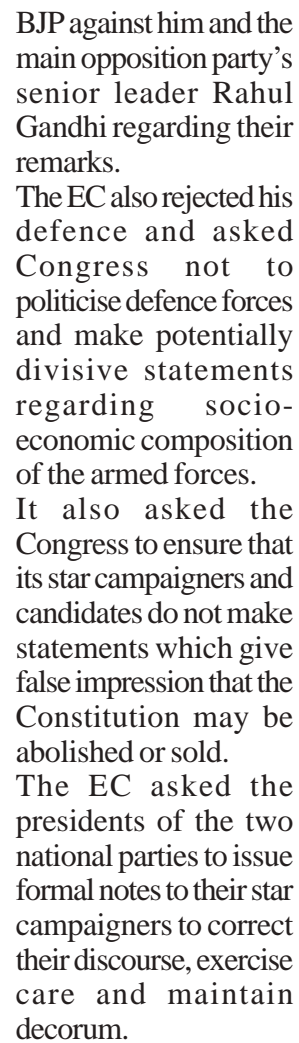

# Modi, Shah likely to revisit Odisha for campaigning



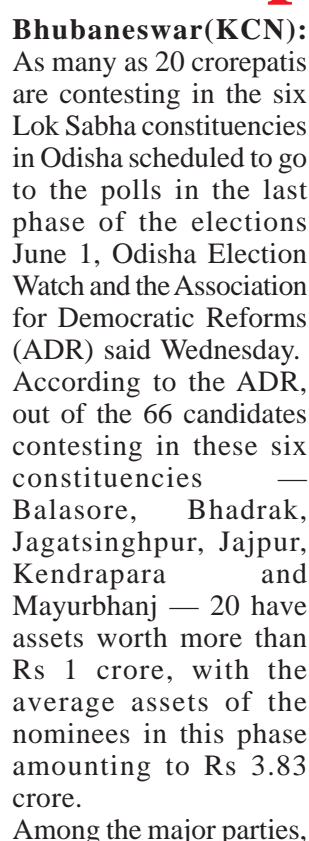

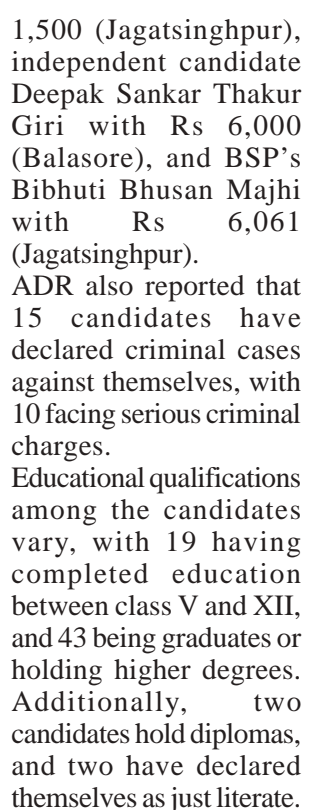

Vote counting is set for June 4.

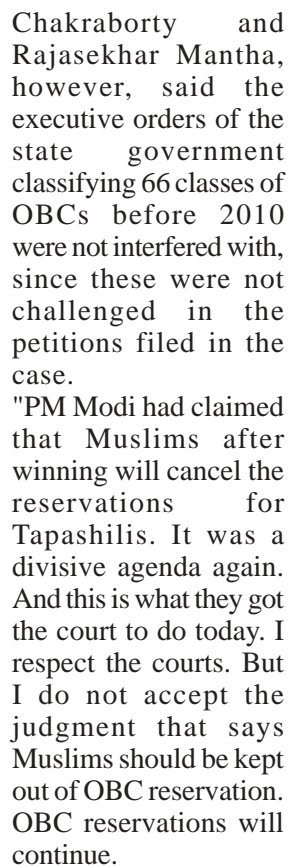

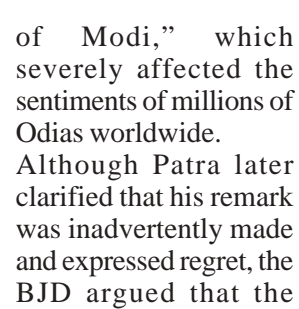

The BJD urged the EC to ensure that all related expenses be appropriately recorded in Patra's expense account. Neither BJP, nor Patra were available for comment.

# Lord Buddha: The architect of religious and individual evolution

Gautam Buddha is a beacon of spiritual awakening. His public welfare thinking, and deeds are timeless that have been guiding the society for ages. His birth anniversary is celebrated on Buddha Purnima, and his Nirvana Day also occurred on the day of Buddha Purnima. On this day, Gautam Buddha blossomed in his fullness; he remained engaged in the search for his own perfection, as well as the perfection of human society that became a timeless inspiration and possibility of perfection. On this Day, Buddha was born, left this world for Heavenly Abode, attained divine knowledge and salvation. Buddha Purnima is an important day not only for the followers of Buddhism, but for the entire human race. Buddha Purnima is the biggest festival day for the followers of Buddhism. A series of celebrations are organized on this day in different fashions. In different countries, celebrations are organized according to their peculiar customs and culture. For example, Sri Lankans celebrate Buddha Purnima as 'Vesak' festival, which is

Food and clothes are donated as alms to the poor. Mahatma Gautam Buddha was the founder of Buddhism. During his life, he always taught people the values of non-violence, love and compassion. Gautam Buddha was born in a royal family in Lumbini, Nepal in 563 BC. Mahatma Buddha is considered to be one of the most important and greatest Indian spiritual thinkers, an accomplished monk, social reformer, and a religious leader. He touched the hearts not only of influential people, but also the common people, and brought positive changes in their lives. Hence, he can be called the architect of a religious revolution as well as a personal and ideological revolution. His revolutionary speech is not only indicative of his revolutionary personality, but also a sharp sarcasm on religious, social distortions and

superstitions that serves as an inspiration for change, which changed the direction of life of countless people around the globe. Before becoming a monk, Buddha was Prince Siddhartha of Kapilvastu. In search of peace, he left home, family, kingdom etc. at the age of 27. While travelling, Siddhartha reached Sarnath near Kashi, where his heart changed. Here he did severe penance under the Bodhi tree in Bodhi Gaya. After severe penance, Siddhartha attained enlightenment and became famous as the great monk Gautam Buddha and illuminated the whole world with his knowledge. When Buddha saw the people of his era surrounded by ignorance regarding religious-social, spiritual and other rituals, and found the common people bogged deep in ignorance in the name of religion, saw women being insulted, saw atrocities against Shudras - then his heart was stirred in sympathy for the people. The Himalayan efforts he made to elevate the life of the people are amazing and astonishing. According to Buddha, it is better to win over oneself than to win thousands of battles in life. If you win over yourself, then victory will always be yours. No one can snatch it away from you. Gautam Buddha says that a person can never end evil with evil. To end it, a person has to

take the help of love. All the big things in the world can be won with love. According to Buddha, happiness always increases by sharing. It



never decreases. One should be afraid of a deceitful and evil friend, rather than a wild animal. A wild animal can harm your body, but a bad friend can harm your intellect. According to Gautam Buddha, three things can never be kept hidden in life. They are: Sun, Moon and Truth. In reality, the main objective of both governance and religious governance is to lead the people on the right path. But the dictators of governance are themselves creatures suffering from illusion, so they are not able to be completely successful in the work of social reform. Well, if someone cannot erase something from his

own heart, how can he erase it from thousands of other hearts? The foundation of a government is not laid on the ground of love,

affection and goodwill; it is usually laid on the foundation of fear, terror and oppression. This is the main reason that a government, even while protecting justice, morality and peace amongst the people, cannot establish a more permanent system. Whereas a religious government is based on mutual love and goodwill, as a result, it fundamentally changes the heart of the society by showing the path of truth and by removing sinfulness from all sides. It establishes permanent justice, morality and peace. Lord Buddha ultimately came to the conclusion that this incurable disease of

India is not going to be cured by ordinary political movements. For this, the whole life will have to be sacrificed; leaving the attachment to

a petty family, the ideal of a 'world family' will have to be adopted. One cannot mingle with the common people by dressing up in royal attire. To reach there, one will have to accept voluntary smallness, that is, one will have to accept monkhood. The greatest gift of Buddha to humanity is to end discrimination. It is an irony that on this land of Buddha, untouchability and discrimination still exist in some form or the other. At that time, the society was divided into different classes due to untouchability. When Lord Buddha talked about mutual unity by considering everyone as equal, a large number of

people started becoming followers of Buddhism. A few decades ago, Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar adopted Buddhism along with a large number of his followers so that they could get an equal position in Hindu society. It is very important even today to give practical form to the principle of equality of Buddhism. Basically, Buddhism remained in line with Hinduism, and Mahatma Buddha started a revolutionary and reformist movement by staying within Hinduism. It is a big expectation of the present era to highlight his contribution in the context of social revolution. Only by doing this, will we be able to build a healthy society. Buddha preached an egalitarian society. Where there is passion and hatred, inequality flourishes. From this point of view, the source of all problems is attachment and hatred. A person keeps wandering in the corridors of inequality to nourish his selfishness, to display ego, to humiliate others, to grab power and wealth. Before coming among the people, before sharing his life experiences, before doing severe penance, Buddha made him alone, made he empty. He underwent rigorous penance. He learned the truth of life. Then he said that do not let anything enter inside you which can pollute the inner world. Do not see badly, do not listen to bad, and do not say badly. This message of emptiness is

the path to happiness, peace, and samadhi. He said to become your own lamp - be your own lamp. Because day and night being surrounded by resolutions and options, happiness-sadness, joy-sadness, being scorched by the worries of tomorrow, carrying the burden of stress, in such a situation, how and when can the mind be empty? How can it become balanced? How can one become meditative? To achieve these spiritual conditions, the practice of living in the present moment is necessary. Neither the memory of the past, nor the worry of the future can help you. One who learns to live today should understand that he has attained the meaning of human life and only a society made up of such people can be balanced, healthy and egalitarian. There is a need to inculcate the teachings of Mahatma Buddha in life for building an advanced and balanced society, and to inculcate Buddha-like qualities in every person. Only by doing this, can we make the society healthy? Do not limit Buddha to mere teachings; rather make Buddha a part of your life, incorporate Buddha in your life.

# Kashinath Mohanty: Dedicated to trade union movement



Death remains at the centre of nature and human life. Death always remains a mystery, relating to life and morality. Nobody knows what was the past of a person before birth and what shape one will take after death.

The biggest question that perplexes even cripples our minds: is death larger than life and does it annihilate life altogether? Ignoring death leaves us with a false sense of life's permanence and perhaps comforts us to lose ourselves in the intricacies of daily life. By contrast, obsessive rumination on death, on the other hand, can lead us away from life and dampen and decimate the spirit, urge, and impulse of achieving something in our lives.

Death is often perceived as the highest evil: not merely because it sets an end to our life, but because it renders all we do meaningless. Allegedly it is for this reason that we need to do everything in our power to stop the presently inevitable decline of our bodies and

to extend human lifespan indefinitely. But researchers use mathematics and cell science to conclude that the aging process and death are inevitable, no matter how hard you try. Hence, when birth and death is not within one's hand, and all become nonentity in death, it is very imperative what types of life one was leading; how he/she was discharging his/her social, official responsibilities; how much he/she had contributed to society etc. What is most important, how one was grappling with a trying, troubled and grim period of life and uphold human, ethical and moral values.

Here we pay tribute to a great trade union leader who was undaunted by trepidation of death and whose life was wedded to development of insurance employees, working-class people especially upliftment of vulnerable sections of society . He is no other than late Kashinath Mohanty, the veteran leader of Insurance employees' movement, former president and General Secretary of Cuttack Division Insurance Employees Association (CDIEA), and vice-president undivided Eastern Zonal Insurance Employees Association (EZIEA).

Late Kashinath Mohanty also happens to be father-in-law of this author. Late Kashinath Mohanty breathed his last at 7 PM on May 13, 2024 in his Cuttack residence. He was 86 years old and had retired from the services of LIC in the year 1998. He is survived by his one son and daughter. His attachment towards his better half was so profound that he left this mundane world just 45 days after death of his better -half late Rangalalata Mohanty who had breathed her last on March 29, 2024.

A trade union (British English) or labour union (American English), often simply referred to as a union, is an organization of workers whose purpose is to maintain or improve the conditions of their employment, such as attaining better wages and benefits, improving working conditions, improving safety standards,

Perhaps the most well-known effect of union membership is higher wages, and increased union density would lead to higher wages for all workers, not just union members, in the working class. With research showing that forming a union is a needlessly daunting task, particularly for workers with fewer years of education, policies that

make it easier for workers to exercise their right to collective bargaining will go a long way. Unions are key to the success of any policy intended to create and improve jobs for the working class.

Many leaders of the



country, like Mahatma Gandhi and Jawaharlal Nehru, supported the cause of workers, which led to the union of goals. Because of these reasons, the working-class movement in India gained momentum leading up to forming various trade unions and labour federations.

While there is no universal definition of "working class," the term commonly refers to workers in the service sector who hold less than a four-year college degree. The Financial Working Class is defined in different ways. Instead, for those of us in economic policy,

"working class" has come to fill in the bottom section of the middle class. As Gallup's Frank Newport describes it, it is a "socioeconomic positioning that is below that of what is associated with the middle class but above that which is associated with the lower class."

The first definition of working class is what Gallup has referred to as "subjective social class." This is the historic and cultural context of the working class, and it refers to people who do manual labour for a living. Merriam-Webster.com Dictionary, the class of people who earn money by doing usually physical work and who are not rich or powerful. Working class is a term used to describe people in society who have jobs which are not academic or highly paid. They're usually jobs which are physical, especially when they are paid an hourly wage. Different societies will have different ideas about what "working class" is. People started talking about the working class after industrialization in the early 19th century.

Karl Marx wrote about the working class. Working class contrasts with the middle class and upper class, which are above the working class. The underclass is below the working class. The working class, or in Marxist terms, the proletariat, includes all employees who are compensated with wage or salary-based contracts. White collar workers are those who work in an office. The name comes from older times, too, when office workers usually wore white, collared shirts at work (and some of them still do). The writer Upton Sinclair was the one who coined this term. White collar jobs examples include bank employees, people in finance jobs, or administrative assistants. Blue collar workers are those who perform manual labour. The name comes from the early 20th century when these workers wore resistant fabrics of darker colours (e.g. blue denim or blue uniforms). They preferred these clothes because they usually got them dirty at work and often couldn't afford to wash them frequently because of low wages. Late Com. K. N. Mohanty led CDIEA and the working-class movement of the State of Odisha in

very difficult periods and strengthened the insurance employees 'movement along with the late Com. S.N. Sircar, former president of CDIEA. His knowledge, commitment, dedication for the organisation, and his elderly affection for the youngsters is worth emulating. He along with late Com. S.N Sircar, was also instrumental in the formation of Cuttack city coordination committee and later on Odisha Sramika Karmachari Ekata Manch (OSKEM). Late Com K. N. Mohanty popularly known as the legal luminary of undivided Cuttack Division. He had rescued many employees from onslaught and, atrocity of management due to in-depth knowledge in staff rules, regulation and legal matters. His perspicacity, correct decision, advice has helped CDIEA in most critical junctures. In his residential place known as Aparna Nagar, Chauhiganja, Cuttack , he has made immense contribution to development of locality and maintaining peace and harmony especially creation of Sitadevi Joglekar UGME School. Normally, the gap between words and deeds of people is widening day by day. Politicians are telling

something and practising something different. Late Com Kashinath Mohanty was practising the same thing that he was telling to others. He had inspired his daughter and son-in-law to embrace the trade union path and intellectual pursuits. His son-in-law Com (Dr) Santosh Kumar Mohapatra is now president CDIEA and while daughter Com Manorama Mohanty is Asst Secretary CDIEA and Divisional cum Zonal women convener. His son S/Aashish Mohanty, who hold post of managing director Odisha Hydro Power Corporation is famous for his honesty and integrity.

The passing away of Com. Mohanty is an irreparable loss to the trade union movement in the most critical juncture especially when there is mounting attack on trade union movement and livelihoods of masses. The working class in India face numerous difficulties related to their work, income, living conditions, education, health and social status. There is an urgent need for government policies and programs to help improve the lives and livelihoods of this large section of society.

today, his office said in a post on X along with pictures of the event.

"VP Jagdeep Dhankhar met Acting President of Iran, Dr. Mohammad Mokhber in Tehran today. VP conveyed condolences on the tragic demise of President Seyyed Ebrahim Raisi and Foreign Minister H.

Amir-Abdollahian," the External Affairs Ministry said in a separate post on X.

Jagdeep Dhankhar, who arrived here earlier in the day to attend the official funeral ceremony, was received by the Iranian authorities on his arrival in Tehran.

President Droupadi Murmu and Prime

Minister Narendra Modi have conveyed their condolences on the demise of Raisi.

External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar visited the embassy of Iran in New Delhi on Tuesday to convey India's condolences on the loss.

Iran's supreme leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei

presided over a funeral on Wednesday for the country's late president, foreign minister, and others killed in the crash. Thousands of people attended the funeral procession of the late president and his companions.

Several world leaders attended the official funeral ceremony in Tehran.

The Iranian president, the country's foreign minister, and several other officials were found dead on Monday, hours after their helicopter crashed in a foggy, mountainous region in the northwestern part of the country, Iran state media reported.

Raisi, 63, and his entourage were heading to Tabriz city after returning from a visit to a locality on the Azerbaijan-Iran border on Sunday.

# Will Arvind Kejriwal Accept Rahul Gandhi As PM? What He Said



**New Delhi,(KCN):** Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Wednesday distanced himself from speculation he could become the next Prime Minister - if the Congress-led INDIA bloc wins the Lok Sabha election.

He also sidestepped questions about Rahul Gandhi as a prime ministerial candidate, saying no such discussion had taken place and that the INDIA bloc would take a decision after the election results.

Mr Kejriwal pointed out the AAP is a "small party...contesting only 22 seats" in this election; the comment has been seen as indicative that his chances of being PM, at this time, are remote. Speaking to news agency PTI, he said, "I don't have any intention of becoming the next PM if INDIA bloc wins." The AAP leader - on bail after his arrest in the liquor policy case - said his aim is to save the nation from a "dictatorship", alleging opposition leaders will be jailed if the BJP comes back to power.

"The polls are for saving the country and democracy from prevailing dictatorship. They (referring to the BJP without naming the party) will finish democracy if they come back to power," Mr Kejriwal said. This is not the first time Mr Kejriwal has had to answer the question of an

INDIA PM face.

Last week, at a press conference in Lucknow, the AAP chief responded with a categorical "No, I am not" when asked if he is in the running to become PM in the event of an INDIA win.

The INDIA grouping - formed in June last year to unite the opposition and stop Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the BJP from claiming a third term - is contesting sans a candidate for the top job. The BJP, on the other hand, continues to fight from behind Mr Modi's larger-than-life shadow. The BJP has often mocked its rivals for not naming a PM candidate or even an alliance figurehead, which it has claimed underlines persistent rifts that reflect incompatible political ideologies.

Earlier today Home Minister Amit Shah - campaigning in Bengal's Ghatal - ripped into the opposition, declaring they had failed to name a candidate because they had no leader of that calibre. In a thinly-veiled swipe at the Congress, Mr Shah said his rivals only sought to extend their "dynasty".

The opposition "does not have leaders or any intention to develop the country" he raged, and repeated his attack from last week; at rallies in Bihar the union minister claimed the INDIA bloc "doesn't have a PM face

(and) have decided to rotate the PM's chair among themselves".

"The INDIA alliance doesn't have any leaders. The INDIA alliance wants five PMs in five years. The INDIA alliances neither have leaders nor have any intention for the development of the nation," he said.

The 'dynasty' jibe is a favoured BJP attack on the Congress and the Gandhi family. It was extended Tuesday by Mr Modi to Samajwadi Party boss and ex-Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Akhilesh Yadav. Congress MP Rahul Gandhi - widely seen as the opposition's leading PM face - last month outlined the bloc's plans in this regard. He said a candidate would be chosen after the election result.

The selection of a candidate, he stressed, would be made by all INDIA constituents.

"INDIA bloc has decided we are, together, fighting an ideological election. After winning the election (questions like) 'who will be the leader', 'who will be the PM'... the coalition will jointly decide."

Congress chief Mallikarjun Kharge offered a similar answer as far back as November, telling NDTV his party was against projecting any one individual to be sucked into a head-to-head against Mr Modi.

# "BJP Will Win 305 Seats": US Political Scientist's Lok Sabha Poll Prediction

**Mumbai(KCN):** The BJP will win 305 (+/- 10) seats in the 2024 Lok Sabha election, American political scientist and global political risk consultant Ian Bremmer told NDTV Profit in an exclusive interview Tuesday.

Mr Bremmer, the founder of the Eurasia Group, a risk and research consulting firm, also said the Indian general election, from a global political perspective, is "the only thing that looks stable and consistent...everything else (including the United States election due in November) is problematic".

"... We have an enormous amount of macro-level geopolitical uncertainty and the future of globalisation is not going the way companies want it to. Politics is inserting



itself into the global marketplace... wars, US-China relations, and the US election are all a big part of that," he said. "All of these not being managed well and these pressures are more negative. In fact, the only thing that looks stable and consistent, politically, is the India election. Everything else looks problematic."

Asked about his prediction for the Indian election, which is spread

across seven phases and began on April 19, Mr Bremmer said Eurasia Group research suggests the BJP will win 295-315 seats.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's party, bidding for a third consecutive term, won the 2014 election with 282 seats (336 including its NDA partners) and the 2019 with 303 (353 with NDA allies).

The BJP is expected to complete its hat-trick this

year - a prediction backed by poll strategist Prashant Kishor, who engineered its 2014 win - although the Congress-led INDIA bloc is seen as mounting a strong challenge. Domestic political analysts believe the 2024 battle could come down to one big factor - can the opposition eat into the BJP's fanatical voter base in the Hindi heartland?

Mr Bremmer, though, stressed that his interest is not in the numbers.

"My interest is that of all the elections in the world (which includes polls in the European Union and, possibly, a national election in the United Kingdom) India, which has the largest democracy, has the smoothest transition. There is not lot of uncertainty about the Indian political system" he declared.

Mr Bremmer also hailed "free and fair, and transparent" Indian electoral process. "Modi is almost certainly going to win a third term on the back of pretty strong economic performance and consistent reform (and) that, in the grand scheme, is a very stabilising message."

# Lack of jobs forcing Joda people to migrate

**Joda(KCN):** Abject poverty has prompted rampant migration of people living in many parts of the mineral-rich district of Keonjhar. However, after they migrate to other parts of India to earn a livelihood, they are often subjected to torture and are not even paid proper salaries. Residents of this bustling town are no exception to this development. They migrate elsewhere in search of jobs.

Locals alleged that despite the Joda mining division contributing Rs 21,000 crore to the state exchequer nothing has been done to solve the unemployment problem in this town. They added

Rs 1,500 crore is collected from the district mineral foundation (DMF) annually by the government, but even that is not used properly to provide relief to the people. If one traverses through this district, the plight of migrant labourers can be heard in every nook and corner. Sources said that some residents of this town had migrated to Chennai for work. However, now they are being held hostage at a cement factory, given food only once a day and are being brutally assaulted by their employers if they protest. They are also forced to work more than 14 hours a day, the sources added.



Sources said that the majority of men living in the tribal villages on the Suna river basin near this town have migrated for work to Chennai.

However, most of them have remained incommunicado since their departure. Two tribal women, identified as Manasi Nag and

Chandu Karua, residents of 'Camp Hutting' said that they do not even remember the last time they talked to their

respective husbands who are supposedly in Chennai. They do not even know when their husbands will return. "I

met the middleman who had provided my husband a job. I tried to find my husband's whereabouts. However, he abused me and sent me back home," informed Chandu. Similar is the story of another tribal woman Saraswati, whose minor son Kalathakur Karua has not returned home for more than a year now. Her co-villager, Sunita Naik is ailing and bed-ridden but has no information about her son George, who is working in Chennai. Unable to get any help from the touts, they lodged a 'missing' complaint at the Rugudi police station.

However, it did not yield

any positive results. Many other families alleged that if jobs had been available at the various mines and quarries in Keonjhar district, the male members wouldn't have been forced to seek livelihood elsewhere. "We have found in most cases that employers take away mobile phones. As a result, our family members lose touch with us. They cannot even tell us the exact locations," said a woman. The residents of 'Camp Hutting' appealed to the district administration to arrange for the safe return of their near and dear ones.

## Voter turnout increases in Naxalite-hit areas

**Rourkela(KCN):** Election officials informed here Tuesday that the voter turnout percentage in Naxal-hit areas has gone up considerably despite Maoists warning people to abstain from exercising their electoral rights. Posters warning people not to vote had appeared in many places close to the Odisha-Jharkhand border.

However, that did not prevent people from turning out in large numbers in the second phase of polls conducted Monday. Officials said that there were large queues in more than 19 booths since morning in various villages under Bisra block.

Special security arrangements were provided for many of the booths including those in Jaraikela, Manko, Tulsikani and Bhalulata gram panchayats. "We informed the voters that their safety is assured and it worked. A record



number of youths turned up in these booths. This is indeed a very positive development," informed a CRPF officer. Despite putting up posters and banners at various places, Maoists have been on the back foot since the deployment of security forces well ahead of the elections. People now want the forces to stay on even after the results are announced fearing repercussions. "Previously many of these places had dismal turnouts of less than 30-35%.

However, this time, the

turnout was more than 60% in the Maoist-hit areas despite polling ending at 4.00 pm. This has been due to the positive attitude of the voters. They were very enthusiastic to vote," said an officer who was present at a booth in Bisra. Another officer from the Bonai region added that the turnout was more than 50 per cent in most of the booths. There were plenty of pictures on various social media platforms of first-time voters. "It just goes to prove that the youths are

ready to vote and are not afraid to hide their feelings. Displaying their pictures on social media platforms is indeed an encouraging sign. It proves that people are not interested in the philosophy of the Naxalites," stated a social media user. It should also be stated here that all the officials who had been deputed from this city to booths in various Naxalite-affected areas returned safely Tuesday. They all said that they were very happy with the security arrangements.

## Let PM Modi find keys to Ratna Bhandar if he has 'some knowledge': Pandian

**Puri(KCN):** Prime Minister Narendra Modi should find the missing keys to the 'Ratna Bhandar' — the Jagannath Temple's treasure warehouse storing the jewellery of deities — if he has "some knowledge" on the matter, Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik's close aide Kartik Pandian said Tuesday. The issue that was long an emotive one in the state has rapidly gained political centre-stage with Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Union Home Minister Amit Shah bringing it up in their rallies in the run-up to the simultaneous Lok Sabha and Assembly elections. Modi recently said at an election rally that the keys could have gone to Tamil Nadu, a reference to Pandian's Tamil origins.

"The prime minister should find out where the keys have gone if he has so much knowledge... I would humbly request the honourable Prime Minister. He has so many authorities under him, he

would be having some knowledge. He can enlighten the people of Odisha," Pandian said in an interview to PTI Videos.

"He is making a political statement so we will take it like that," the former bureaucrat, Patnaik's confidant for years and now a BJD leader, added about the matter.

Addressing election rallies in Angul and Cuttack Monday, Modi took up the issue of the missing keys and asked why the Patnaik-led Biju Janata Dal (BJD) had "suppressed the judicial commission report" on the matter.

"The BJD's role in the case is suspicious. After the BJP forms the government in Odisha, it will make the report public," Modi said. Naveen Patnaik should clarify on the missing keys of Puri Jagannath temple's Ratna Bhandar, Shah added in another rally in Nayagarh Tuesday.

Hitting back, Pandian said the inner chamber of the Ratna Bhandar has not been opened in almost

four decades. Of these, one decade was when BJP ministers handled the issue. "So perhaps they should find out where the keys are," he said.

The Ratna Bhandar has an outer chamber storing the day-to-day ornaments of The Holy Trinity and an inner chamber. Keys to the latter were found to be missing in 2018 when the Orissa High Court ordered an inspection.


Following the orders of the court, the Odisha government last year formed a committee headed by a retired Supreme Court judge. Though the original set is missing, there is a duplicate key.

Asked if the Ratna Bhandar will be opened, Pandian said, "Absolutely, date is fixed." However, he did not elaborate.

"The honourable high court ordered the Jagannath temple administration to open the Ratna Bhandar at a time fixed by the administration... So they have decided at the Rath Yatra time, when pilgrims

will not be there, the sanctity of the lord will not be affected..." Pandian said.

"We would humbly request the prime minister to also come and witness the opening of Ratna Bhandar after 40 years," he said without getting into details. The inner chamber of the Ratna Bhandar, storing gold, silver and other precious items, can only open only during the Rath Yatra period in July when the deities are taken out of the temple for nine days. During the Rath Yatra period, the Ratna Bhandar will be opened for an inventory of ornaments and repair of the inner chamber, the managing committee has said in an affidavit to the high court. The managing committee looking into the affairs of the 12th century temple is headed by Gajapati Maharaj Vidyasingha Deva. The Shree Jagannath Temple Administration (SJTA) looks after the day to affairs of the temple.

operations, Nepal will receive 21.9% of the electricity generated by the Arun-3 power plant as free power.
