.

Special consideration will be made for the appointment of Odia teachers in high schools across the state. The work for the establishment of Paika Academy and Memorial at Barunei will be accelerated.

The state government is committed to giving importance to the development of the various heritage sites of the state. All work will be done with the cooperation and suggestion of the public,

state and that a Language Commission will be set up for the preservation and promotion of the Odia language.

He stated that the Sahitya Academy, Art Academy, Sangeet Academy, Odisha Lalit Kala Academy, and Odia Language Institute will be reconstituted and expanded. Local art and culture will be encouraged by establishing cultural bhawans in each district. Majhi said the library movement will be strengthened in the state, and efforts will be made to conserve, preserve, and develop heritage sites in Odisha.

He also mentioned that the appointment of Odia language teachers in high schools across the state will be considered, and research will be undertaken for the promotion, preservation, and propagation of Odia pride and self-respect.

Traffic comes to standstill as India's victory parade starts in Mumbai

Mumbai(KCN): The victory parade of the T20 World Cup-winning Indian team commenced after a two-hour delay as complete crowd chaos along the stretch of South Mumbai brought the traffic to a halt after Rohit Sharma and his men touched down a little after 5pm here Thursday.

As per the itinerary shared by the officials here, the two-hour open bus parade started from the National Centre for Performing Arts (NCPA) in Nariman Point till the Wankhede Stadium started a little

after 7:30pm in the evening as the Maximum City's stretch along the Marine Drive was drowned in an 'Ocean of Humanity'. The Indian team left could only fly from New Delhi around 3:42 pm after a breakfast meeting with the Indian PM Narendra Modi, having returned from Barbados in the wee hours of morning. The Wankhede Stadium here was thrown open to fans, who filled up the stands within minutes to celebrate the Indian cricket team's title triumph last Saturday.

After arriving in the city, Rohit Sharma's team and its support staff made their way to the southern tip of the city which houses the Wankhede Stadium. But not before their aircraft — a Vistara flight — got the famous 'Water Salute' after arriving here at the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport's Terminal 2. The players walked out of the airport with a sea of fans and media waiting for them for last several hours. Meanwhile, here at the iconic Wankhede

As the gates closed amid intermittent rain, extreme humidity and chaos of several thousand people arriving in the vicinity, those fortunate ones who were able to find their places inside Wankhede remained fixated to their seats even if there was scarcity of food and water. As the fans ran in all directions to take their places in the stands amid a heavy burst of rain, several pairs of footwear got left behind in the rush while debris of all kind was also thrown around along the way. While the wait extended,

rain kept pelting down with breaks but it could not force the fans off their seats inside the stadium. The DI kept entertaining with songs of all genres and at one instance it felt like Wankhede was hosting a rain-dance party with the stadium's speakers blurring out Vengaboys' party hit 'To Brazil' and country's unofficial sports anthem "Chak de India". Soon after, Wankhede came alive with its customary chants of 'Sachin... Sachin' followed by 'Mumbaicha Raja, Rohit Sharma!' and 'India... India'.

Hathras stampede: Six ‘sevadars’ arrested, UP Police says Baba to be grilled if required

Hathras: The Uttar Pradesh police Thursday said they have arrested six ‘sevadars’, including two women, of the organising committee in connection with the Hathras stampede that killed 121 people. The only accused named in the FIR is at large while preacher Surajpal, who is also known as Narayan Sakar Hari and Bhole Baba, will be questioned if required during the

investigation, a senior officer said. “All six persons who have been arrested worked are ‘sevadars’ (volunteers) at the ‘satsang’,” Inspector General of Police (Aligarh Range) Shalabh Mathur told reporters here. “A reward of Rs 1 lakh will be announced soon and non-bailable warrant (NBW) will also be issued against key accused Devprakash Madhukar,” Mathur said. The preacher, Surajpal,

was not mentioned as an accused in the FIR lodged at the local Sikandra Rau police station Tuesday after the stampede at Phulrai village that left 121 people dead in its wake. Those arrested have been identified by the police as Ram Ladaite (50), Upendra Singh Yadav (62), Megh Singh (61), Mukesh Kumar (38), and women Manju Yadav (30) and Manju Devi (40). Ram Ladaite is a native of Mainpuri district



while Upendra Singh Yadav is from Manipuri and the rest are local residents of Hathras. All six were arrested Thursday by the officials of Hathras Kotwali and Sikandra Rau police stations, the police said. IG Mathur said, “When information regarding the arrestees was obtained through detailed enquiry, these people told during inquiry that they are members of the organising committee and work as ‘sevadars’.” “The organisers and members gathered crowd and collected donations in the ‘satsang’ committee for cooperation,” the officer added. The FIR was lodged July 2 under Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita Sections 105 (culpable homicide not amounting to murder), 110 (attempt to commit culpable homicide), 126 (2) (wrongful restraint), 223 (disobedience to order duly promulgated by the public servant) and 238 (causing disappearance of evidence).

Ram Vilas Paswan: Successful Leader in Dalit Empowerment

The life of Shri Ram Vilas Paswan, an extinguished leader of Indian Dalit politics and former Union Food Supply Minister, who created miracles in Bihar politics, has been an inspiration for creating new standards in politics. He remained active in politics for more than five decades and played the responsibilities of MLA, MP and even Union Minister very well. Paswan is considered a leader who received love and support from people of every religion and community and he was known as a development man in the country. Paswan played an important role in implementing the recommendations of the Mandal Commission. During his tenure as Railway Minister, many projects were started in Bihar and in whichever ministry he was, the poor and marginalized people were always at the centre of his concerns. The life of Ram Vilas Paswan is a living document of his commitment towards Dalit empowerment. His 78th birth anniversary is being celebrated at the national level on 5 July

2024. Ram Vilas Paswan founded the Lok Jan Shakti Party in the year 2000 and his political journey started with the United Socialist Party. He was the only political personality who got the opportunity to work with many Prime Ministers and he was also the leader of the House in the Lok Sabha twice. He created a unique history by winning the election from Hajipur with record votes in 1977. He always fought like a karmayogi for the Dalits and the proletariat class. Ram Vilasji, who started his political journey from 1969, played an active role in the JP movement and emerged as a firebrand socialist. He was a public servant who gave voice to the deprived classes and constantly fought for the marginalized people. His life in politics was not only a great hero who promoted the Dalits and the deprived but also an inspiration of high character and moral values. Paswanji was born in Shaharbanni village of Alauli block of Khagaria district of Bihar. He was born on July 5, 1946 in a Scheduled Caste family to father Jamunji Paswan and mother Siya Devi. He first married Rajkumari Devi in the 1960s, whom he divorced in 1981. He has two daughters Usha and Asha from his first wife Rajkumari. In 1983, he married Reena Sharma, an airhostess and Punjabi Hindu from Amritsar. He has a son and a daughter from her. His son Chirag



Paswan is an actor turned politician, currently the national president of LJP and after winning the Lok Sabha elections with a huge margin, he is the Union Minister of Food and Supplies, following in his father's footsteps. He is the confidante of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi as his 'Hanuman'. The political life of Shri Ram Vilas Paswan has been a combination of many specialties and peculiarities. He contested elections 11 times and won nine of them. He once again became the Consumer Affairs Minister in the Modi government in the 17th Lok Sabha. Paswan, who could never become a major force in Bihar, kept himself a force in Delhi politics and remained a necessity for various Prime Ministers of the country for three decades. He also held important positions in the governments of Vishwanath Pratap Singh,

HD Deve Gowda, Inder Kumar Gujral, Atal Bihari Vajpayee, Manmohan Singh and Narendra Modi. This combative and resilient leader of Indian politics lived his life like a Karmayogi in politics. It is true that he was from Bihar, it is also true that he was from LJP, but the bigger truth is that he belonged to the nation, he was a national leader. He was a gem personality in the country's politics. There were many characteristics of the personality and work of this extraordinary politician who became the voice of the poor, the deprived and the Dalits; those noble values, such closeness to public life, such simplicity, such love for religion and culture and so much truth had made his personality very high. He continued to serve the country and the downtrodden till his last breath. His death was the end of a great leader with

a nationalist mindset and a messiah of the proletariat. He was a symbol of a series of people who lived by principles and ideals. His life was unique and exemplary of purity in political life, values, culture, Dalit politics, and struggle for the proletariat, the inspiration of not bowing down or compromising by remaining firm on principles. He was always different from others, untainted in corrupt politics, Fearless in thoughts, Firm in the face of crumbling values and Dignified in the crowd that broke through the fence. The positive perception and realistic thinking associated with his life were such powerful weapons whose attack never went in vain. For Bihar, he was truly 'Ram', that is loved by everyone. As a young leader, he presented his independent political thinking and viewpoint by strongly and effectively opposing the atrocities and attack on

democracy during the Emergency. While helping the needy, creating new political faces, smiling and laughing, behaving affectionately with the younger ones and having a lot of fun and laughter with people of his age, the life of Shri Ram Vilas Paswan will be considered inspiring, unique and extraordinary in the sense that he touched all the concerns of life. When he was a politician, he raised his voice for the Dalits and the deprived, cared for the proletariat class, and fought for their rights. His outlook was broad and he was committed to the interests of the Dalits. He was also a Dalit agitator and the architect of political events. He was always seen connected with the concerns of revolutionaries and senior freedom fighters. Despite being a big and busy politician, his spontaneous

participation in various religious and cultural activities were various aspects of his life. As much as he cared for the welfare of the Dalits, he was equally ready for the upliftment of the tribals. He got full support in the activities conducted under the leadership of Gani Rajendra Vijayji and Sukhi Parivar Foundation in the tribal areas of Baroda-Chhota Udaipur in Gujarat. He had a big plan for the welfare of Jain Tirthankaras in Bihar. He was counted among the strong leaders associated with the soil of Bihar and he had good relations with all the parties. Ram Vilas Paswanji was a very aggressive leader, his feelings towards everyone were always creative, and this always made him different from others. His attitude was always towards positive politics. His suggestions were so serious that they attracted everyone's attention. He used to give suggestions to move one step ahead of politics in the direction of development. He was not only an ally of the NDA alliance, but was also the main architect of its success. He was an important character in alliance politics. He tried to ensure that the deprived section of the society gets justice and its rights are respected. Ram Vilas Paswan gave a new direction to politics with his coordination policy,

simplicity and straightforwardness. He was one of the distinguished leaders who gave life to the cultural heritage of Bihar and raised his voice for the Jain-Buddhist culture of Bihar and fought for its rights. He was a politician who ruled the hearts of the people, he could stay anywhere like an ordinary worker. Bihar and its people were always in his heart and mind. The politicians who are stuck in the arrogance of power, corruption and ego would take lessons from him. He defeated the darkness of despair, inaction, failure and indifference with his self-confidence and the hopeful lamps of life. His life's endeavour was that people should not feel his presence; rather he worked in such a way that people remember him even when he is not among them. In this way, he gave a new dimension to his life and remained in the hearts of the people. His personality is such an ideal political personality that it can be called an inexhaustible source of development, culture, service and reformism of the proletariat class.

Garbage piles up in Silk City as BeMC, agencies shirk duty

Berhampur(KCN): Despite tall claims of various steps being taken by the Berhampur Municipal Corporation (BeMC) for adequate waste management, garbage is piling up in many wards of the civic body on account of abject failure on the part of agencies hired to maintain proper cleanliness, sources said Saturday. Things have come to such a pass that life has become miserable for the denizens of the Silk City.

As per sources, cleaning operations are being carried out by private agencies on behalf of the civic body which has earmarked an annual budget of

Rs29.42 crore towards the works. Private agencies such as Pratyush, Safai Abhiyan and PMR have been entrusted with the city's sanitation responsibilities.

The Silk City is divided into five zones and 42 wards for efficient management of civic affairs. Currently, 132 garbage collection vehicles and 1,336 sanitation workers are employed for waste collection and management. After the removal of dustbins, garbage is now being collected at designated spots and transported to five collection points in the city. From there, the waste is transported to Mohuda for disposal



after its segregation into dry and wet categories.

Additionally, GPS devices have been installed on garbage collection vehicles, which provide real-time

data to the sanitation department about their routes and collection details. However, the ground realities paint a different picture.

For instance, in Ward No. 28, near Gosani

Nuagaon overbridge, waste has piled up, turning the area into a dumping yard. Residents have alleged that sanitation workers are dumping all the waste collected from the ward

at one spot. Furthermore, reports said there have been several complaints of non-collection of garbage by the agencies entrusted by the BeMC.

Even though established rules require the agencies to collect garbage from designated points, violations have been reported including instances of irresponsible burning of garbage piles. This has caused severe inconvenience to locals owing to emanating smoke and odour. Repeated complaints to the BeMC authorities have not led to any effective action, they rued.

A similar situation is witnessed near Dhanamera Sahi where garbage accumulation has been causing significant odour issues affecting commuters. Additionally, the

promised 'transparency boards' displaying the number of sanitation workers and vehicles per ward have not been implemented. BeMC's assurance of resolving cleanliness complaints within 24 hours also remains unfulfilled, sources said. Residents' complaints to the BeMC about sanitation issues often remain unresolved, they added.

When asked, BeMC Deputy Commissioner Ashirbad Parida said agencies are being directed to immediately clean areas where garbage has been accumulating. However, the effectiveness of these directives remains questionable.

Elaborate Rath Yatra Arrangements by ECoR

Bhubaneswar,(KCN): Keeping in view the ensuing Rath Yatra, Ministry of Railways have decided to provide convenience to the devotees coming to Puri by Rail.

Safety, Security and additional services of Rath Yatra special trains have been planned along with sanitation and cleanliness of station premises in view of huge congregation.

Opening of a round-the-clock Control Room to look into passengers' issues as well as smooth train operations. Emphasis is to be given on effective announcements at station and smooth disbursement of tickets through additional ticket booking counters. Traffic & other arrangements and facilities at enroute stations have been given attention.

ECoR has extensively preparing for the Rath Yatra arrangements. The measures to be implemented by Railways during Rath Yatra are - Crowd Management, Train Information System/ Enquiry Counters, Video Walls Display, UTS on Mobile App, Additional Ticket Booking Counters and Mobile Ticket Counters, Pilgrim Waiting Area/Shed and Mela Shed to accommodate 15000 pilgrims & devotees, Security Arrangements, Catering & Hospitality, Medical Facilities & Ambulance, as well as the provision of power supply, water supply, cleanliness, security, drinking water, and sufficient toilets for the convenience of passengers. Railways aims to carry 15 lakh passengers to and from Puri during the festival. Apart from this, Special Trains will be run by using AI based dynamic Scheduling System.

Special Trains:Railways will be running more than 315 Special Trains from almost all parts of Odisha and from neighboring States like Chhattisgarh, Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal. A large



number of extra coaches will be put into service in order to run these special trains. Elaborate arrangements has been made for cleaning and watering of trains for ensuring pleasant and comfortable journey. Special Train will also run by using AI based dynamic Scheduling System.

Extra Ticket Counters:In order to handle large number of pilgrims, additional ticket counters will be opened at Puri Railway Station round-the-clock. Similarly, in order to handle the additional rush of pilgrims at other stations, additional booking counters will be opened at peak hours at Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Khurda Road, Brahmapur, Balugaon, Khalokot, Paradeep, Bhadrak and Jajpur Keonjhar Road along with other important other Stations in its jurisdiction. Enquiry Counters and I n f o r m a t i o n Centers:Additional enquiry counters will be opened at Puri Railway Station in addition to existing counters. These counters will be strategically located in the circulating area and near the temporary entry point at the extreme end of platform.

Passenger Help Desks will be set up near the buffer ends of Platforms in order to guide the passengers. Passengers can also enquire about the train running information, medical assistance, security assistance, etc. Time table and Publicity.A number of Train Timetable Boards will be put up at stratetgic conspicuous locations at Puri Railway Station and other important locations. Train Indication Boards, indicating the schedule of trains along with platform departure will be

functioning in Mela Shed and other locations at Puri Railway Station. Wide publicity of special trains to be run during the Rath Yatra will be made through PA System installed at Puri Railway Station. In addition, leaflets will be distributed amongst the passengers at the railway stations for educating the passengers regarding Rath Yatra arrangements made by the Railways.

Mela Shed. A large number of devotees are expected to arrive at the Puri railway station from various locations in and outside the State round-the-clock. In order to provide them with resting and toilet/ bathing facility, a temporary Mela shed is being erected at the Puri railway station to accommodate devotees. Permanent Mela Shed and Temporary Mela Shed will accommodate 15 Thousand Devotees/ Pilgrims at a time.

Catering and Drinking water:In addition to a Food Plaza at Puri Railway station, arrangements are being made for selling of Tea, Snacks, Water bottles and Janata meal. A number of drinking water taps are available on PFs of Puri Railway Station. Water Coolers are also available for ensuring cold potable water to the passengers. Additional food stalls will be functioning at major enroute stations.

Sanitation. Sufficient supervisors and staff will be deputed round the clock for ensuring proper cleanliness and sanitation in the station premises including the Mela shed and the circulating area. M e d i c a l Assistance:Medical Assistance Booth will be functioning in the

circulating area of Puri Railway Station round the clock. It will be manned by adequate doctors and nurses and other para medical staff and will have Ambulance service as well.

Illumination:Adequate arrangements are being made by railways for ensuring uninterrupted power supply at Puri railway station for ensuring non-stop functioning of lights, fans, electric equipment and other passenger amenity services.

LC Gate Management. Considering the heavy flow of road traffic through LC gates, additional manpower including GRP personnel, will be deployed at the L.C.Gates in order to ensure trouble free movement of train services and road vehicles.

Humble Services offered during the yatra. Like in previous years, railways will be providing trained workforce, breakdown attention tools such as Jacks etc., to attend any possible breakdown of Chariots during the Rath Yatra and also for assisting in turning of the chariots.

Safety and Security. Considering a large congregation of devotees at Puri Railway Station, elaborate safety arrangements are being made.

Large contingents of RPF, sniffer dogs and GRP would be mobilized for round-the-clock deployment. Fire service personnel will be available along with Fire Tenders at the station. Adequate Fire extinguishers have been made available at strategic locations. CCTV Cameras will be installed covering the entire length and breadth of Puri railway station in order to keep a close watch against anti-social activities. Apart from this, Steps have been taken for Crowd Management.

The game also dragged Corey Anderson from cricketing oblivion after a dazzling knock of 91 off 52 deliveries. Unicorns drafted in old war horse Liam Plunkett as the primary pick for \$70,000 in the draft last year. Unicorns stop-start campaign embodied the returns of their international stars including the likes of Marcus Stoinis and Finn Allen who failed to muster a single score of over 40 runs in 5 innings. The Unicorns made some sweeping changes to their international

rosters. The franchise will pin high hopes on their bumper signing of Pat Cummins. There would have been a temptation to parachute in Cummins as the captain following the leadership vacuum with the retirement of Aaron Finch but the Unicorns management bestowed the captaincy to Anderson keeping in mind his local wherewithals. World cricket's latest sensation Jake Fraser McGurk would hope to carry where he left off from

the IPL where he scored 330 runs striking at 234.04 while Kiwi, Finn Allen manages to retain his spot after a pedestrian season with the bat. Josh Inglis and Sherfane Rutherford have been entrusted to add the muscle in the middle order while fast bowlers Haris Rauf and Matt Henry will find themselves at the core of the Unicorns bowling attack. The Unicorns went all out to grab former Pakistan U19 captain Hassan Khan at the

MLC domestic draft this year. Khan bagged a top drawer \$75,000 contract for putting on a splendid all round show in last year's Minor League Cricket tournament, amassing 220 runs in 5 innings at a S/R of 181 to go with his tally of 11 wickets at an ECON of under 5. Khan will form a troika with left arm spinning all rounders Sanjay Krishnamurthy and Karima Gore. Former West Indies wicket-keeper Jahmar Hamilton has finally been rewarded for his stellar show in the Minor League season after season. Liam Plunkett comes back for yet another MLC season in what may finally be his swansong from the sport while Carmi Le Roux has been retained to form the only left hand seaming option for the Unicorns. both sides, with himself top scoring with an unbeaten 204 while Cameron Bancroft and Miles Hammond too crossed the three-figure mark. Meanwhile for Glamorgan, Marnus Labuschagne scored 119 while Glamorgan skipper Sam Northeast scored 187. He was also proud of how the bowlers were on the money throughout the game with Gloucestershire bowling 152 overs in the fourth innings. Germany's Toni Kroos confident ahead of quarter-final clash vs Spain

New Delhi: Veteran Germany midfielder Toni Kroos is confident ahead of quarter-final clash against Spain in Euro 2024. Kroos said the Spain clash will not be his last international match. Retiring Germany midfielder Toni Kroos is not feeling nostalgic ahead of their Euro 2024 quarter-final against Spain that would be his last match as a player if they lose. Kroos, who won the Champions League with Real Madrid last month and will hang up his boots after the Euros, came out of international retirement this year to chase the one major trophy missing from a vast haul that also includes the 2014 World Cup.

"It would be a sensational end but I have also considered the possibility of it not happening. I am not nostalgic at all and did not bring any treats for you (journalists) either," he told a press conference As Germany prepares for their Euro 2024 quarter-final clash against Spain, retiring midfielder Toni Kroos remains focused on the title, not nostalgia. Kroos, who recently secured the Champions League with Real Madrid, returned from international retirement this year to pursue the elusive Euro title, the only major trophy missing from his illustrious career. "It's the second most important title you can win, and it would mean a lot to me," said the 34-year-old Kroos on

Wednesday. "If I didn't believe we had a chance, I wouldn't have come back." Facing the possibility of his final match if Germany loses on Friday, Kroos dismissed any sentimental feelings. "I don't expect tomorrow to be my last game, so I assume we will see each other again," he told reporters. Germany is aiming for their first major title in a decade, following disappointing performances, including early exits in the 2018 and 2022 World Cups. "There were big doubts about this tournament given our recent history," Kroos acknowledged. "But we've achieved a minimal goal by reaching the quarter-finals, and now we're focused on



going further." The team is determined to

avoid another early exit, especially on home soil.

"We're not just playing for a bonus; we want to

win the tournament," Kroos emphasized.

"We've reached a stage we aimed for, and we're confident we can progress." Germany faces a tough challenge against Spain, a team they haven't beaten in a tournament since the 1988 Euros. Spain's Joselu, a Real Madrid teammate of Kroos, expressed his desire to send Kroos into retirement with a loss. "Because we will win? Is that a good enough answer," Kroos responded when asked about Joselu's wish. "We have a lot to offer against it, and we have good chances. The Spaniards play good football, and so do we. It will be an interesting game, not boring. I will do everything to ensure his wish is not fulfilled."
