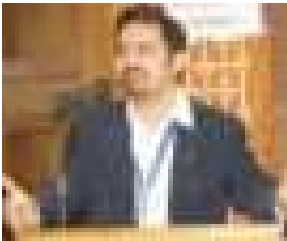

Residents Denounce BJD Candidate for Unkept Commitments "Go back Tushar"



Bhubaneswar, (KCN Bureau) : In a dramatic display of discontent, villagers of Tarakoi panchayat in Gop block, Puri district, Odisha vehemently opposed the campaign visit of Odisha state home minister and BJD candidate for Kakatpur constituency, Tushar Behera. The incident unfolded last Monday evening as Behera, flanked by his security guards, sought support for the forthcoming final phase of the general election. Tarakoi villagers' grievances trace back to

the 2019 election when Behera, then a contesting candidate, assured them of a critical improvement—access to pure drinking water. Currently dependent on the salty waters of the Kusavadra River, the villagers had placed their hopes on Behera’s promises. However, as Behera’s five-year term concluded without any progress on this front, the promise remained unfulfilled. The villagers' frustration reached its peak as Behera returned to seek re-election. Gathering in

significant numbers, they confronted Behera, questioning his contributions over the past five years. The atmosphere grew tense as an angry mob clashed with Behera’s supporters, ultimately warning him not to step into their area again. The villagers expressed their d i s s a t i s f a c t i o n , highlighting a sentiment of betrayal and accusing Behera of neglecting his duties as their elected representative. This confrontation underscores a broader narrative of political

d i s e n c h a n t m e n t . Villagers accused Behera of only engaging with his constituency during election periods, leaving them to struggle with unmet promises and deteriorating conditions once in office. The incident forced Behera to hastily retreat with the aid of police security, reflecting the extent of the negative perception held by the Kakatpur electorate. The resistance in Tarakoi panchayat is emblematic of a deeper, growing frustration among voters who feel neglected and deceived by their leaders. The episode serves as a stark reminder of the critical importance of accountability and sustained action in political office. As the election approaches, it remains to be seen how this wave of discontent will influence the electoral fortunes of Tushar Behera and the BJD party in Kakatpur constituency.

Woman dies after being hit by OSRTC bus in Odisha’s Kendrapada

NewDelhi,(KCN):A tragic incident unfolded on Tuesday morning as an OSRTC bus traveling from Kendrapara to Cuttack in Odisha fatally struck a woman on Chandbali Road, at Chandol Kharida Sahi under the jurisdiction of Kendrapara Sadar police limits. The



woman's identity remains unknown at present. Reports indicate

that the bus collided head-on with a scooter coming from the opposite

direction, causing the woman riding the scooter to fall and subsequently be run over by the bus. Upon receiving the information, the police promptly arrived at the scene and initiated an investigation into the heartbreaking accident.

Strong internal security is Modi's big success



Once upon a time, there was an atmosphere of insecurity and terror in every part of the country. Terrorist attacks were common in the country. Whenever the terrorists wanted, they would cross the border and kill innocent people in different cities of the country. Bombings had become an everyday occurrence. While Pakistan continued firing on the borders, it also continued to fuel terrorism within our country. Although there was no corner of the country where terrorists did not wreak havoc, but Mumbai was the favorite target of terrorists. After the demolition of Babri Masjid, the entire

Mumbai was shaken by bomb blasts on 12 March 1993. The entire world was stunned by the attack on Mumbai by Kasab and his associates on 26 November 2008. Who can forget the death of 209 people due to the blast in local trains on July 11, 2006 ? The killing of 10 people when a bomb exploded in a train in Mulund, Mumbai on March 14, 2003, and the killing of 50 people when two bombs kept in cars exploded near Zaveri Bazaar and Gateway of India on August 25, 2003, haunt us till today. Before the Modi government, the country's capital Delhi was always the target of terrorists. The attack on Parliament on 13 December 2001 was an attack on the sovereignty of the country. On 29 October 2005, a day before Diwali, terrorists carried out three blasts in New Delhi, killing more than 70 people and injuring at least 250 others. I have been living in Delhi for the last 55

years. While I have seen the peace of Delhi, unfortunately I have also had to witness the turbulent days. Delhi has faced countless terrorist attacks in the last four decades. The daily shaking of Delhi by bomb blasts still shakes us. Why only Delhi and Mumbai, the nefarious designs of terrorists continued to succeed in big cities of all the states of the country including Jaipur, Ajmer, Malegaon, Srinagar, Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Rampur, Hyderabad, Coimbatore, Varanasi. It is unfortunate that whenever terrorist attacks took place in the country, the reaction of our governments was always limited to 'strong condemnation' but after the formation of Modi government in 2014, extensive work started on the policy of killing terrorists on the border itself. The work of the terrorists who had entered India also started being completed. Although the frightened terrorists had the

audacity to attack Pulwama and Uri in Kashmir and Pathankot airbase in Punjab, but the way the Modi government killed the terrorists by entering Pakistan, it demoralized the terrorists and their patron Pakistan. Obviously, as per the vision of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the Central Government has been committed to ensuring the nation's border and internal security by strengthening all aspects. Since the formation of Modi

government in 2014, India has not had to face major terrorist attacks. Union Home Minister Amit Shah's claim is absolutely correct that under the leadership of Modi, the internal security situation of the country has strengthened and there has been success in completely controlling terrorism in Kashmir. There has been a lot of change in the internal security situation of the country during the Modi era. In the last ten years, the strategic power of the country has

increased manifold. The borders have become more secure than before. Our forces are more fully equipped with defense equipment than before and are ready for war in every way and at all times. The morale of our forces is very high. The process of reforms in the defense sector started by the Modi government is showing better results. After the removal of Article 370, terrorism has been completely controlled in Kashmir and the number of deaths and other violent incidents have declined by 72 percent. Violent incidents have also decreased by 65 percent in the North-East region. We are seeing a huge change in the situation in Naxal affected areas also. Modi government has been completely serious towards national security. The National Security Strategy Conference held in New Delhi last year under the chairmanship

of Home Minister Amit Shah has been an important link in fulfilling the vision of Prime Minister Modi. This topic has been discussed extensively in this conference so that better security can be ensured in every aspect of the country. After this, work is being done to provide an infallible shield of security everywhere, from village to district, from district to state and from state to country's borders. Whenever Modi government has raised its voice against the enemies of the country, Congress and all the opposition parties have criticized it. Many times the opposition parties have been seen taking Pakistan's side on sensitive issues related to national security, but the Modi government is working considering the nation and its people as supreme. The Modi government has been successful in creating such an impenetrable structure on the

country's borders and within the country, due to which every countryman is feeling safe. Before 2014, Delhiites like me, who have seen 70 years of life, were afraid of going to the airport, railway station and bus terminal. People's fear increased further after hearing the announcement being made that do not touch any unclaimed object as it could be a bomb. But now the situation has changed. Every citizen, not only in Delhi but in every city of the country, leaves home feeling fearless and confident and also returns home safely in the evening. Now we are not afraid of any terrorist. Due to secure borders and internal security, the country is moving rapidly on the path of progress. If Modi is there then it is possible.

The future of India-Iran relations



Iran is a natural gateway between Eurasia and the Indian Ocean. Which gives easy market access in India, Russia and Europe. The maritime competition between the two superpowers of the Asian continent, India and China, can be seen in the transportation and transit strategy. India has finally succeeded in breaking the trap of China's 'Pearl of Spring' in the form of Chabahar Port. But in terms of Iran's position in international politics and diplomacy, it can be said that the real test of India's strategic and economic capabilities is just beginning.

Actually Iran is a country. Which seems always ready to join the anti-American camp despite facing political, diplomatic, economic and strategic obstacles. Whether it is the start of strategic relations between China and Iran in 2021 or efforts to maintain a 'proxy' group in the Middle East, Iran has increased the challenge for the US. Meanwhile, India-US cooperation has increased. America needs to deal with China from Indian Ocean to Ladakh. In such a situation, there is deep fear that India-Iran

relations will remain normal for a long time. Iran is a member of China's Belt and Road Initiative. It is seen as an opportunity to restore its historic status as a bridge between East and West. China is investing billions of dollars in various projects in the fields of transport, ports, energy, industry and services in Iran. Iran has emerged as a strong economic partner. There are also Karachi Port, Gwadar Port, Kandla Port, Mumbai Port and Chabahar on the Arabian Sea coast. Chakhar port located in the Gulf of Oman is now under Indian control. Iran has



also been assured. The strategic battle to connect India's South Sea with India's West Sea has been successful. Not only this, Afghanistan's cooperation in this project will also help in creating strategic balance. Iran is also very excited about this new route. Because before, the goods going to Afghanistan through Pakistan will first go to Chabahar port in Iran by ship and then reach Afghanistan by truck. Through Chabahar Port, India will be connected with Afghanistan, Central Asia, Russia, Petersburg and the 'Land Lock' region of Central Asia. Therefore, this port

will greatly improve India's strategic, economic and geographical position. Chabahar Port is also seen as a symbol of India's hope to become an economic powerhouse. Chabahar can be reached in just a few days from Kandla port in Gujarat. From there, goods can be transported by rail or road. Iran will also get



the same benefits. India needs connectivity with Iran for oil, gas and Central Asia. By which gas can be brought through the pipeline. But due to Iran's complicated religious and global policies, there is deep confusion about how to fulfill India's long-term plans for the Chabahar port. Iran, Afghanistan and Russia are benefiting India from Chabahar port. All three countries now face severe global sanctions. US support for the Taliban has been declared a crime. In such a situation, the scope of cooperation between Afghanistan and the Taliban occupying India is very

limited. Since the attack on Ukraine, Russia has been facing severe international sanctions. Many countries, including the United States, the United Kingdom, and the European Union, as well as Australia, Canada, and Japan, have imposed more than sixteen thousand sanctions on Russia. About 70 percent of the

economic and strategic partners. India and the US have extensive strategic partnerships and alliances in many areas including trade, defence, multilateralism, intelligence, cyberspace, civil nuclear power, education and healthcare. India and Israel have deep bilateral economic, military and strategic relations. Israel is India's second largest defense supplier after Russia. Military and strategic ties between the two countries spying on terrorist groups. Sharing and expanding joint military training. Chabahar Port can be of great help to India in increasing its access to global markets. But Iran is continuously moving forward with China and Russia. 21 Unexplained Deaths In Kota Amid Severe Heat Wave In Rajasthan

Jaipur (KCN):

Rajasthan is in the grip of a severe heat wave. Temperatures in eleven cities, especially in the western region, are hitting the sizzling peak of 47 degrees Celsius. In the capital city Jaipur, mercury was at an eight-year-high of above 46 degrees.

Amid the scalding temperatures, the state has been witnessing an unexplained rise in the number of sudden deaths.

In Kota alone, 21 abandoned bodies were found in the past 48 hours and handed over to an NGO for the last rites.

The government, however, has denied that these deaths are due to heat. There has been only one death officially due to heat stroke, according to the state's health department.

But on the ground, the indications are that the figure is much higher and some deaths are due to comorbid conditions that are aggravated by the unbearable heat wave.

In the last 48 hours, the Karma Yogi Seva Sansthan - an NGO that carries out the last rites of unidentified bodies - has received frantic calls from the local police. As many as 21 bodies, found on footpaths, under bridges, near railway tracks and outside temples and dargahs have been handed over to the NGO for the last rites.

"I have been doing last



rites of unidentified bodies for the past 24 years but I have never received so many calls from the police. The heat definitely has something to do with it," said Raja Ram, the president of the Karma Yogi Seva Sansthan.

Of the 21 deaths - mostly vagrants and homeless, only two have been identified. One among the two was Munna Khan who spent his days outside the dargah in Nayapura in Kota. His relatives said he preferred to sleep in the courtyard outside the dargah.

They said he was healthy and appeared to have died of exposure to the severe heat. However, until a post-mortem doesn't establish the cause of death as heat stroke, it won't be noted in official figures. The district collector of Kota, Ravindra Goswami, said until the

postmortem report doesn't establish these deaths as caused by heat stroke it will be premature to make an assumption.

The Rajasthan health department, meanwhile, has asked all hospitals to be prepared for patients coming in with symptoms of heat stroke. Blocks of ice have been placed in specially created wards in hospitals to treat patients who suffer from heat stroke symptoms.

But, state health minister Gajendra Singh Khimsar maintains that one person has died due to heat stroke: "People who live on footpaths and besides railway tracks are alcoholics and drug addicts. So, of course, they are vulnerable as are daily wage workers like farm labour and coolies." But, those who have comorbid conditions, that can also be aggravated by heat stroke but the official figure of death is only

one," he said.

State minister for disaster relief Kirori Lal Meena, on the other hand, maintains that six people could have died due to the "loo (local word for hot winds)". "There is no provision to give financial compensation to people who die of heat and cold," he added.

He also met Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma over the issue today and has issued an advisory to districts on precaution. Suspected heat-related deaths have also been reported from several other areas of the state. On Sunday, a BSF soldier guarding an outpost on the western border was taken ill suddenly and rushed to a hospital. He died while undergoing treatment. The BSF has not confirmed if his death was due to heat stroke or some other condition.

in Bundi adjoining Kota, where temperatures are in the range of 47 and 48 degrees, five deaths with symptoms of heat stroke have been reported.

A police constable Mahaveer Meena was found dead in the police line quarters. His family says he was healthy and appears to have gone to sleep on Monday night after his duty hours were over. The next day he was found dead. There were prima facie no injury marks on his body.

The body of one Om Prakash Bairwa was found in a forested area. On the family's complaint, a post-mortem to look at heat stroke as a possible cause of death has been done.

A daily wage labourer and a woman who had gone to graze goats and an auto-rickshaw driver were also found dead in Bundi. The Rajasthan Police are investigating these deaths and medical samples have been sent to check if these were due to heat stroke. So far, 3,965 people who have suffered a heat stroke in Rajasthan and who have reached government hospitals for treatment, as per official records.

India is no stranger to searing summer temperatures. But, years of scientific research have found climate change is causing heatwaves to become longer, more frequent and more intense

Petition Seeks To Stop "Demolition" Of Supreme Court Building For New One

New Delhi (KCN): A petition has been filed in the Supreme Court seeking directions to the Union government and top court registry to not "demolish" the Supreme Court building and instead make a new building in another place.

The plea stated that the Supreme Court of India building is one of the important memorial buildings, built after the Independence of India and also currently so many courts, tribunals and government establishments working in private properties on a rental basis may be accommodated there.

The petitioner KK Ramesh contended that the Supreme Court building needs to use another purpose instead of demolishing.



The PIL said that currently the top court has 17 courtrooms and two registrar courtrooms and the Centre is going to demolish the entire building and ? 800 crore is going to be spent on rebuilding 27 courtrooms with four registrar courtrooms.

"That making the 27 courtrooms with the four registrar courtrooms will not help after 10 years because the fast-growing economy and

civilisation, the number of Supreme Court Cases also increasing rapidly. After 10 years, the 27 courtrooms may lead to huge inconvenience for the Indian people," it added.

Further, the petition said that the Centre did not release the new design of the Supreme Court building and did not discuss with the common people and bar associations about the new building design.

Court Reserves Order On Probe Agency Chargesheet Against Arvind Kejriwal

New Delhi: A Delhi court on Tuesday reserved for June 4 its order on whether to take cognisance of the Enforcement Directorate's supplementary charge sheet against Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal in the money laundering case linked to the alleged excise scam.

The court will also decide whether to take note of the alleged offence against the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), the first political party which has been booked under the Prevention of Money

Laundering Act (PMLA) by the ED. The supplementary charge sheet has also claimed that bribes were received even from Punjab businessmen to allow them to invest in liquor trade in the national capital.

The Enforcement Directorate has claimed those businessmen from Punjab, also ruled by the AAP, who did not pay up, were forced out of their ventures in the neighbouring state.

Special Judge Kaveri Baweja reserved the order

after hearing the arguments advanced by the ED, which claimed it has sufficient evidence to prosecute Kejriwal in the case. The federal anti-money laundering agency told the court that Kejriwal, the national convenor of AAP, and the party were inextricably linked to the alleged scam.

Arvind Kejriwal is the "kingpin and key conspirator" of the scam, which also involves other AAP leaders and private individuals, the ED has alleged.

"Action Against Corrupt Leaders Will Accelerate After June 4": PM Modi

New Delhi (KCN): From Barasat in West Bengal to Dumka in Jharkhand, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Tuesday vowed to launch a thorough investigation against corrupt leaders once the results of the ongoing Lok Sabha elections are out on June 4.

This, he promised, was a "Modi ki guarantee" and an "X-ray so powerful" that it will deter future generations from indulging in corruption.

"Ten years ago, I pledged to eradicate corruption, and I've upheld that promise. Now, I assure the nation that 'na

khaunga, na khaane dunga'! The mountains of notes that have been recovered from TMC leaders will be accounted for, every single penny of it. Legal measures are being implemented to ensure justice," said Prime Minister Modi during the election rally in Barasat. In Dumka, as he slammed Jharkhand Mukti Morcha and Congress of "looting Jharkhand from all sides", the Prime Minister said that the resource-rich state is now infamous for its mountains of currency



notes. "After June 4, action against corrupt leaders will accelerate, and this is the Modi ki

guarantee," he said while reiterating his commitment to combating corruption in

the country.

On Monday, while speaking exclusively to IANS, Prime Minister

Modi elaborated on how his government has been working tirelessly to weed out rampant corruption from the system.

"Today, when the big fish are being caught, questions are being raised by vested interests. It's difficult to understand what is the motive of the Khan Market Gang and why it is framing such narratives to save the criminals from facing the law," he said.

He had also made it clear that the independent agencies take action based on facts which are gathered after a lot of hard

work.

"It is the Independent investigative agency which apprehends the accused and the judiciary which decides on their conviction or trial. The Prime Minister has no role in this," said Prime Minister Modi. While addressing multiple election meetings in different parts of the country over the past many weeks, the Prime Minister has emphasised that the next five years will prove to be extremely important in the country's fight against corruption. Last August, while speaking from the ramparts of the Red Fort

on the occasion of 77th Independence Day, Prime Minister Modi had mentioned that corruption, nepotism and appeasement are the three major challenges that have suppressed the aspirations of people in the country. "Freedom from corruption, fight against corruption in every area and in every sector is the need of the hour. And countrymen, my dear family members, this is Modi's commitment; it is my personal commitment that I will continue to fight against corruption," said the Prime Minister on August 15, 2023.

Cyclone Remal brings havoc for Olive Ridley eggs, hatchlings

Kendrapara(KCN): The adverse weather conditions and torrential rain caused by Cyclone Remal in the Bay of Bengal have severely disrupted the emergence of Olive Ridley turtle hatchlings at the mass nesting sites of Nasi-2, the world's largest rookery of the species in Odisha. DFO of Rajnagar Mangrove (forest) and Wildlife Division, Sudarshan Gopinath Jadav, said the turbulent sea, along with high tides due to Cyclone Remal, washed away several eggs. The incessant rain also damaged the turtle eggs, he added. Official

sources said about 1.20 lakh Olive Ridley sea turtle hatchlings emerged from the eggs at the mass nesting sites of Nasi-2 three days ago. However, the prevailing adverse weather conditions due to Cyclone Remal have halted the emergence of the baby hatchlings from the pits. "We are now in a wait-and watch situation with fingers crossed, as we anticipate the eggs might have been destroyed due to Cyclone Remal," Jadav said. Around 3 lakh Olive Ridley sea turtles came ashore en-masse

to the golden beach of Nasi-2 within Gahirmatha Marine Sanctuary and laid eggs over five days, starting April 2. The mass nesting process of the sea turtles was also affected by the adverse weather, Jadav noted. According to Jadav, the hatchlings of the endangered Olive Ridley sea turtles started emerging six days ago at the tranquil sandy nesting ground at Nasi-2, located close to the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) at Wheeler's Island under the Gahirmatha Marine Sanctuary. He



said it was expected that the process would continue for at least the next five days, but Cyclone Remal has disrupted the emergence of the baby

turtles from their eggshells. Earlier, due to multi-layering at Nasi-2, more than 15 per cent of the eggs laid were destroyed in some segments during

the mass nesting, as turtles were seen laying eggs on the same spot, digging the earth with their flippers, and destroying previously laid eggs. Female Olive

Ridley sea turtles generally lay 100-120 eggs at a time. They lay their eggs at midnight in 45-cm pits, which they dig 2-3 feet deep with their rear flippers. Hatchlings emerge from the eggs after 45-55 days and find their way to the sea, creating a cacophony, the DFO said. Once hatched, the turtles dig their way to the surface and scurry to the ocean. It is believed by some that imprinting on the Earth's magnetic field may occur upon their emergence from the sand. This imprinting is thought to guide the hatchlings back to the

same breeding areas in adulthood. If the hatchlings reach the ocean successfully, they will spend the next several years dispersing in ocean currents, associating with sargassum rafts and floating debris, which provide them with food and shelter, Jadav said. It is one of nature's rare phenomena where babies grow without their mother. The endangered species' mortality rate is so high that only one out of every 1,000 eggs laid hatches and survives to become an adult Olive Ridley turtle, Jadav explained.

Amit Shah's Nimapara Address : Vows of Cultural Revival and Economic Growth Ignite Debate

"The anarchism by a Tamil person over Odisha can never be tolerated," Shah asserted, positioning the BJP as the party that will restore local governance and integrity. He assured the crowd that if the BJP comes to power, the state would have an Odia as Chief Minister, thus ensuring that leadership remains in the hands of someone who genuinely comprehends and values the local culture and issues. Amit Shah's election campaign in Nimapara marks a strategic move by the BJP to leverage both cultural and economic appeals in its campaign. By criticizing the current administration's handling of the Sri Jagannath Temple and promising significant economic reforms, the BJP aims to attract a wide base of voters disillusioned with the status quo. Odisha: 348 Assembly candidates face criminal charges; BJP fields highest among other parties

Bhubaneswar(KCN): A joint report of the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Odisha Election Watch has revealed that 348 candidates out of the 1283 candidates who are contesting the ongoing Assembly election in Odisha face criminal cases. The report reveals that the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), among all the major political parties in the state, has fielded the highest number of candidates facing various different criminal cases. As per the report, a staggering 68 per cent of BJP's candidates (100 out of 147) have criminal cases against them. Meanwhile, the report claims that 58 per cent of candidates fielded by the BJP are facing serious criminal charges including kidnap, assault, rape, murder and Offence for which the maximum

punishment is of 5 years or more etc. Similarly, 41 per cent (60 of the 145) candidates of Congress have declared criminal cases against them. The ruling Biju Janata Dal has fielded 46 (31 per cent) of the 147 candidates facing criminal charges. "The role of money power in our elections is evident from the fact that all major political parties give tickets to wealthy candidates. Among the major parties 128 (87 per cent) out of 147 candidates analysed from BJD, 96 (65 per cent) out of 147 candidates analysed from BJP, 88 (61 per cent) out of 145 candidates analysed from INC and 11 (27 per cent) out of 41 candidates analysed from AAP have declared assets valued more than Rs 1 crore," reads the report.
