


President Droupadi Murmu arrives in Odisha on four-day visit

PRESIDENT OF INDIA GRACES THE 96TH DEATH ANNIVERSARY OF UTKALAMANI PANDIT GOPABANDHU DAS

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu graced the 96th Death Anniversary of Utkalamani Pandit Gopabandhu Das at Bhubaneswar, Odisha today (July 6, 2024). Speaking on the occasion, the President said it

doesn't matter how long a person lives; rather, what is important is the kind of life he or she lives. That is, the reputation of a person is evaluated based only on his/her contribution to society and country. She stated that it is amazing to think about the number of good deeds Pandit Gopabandhu Das did in his short lifespan. She said that his contribution to the fields of social service, literature, education, and journalism is unforgettable. She paid her tributes to Pandit Gopabandhu Das.

The President said that Pandit Gopabandhu Das knew very well that no society or nation can progress without proper education. That is why he established Mukhtakash School, also known as Van Vidyalaya, at Satyabadi in Puri district. His approach of introducing students to nature right from the beginning is very important. Pandit Gopabandhu emphasised on holistic development of students through Van Vidyalaya. In his view, education does not mean only bookish knowledge



Bhubaneswar(KCN): The high-level committee set up by the Odisha government to supervise the Shree Jagannath Temple Managing Committee in carrying out inventoryisation of valuables including jewellery in the 'Ratna Bhandar' will meet July 9 to fix the date for reopening of the temple's treasury. Justice Biswanath Rath, who is the chairman of the high-level committee, said this after the committee held its first meeting in Puri Saturday. Speaking to media persons after the meeting, Justice Rath said, "After examining the available documents



observed that the repair work cannot be taken up without shifting the jewellery and other valuable materials stored in the treasury. It was decided in the meeting to ask the temple managing committee to take a decision on proper storage of the jewellery and ornaments during the repair work, he said. Rath said the SOP will also mention the inventorisation of valuables including jewellery immediately after its shifting to a safe place. During the last time, experts from Hyderabad and Chennai were brought for the inventory of the ornaments. So, this time also, the managing

committee will decide who will be engaged for proper inventorisation of the ornaments of the Jagannath temple, he said. "We hope that the repair work will be started and shifting of the ornaments will be completed during the annual Rath Yatra, before the return of Lord Jagannath and his siblings to the temple," he asserted. The reopening of the Ratna Bhandar was a major political issue in the state during the recently concluded elections. The BJP had promised to reopen the treasury for necessary repair work and inventory after it came to power in Odisha. The Ratna Bhandar was last opened 46 years ago in 1978.



viable district cooperative bank and a viable district milk producers' union. Even today there are two lakh panchayats in the country where there is no cooperative institution. In the next five years, we will work to create multipurpose PACS in these two lakh panchayats," Mr Shah said.

The Centre will soon bring a National Cooperative Policy, he said, adding that 1100 new Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) have been formed in the country, and more than 1 lakh PACS have accepted the new

bylaws. The National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) will be able to work for the welfare of more cooperative institutions with the issuance of bonds worth ₹ 2000 crore, Mr Shah said. He urged National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) and state cooperative banks to make arrangements for PACS and other cooperative institutions to open their accounts in the district or state cooperative banks, which will strengthen the cooperative sector and increase capital and confidence.

If this despicable nonsense by the policy makers in the parliament gives you a snigger of

satisfaction, enjoy it. Or withdraw yourself into solitude and shed at least a single tear for your having voted them to the temple of democracy. Should they be allowed to meet you in your respective constituencies after what they have put us through in the parliament? India, the largest democracy, is seriously disconnected with the ground realities. Both houses have become battlefields and revenge is the slogan. Those who lost for three consecutive terms began to display their desperation and the result is they are raucously wild. And those who made resounding victories twice have also reasons to be desperate. Of course, the apparent hysteria on both sides is enough to conceal the reality. Their relentless sarcasm on each other is a reminder to every citizen. As the world's largest democracy, we have not grown enough in terms of our constitutional responsibility. Except for his blazing presence as the Leader of the Opposition (LOP),

Rahul Gandhi's speech in the parliament was an underperformer's usual plaintive number. His gimmick was too harsh and embarrassing. Certainly, his presentation was a reflection of his acute intellectual crisis. He should have had the sense of what he had been up to in the parliament as he flashed pictures of divine figures. His statements not only highlighted his unchanged behavior, it also underscored his insensitivity. Arrogantly calling a particular religion in the parliament violent was a deliberate attempt to satisfy his party's vote bank, especially the minorities. The Prime Minister's reply had been direct, and he incrementally hit the opposition with resounding resilience. To what Rahul Gandhi meant by displaying the images of Gods in the parliament, the Prime Minister retorted by saying that images of Gods are not for Pradarshan for petty political gains, but they are for Darshan.

A devotee takes the darshan of the God and for a non-believer it is for Pradarshan (Display). I thought the opposition, having increased its tally considerably, would present its acts more responsibly. But its performance in the Rajya Sabha was a deplorable repetition of what it did in the Lok Sabha. Borrowing the words of Keir Starmer, Leader of the Labour Party in England, I would say that they have kicked the hope out of people thoroughly. They seemed to have retained their narcissist mindset loaded with contempt and took no notice of democratic values. The Prime Minister, throughout his speech, had exposed the volatility in their behavior and their double standard and impertinence for constitutional morality. This behavior of the opposition cannot be an admirable gesture. Distressingly, Sanatan Dharma, which represents almost 80 percent of India's population, is frequently under attack. It has become an international

phenomenon as most of the western views on India are designed and defined to accuse its Hindu ethnicity. And more distressing are the efforts to humiliate it in its birthplace. Rahul Gandhi's understanding of Sanatan Dharma goes against what in real terms it stands for. Imagine India without Sanatan Dharma. We need to understand how deeper its roots of congeniality penetrated and how impactful was its effect that survived for millennia despite external aggression toppling its symbols of civilizational greatness. Therefore, to imagine India without Sanatan Dharma at its center is terribly depressing. Throughout its political journey, the Congress party consistently failed to understand its depth and veracity. It has institutionalized its anti-Hindu stand. Sanatan Dharma or Hindutva is unadulterated nationalism. Its principal view of nationalism stems from the idea of

motherhood. Nation, according to Hindutva, is a manifestation of the divine in the form of mother. Consecration of Ram Mandir in Ayodhya was a reminder and a moment of obeisance to what Lord Ram stood for with regard to this idea of motherhood. He is the first proponent of nationalism, and the consecration of the temple was the reaffirmation of his iconic stand. In the Ramayana, a jubilant Lakshmana comes to Lord Ram after the latter slayed the demon, King Ravan. Lakshmana was mentally swept away by the beauty of Lanka which stood submersed in gold. He suggested Ram take hold of the reins of the island, where he thought life would be more satiating than in Ayodhya. Ram, with his heavenly composure, had made a statement to Lakshmana. He said to him with brotherly love and compassion sparkling in his eyes, that mother and motherland are greater than heaven.

There began, to be precise, an understanding that went for generations, and even today keeps elevating people to make great sacrifices for their country. Hindutva in principle is this notion, in its highest realm of application. And Rahul Gandhi for obvious reasons, has not been culturally equipped enough to understand this doctrine, which made brave men live and die for this noble cause. So, India, according to Hindutva, is not a tattered landscape which is closely stitched into a union for administrative reasons. But it is a cultural interconnectedness that survived through our rich traditions and practices. Rahul Gandhi seriously failed to know this dimension of India.

Prasanna bats for quota for state cricketers in IPL

Not just a money-making machine, The Indian Premier League (IPL) has helped Team India become a powerhouse of cricket, with many more wins than losses in all formats of the game. It has played a pivotal role in enriching the bench strength of the Indian cricket team. EAS Prasanna, a legendary former Indian spinner has suggested the introduction of a quota system for state cricketers alongside Indian and foreign players. When the IPL was inaugurated, many

hoped that local players would have ample opportunities to showcase their skills on a mega stage. As the Indian Premier League (IPL) continued to captivate millions of cricket fans around the world, there has been a persistent call for the inclusion of local talent in the league. However, as Prasanna pointed out, the dynamics of investment and returns took precedence. "When the IPL started, many believed that local players would get opportunities." "However, the reality is driven by investment and returns. No franchise will invest money without expecting a return, and the

BCCI's rules allowed overseas players in the playing XI," he said on the sidelines of the unveiling of Maharaja T20 Trophy 2024 in Bangaluru recently. Prasanna proposed a retrospective clause that could have significantly altered the course of the IPL. He suggested that teams could have been mandated to include a certain number of players from their respective states. "For instance, RCB could have been required to include four Karnataka players in their squad of 17. Similarly, teams from Maharashtra, like the Mumbai Indians, and other states could have picked their local talents," he explained. Despite

this missed opportunity, Prasanna acknowledged the invaluable contributions that foreign players have made to the league. "What foreign

players have brought to the IPL is the standard of fielding. It may be recalled that Prasanna, the legendary off-spinner used to cast a web with his flight and trajectory on the

opposing batters was part of India's triumphant spin quartet that clinched maiden victory over England and West Indies in 1971. The birth of Indian Spin Quartet brought

about a paradigm shift in world cricket. Never in the history of the game did spinners have the lead role in a bowling attack. The notion that spinners were expected to play the side show changed once and for all. As a civil engineer, Prasanna knew how to get his angles, loops and velocity right. After making his debut in 1962 and playing two Tests, came back with vengeance in 1967 and became skipper MAK Pataudi's main lethal weapon. Prasanna was often said to be a chess player in the body of a spinner; a man who outthought his victims well before reaching his delivery stride. What separates him from

others in the quartet was the fact that he always had complete control over the flight, which made him a very difficult person to pick even on even the most placid pitches. In 58 Tests, he picked up 242 wickets at an average of 29. 74 in 58 Tests. Ian Chappell, a highly talented dogged Australian batter regards Erapalli Prasanna as the best slow bowler he faced, and Prasanna retains healthy respect for Chappell's proficiency against spin.

of governing the state and working for its betterment, Bhagwant Mann is staying in Jalandhar due to the upcoming by-elections in Jalandhar West. I would like to ask, is Bhagwant Mann the CM of Punjab or a representative of only Jalandhar?" questioned Khadial. He further emphasized the growing discontent among the people of Punjab towards the Aam Aadmi Party government. "The Punjab CM can try his best, but it is clear that the people of Punjab have gotten fed up. Their bold claims of 13-0 in Lok Sabha elections by the AAP have failed to win only 3 seats, a similar image is set to be seen following



the by-elections in Punjab," Khadial predicted. Khadial painted a grim picture of the current state of Punjab, noting the lack of investment, industry, and infrastructure. He attributed the decline in employment and the

Bhagwant Mann-led AAP government is to be blamed for this," he asserted. He also addressed the pressing issue of brain drain, where the youth of Punjab prioritize migrating abroad over staying in the state due to the lack of job opportunities.

"Even though the situation abroad isn't fruitful, people still prefer that over staying in Punjab. This has all been caused due to the incompetence and inexperience of the Aam Aadmi Party, a party which has not worked throughout the last two years but only focused on false branding and marketing," Khadial said. PMAY goes haywire in Rayagada

Rayagada(KCN): The Centre sponsored housing scheme Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) has allegedly gone haywire in the tribal-dominated Rayagada district as over 862 beneficiaries have failed to build a house despite receiving work orders. The unavailability of land for the beneficiaries is said to be the chief cause behind this. The Union government launched the PMAY housing scheme in 2015 to provide pucca houses to poor households in the country. Officials said the Centre has been conducting surveys in rural areas to identify poor to very poor people and bring them

under the housing scheme. Villagers of Haladipada in JKPur alleged that the actual beneficiaries have failed to get the benefits of the scheme while work orders for the construction of houses are issued to only those who pay bribe. Moreover, many beneficiaries have received work orders but they are unable to carry out construction due to unavailability of land. Reports said as many as 862 beneficiaries were identified in 2021 and work orders were issued but they are unable to proceed as land is not available. As per government norms, the District Rural Development Agency (DRDA) which manages



and oversees the implementation of various anti-poverty programmes identifies the landless and submits the list to the tehsil office. The beneficiaries construct their houses after the tehsildar reviews the list

and provides government land for the purpose, an official of the DRDA said. He, however, said that they are regularly writing letters to the tehsil office but without any success. When contacted, Nihar

Ranjan Kanhar, executive officer of DRDA and Rayagada Zilla Parishad said that there were 2,868 landless beneficiaries in the district before he took charge. However, the number has come

down to 862 after he repeatedly raised the issue in Revenue Department meetings and wrote to the tehsildars to expedite the matter. Similarly, many PMAY houses are only halfway through their construction. A total of 38,180 beneficiaries have been identified and issued work orders in 11 blocks of the district in last six years from 2016-17 to 2020-21. However, 36,204 houses have been completed while the rest 1,976 houses remain incomplete. A maximum of 595 houses are incomplete in Kashipur, 378 in Muniguda, 204 in Kalyansinghpur, 108 in Chandrapur, 224 in Bissam Cuttack and

similar numbers in other blocks. Similarly, 26,647 beneficiaries have been issued work orders in 2021-22 FY. However, 13,643 houses have been completed while 13,004 are incomplete. A maximum of 1,951 houses have remained incomplete in Kalyansinghpur block, 152 in Bissam Cuttack, 652 in Chandrapur, 752 in Gudari, 870 in Gunupur, 1,206 in Kashipur, 1,510 in Kolnara, 1,530 in Muniguda, 710 in Padmapur, 550 in Ramnaguda and 1,553 in Rayagada. It has become a difficult task to transport building materials to the hilly regions in the district,

DRDA executive officer Kanhar said. "However, we are regularly conducting meetings and making efforts to complete the houses in the given time period," he added. Rayagada MLA Appalaswamy Kadraka alleged several beneficiaries in rural areas have been deprived of a house under PMAY. People are being harassed during transfer of money for construction while funds are not being released to the actual beneficiaries within the time frame. He however, assured to take up the matter with concerned officials and raise the issue in the state Assembly

Odisha to create dedicated force to handle natural disasters: CM

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Odisha government will initiate steps to create a dedicated force and raise the number of Odisha Disaster Rapid Action Force (ODRAF) from existing 20 units to 30 units to handle natural disasters, Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi said. Majhi who chaired the state Natural Disaster Committee meeting on Thursday said, ODRAF is the first state level Disaster Response Force in the country which is considered as the best force at the all India level. He said the ODRAF has brought laurels for the state in effectively handling natural disasters both in the state and outside the state. The Chief Minister said the Home Department will be asked to raise the ODRAF strength from 20 units to 30 units and create a Dedicated Force to meet any eventualities during the natural calamities. Majhi said keeping the Bahanaga train tragedy



in view, steps will be taken to create five Regional Fire Service Hubs in the state to handle such types of accidental calamities. He said the state government will emphasize zero casualties while managing the natural disasters and calamities. The Chief Minister said the south west monsoon had already set in and the state is expecting heavy rains, floods and cyclones till October next. Accordingly, a proper review meeting should be held and the administration has to be on alert to face the situation and initiate steps in advance for relief and rescue operation, drinking water problems and health care facilities. The ODRAF and the Fire Service Units, he said should remain alert and 24

X7 control room should operate in various departments at the block and district level. The Chief Minister said efficiency of the Fire Services has been strengthened with Rs.394 crores from the State Disaster Response Fund and another Rs 200 crore would be arranged for the purpose. Majhi also directed the Health Department to keep sufficient anti venom injection at the health centres keeping in view the possibilities of snake bite cases during the rainy season. The review meeting discussed the measures to control artificial flooding during torrential rainfall in urban areas in the state. The Chief Minister also directed the concerned departments to

undertake necessary repair of weak embankments and clean the drains in the municipalities. He said long-term measures will be taken to manage artificial flooding in Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and other cities on a long-term basis with the technical assistance of the IIT, Delhi. The Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation (BMC), Majhi said, would prepare a Rs.200 crore proposal for flood management in the city. State Revenue and Disaster Management Minister Suresh Pujari conducted the meeting attended by MPs MLAs and other senior officials. Special Relief Commissioner Satyabrata Sahu briefed the meeting about the preparedness to deal with the possible flood situation. The review meeting discussed the measures to control artificial flooding during torrential rainfall in urban areas in the state.

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The Odisha government has set a target to plant five crore saplings under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's 'Ek Ped, Maa Ke Naam' initiative, Chief Minister Mohan Majhi said here Friday. "The 'Ek Ped, Maa Ke Naam' campaign is going on across the country including Odisha. Under it, any person can plant a sapling and upload the photos," he said. The CM said 1.48 lakh photos have been uploaded in Odisha so far under this campaign, the highest in the country, while Kerala is at second position. Majhi said this while addressing at the state-level 75th 'Bana Mahotsav', a tree planting festival here at



Government High School, Dumuduma. "As Odisha's population is four-and-a-half-crore, we should plant at least an equal number of trees in this campaign," he said. He called everyone to get more involved in this programme and upload photos by planting trees. Majhi asked the district collectors and divisional forest officers (DFOs)

to conduct joint monitoring for the success of the programme. The state forest department has also decided to plant 19 lakh palm trees to check lightning strikes and resultant fatalities in the state. The trees will be planted in all forest blocks of the state, he said. Majhi announced that


