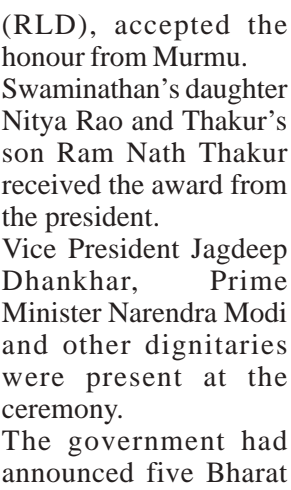

Veteran parliamentarian Mahtab, who quit the BJD recently, will contest from Cuttack, Sukanta Kumar Panigrahi to contest from the Kandhamal LS seat, while Rabindra Narayan Behera will be the party's candidate from the Jajpur parliamentary seat. Hans Raj Hans, who had won from North West Delhi in 2019 on a BJP ticket, will contest from the Faridkot seat, which is reserved for Scheduled Castes (SCs). Bittu will contest from Ludhiana,

Kaur from Patiala, and Rinku from Jalandhar, a seat reserved for SCs. Both Bittu, the grandson of former Punjab chief minister Beant Singh, and Kaur, the wife of former Punjab CM Amarinder Singh, were in the Congress before joining the BJP, while Rinku was in the Aam Aadmi Party. The BJP Sunday named two candidates from West Bengal, three from Odisha and six from Punjab. It has so far announced its candidates for 411 seats.

New Delhi(KCN): President Droupadi Murmu Saturday conferred Bharat Ratna, the country's highest civilian honour, on former prime ministers PV Narasimha Rao and Chaudhary Charan Singh, agriculture scientist MS Swaminathan and two-time former Bihar chief minister Karpooiri Thakur, posthumously at a ceremony held at the Rashtrapati Bhavan here. The awards to Rao, Singh, Thakur and Swaminathan were received by their kin. PV Prabhakar Rao, son of former Prime Minister Rao, received the award conferred on his father from the president. Jayant Chaudhary, Singh's grandson and the president of the Rashtriya Lok Dal



Ratna awards this year, including one to Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) stalwart and former deputy prime minister LK Advani.

New Delhi: The Congress' claims of "tax terrorism" based on fresh notices from the Income Tax department have been strongly countered by sources in the government agency, who have pointed out that incriminating material had been seized and the assessment proceedings

Officials said income tax searches in April 2019 had revealed cash receipts by the Congress from Megha Engineering — which has emerged as the second-largest donor in the electoral bonds scheme — and others. This, they claimed, was discovered during raids on associates of Congress leader and former Madhya Pradesh chief minister Kamal Nath. The total receipts in cash between 2013-14 to April 2019 were to the extent of ₹ 626 crore, the officials claimed, and included proceedings of an alleged corruption scam.

"These cash receipts have been established and corroborated in multiple ways, including documents found during

searches, WhatsApp messages and recorded statements," an official said. Under Section 13A of the Income Tax Act, money received by a political party is exempt if certain conditions are met, including not accepting amounts over more than ₹ 2,000. Since the Congress violated these conditions, it became liable to pay tax on its entire income, the officials said. "The reason that the Congress has been able to get a stay is that the Income Tax department has produced in courts detailed, corroborated evidence that is on record. If the Congress party thinks it is innocent, it should release the entire assessment order to the public and the truth will be revealed," said a source.

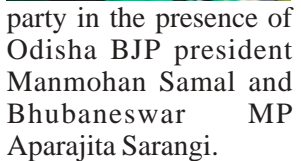
Bhubaneswar(KCN): In a jolt to the ruling Biju Janata Dal, a sitting MP and two ex-MLAs Saturday resigned from the regional party ahead of the upcoming Lok Sabha and Odisha Assembly elections.

MLA Akash Das Nayak also resigned from the BJD. In a video statement, the former Korei MLA announced his resignation from the primary membership of BJD.

“After listening to my inner voice, for self-respect and the respect of Korei residents, I have decided to quit BJD,” he said.

Das Nayak said he would take the next course of action after holding discussion with the people of Korei and his supporters.

During the day, former party MLA from Bhubaneswar-North Priyadarshi Mishra also resigned from BJD and joined the Bharatiya Janata Party Saturday. He joined the saffron



BJP's election in-charge for Odisha Vijaypal Singh Tomar was also present at the programme at the party office in Bhubaneswar.

The BJP leaders said that Priyadarshi's entry would further strengthen the saffron party in the

state capital and neighbouring areas ahead of the twin elections.

Priyadarshi had earlier sent his resignation letter to BJD president and Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik in the morning. He claimed 'continuous neglect' in the party as the reason behind his decision to quit the BJD.

A former MP Dhaneswar Majhi had also resigned from the BJD Friday and joined the BJP. Majhi was a Rajya Sabha MP and was elected for five times from Kesinga and Narla assembly constituencies.

Majhi said he resigned from the BJD and joined the BJP as he has confidence in Prime Minister Narendra Modi taking the country to a new height.

Biswal quit the Congress and is likely to join the BJD.

"I hereby tender my resignation from the primary membership of the Indian National Congress. I request you to kindly accept my resignation with immediate effect," Biswal said in the letter to OPMC president Sarat Pattanayak.

A copy of the resignation letter was also sent to AICC president Mallikarjun Kharge.

Manwhile, former Congress MLA K Surya Rao from Parlakhemundi assembly seat joined the BJD Saturday in the presence of Rajya Sabha MP Sasmit Patra at the BJD headquarters in Bhubaneswar.

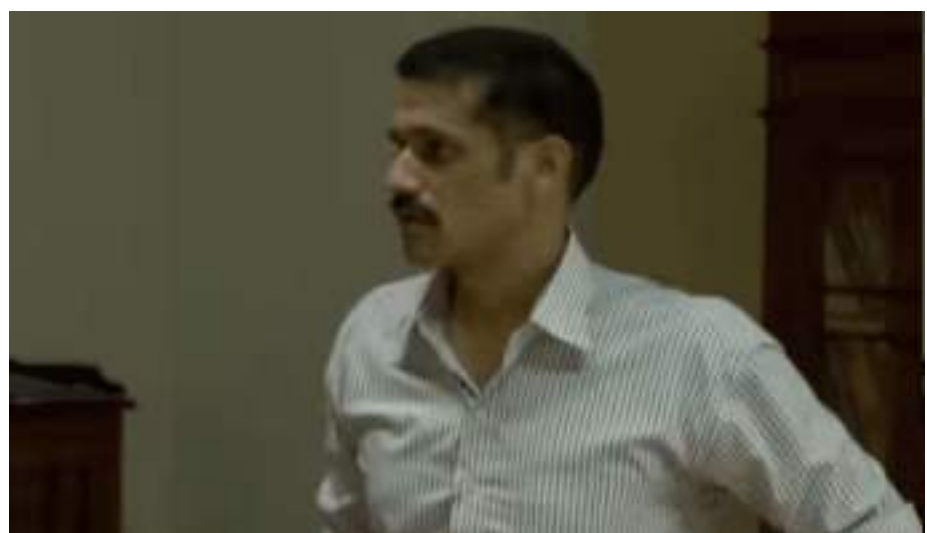

Blind faith is bad

In the name of tradition there is such evil going on that shows no sign of stopping. One such evil practice is 'Dagaana', which is increasing with time. It has become a matter of concern for today's progressive society and government and administration. Innocent people are mostly victims.

Amidst all the claims of modern progress, the reality is that the incidence of superstition is not diminishing. Sensible things like ghosts, ghosts, magic, spells, spells, and rituals are still common topics. It is common to see false exorcisms, exorcisms, exorcisms and people addicted to it everywhere. Despite all the efforts, the practice of Dagana, which is prevalent in many urban and semi-urban areas including tribal areas, is not being stopped. Most of its victims are innocent children. Tribal people often torture even ten-fifteen-day-old children in superstitions. From children to adults they are chained with a hot iron rod around the navel and a hot iron elsewhere. Especially the tribal Shahdol section of Madhya Pradesh is in the limelight now.

Even now, such

incidents are happening here continuously. Because of this, the number of deaths there is also increasing. Even the district administration and the medical college have clashed over this issue. In February 2023, a case was reported from Katothia (Singhpur) village near Shahdol. The three-month-old baby's breathing and digestion were not functioning properly. His superstitious father burned his body fifty times with a hot iron rod. Because of this his health deteriorated instead of improving. Finally, the girl was admitted to the medical college, but could not be saved. In this, the collector declared the cause of death as pneumonia, while the medical college declared Daganar (cheek) wound. In fact, the girl was suffering from malnutrition.

It is also true that in tribal societies malnourished babies are born due to lack of proper care of pregnant mothers. The government and administration are aware of this. There are Asha workers,

NMs and Anganwadis everywhere. Districts also have a Center for Malnutrition Rehabilitation. But it seems that everything is organized only on paper. The situation on the ground is different. Due to bad practices in Shahdol department. The headline of more than two thousand children being victimized on the newspaper page attracted everyone's attention. A similar case came to light last month from Anupur district in which a video of an elderly man being hot-branded in Dand was made and widely circulated.

A similar game of superstition takes place all over Rajasthan. Here the vape inflicts stigma on innocent people. In the name of cure, the body is kept with hot rods. There were also incidents in which children who were taken to the hospital after their health deteriorated died. In spite of such incidents happening in many places, superstitions about dams continue. Incidents happening in front of the

administration and lack of hidden action by Bhopas do not break their morale. In many rural areas, due to illiteracy, superstition and poverty, children are brought to VOP instead of hospitals. Often even doctors admit that many children who are victims of such superstitions are no longer alive. But this practice continues in the name of tradition.

A similar tradition exists in the villages of Jharkhand. The tribal community there called it Chiri Dag. During Makar Sankranti in January, on the eve of the Tusu festival, the uncle's chen (branding) process begins in every village. It is especially prevalent in the Kharswans of East Singhbhum, West and Seraikela, Kolhan areas, where large gatherings take place. They bring the children, forcefully tie their hands and feet and make them sleep on the bed. Then apply mustard oil on the navel and burn it with a hot rod.

There is a belief that doing this does not cause stomach related

diseases. More or less, this evil practice of wells is prevalent in Odisha as well. Here in Odisha it is called Chenk. In this, birth checks (branded) of seven to twenty one days are given. There is a superstition that if a child gets sick or if blue veins are visible. Then it is considered to be the influence of an evil spirit. It is believed that by stamping (stomping) he will escape.

Such a child will be protected from the evil eye. During the harvest festival of Makar Sankranti, everything goes on here. Sick men and women are also warned. This work is done here by special exorcists. They are called traditional doctors. But in Odisha a unique experiment has been done to get out of it. The state government launched the 'Jin Samla' scheme in partnership with UNICEF for the empowerment of tribals. The aim was to stop the practice of checking with local NGOs. When the community that practiced and

believed in Chen (branding) was told that they were doing a punishable act. There was strong opposition.

But when everyone was taken into confidence and explained that they need not give up worship, reading, rituals. Instead, take care of the children and send them to the hospital. Some people somehow agreed and children started arriving at the hospital. At the second level, work was done in collaboration with ASHA workers and ANMs. Govt to check those with public support. Awareness was given about the advantages and disadvantages of these schemes. If one does not agree, all kinds of schemes and ration cards are feared to be confiscated.

However, even bigger changes have to be made. Odisha must be chosen as a model in the whole country to stop evil practices like Che's (Dagana).

KU Senate approves budget of Rs.431.20 cr with Rs.8.08 cr deficit

Warangal, March 30 (KCN): Kakatiya University annual budget 2024-25 financial year was unanimously approved in the 39th academic senate held on Saturday presided by Vice-Chancellor Prof. Thatikonda Ramesh. Presenting the budget, Dean of the Faculty of Commerce and Principal Prof. P.Amaraveni said that the Kakatiya University revenues were estimated at Rs. 431.20 crores against the expenditure of Rs.449.73 crores leaving a deficit of Rs.8.08 crores. Rs.134.94 crores were sanctioned by the State Government in the form

of Grant-in-aid, and from other resources Rs. 296.26 crores. The internal resources include Rs.32.81 crores from UGC arrears, Rs.8.00 cr from academic and tuition fee, Rs.24.28 cr from others, Rs.58.79 from Examination Branch and so on. Budget presentation figures include an expenditure of Rs. 207.44 cr towards salaries of regular employers and pensions; which accounts for more than 60%, while it is Rs. 63.44 cr for examinations and academic activities. This year University is expected to receive grants from RUSA to the extent of Rs.44.00 cr. for



research-cum-infrastructure and developmental activities. The senate also approved the annual reports for the year 2022-23. Earlier, Vice-Chancellor Prof. Thatikonda Ramesh

in his report highlighted the achievements which included securing NAAC "A+" grade, conducting the 82nd Indian History Congress, Convocation, conduct of Ph.D. admissions and

infrastructural development including K.Hub, P.V.Knowledge Centre, Dining Hall of Boys hostel, increase of Girls accommodation, 2nd floor of administrative building

etc., He also informed the senate that he had enhanced the wages of daily wage employees which were pending for long and assured that the wages for the casual and lump sum employees

would be enhanced soon. The university issued compassionate appointments, and paid arrears to pensioners both teaching and non-teaching and pay revision arrears to regular employees despite financial constraints. The University also implemented the GOs enhancing the remuneration of contract and part-time teachers. Former Vice-Chancellor Prof. V.Gopal Reddy responded with a suggestion to introduce skill and job-oriented courses to increase internal resources. Former Vice-

Chancellor Prof. Vidyavati sought immediate appointment of regular faculty to fill staff gap and efforts should be increased to undertake continuous and multi-disciplinary research. Kangana Ranaut's Himachal Challenge - Empowering Women in the Sunderban Area: ICAR-CIFRI's Impact

Shimla(KCN): The influence of BJP dissidents and the erstwhile royal families in the Mandi Lok Sabha constituency can make the road tough for Bollywood actor turned-politician Kangana Ranaut who is making her electoral debut as the BJP candidate from the high-profile seat.



Maheshwar Singh, a former BJP state president, three times MP and scion of the erstwhile royal family of Kullu, has asked the party high command to review its decision to field Kangana Ranaut while BJP dissidents who were denied a ticket in 2022 assembly polls and fought as Independents held a meeting to chalk out the strategy. BJP leader and former minister Ram Lal Markanda has resigned from the party along with his supporters after Congress rebel Ravi Thakur who voted in favor of the BJP in Rajya Sabha elections was given a ticket for assembly bypolls from Lahaul and Spiti. "I have left the BJP along with my supporters and would definitely contest the assembly polls," he had told PTI adding that there is a possibility of him contesting from the Congress party. Mandi Parliament seat comprises 17 assembly seats -- three tribal

assembly constituencies of Kinnaur, Lahaul and Spiti and Bharmour in Chamba district, all four assembly segments of Kullu district - Kullu, Manali, Banjar and Anni and nine assembly constituencies of Sundernagar, Balh, Mandi, Darang, Jogindernagar, Nachan, Seraj, Karsog and Sarkaghat assembly constituencies in Mandi district and Rampur in Shimla district. Out of the 17 assembly seats, eight are reserved for Schedule Tribes and Schedule Castes. The Mandi Lok Sabha constituency has mostly remained the battlefield of erstwhile royal families and their scions have won 13 out of the 19 elections including two by-elections held for the seat. As Kangana Ranaut launched her election campaign with a roadshow and rally on Friday, senior BJP leader Maheshwar Singh urged the BJP high command to review its decision to field the actor who has

made "no contribution" and claimed that he had been promised the ticket. "Kangana has made no contribution to the party and the people of Mandi have become vocal and are asking for a review of the decision on social media," Maheshwar Singh told PTI on Saturday. "Talks are on with the BJP high command on reviewing their decision," he said, adding, "I was earlier promised the ticket". Hiteshar Singh, son of Maheshwar Singh, former BJP general Secretary Ram Singh and former Anni MLA Kishori Lal - all three who contested the 2022 assembly polls as Independents after being denied a ticket by the BJP - held a meeting with other disgruntled BJP leaders in the parliamentary constituency after Kangana's candidature was announced. Congress state chief and sitting MP from Mandi seat Pratibha Singh had earlier pulled out of the

race for the party ticket, maintaining that the ground reality is not favourable and workers are disheartened. However, the wife of former chief minister Virbhadr Singh and mother of Himachal Pradesh PWD minister Vikramaditya Singh from the erstwhile Bushar Royal family has changed her stance after Kangana was announced as the BJP candidate and said that she "will follow the directions of the Congress high command". "People have a sentimental attachment with former chief minister Virbhadr Singh and that is the reason why people always support our family and want somebody from this family to contest this election," she told PTI on Friday. The silver lining for Kangana Ranaut is that BJP leader Khushal Thakur, a Kargil war hero who lost to Pratibha Singh by a margin of 7,490 votes in the by-elections held in November 2021, has backed her candidature. "I am supporting Kangana. There are over one lakh ex-servicemen in this Parliament constituency," he told the PTI on Saturday. Kangana Ranaut, who addressed her first election meeting on

Friday, called herself a "daughter and sister" of the people of Mandi and claimed she was constantly "bullied" for hailing from Himachal Pradesh. "I have constructed a small Devi temple in my village and have built a house in Manali. I had struggled and worked hard to carve a niche for myself," Kangana Ranaut said. "It is not that my father or husband is chief minister and I have joined politics," she said in an oblique attack on Pratibha Singh and Vikramaditya Singh who had earlier compared her to Sunny Deol, another actor-politician in the BJP camp who has been criticised for his alleged absence from his Lok Sabha constituency. Those elected in the past from the seat are Raj Kumai Amrit Kaur of Kapurthala dynasty and Raja Joginder Sen Bahadur of the erstwhile princely state of Mandi (both elected once); Raja Lalit Sen of Suket represented Mandi twice, Virbhadr Singh and Pratibha Singh (three times each) and Raja Maheshwar Singh (thrice). Former Union minister Sukh Ram (who won thrice), Ram Swaroop (twice) and Ganga Singh were the only Mandi MPs not from the erstwhile royalty.

The victim, Manvi, was seen cutting the cake and celebrating with her family in a widely shared video on social media, just hours before her death. She cut the cake around



7 PM on March 24, by 10 PM the same night, the entire family fell sick, her grandfather Harban Lal said, adding that the

sisters started vomiting soon after. Manvi asked for water, expressing extreme thirst and complaining of dryness in

on oxygen and an ECG (electrocardiogram) - a recording of the heart's electrical activity - was performed Harban Lal

said. But they couldn't save her. She was declared dead soon after, he said. The family has alleged that the chocolate cake, ordered from 'Cake Kanha', contained some poisonous substance. A first information report or FIR has been filed against the bakery owner. "The postmortem of the body has been done. A sample from the cake has also been sent for testing. We are awaiting the reports," they said.

High stake battle in Sambalpur as BJD's Pranab Das takes on BJP's Dharmendra Pradhan

Sambalpur(KCN): The Sambalpur Lok Sabha seat in Western Odisha will witness a high-profile contest as ruling Biju Janata Dal has put up party general secretary Pranab Das against Union Minister Education Minister and BJP's Odisha face Dharmendra Pradhan. Fifty-two-year-old Das is a three-time MLA from Jajpur seat in the coastal area of the state, while Pradhan, who was a Rajya Sabha MP has returned to the electoral fray after a gap of 15 years after he was nominated from the Sambalpur Lok Sabha seat.

Das who is popularly called Bobby started his election campaign by paying obeisance to Maa Samaleswari, the presiding deity of the western Region of the state Friday. "I have sought blessings of Maa Samaleswari for the wellbeing of Odisha and also Sambalpur," Das said after offering puja at the temple. Asked whether he faced an outsider tag in Sambalpur, Das said: "My late father Ashok Das and his sister had 60-year relationship with Sambalpur. My family has a strong link and my father stayed in this town for years. Today, I feel like standing in my one

home." Earlier, Sambalpur BJP MLA and Leader of Opposition Jaynarayan Mishra alleged that Das who hails from Jajpur district in the coastal region of the state is not the son of the soil while BJP candidate Dharmendra Pradhan is a local man. Replying to reporters on how he sees Pradhan as a rival, Das said: "I have been sent to Sambalpur by chief minister Naveen Patnaik who means development of the area. I have relations with the people of Sambalpur and not with the candidate of the rival party. I am here to serve the people and take developmental



works to the next level." Das is the son of late Ashok Das, a popular Janata Dal leader of the 1990s. Though Ashok Das remained an MLA for many years, he had all along worked for the party and never accepted any ministerial



berth when Biju Patnaik government was formed in 1990. Like his father, Bobby also remained out of the Naveen Patnaik's council of ministry though he served as a minister for a small

time. He has a great organizational skill and therefore became close to Patnaik and his close aide VK Pandian. The Sambalpur Lok Sabha seat is significant this time as Das, who holds a significant

power centre in the BJD, has been pitted against Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, the BJP's face in Odisha. Both the contestants are equally important for their parties and therefore a high-profile election is on the card, said political analyst Sandeep Mishra. The Sambalpur seat will go to polls in the sixth phase May 25.

The Sambalpur Lok Sabha seat has a unique character as none can claim it as any party's stronghold. In the last three elections in 2009, 2014 and 2019, Sambalpur has voted in favour of three

different party candidates in the Lok Sabha elections. In 2009, Congress candidate Amarnath Pradhan won the Sambalpur Lok Sabha seat by a margin of 14,874 votes while in 2014, BJD's Nagendra Pradhan won it by a margin of 30,576 votes. In 2019, BJP candidate Nitesh Ganga Deb won by a margin of 9,162 votes. Prior to 2009 when there was an alliance between BJD and the BJP, Prasanna Acharya as a BJD candidate won thrice from Sambalpur Lok Sabha seat in 1998, 1999 and 2004.

Minor among eight held for street violence in Bhubaneswar

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The Commissionerate Police Friday arrested eight hoodlums, including a minor boy, who allegedly created a ruckus in the streets of Bhubaneswar two days back which left four persons injured. The incident took place under Nayapalli police station limits. The accused are all historysheeters and are in the habit of committing crimes after getting released on bail. They were booked thrice in the past by Nayapalli police, including on murder charges. Meanwhile, the minor boy has been sent to a juvenile home, said a senior cop at the Nayapalli police station.



The accused were identified as Kusha Munda alias Rundu, 28, Sudarsan Balamuchu, 19, Rocky Nayak alias Bhalu, 18, Rajkishore Digala alias Muna, 18, Suman Patra, 18, Sanjay Sahoo alias Sanju, 24 and Bibhu Nayak, 18. All of them live in Nayapalli area. DCP Bhubaneswar Prateek Singh said the complainant in the case, Kendu Khuntia, allegedly went to take a dip at the Balunkeswar pond in Gadasahi area of

Nayapalli, around 3pm, Tuesday. The accused men, who were present near the pond at that time, had an altercation with Kendu over some petty reasons. The altercation soon escalated, leading to a brawl between Kendu and the hoodlums. Kendu somehow managed to go back home, he added. Singh said on the same evening, the gang, armed with iron rods and hockey sticks, arrived at Kendu's home to seek revenge. Upon not finding him at

home, the hoodlums, in inebriated state, thrashed Kendu's parents and younger brother. Later, they went berserk on the road, damaging parked vehicles.

A local resident, Durgaprasad Behera, who came on their way, sustained serious injuries on head and arms after being attacked by the hoodlums, Singh said. Later, the Nayapalli police station identified the miscreants from CCTV footage collated from the area and arrested them. The arrested accused have been booked under IPC Sections 147, 148, 307 and 149. They were produced in a local court Friday and remanded to judicial custody.

Odisha: Women candidates to lock horns in Aska Lok Sabha seat




Aska(KCN): The ruling BJD has sprung a surprise by fielding a political greenhorn in the politically significant Aska Lok Sabha seat, which was represented by Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik as well as his father Biju Patnaik. The BJD has nominated 33-year-old Ranjita Sahu, the daughter of former chairperson of Kodala Notified Area Council Hara Prasad Sahu, for the seat. A postgraduate in Economics, Sahu is a social activist who has formed an organisation 'Kodala Youth Forum' to undertake social work in Kodala, Polasara and

Kabisurya Nagar areas. "I thank the chief minister for nominating me from the Aska Lok Sabha constituency," Ranjita Sahu said. Although it is the first time she is contesting elections, Ranjita Sahu is no stranger to politics. "I come from a political family. My father (Hara Prasad Sahu) and mother (Sunita Prabha Sahu) were elected as chairpersons of Kodala NAC," she said. BJD's Ganjam district president Ramesh Chaupatnaik said, "She is a young and educated woman. She also comes from a political family. We thank the CM for

selecting the right candidate for the Aska constituency." By fielding Ranjita, the CM has once again shown his efforts towards political empowerment of women, said Sanghamitra Dalei, Mayor of Berhampur Municipal Corporation. Ranjita Sahu will contest against BJP's Anita Priyadarshini, the daughter of former minister Rama Krushna Patnaik and Kumudini Patnaik, who was a former MP of Aska. Anita Priyadarshini had in 2019 unsuccessfully contested from the Aska on a BJP ticket.

In the 2019 elections, BJD had surprised everyone by fielding 70-year-old Pramila Bisoi, a leader of a women self-help group as its candidate from Aska. She defeated Anita Priyadarshini by a margin of over 2.04 lakh votes. The party however dropped her this time. Former chief minister Biju Patnaik had represented the seat in 1996 polls, while his son and present CM Naveen Patnaik was elected from the constituency in 1997 (by-election) and 1998. The Congress was yet to announce its candidate for the seat.

Bangladesh's Afghanistan tour rescheduled

Trusty old template brings fresh PowerPlay hope for KKR



DHAKA: Bangladesh Cricket Board announced on Saturday that their all-format away series against Afghanistan in July has been rescheduled. Afghanistan Cricket Board was expected to host Bangladesh for two Tests along with three ODIs and three T20Is following the ICC T20 World Cup. "The away series against Afghanistan will be rescheduled after both boards agreed to play the series at some other point of time," BCB cricket operations chairman Jalal Yunus confirmed the development to Cricbuzz on Saturday. Bangladesh were expected to play 12 Tests in 2024 along with other white-ball assignments but now will be featuring in only eight Tests. This is after their two-match Test series against Zimbabwe got rescheduled from May, choosing instead to play only five T20Is. However, Bangladesh

will still have a busy 2024 after the T20 World Cup as they will travel to Pakistan to play a two-match Test series following which will be the tour of India to play a series comprising two Tests along with three T20Is. In October, Bangladesh will host South Africa for a two-match Test series while in November-December, they will travel to West Indies to play two Tests along with three ODIs and three T20Is. Bangladesh have gotten a big boost as talismanic all-rounder Shakib al Hasan has informed the board that he is ready to play regularly across all formats for the country. Shakib made a return to Test cricket after a year's gap with the ongoing two-match Test series against Sri Lanka as he decided to play the second Test after missing the opening game of the series. He had earlier skipped the white-ball series in its entirety.

It is understood he had taken the break as he wanted to make a comeback to international cricket after making sure that his eyesight issue had been completely resolved. Shakib had been diagnosed with an eye problem that he had been suffering from since the ICC World Cup and it continued to the initial stages of the Bangladesh Premier League. "He (Shakib) is ready to play in all the three formats in the coming days unless there is some fitness issues and that is good news for us considering his experience is very essential for our team," added Jalal. Earlier, Shakib insisted that he would make a decision regarding his international cricket future following the ICC Champions Trophy in 2025 and now BCB is expecting him to be available without any disruption till that point of time.

KOLKATA:Thirty-two minutes into Kolkata Knight Riders' chase of 182, Gautam Gambhir strode out into the playing area of the Chinnaswamy Stadium clapping enthusiastically. Virat Kohli, then occupying a different part of the field, wasn't in Gambhir's vicinity and therefore this dramatic entry at the strategic time-out didn't merit too much attention. The air appeared to have been sucked out of the stadium when KKR's mentor clapped all the way until he was joined by Sunil Narine and Phil Salt, the opening pair that had plundered 85 runs in the PowerPlay. In 38 balls of exhilarating hitting, KKR's openers whittled down nearly the same amount of runs from the target that Kohli had assembled by carrying his bat through the first innings on a difficult, two-paced track. Helped on by the arrival of dew as well as some RCB profligacy, KKR made short work of what should have been a competitive score of 182. But more than the two points they bagged or the streak of home team victories in IPL 2024 they ended, the night offered some hope for KKR: that their biggest recent bug bear could have a trusty old solution. The events of Friday (March 29) were eerily similar to those of May 7, 2017 at this very

venue when Narine unleashed PowerPlay pandemonium on RCB to the tune of 105 runs. Seven years ago, having found his calling as a T20 opener with the Melbourne Renegades in the IPL, Narine reprised that role to devastating effect, forming an unusual but frightening partnership with Chris Lynn. The pair opened 25 times together and scored 707 partnership runs at an impressive run-rate of 10.60 over two seasons. But like with all sides, KKR went through the evolutionary churn. They moved on from Lynn and when teams began bowling short and fast at Narine, his batting returns diminished and he duly slid back down the order, coming out to open the innings only seven times in the last four seasons. Emerging talents Shubman Gill and Venkatesh Iyer had a good run together in KKR's run to the final of IPL 2021, but while they averaged 50.80 for their stands, their runs came at a more modest rate of 7.95 to the over. And when Gill exited after that year, the roulette made several stops. KKR's PowerPlay struggles are best underscored by the fact that in the last seven years, they've had 29 different opening combinations and two games in, the Salt-Narine combine already has more partnership runs than 20 other pairs that



got a KKR innings underway in this time. One performance, in a stadium like the Chinnaswamy and against one of the seemingly lesser attacks in the competition, is no indication that KKR have landed on a fix or that Narine has rediscovered his batting mojo. However, there is tactical merit in running with the move for the time being. For the Narine-Salt combine is the closest KKR have come to recreating the Narine-Lynn pairing, which offered two-prong dynamism. At the receiving end on the night, Faf du Plessis said it best when he echoed erstwhile SRH coach Tom Moody's assessment of bowling to the Narine-Lynn pair from 2017. "With Narine there, you can't really go to spin, you want to use pace upfront. That's also a really good match-up

for Salt and the way he plays. They were excellent, really broke the game in the first six overs," the RCB skipper said. Beyond the usual advantages of a left-right pair, it's always a great idea to pair a spin hitter with an excellent hitter of pace. Both can maximise their match-ups and cover for the partner's weaknesses. Narine has hit spin in the IPL at a strike-rate of 193.78. Salt, on the other hand, holds a T20 strike rate of 157.89 against fast bowlers. This may be a few points down from Lynn's scoring rate of 172.67 during that incredible 2017-18 phase but among T20 openers with 4000 runs, Salt is the only one to score at a rate in excess of 150. He is the opener that offers the promise of both speed and volume of runs while Narine trades off some of the volume for

more speed. It is a great combination and together they also lengthen KKR's batting to a point where they can allow the brains trust some degree of flexibility to control the entry points of key personnel lower down the order like Andre Russell. It is funny how these things can pan out. Salt wasn't even supposed to be here and his two back-to-back T20I hundreds for England against West Indies hadn't merited a single bid at last year's auction. A second window of opportunity arose when Jason Roy pulled out of the competition. Similarly, Narine, who never opened with Roy last year, may not have been accorded a second chance to open with Salt with Shreyas Iyer confirming that there were deliberations about sending the West Indian to start the chase in Bengaluru.
