

The Bench, also comprising Justices JB Pardiwala and Manoj Misra, refused to pass any direction subjecting grant of citizenship under the impugned law to the outcome of the petitions challenging the validity of CAA.

Solicitor General (SG) Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, pleaded that the impugned law does not take away but grants citizenship and hence, no prejudice must

## KIMS Doctor Saves Life Mid-Air on Air India Flight

**Bhubaneswar, (KCN):** In a remarkable display of quick thinking and medical expertise, Dr. Ashok Kumar Badamali, senior consultant in Cardiac Anesthesia at Kalinga Institute of Medical Sciences (KIMS) Bhubaneswar, saved the life of a fellow passenger aboard Air India Express flight IS 764 enroute from New Delhi to Pune. The incident, which unfolded in the early hours of the morning, began when the cabin crew, led by Mr. Saurav, made an urgent



a n n o u n c e m e n t requesting the assistance of any onboard paramedics or nursing personnel due to a medical emergency. A middle-aged woman was found unresponsive

in her seat, prompting immediate action. Dr. Badamali, who was traveling to Pune for research activities, promptly responded to the call for help. The patient was moved to the floor of the aircraft to facilitate resuscitation efforts. Upon examination, Dr. Badamali found the patient to be unresponsive, and exhibiting agonal breathing, with an extremely fast carotid pulse. Utilizing his expertise in cardiac emergencies, he performed a carotid

massage that proved to be life-saving. Under Dr. Badamali’s careful management, the patient was placed in the recovery position and remained stable until the flight successfully landed at Pune International Airport. The pilot of the flight, Mr. Rahul, along with crew members Mr. Saurav and Miss Puja, expressed their gratitude to Dr. Badamali for his timely and decisive action. Dr Achyuta Samanta, Founder, KIIT, KISS, and KIMS also thanked Dr. Badamali for his service.

## SRK's wife Gauri Khan in legal trouble as FIR registered against her over property issue



Gauri Khan, a well-known interior designer and Bollywood superstar Shah Rukh Khan's wife, has found herself in legal trouble as an FIR has been registered against her, here.

The FIR, which has been registered under the Indian Penal Code (IPC) section 409 (criminal breach of trust), was

registered at the Sushant Golf City police station in Lucknow.

The managing director of Tulsiani Construction and Development Limited, Anil Kumar Tulsiani, the director, Mahesh Tulsiani, and the brand ambassador, Gauri Khan, have all been named in the FIR.

They have been accused of not delivering a flat to a buyer even after receiving payment of approximately Rs 86 lakhs.

Kirat Jaswant Shah, a resident of Mumbai, has filed the complaint, claiming that he had paid the entire amount for the flat, but had not been handed over possession.

The flat in question is located in the Tulsiani Golf View project in the Sushant Golf City area of Lucknow.

The buyer alleges that Gauri Khan's promotion of the project influenced his decision to buy the flat. She's considered among one of the best interior designers in Bollywood and has decorated the houses of many celebrities like Sidharth Malhotra, Farah Khan, Ranbir Kapoor and Jacqueline Fernandez, among others.

This FIR against Gauri comes at a time when her husband Shah Rukh has been basking in the success of his recent blockbuster 'Pathaan'. Helmed by Siddharth Anand, the action-packed movie breached the Rs 500 crore net in Hindi within a month of its release and has crossed the Rs 1000 crore worldwide.

## Salman Khan teaches democracy to Indians (and Pakistanis) in Tiger 3. Let that sink in



What if someone told you that the latest Salman Khan actioner can give you a ready reckoner on why democracy is better than dictatorship? Maneesh Sharma's Tiger 3 is not just the popcorn-and-patriotism entertainer you always expected it to be, the latest Bhai film also expounds the idea that democracy needs to be protected against people who declare themselves to be the sole custodians of the country, making you hopeful for the future of Indian movies. For many decades now, star-driven action films in India have been all about seeking revenge. It could be for the death of the hero's beloved, or any other woman; it could be some childhood trauma that has scarred him for life and he is now looking for comeuppance; or, it could be all about seeking retribution for one's country. The last one has been frequently revisited in our films and has appealed to the masses. The idea of patriotism, however, has changed a fair bit in our movies and in 2023, this was particularly evident. The year started with Shah Rukh Khan's Pathaan where a Pakistani agent, played by Deepika Padukone, had the crowd cheering for her when she joined forces with SRK's Indian agent to save humanity. A few months later, in Jawan, Shah Rukh gave a rousing monologue where he spoke directly to his fans about the importance of voting for the right candidate. The film did not shy away from taking shots at the corrupt troika of bureaucracy, politics and business. And the year ended with Salman Khan in Tiger 3 where his main mission was to save Pakistan from the evils of dictatorship.

Tiger 3 is an Indian film with an Indian hero at the center of its story but strangely enough, India has no stake in the story of this film. The many times when Tiger is asked as to why he cares about what's happening in Pakistan, he comes up with a rather flimsy excuse, a reason he repeats many times in the film. It makes you wonder why Maneesh and Salman zeroed in on this subject for the third Tiger installment. In the film, the protagonist asks his crew, who are stand-ins for the audience, a question that immediately tells you about the central idea of this film. ‘Democracy or dictatorship?’ asks Tiger and his crew responds in unison, ‘democracy.’

It is a rather strong statement when one of the most successful movie producing studios in the country decides to make a film where a choice as simple as this, at least for Indians who have been living in a democracy for over 75 years, needs to be reminded to the audience. The makers actually had to spell out why the need to have fair elections is essential and why democracy is better than having a dictator, the villain of this story, who might pretend to have good intentions. They underline that complete control in the hands of one person can't be good for the health of a nation.

## Boosting the popularity of social media posts

Computer scientists created a new algorithm to recommend tags for social media posts which should boost the popularity of the post in question. This algorithm takes into account more kinds of information than previous algorithms with a similar goal. The result is a measurably improved view count for posts which use the tags recommended by this new algorithm. Such research could be useful commercially and for other researchers who study online behavior. Xueting Wang is a postdoctoral researcher at the Yamasaki Laboratory. As a keen user of social media sites, she was puzzled by how different posts by different people achieve notoriety or

fade into obscurity. Driven by this curiosity Wang, her colleague Yiwei Zhang and their supervisor, Associate Professor Toshihiko Yamasaki, investigated the relationship between social media content, the tags attached to content and the people who post it. "It is well-known in our field that tags for social media posts are important," explained Wang. "It's also known that the nature of these tags, and the relative popularity of the user in question, can impact the popularity of a post -- for example the number of views. What I wanted to do was come up with a system to recommend suitable tags for your posts that would demonstrate

improve their popularity." This is far easier said than done. Computers are exceptional at precisely defined mathematical tasks; however, some of the social concepts explored by the researchers, such as a user's popularity, are too vague for a computer to process directly. Wang and team had to carefully define every aspect of the problem in mathematical terms for an algorithm to be possible. "We had 60,000 publicly

available images with tags, number of views and associated user data from photography website Flickr to experiment with," continued Wang. "That gave us enough source data to make a system to score different user and image details, and assign numerical values to things. This meant we could perform different functions on the data." Wang and team used this data to rank the effective success of a specific tag in contributing to the images view count.

Essentially, successful tags were recommended by this process that resulted in a 20-percent boost to the popularity of a post. But what sets their approach apart from others is that it takes into account who created the post. The system cleverly imitates the tagging behavior of people with high social popularity scores to recommend effective tags. "The algorithm is called the 'user-aware folk popularity rank' and it is the first of its kind to be,

as the name suggests, aware of the user in how it recommends tags," said Wang. "We see from our results that carefully selected tags which express emotional impressions rather than just literal representations of the image content will be more effective. But all the tags the system produces are from an existing pool and it would be good to grow our system so it can generate new ideas."

To enhance the stock of Hilsa population and support the livelihood of local fishermen, the ranching was performed at the upstream of Farakka barrage with those artificially bred 13.9 lakh hilsa eggs and 40000 spawn in the river Ganga, in different suitable place at Rajmahal, Jharkhand, Baluga and Gaziapur Malda, West Bengal to protect it from strong currents and human interference.

## "Worthless": Ajit Pawar Scolded By Older Brother For Leaving Uncle Sharad

**New Delhi(KCN):** Ajit Pawar may be Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister, but that hasn't stopped his brother - Shrinivas Pawar - from exercising an elder sibling's privilege, a stern rebuke, ahead of the Lok Sabha election. A video of Mr Pawar's scolding has been shared online. In it, Shrinivas Pawar distances himself from his brother and labels him "nalayak", or "worthless". He also accuses him of abandoning their uncle, Sharad Pawar, when the veteran politician needed him the most. "It is my personal opinion there can be no more worthless person than him (Ajit Pawar)," Mr Pawar told reporters. Not insignificantly, the jabs came as he visited a temple in Maharashtra's Baramati, which is the family stronghold; Sharad Pawar is a six-time MP from this seat, including four consecutive wins between 1996 and 2004. The seat has been held by his daughter, Supriya Sule, since. In the 2024 election Ms Sule will likely face-off against Ajit Pawar's wife



Sunetra. "I followed Ajit all the time... in all situations. I supported decisions and never questioned him. Many people know me here (Baramati)... I grew up here. When Ajit and I had a discussion, I told him, 'you keep contesting Baramati as MLA and leave Lok Sabha under Pawar saheb's leadership... as we are grateful to him for various things he did for us. I didn't feel good about leaving him alone at 83.'" Pawar senior also said the 83-year-old Sharad Pawar had done a lot for the family. "Some of our friends told me the future lies with Ajit instead of Sharad... but this thought was very painful. (I don't) want to

leave a person in their old age... a person who can benefit us. In my personal view, if someone thinks in such a way, he is an incompetent person," he declared. Shrinivas Pawar wasn't done yet. He also accused Ajit of standing on the shoulder of their uncle for political gain, and then casting him aside, and then appeared to signal a break with his brother. "This is like removing the owner of a house after getting ownership of the land. We all know whoever got positions in politics... it was because of Sharad Pawar. Like medicines (which have an expiry date) some relationships also expire. I am 60... I can't live under pressure," he said.

Shrinivas Pawar's broadside at his brother was a stinging one, but it was unlikely that it was an unexpected one; last month the Deputy Chief Minister said, "My entire family will now be against me. They will campaign against me... but my workers are my family now." This particular Pawar versus Pawar squabble comes as Ajit Pawar's faction faced a setback in the Supreme Court in a battle for the undivided NCP's clock symbol. It, and the NCP name, was given to Ajit Pawar by the Election Commission, but the Sharad Pawar camp has challenged that award. The court has, for now, said the Ajit Pawar camp gets the symbol, but only with

The Pawar family split also compounded the problems of the Maha Vikas Aghadi, a mismatched (on the face of it) alliance between the Congress, the NCP and the Shiv Sena group led by ex-Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray, which went through its own civil war almost exactly one year earlier.



# 'Is this development?' Neglected Odisha village threatens poll boycott

**CUTTACK (KCN):** Development has been a mirage for the villagers of Bondal under the Tangi-Choudwar block of Cuttack district.

Only 20 kilometres away from a town, Bondal village is inhabited by some 80 families. For the villagers, basic amenities are a distant dream, let alone the government schemes that seem to have made a detour to the village.

With no motorable road, an ambulance can't come to the village. Shifting a patient or a woman in labour to the hospital is always a herculean task for the villagers. There are instances when serious patients were shifted on

motorcycles.

About the drinking water facility, the least said the better. There is only one tube well in the village to meet the requirements of 80 families, forcing villagers to use water from a pond.

The wait for a pucca house seems unending. Hema Mallick and Sanatan Mallick are two eligible beneficiaries for a pucca house but they are yet to receive them. For a house, they have requested administrative officials to the local MLA, but to no avail. In 2020, Sanatan Mallick received the work order for his house. Meanwhile, four years have passed, and nothing has progressed.



The villagers' pent-up anger may find an outlet this election as they are determined to boycott polls. "Six to seven years have passed since Cyclone Fani pulled down my house. I am still living in a dilapidated house. Is this the real picture of development?" rued Sanatan.

"In the absence of a road, neither ambulance nor fire tenders can reach our village. We experience a lot of difficulties when we have to shift a patient to hospital or when a house catches fire," said Abhisekh Mallick, a villager.

"When the election comes, leaders make a beeline with a list of promises. But after the election, they forget us. This time, we won't cast votes," said Mitu Mallick, a villager.

When contacted, Tangi-Choudwar BDO Hemanta Kumar Mohanta said, "After an enquiry, we will take appropriate steps."

## SRC On Contingency Plan

**Bhubaneswar (KCN):** As the General Elections 2024 is going to be held in sunny May, Special Relief Commissioner (SRC) ACS Satyabrata Sahu has asked all Collectors to prepare a contingency plan for smooth conduct of the twin elections.

Writing a letter to all Collectors, the SRC Shri Sahu said General Elections, 2024 has been declared by the Election Commission of India. During this period, there may be extreme heat wave conditions which challenge health and conduct of elections.

The IMD has issued seasonal outlook on temperature and rainfall for hot weather season during March to May, 2024. The maximum temperature is most likely to prevail over most of the parts of the State, ACS Shri Sahu said. Similarly, the IMD has been issuing daily



bulletins during the Summer Season. He asked the Collectors to follow these bulletins daily for appropriate actions. They have been requested to take mitigation, preparedness and response measures. "Heat wave mitigation measures involve multi-sectoral and multi-

dimensional administrative approach such as provisioning of drinking water, temporary shelter, rescheduling of working hours, rescheduling of timing of schools/public educational institutions and providing better medical emergency services and public

health, etc. to reduce the negative impact of extreme heat wave conditions," the SRC noted.

As it is an election year, several rallies are going to be held. So, the collectors were instructed to take proactive measures with the help of concerned line Departments.

SRC Shri Sahu directed the Collectors to follow the detailed instructions that had been communicated in February on preparedness and precautionary measures to be taken in view of the Heat wave conditions, 2024. "Your personal attention is highly required for effective heat wave management in your district. Any untoward situation shall be brought before the undersigned for immediate intervention," he wrote to the Collectors.

## BJD Holds Poll Talk





**Bhubaneswar (KCN):** Amid speculations over its pre-poll alliance with BJP, the Governing BJD today formally started holding meetings for the upcoming Lok Sabha and Assembly elections in the State. # Nigeria stun understrength Namibia at African Games

**New Delhi:** The Achimota Oval at Accra witnessed one of the greatest updates in T20 Internationals on Monday (March 18) as 38th-ranked Nigeria snatched a last-ball win over a depleted Namibian side at the ongoing African Games. This result dealt a critical blow to Namibia's hopes of direct qualification for the 2026 T20 World Cup. Nigeria captain Sylvester Okpe sealed a famous comeback victory with a booming six over extra cover on the final ball of the 20th over, slamming a hip-high full toss from Shaun Fouche out of the ground to complete what, by ICC T20I rating, was the most extraordinary upset in the history of the format. Before the two sides met, Nigeria's T20I rating was a mere 74.00, while Namibia were nearly 119 points above them at 192.78, vying to hold onto a crucial slot in the top 12 which could see them through to the

2026 T20 World Cup come the cut-off at the end of June. The confirmation of the qualification criteria for the 2026 T20 World Cup last week set up a rankings-race that will see Namibia jockeying for position with Ireland, Zimbabwe, Scotland and the Netherlands to secure the insurance of a top 12 ranking ahead of the 2024 edition. The announcement that the ICC would again be relying on T20I rankings to allocate between two and four qualification slots for the flagship short-format tournament affords a potential lifeline to sides failing to make the Super 8 stage of the 2024 edition, lending a sudden salience to poorly-understood rankings table. In the context of that contest, Namibia will likely rue their decision to send a development squad to Ghana for the African Games, having now lost both of their first two

matches - the first to a similarly understrength Zimbabwe and now to a spirited but unfancied Nigerian side. Missing the majority of their senior side, Namibia struggled to impose themselves with the bat after winning the toss. Left-arm spinner Isaac Danladi claimed two wickets for just six runs in his first three-over spell as Namibia struggled to 30-4 in the Powerplay. Young offspinner Joshua Asia kept the pressure on at the other end, his four overs returning figures of 1-14 as the Namibians were frustrated through the middle overs. Dylan Leicher's unbeaten 42 from No. 6 ensured a measure of respectability at the break, seeing Namibia to a total of 121 for 7, but with barely a run-a-ball required, Nigeria will have sensed an opportunity. The Nigerian top-order



opted for a cautious approach to the chase, allowing the asking rate to climb as they crept to 79-3 with six overs to come. It looked as though they would regret their timidity when they finally looked to hit out. However, first the set Ridwan Abdulkareem and then teenaged finisher Prosper Useni holed out off consecutive deliveries from Namibia skipper Jan-Nicol Loftie Eaton in the 15th over.

Simon Shikongo then dealt a further blow in the next over, sending an arm-ball into Sesan Adedeji's leg sump as he backed away for room. At 85 for 6 after 16, with the required rate climbing toward double figures, it seemed as though Namibia were on course to dodge the bullet. Nigeria's captain had other ideas however, keeping his side in the game even as his brother

Isaac was stumped at the other end for 12 in the penultimate over. New man Mohammad Taiwo jumped across two feet clear of off stump to smear Jan Balt for a six over backward point off the final ball of the 19th to reduce the equation to 14 needed off the final over, as Namibian nerves began to fray. Both bats then found the rope off Shaun Fouche to put the Nigerians

clearly ahead for the first time in the chase, before a scrambled leg bye brought Okpe to strike with just two required to win. A bungled attempt to run out Taiwo at the non-striker's end held up proceedings, but when the ball finally came it arrived on the full around sixth stump and Okpe needed no second invitation, swinging through the line to send it out of the park over extra cover for six. The win keeps Nigeria in the hunt for a semifinal spot, while for Namibia, though they too remain in contention to progress, the implications are grave. The defeat will take approximately three points off their T20I rating, a blow that will be exacerbated come the rankings refresh on May 1st. Having begun the tournament in pole position in the rankings race, ranked 11th ahead of full members Ireland and Zimbabwe, they now

sink to 15th and face an uphill battle to undo the damage of the past three days. Should they remain outside the top 12 on the rankings table, a run to the Super 8s at the 2024 World Cup will be their only route to direct qualification for the following edition. In the context of the African games, they will need an emphatic win over Tanzania in their final group game on Wednesday to keep their semifinal hopes alive. Nigeria meanwhile, currently level with Tanzania on one win apiece, will likely need another big upset when they face group-leaders Zimbabwe in their last group game in two days' time if they are to progress in the tournament. **New Delhi:** A swashbuckling half-century from Heather Knight was instrumental in England taking a 1-0 lead in the T20I series against New Zealand. While Tammy Beaumont fell early for 15, Sophia Dunkley set herself up for a long haul at the crease after smashing six boundaries. However, she fell for 32 by the end of the eighth over, forcing England to rebuild.

Knight then joined forces with Maia Bouchier to revive the innings as the duo ended up adding 91 for the third wicket. While Bouchier couldn't accelerate as much as she would have liked, Knight was fluent in her stay at the crease as she hammered 63 before departing in the penultimate over as England finished with a strong 160 on the board. In reply, New Zealand

were handed a blow very early in the game as 19-year-old Isabella Gaze fell in the first over for a duck. Georgia Plimmer and Suzie Bates then added 60 for the second wicket but they allowed the required rate to climb up. Maddy Green's 14-ball 8 added to their woes as the onus was now on Bates to help the hosts get closer to the target. While she did hit a fifty, needing 71 from the final five overs proved to be too much for New Zealand as they fell well short of the target by 27 runs. ## Sarfaraz Khan, Dhruv Jurel awarded with central contracts by BCCI

**New Delhi:** India's newest batting star Sarfaraz Khan and wicket-keeper Dhruv Jurel were inducted into Group C of BCCI's central contract with an annual retainership fee of Rs 1 crore, having fulfilled the criteria of playing three Tests in a current season. Their names were ratified during BCCI Apex Council meeting which was held on Monday. Sarfaraz, a domestic heavyweight for Mumbai, scored three half-centuries in three Tests against England while Agra man Jurel, with scores of 90 and 39 not out in a tricky chase at Ranchi, won the Player of the Match in



only his second game. The BCCI is likely to revisit the Ranji Trophy calendar for the next season and will not schedule any matches in the northern part of India during the months of December and January, when fog and bad light

often play spoilsport. While the detailed domestic calendar will be announced later, the BCCI Apex Council did discuss the tentative schedule of the 2024-25, which was one of the primary items in the eight-point agenda of the

Apex Council meeting on the day. For the past few seasons, the Ranji Trophy is starting in January and ending in second week of March and in north-Indian cities like Delhi, Chandigarh, Kanpur, Meerut, Jammu,

Dharamsala, most matches are being affected by bad light and fog during peak winter months. "No decision has been taken yet but Ranji Trophy, like earlier years could start from mid or end October after the Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy, which serves as an IPL auction platform. Some states are losing crucial points in do-or-die games because of inclement weather from mid-December to mid February," a senior BCCI source told PTI. It has been also learnt that BCCI will form a committee, which will decide whether union territory Daman & Diu get associate membership.

## KL Rahul to join LSG in next two days

**New Delhi:** KL Rahul, undergoing rehab at the National Cricket Academy (NCA) in Bengaluru, will join his Indian Premier League (IPL) franchise in two or three days. The skipper of the Lucknow Super Giants team, who has been out of cricket since the first Test against England in January, has been cleared to take part in the IPL. "He will be very much available from the first game of the season," said a franchise source. Rahul was expected to leave for Lucknow on March 20 but in view of the pre-IPL Captains Conclave in Chennai on March 21, he may join the teammates a day later. LSG's first game is against Rajasthan Royals in Jaipur on March 24. The IPL kick-starts on March 22. As previously reported by this website, Rahul will



be using the IPL as a platform to make a comeback into Twenty20 Internationals. A career opener, Rahul will be playing in the middle order and also will be keeping wickets during the IPL. "He will be keeping wickets from the first game itself to stake his claim in the India team for the Twenty20 World Cup," a source, well conversant with the development, said. Rahul, who went to London to consult an expert for nagging quadriceps pain last month, was cleared by NCA on Monday after

he proved his fitness by playing a game. It has come to light that Pat Cummins, a Rs 20.5 Crore buy by the SunRisers Hyderabad, will be linking up with his teammates in Hyderabad on Tuesday. The SRH team has been having a camp in Hyderabad for the last few days and Cummins, named captain of the side, has taken permission from the management to join the side a little late. Mitchell Starc, Cummins's Australia teammates, has joined Kolkata Knight Riders while in Bengaluru. Virat Kohli, who missed the five-Test home series against England this winter due to birth of his second child, has integrated himself with his Royal Challengers Bangalore teammates on Monday.

## Miami Open: Simona Halep set to face Paula Badosa on return from doping ban

**New Delhi:** Simona Halep will make her competitive return this week after winning an appeal over a doping suspension when she takes the court at the Miami Open where Indian Wells champion Iga Swiatek will look to pull off the Sunshine Double. Halep, who accepted a wild card into the Miami Open after her four-year ban was cut to nine months by the top court for global sport, will face Paula Badosa on Tuesday with the winner getting world number two Aryna Sabalenka in the second round. For Halep, the clash against world number 80 Badosa of Spain will mark her first match since the 2022 U.S. Open where she was upset in the first



round by Ukrainian qualifier Daria Snigur. Halep, a former Wimbledon and French Open champion, was suspended in October 2022 after testing positive for roxadustat - a banned drug that stimulates the production of red blood cells - at that year's U.S. Open. Halep vigorously denied the charges against

her. The Romanian former world number one owns a 2-0 record in head-to-head meetings with Badosa, having never lost more than three games in a set. Top seed Swiatek missed her Miami Open title defence last year due to injury but returns in stellar form and fresh off a dominant 6-4 6-0 win over

ninth seed Maria Sakkari in the Indian Wells final. Now Swiatek will set her sights on capturing the Indian Wells and Miami Open titles back-to-back, a feat known as the Sunshine Double given the tournaments' respective locations in California and Florida, for a second time. Should Swiatek, who will

face either Italy's Camila Giorgi or fellow Pole Magdalena Frech in the second round, claim the Miami title she would join Steffi Graf (1994, 1996) as the only women to complete the Sunshine Double twice. Florida resident Coco Gauff, who reached the Indian Wells semi-finals, will enjoy plenty of crowd support as she returns to Miami for the first time since her triumph at last year's U.S. Open. On the men's side, Carlos Alcaraz will also chase the final piece of the Sunshine Double after a successful title defence at Indian Wells where he beat reigning Miami Open champion Daniil Medvedev in a rematch of the 2023 California final.
