Normally, the monsoon arrives in the northeastern states of Arunachal Pradesh, Tripura, Nagaland, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Manipur, and Assam June 5. The onset of the monsoon in Kerala marks the start of India's southwest monsoon

season, which stretches from June to September, and accounts for over 70 per cent of the country's annual rainfall. The monsoon plays a key role in the Indian economy as close to 50 per cent of the country's farmland does not have any other source of irrigation. The monsoon rains are also crucial for recharging the country's reservoirs and aquifers from which the water can be used later in the year to irrigate crops.

**Bhubaneswar(KCN):** Expressing his views on the much-debated succession plan of BJD's leadership and grooming of his close confidante Kartik Pandian, Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik Thursday has said that Pandian is not his successor. In an interview with ANI, Naveen said that bureaucrat-turned-politician Pandian is not his successor and that the people of Odisha will decide about his successor. "I can't understand these

(Pandian being projected as Naveen's successor) exaggerations. You may have noticed that he (Pandian) is not even standing for elections," the BJD supremo added. Naveen further cleared the air on the allegations labelled by the opposition regarding the decision-making power of Pandian on behalf of the Chief Minister and said, "This is ridiculous and I have said it often before, this is an old allegation and it holds no weight." Responding to a question on Prime Minister



Narendra Modi's recent remarks on his health, Naveen said, "If he (PM Modi) is so concerned about my health, all he needed was to pick up the telephone and enquire about my health instead of stating it loudly

at public meetings three times yesterday (Wednesday).” Naveen also said, “My health is perfectly alright as you can see I have been campaigning for the past month all over the state amid a very hot season.”

When asked about attending cabinet meetings, the Chief Minister said, "I always chair the cabinet meetings. There is not a single cabinet meeting that I do not chair." Regarding the prospects of BJD in the ongoing simultaneous elections in Odisha, the five-time Chief Minister said that his party will get a 'handsome' figure, form government in Odisha, and win a majority of Lok Sabha seats from the state.

**Chandigarh (JAG MOHAN THAKEN), May 30:** Claiming the progress India has made under his leadership, in a public rally in Hoshiarpur, Punjab, Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed confidence in the country's future. "Today the country has new aspirations, new hopes, new confidence. After decades, a majority central government is going to score a hat-trick," he said. Emphasizing the dream of a developed India, he noted, "Every Indian is connected with this dream, and that's why they are blessing us."

PM Modi reiterated his commitment to transforming India in the 21st century, citing the unprecedented development of the past decade. "When people from Punjab and other states go abroad, they see for themselves how much respect for India and Indians has

increased,” he stated, attributing this respect to the strength of a stable government.

Prime Minister Modi, on Thursday, concluded his 2024 election campaign with a public rally in Hoshiarpur, Punjab, paying homage to the sacred land of Guru Ravidas Ji and emphasizing his government's commitment to development and heritage preservation.

“Hoshiarpur is called the small Kashi. This is the sacred land of Guru Ravidas Ji. Ending the election campaign here is nothing short of a blessing,” PM Modi remarked, connecting the spiritual significance of Hoshiarpur with his constituency, Varanasi, which is also the birthplace of Guru Ravidas Ji.

Drawing inspiration from Guru Ravidas Ji's teachings, PM Modi emphasized his government's focus on the welfare of the poor.

“Guru Ravidas Ji used to say, ‘I desire such a rule, where everyone has food.’ In the past 10 years, we have provided free grain and free treatment facilities to the poorest of the poor,” he declared.

Highlighting the impact of his government’s welfare schemes, PM Modi noted, “Today, no poor, Dalit, or deprived child has to sleep on an empty stomach. Today, a poor woman does not have to hide her illness out of compulsion. Now she has a ration card and an Ayushman card.”

PM Modi underscored his government’s efforts to eliminate caste discrimination and

promote social equality. “Guru Ravidas Ji wanted a society without discrimination based on caste. Today, the benefits of the Modi government's schemes are reaching everyone without discrimination,” he said, listing achievements such as providing concrete houses, gas connections, toilets, and electricity connections to all sections of society. He reaffirmed his commitment to the principle of “Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas” which he described as a guiding philosophy for his administration. PM Modi highlighted his government's initiatives

to honour the heritage of Guru Ravidas Ji. “In Madhya Pradesh, I laid the foundation stone of a grand memorial to Guru Ravidas Ji. Facilities are being increased at Guru Ravidas Ji’s birthplace in Kashi. Even in Delhi, there is a holy place of Guru Ravidas Ji Maharaj in Tughlakabad,” he announced. He also expressed his desire to name the Adampur airport after Guru Ravidas Ji, promising swift action once the government is formed. Addressing the challenges faced by his government, PM Modi criticized the self-serving politics of Congress and

the INDI alliance. He accused them of indulging in vote bank politics and failing to assert India's rights during the partition. "Their love for the vote bank was such that during the partition, they couldn't assert India's right over our Kartarpur Sahib," he said.

PM Modi also condemned their opposition to the Ram temple and the CAA, attributing it to their appeasement politics. "These are the same people who strangled the constitution during the Emergency and did not think of the constitution during the 1984 riots," he asserted.

Criticizing the INDI alliance's misgovernance, PM Modi recalled the dark hour of Indian history and said, "Nowadays, the country's people hear much about the constitution from the INDI alliance members. These are the same people who strangled the

Constitution during the Emergency. When Sikhs were being burned with tires around their necks during the 1984 riots, they did not think of the Constitution.”

“In the 10 years of my government, I have continuously protected the reservation of SC-ST-OBC. Congress and the INDI alliance are furious about my efforts. Their intentions regarding reservation are very dangerous. Their entire track record is about snatching the reservation of SC-ST-OBC,” said PM Modi condemning the INDI alliance and Congress’ appeasement politics.

Taking a sharp dig at Congress and the INDI alliance, PM Modi highlighted, “Congress is the mother of corruption. Congress has done a double Ph.D. in corruption in 60 years. And now another corrupt party has joined Congress. This party is also extremely deceitful. These people came in

the name of making Punjab drug-free. But they have made drugs their means of income. The whole world knows about the liquor scam in Delhi. Here, the mining mafia is also running unchecked.”

“These hardcore corrupt people, these extreme deceivers have thrown Punjab into gang wars. These people have ruined both industry and agriculture in Punjab. These hardcore corrupt people, extreme deceivers are also becoming number one in women's oppression. Today the world is seeing their deeds from Delhi to Punjab,” he added.

During his concluding remarks, PM Modi urged the people of Punjab to support BJP candidates in the upcoming elections. “The coming 5 years will be for the rise of the poor, farmers, youth, and women empowerment. I urge you to make the lotus bloom on every seat in Punjab on June 1st,” he appealed.

# Pradhan Assails BJD : Promises Development at Astarang Rally

**Bhubaneswar, (KCN Bureau):** Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan attended a significant BJP victory rally at the Astarang block ground on Wednesday, where he launched a sharp critique of the ruling Biju Janata Dal (BJD) and its leadership in the Kakatpur constituency. ## Ranching of IMC fingerlings for conservation at Balagarh, West Bengal

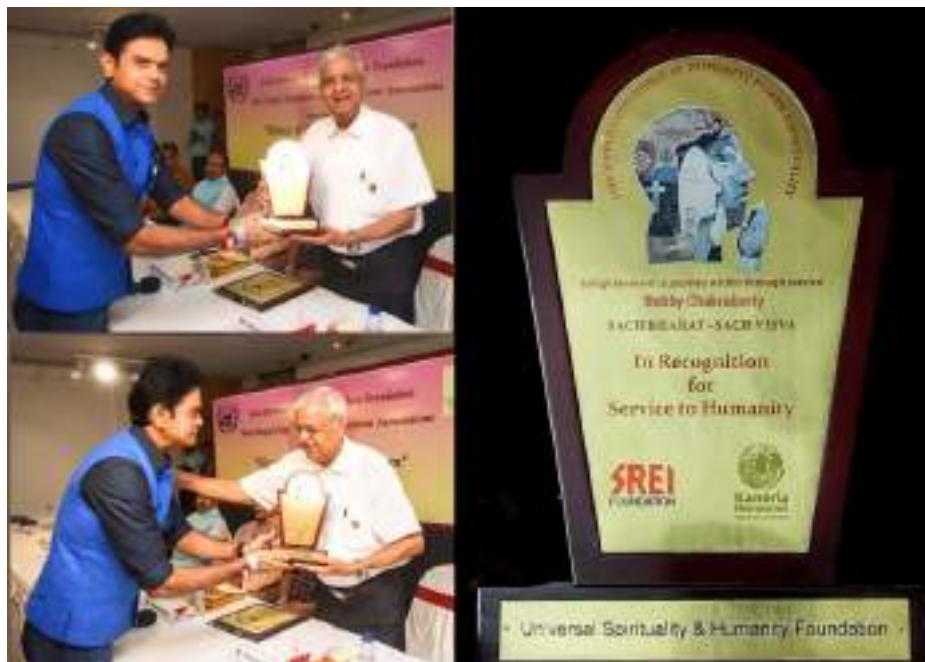


**Kolkata, (KCN):** ICAR-Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute (CIFRI), Barrackpore, performed a River Ranching Program-2024 at Balagarh, West Bengal, as part of the "Namami Gange" programme, with the goal of protecting and revitalising the Ganga River. Along with local fishermen and other members of the ICAR-CIFRI NMCG project team, 3.06 lakh IMC fingerlings were released into the Ganga River at P.C. Pal Ghat, Balagarh. In the event, 50

fishermen from local co-operative society and local women from fisher families had participated in the ranching programme. Scientists from ICAR-CIFRI gave an overview of the goals of the Namami Gange initiative and emphasised its recent accomplishments. Speaking with local fishermen, they emphasised the significance of preserving the Ganges river system's health in order to protect the variety of native fish species. Extensive work and

noteworthy accomplishments from NMCG Phases I and II had been highlighted. These included surveying fish diversity, assessing the stocks of economically significant species such as Hilsa, producing seeds from wild germplasm of particular fish kinds, and putting ranching programmes into action in river segments that have run dry. The successful execution of this effort may strengthen the Ganga river system's long-term viability.

**Kolkata, (KCN):** A scientific team of ICAR-Central Inland Fishery Research Institute, Barrackpore under NMCG project carried out a survey on fish diversity and other abiotic factors in river Dwarakeswar and Rupnarayan from Kashipur, Purulia to Bandar, Hooghly covering about 120 km. The river Dwarakeswar originates from the Chota Nagpur Plateau in the state of Jharkhand and flows through the Purulia, Bankura, and Hooghly districts of West Bengal before merging with the Rupnarayan River. After emerging from the Chota Nagpur plateau foothills northeast of the city of Purulia in West Bengal state the river Rupnarayan initially known as Dhaleswari (Dhalkiswar) enters the city of Bankura, where it is known as Dwarakeswar. From Bankura it flows meandering across the plain to the city of Ghatil and meets with Silai and takes the name Rupnarayan. During the sampling period a total

Fishing Practices Fishing in the Dwarakeswar River is mostly traditional,

involving: Cast Nets: Commonly used by local fishermen to catch a variety of fish. Gill Nets: Used for catching larger fish such as carps and catfish. Hand Lines and Long Lines: For targeting specific species like catfish. Traps and Bamboo Structures: For catching smaller fish and prawns. Challenges The fisheries of the Dwarakeswar River face several challenges: The visiting team highlighted that the flow in river Dwarakeswar has diminished at upper stretches due to various anthropogenic activities in the form of hydraulic structures, water extraction, sand mining, check dam etc. Pollution: Industrial discharge,

agricultural runoff, and domestic waste contaminated the river, affecting fish health and populations. Habitat Degradation: Changes in river flow due to damming, sand mining, and other activities can disrupt fish habitats. An interactive session with the local fishermen revealed that a perceptible rise in the occurrence of fishes were recorded from the river in few decades back but due to diminished water flow and other anthropogenic factors fish catch has declined. Fisheries in the Dwarakeswar River contribute significantly to the livelihoods of local communities. Fishing is often a primary or supplementary source of income for many households, especially in rural areas. During the present study, it has been documented that there is a rich occurrence of small indigenous fishes (SIF) in the upper stretches of the river which needs more attention for the conservation and sustenance of their population.

## Land, Fish, Fear: Probe Agency On How Shahjahan Built Sandeshkhali Empire

**New Delhi (KCN):** Sandeshkhali strongman Sheikh Shahjahan, the man at the centre of allegations that evolved into the biggest talking point in West Bengal this election, allegedly used an intricate web of dummy traders, numerous properties and multiple bank accounts to turn black money into white, the probe by Enforcement Directorate has found. The central agency has filed a prosecution complaint before a special court in Kolkata under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act.

"ED initiated investigation on the basis of 13 FIRs registered by West Bengal Police under various sections of IPC Act, 1860 and Arms Act, 1959 against Sahajhan Sheikh and others on the allegations that they have created an atmosphere of terror by indulging in organized crime of giving threats of injury, murder, attempt to murder, extortion etc. and also grabbed land of general public and obtained illegal monetary gains/benefits," ED has said in a statement. The agency has said that its probe found that

Shahjahan "created a criminal empire revolving around land grabbing, illegal fish farming/trading, grabbing brick fields, cartelization of contracts, collection of illegal taxes/levies, commission on land deals etc". According to ED sources, the former Trinamool leader used political influence and armed goons to conduct his illegal businesses on the nondescript island in North 24 Parganas district. Four people have been arrested in the case -- Shahjahan, his brother Alamgir and the



strongman's aides Shib Prasad Hazra and Didar Boksh Molla. Statements of 100-odd witnesses have been recorded; these include local farmers, tribals, fish traders, landowners and contractors working in the area. The ED had earlier attached assets worth ?

27 crore allegedly belonging to Shahjahan and others. Three SUVs belonging to the strongman -- Mahindra Thar, Jeep Compass and Mahindra Scorpio -- have been seized. "Out of the proceeds of crime of value Rs.261.41 Crore derived and obtained by said persons from criminal activities, as revealed during the course of investigation conducted under PMLA, 2002," the agency has said. ED sources said the proceeds of crime include the strongman's earnings from fish depots, rent

from 'Shahjahan market' and brick kilns. They also include government tenders received by Alamgir and Hazra due to Shahjahan's political influence. ED sources also explained how the strongman, who was expelled by Trinamool soon after the allegations came to the fore, cleaned the black money made through illegal means. The agency has said in its chargesheet that back in 2009-2010, Shahjahan, then a CPM leader, grabbed fisheries of 60-70 bighas land and started business in the

name of Sk Sabina Fisheries. He joined the Trinamool Congress in 2013 and became sub-pradhan in Agarhati gram panchayat on an invitation from then local Trinamool MP Haji Nurul Islam and with the backing of then minister Jyoti Priya Mallick, the chargesheet says. "On one hand, Sk Sahajhan helped people by offering a few free medical services, financial aid, and essential provisions. However, on the other hand, Sk Sahajhan employed over 100 goons who remained

close to him and his residence. These goons would intimidate and extort individuals, compelling them to comply with Sk Sahajhan's orders. Those who resisted faced physical violence and threats of severe consequences," it says, adding, "these individuals were known to carry illegal firearms and were not hesitant to use excessive force". In the aftermath of his arrest by the ED in February, the Trinamool Congress suspended him for six years.



# RMC awaits legitimate election

**Rourkela(KCN):** In a few days, Rourkela Assembly seat will get its new elected representative. However, despite the upgradation of Rourkela Municipality to Rourkela Municipal Corporation (RMC), the Steel City civic body is yet to get an elected body to take care of its day-to-day affairs. The last election of the civic body was held in 2008 and its upgradation was done in 2014. The term of the elected council led by BJD's Rashmibala Mishra as chairperson of

the municipality came to an end in 2013. A long time has passed since then but the wait for an elected body of Rourkela Municipal Corporation is yet to end. The number of wards under the civic body increased from 33 to 40 by merging Jagda area and parts of Jhartarang panchayat after Rourkela Municipality was upgraded to Municipal Corporation. This met with massive tribal opposition and legal hurdles, as a case was filed in the Orissa High



Court opposing the enhancement status in 2015.

Ironically, it was George Tirkey, who is now in BJD, who had led a month-long seizure of the RMC office and also had

filed the case in the Orissa HC. Notably, his son Rohit Joseph Tirkey is contesting on a party ticket from Biramitrapur Assembly segment in the ongoing polls. No serious effort is visible

on the part of the BJD government to conduct the elections and take the plea as "the matter is sub-judice". Nihar Ray, former chairman of Rourkela Municipality, who fought as an

independent candidate as he was denied a BJP ticket for the Assembly polls, filed a writ petition in OHC in 2021. "My point is that the government should hold elections for the 33

wards of the municipality and not for the corporation since the latter's status has been challenged in the OHC," said Ray sometime back. He had further alleged that the state government is deliberately avoiding elections and is not serious about the legal hurdle as that will help it to take de facto control over the municipality by installing a commissioner here. Interestingly, when the monthlong siege was laid by Tirkey, most of those

who sat in demonstration did not belong to Rourkela. "They were drawn from all parts of the district to continue the agitation," a police officer had said then. Today, in the absence of any elected representative, the city residents are completely dependent on the mercy of the RMC staff. It has affected all the denizens and also the overall performance and achievements of RMC. Now, the question arising in everybody's mind is: when the elections will be held for RMC?

## 30 injured as crackers go off during Chandan Yatra

**Puri(KCN):** More than 30 persons were injured, many of them critically, in a firecracker explosion during Chandan Yatra of Lord Jagannath and his siblings at Narendra Pond Wednesday night. Sources said hundreds of people had congregated near the pond to witness the deities' water sports when the mishap occurred. "Huge



quantities of firecrackers were kept near the pond. Some youths were bursting those one after the other. Suddenly, an explosion took place. Many people, including a few children, suffered severe burns in the

explosion," they said. While 10 of the injured are being treated at the district headquarters hospital (DHH) here, nearly 20 have been shifted to facilities like SCB Medical College and

Hospital in Cuttack, they pointed out. Meanwhile, Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik directed Chief Secretary PK Jena and the district administration to ensure proper treatment of the

injured. "All expenses for the treatment of the injured will be met from the Chief Minister's Relief Fund. I pray Lord Jagannath for the speedy recovery of the injured," Patnaik said.

## Naveen leads massive roadshow in Nimapara

**Nimapara(KCN):** Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik led a mega roadshow in Nimapara under Jagatsinghpur Lok Sabha constituency Wednesday.

A large number of people gathered on both sides of the road in Nimapara as Patnaik greeted them from a specially-designed bus. On the 2-km route, he was greeted by supporters holding cutouts of 'conch', the party's election symbol, and waving the BJD flag.



The chief minister also delivered a brief speech, in which he assured the gathering of providing free electricity and

extending the Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana (BSKY) scheme to people of all sections.

"No electricity bill will come from July. All will be covered under BSKY. Mission Shakti members will get pensions," he said, urging the people to bless the BJD in the simultaneous elections to the state assembly and Lok Sabha. Meanwhile, senior BJD leader VK Pandian campaigned at Jashipur, Sarskana, Moroda, Udala and Bangirposi in the Mayurbhanj Lok Sabha constituency during the day.

## 'BJP design' behind EC action against two IPS officers in Odisha, alleges Pandian



**Balasore(KCN):** Terming as "unfortunate" the EC action against two IPS officers working in Odisha CMO for "interfering with polls", senior BJD leader Kartik Pandian Wednesday alleged it was done as per "design of the BJP, which was unable to

digest imminent defeat" in elections in the state. The Election Commission Tuesday suspended IPS officer DS Kutey and ordered the medical examination another officer, Asish Singh, who has been on medical leave since May 4. "It is very unfortunate that the ECI has taken action

against some of the officers working in the CMO. I would say that those two officers are outstanding officers of Odisha and both of them have played a great role in controlling Naxalism in the state by risking their lives, be it Gajapati or Malkangiri. I think they have been awarded by the highest authorities of the country for their commitment, dedication and sacrifice," Pandian told reporters at Balasore.


Stating the action as "unfortunate", he said, "It is as per the design of the BJP, which cannot digest imminent defeat in the hands of BJD. And it cannot stand against the popularity of Naveen babu (Patnaik)."

The ECI, in a letter to the Odisha CEO, said that

1997-batch IPS officer DS Kutey, who is presently working as the special secretary to the chief minister, be placed under suspension on the charge of "interfering" with the conduct of elections.

Kutey has been asked to report at the office of Resident Commissioner, Odisha at New Delhi Wednesday.

Similarly, Asish Singh, an IPS officer of 2010-batch who is presently working as IG (CM security), was asked to present himself for a detailed examination by a special medical board constituted by the director of AIIMS Bhubaneswar, not later than May 30. He has been on medical leave since May 4.
