

PM Modi extends Ayushman Bharat for all over 70 years

New Delhi(KCN): Prime Minister Narendra Modi Tuesday launched development projects worth nearly Rs 12,850 crore and extended his government's flagship health insurance scheme Ayushman Bharat to all senior citizens aged 70 years and above. The major push in the health sector was unveiled on the occasion of the ninth Ayurveda Day and the birth anniversary of Dhanvantari, the Hindu god of medicine. Modi also inaugurated phase II of India's first All India Institute of Ayurveda in the national capital which includes a Panchakarma hospital, an Ayurvedic pharmacy for drug manufacturing, a sports medicine unit, a central library, an IT and startup incubation centre, and a 500-seat

auditorium among others. In an innovative usage of drone technology to enhance service delivery and make healthcare more accessible, Modi launched drone services at 11 tertiary healthcare institutions. These are AIIMS-Rishikesh in Uttarakhand, AIIMS-Bibinagar in Telangana, AIIMS-Guwahati in Assam, AIIMS-Bhopal in Madhya Pradesh, AIIMS-Jodhpur in Rajasthan, AIIMS-Patna in Bihar, AIIMS-Bilaspur in Himachal Pradesh, AIIMS-Raebareilly in Uttar Pradesh, AIIMS-Raipur in Chhattisgarh, AIIMS-Mangalagiri in Andhra Pradesh and RIMS-Imphal in Manipur. The prime minister also launched a helicopter emergency medical service from AIIMS Rishikesh, which will help

deliver medical care speedily. Modi launched a U-WIN portal that seeks to benefit pregnant women and infants by fully digitising the vaccination process. It will ensure timely administration of life-saving vaccines to pregnant women and children (from birth to 16 years) against 12 vaccine-preventable diseases. Further, the prime minister launched a portal for allied and healthcare professionals and institutes. It will act as a centralised database of existing healthcare professionals and institutes. Modi also inaugurated three medical colleges at Mandsaur, Neemuch and Seoni in Madhya Pradesh, besides facility and service extensions at



various AIIMS — Bilaspur in Himachal Pradesh, Kalyani in West Bengal, Patna in Bihar, Gorakhpur in Uttar Pradesh, Bhopal in Madhya Pradesh, Guwahati in Assam and in New Delhi, which also include a Jan Aushadhi Kendra.

Modi also inaugurated a Super Speciality Block in Government Medical College at Bilaspur in Chhattisgarh and a Critical Care Block in Bargarh, Odisha. The prime minister laid the foundation stones of five nursing colleges in Shivpuri, Ratlam,

Khandwa, Rajgarh and Mandsaur in Madhya Pradesh, 21 critical care blocks at Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Manipur, Tamil Nadu and Rajasthan under the Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission, and several facilities and service

extensions at AIIMS in New Delhi and Himachal Pradesh's Bilaspur. Among other projects, Modi inaugurated an ESIC hospital at Indore in Madhya Pradesh and laid the foundation stone for such hospitals at Faridabad in Haryana, Bommasandra and Narasapur in Karnataka, Indore in Madhya Pradesh, Meerut in Uttar Pradesh, and Atchutapuram in Andhra Pradesh. These projects are expected to bring healthcare benefits to around 55 lakh ESI beneficiaries. The other projects whose foundation stones were laid include a central research institute in yoga and naturopathy at Khordha in Odisha and Raipur in Chhattisgarh, centres of excellence at NIPER-Ahmedabad for

medical devices, at NIPER-Hyderabad for bulk drugs, NIPER-Guwahati for phytopharmaceuticals, and NIPER-Mohali for anti-bacterial anti-viral drug discovery and development. In a major boost to the Make in India initiative in the healthcare sector, the prime minister also inaugurated five projects under the Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for medical devices and bulk drugs at Vapi in Gujarat, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Kakinada in Andhra Pradesh and Nalagarh in Himachal Pradesh. These units will manufacture high-end medical devices, such as body implants and critical care equipment, along with important bulk drugs.

Patna metro construction site accident: Odisha Minister expresses grief over death of two labourers from state

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Odisha Labour Minister Ganesh Ram SinghKhuntia Tuesday expressed grief over the death of two labourers from the state in an accident at Patna's metro tunnel construction site. The minister also assured to give adequate compensation to the deceased's family members after completion of the verification process. SinghKhuntia has also stated that the state government will talk to the Bihar counterpart over the issue. Speaking to media persons in Bhubaneswar Tuesday, the labour minister said that the state labour department authorities Tuesday early morning received information from reliable sources that out of the seven victims, three hail from Odisha. Two of

them died while another Odia victim who sustained severe injuries in the mishap is currently undergoing treatment at the Patna Medical College and Hospital. "Following the receipt of information regarding the incident, we immediately deputed Satyanarayan Acharya, District Labour Officer (DLO), Bhubaneswar, to the incident spot in Patna in Bihar. He will investigate the matter immediately after reaching there. The districts to which the deceased persons belonged are yet to be ascertained. The Aadhar verification is on to find out their complete identity details," said SinghKhuntia. The Labour Minister also revealed that the deceased from Odisha were identified as Manoj and Shyam Babu. Meanwhile, another Odia

victim identified as Bijay who has sustained serious injuries is currently undergoing treatment at the Patna Medical College and Hospital. Notably, at least three workers were killed and four others sustained serious injuries during the construction of an underground tunnel for the Patna Metro. The incident occurred near the National Institute of Technology (NIT) Ashok Rajpath, Mahendru late Monday night. According to reports, the accident happened when a loco machine, used to transport materials within the tunnel, experienced a brake failure. The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC), overseeing the construction, has confirmed the incident and initiated an investigation into the cause of the brake failure.

PM Modi inaugurates, lays foundation stones of three health projects in Odisha

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Prime Minister Narendra Modi Tuesday virtually inaugurated and laid the foundation stones of three health projects in Odisha. The Prime Minister inaugurated the Central Drugs Testing Laboratory at Gothapatna in Bhubaneswar and a 50-bed critical care block at the District Headquarters Hospital (DHH) in Bargarh. He also laid the foundation stone for the Central Research Institute in Yoga and Naturopathy at Jatni, on the outskirts of Bhubaneswar. Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi and Health Minister Mukesh Mahaling attended the inauguration of the



Central Drugs Testing Laboratory, while local MPs and MLAs participated in the events at Jatni and Bargarh. Addressing the gathering, Majhi said the Odisha government will implement the Ayushman Bharat scheme soon and added that the left-out eligible beneficiaries will get the benefits of the

scheme. The Gopabandhu Jan Arogya Yojana will also continue in the state, he said. The state government has allocated Rs 3,556 crore for health coverage schemes during this year's budget (2024-25), the CM said. Majhi said the health department received an



Aparajita Sarangi said the PM laid the foundation of a 100-bed Central Research Institute in Yoga and Naturopathy, to be constructed at an estimated cost of Rs 100 crore. The proposed institute will provide treatment for both indoor and outdoor patients, featuring a yoga hall and offering naturopathy classes, the MP added.

Show-cause notice to servitor after photos of Shilpa Shetty visiting Lingaraj Temple go viral

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The Lingaraj Temple administration in Odisha's Bhubaneswar has issued a show-cause notice to a servitor and an official, after photos and videos of actor Shilpa Shetty visiting the shrine, where photography is prohibited, went viral. The move came following an outrage among devotees over how pictures and videos were allowed to be captured inside the temple premises, officials said. Shetty was in the state capital Monday to attend an event and had visited the temple in the evening, sources said. "It has come to our notice that Shilpa Shetty's pictures have gone viral. We have served show-cause notice to a servitor



and a supervisor in connection with the matter... They need to give an explanation within seven days," Bhubaneswar Additional District Magistrate (ADM) Rudra Narayan Mohanty, who is also in charge of the temple administration, said. Mohanty said the duo was seen in pictures along with the actor. Local MLA Babu Singh, too, raised concern over how cameras or mobile

phones were allowed inside the temple premises despite a ban. "Even when the Prime Minister or President visits the temple, no camera is allowed inside Lingaraj Temple. The celebrities who visit the shrine are also instructed to not carry mobile phones inside the premises. But still, these mistakes are happening. Strict action needs to be taken against those found involved in such incidents," Singh said.

Central Government wants to take revenge for farmers' movement: alleges AAP

Chandigarh (JAG MOHAN THAKEN), October 29: The Aam Aadmi Party once again attacked the BJP and the central government over the issues related to the purchase and lifting of paddy and alleged that the Central Government wants to take revenge for farmers' movement.

AAP MP Malvinder Singh Kang alleged that this time the central government intentionally did not empty the warehouses to trouble the farmers of Punjab.

Kang stated that it is the routine procedure of the Food Supply Ministry of the Government of India for the FCI (Food Corporation of India) to lift old grains from its warehouses before the arrival of new grains in the mandis (markets) each year, so that there is space available for grain shifting. This process has been in place for decades, not

just for a year or two. Addressing the media along with AAP leaders Jagdeep Singh Kaka Brar and Shaminder Khinda at the party office in Chandigarh on Tuesday, Kang said that this time the central government intentionally did not empty the warehouses to trouble the farmers of Punjab. Now, as the controversy has escalated and the central government finds itself in a difficult position, it is misleading the people of Punjab through its minister Ravneet Bittu. The BJP has deliberately created this issue.

Kang raised questions regarding BJP leaders asking why the Chief Minister himself is not going to Delhi to resolve the matter. He questioned whether the BJP wants the Chief Minister of Punjab to beg the Prime Minister to empty the warehouses. If that is



what they want, they should openly state that the Chief Minister will have to plead with the Prime Minister for a resolution.

Kang mentioned that since March, Punjab's Food Supply Department has been writing letters to the FCI and the central ministry, requesting the lifting of grains. But the central government was sleeping like Kumbhakaran for nine months. He noted the dates, saying that the Punjab Food Supply Department first wrote

to the FCI on March 5, followed by letters on March 11, 13, 19, and 22. In June, letters were sent on the 14th and 27th. A letter was also sent on September 3.

Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann also spoke to Central Minister Prahlad Joshi on September 25 and met him in Delhi on September 30. The Chief Minister also met with Union Home Minister Amit Shah and Union Minister JP Nadda.

Kang challenged the BJP to tell them whom else the

purchases as a favour, when in fact it is the central government's responsibility to manage purchases and storage. He accused the central government of trying to tarnish the reputation of the Punjab government to hide its own failures. He argued that the BJP is acting out of a desire to take revenge on the farmers and traders of Punjab, demonstrating its stepmotherly treatment of the state. Kang praised the Punjab government and state officials for lifting 5 lac metric tons of grain on October 28 and assured that regardless of the central government's efforts to create difficulties, the Punjab government will not let its farmers, traders, and millers face any issues. "We stand with them," he concluded.

On the other hand, the Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) Tuesday said

both the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) as well as the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) were equally responsible for the harassment being suffered by farmers in Punjab due to lack of timely procurement of their paddy crop which was forcing them to sell below the minimum support price.

Asserting that both these parties were responsible for the miserable condition of farmers in the State, senior SAD leader Dr Daljit Singh Cheema said, "Had both the parties shouldered their responsibility in time, the present agricultural crisis could have been averted". He went on to say, "Both these parties are hand in glove with each other and are taking revenge on the farmers for the Kisan Andolan launched against the three agricultural laws".

Dr Cheema said it was

pitiable that instead of solving the crisis, both AAP and the BJP were resorting to cheap politics by holding press conferences against each other and indulging in a blame game. Asserting that these press conferences were mere "tamashas", Dr Cheema said "such attempts to play to the galleries will not relieve the agony of farmers who are suffering in the grain markets and being forced to sell their produce below the market rate".

Calling upon both parties to sit together and solve the problem being faced by farmers, Dr Cheema said besides ensuring procurement of paddy, appropriate rate for Basmati and lifting of last year's paddy stocks from the State, immediate arrangements should be made to ensure adequate supply of DAP fertiliser to farmers for their upcoming paddy crop.

The post read: "My film FATEH is inspired by real life incidents involving Deep Fake and fake loan apps. This is the latest incident where someone tried to extract money from an unsuspecting family, by chatting with them through video call pretending to be Sonu sood. Many innocent individuals fall into this trap. I request all of you to be vigilant if you receive such calls. #fateh"

Interestingly, inspired from such events, the actor turned writer and director for his new thriller, Fateh. Sood wrote the story after one and a half years of research and interviews with victims, cybercrime police officers, and ethical hackers. He essays the role of a tech-savvy investigation agent who is on a mission to protect the country from cybercrime.

Grammys Reduce Nominees From 10 to 8 In Top 4 Award Categories

Grammys has announced to reduce the number of nominees in four of its award categories - Album, Song, Record of the Year, and Best New Artist - from 10 to 8, Variety reported on Friday. An announcement in this regard was made after the Recording Academy updated its rules and guidelines following its semiannual board of trustees meeting. The number of nominees for those categories was increased from eight to ten in November 2021, just before the nominees for 2022 were announced -- a surprising and perplexing turn of events, given that such changes usually occur after the annual board meetings, Variety reported. While three new award categories were announced earlier this week, the reduction in the number of nominees in four award categories was announced on Friday. An Artificial Intelligence (AI)-related rule was also introduced, effectively stating that only human creators are eligible for awards; however, as with all things AI, the vast possibilities that the technology makes possible in this still-developing area necessitate an extensive series of caveats, Variety further reported. While Recording Academy CEO Harvey Mason Jr. stated at the time that the change was "an incredible opportunity for us to honour more artists and shine a light on more great music, and potentially offer a greater chance for more genres of music to be honoured", some speculated that it was done to ensure Taylor Swift received a best new album nomination for her album 'Evermore' and thus increase the chance that she would appear on the show and boost its rating, as reported by Variety.

Diwali major festival for Overseas Hindus

Diwali, a significant cultural and religious festival, is celebrated by Hindus, Sikhs, and Jains globally. Known as the "Festival of Lights," Diwali is commemorated with great enthusiasm both within India and throughout the Indian diaspora worldwide. On the primary day of Diwali, known as Lakshmi Puja, it is an official holiday in various countries, including Cambodia (Angkor Wat), Fiji, Guyana, India, Indonesia (Bali), Malaysia, Mauritius, Myanmar, Nepal, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Suriname, and Trinidad and Tobago. Also referred to as Deepavali or Dewali, Diwali falls in October or November each year, with celebrations often spanning up to five days in communities where the Indian diaspora is notably present. Derived from the Sanskrit words *dipa* (lamp) and *awali* (row or line), "Deepavali" or "Diwali" translates to "Row of Lights." This illumination

symbolizes the victory of light over darkness, aligning with the Hindu New Year according to the lunar calendar and symbolizing the triumph of good over evil. Preparations for Diwali begin well in advance, including thorough cleaning and refreshing of homes, discarding unusable items, and often repainting or refurbishing furniture. As dusk approaches, families perform Lakshmi Puja with reverence to invoke blessings of prosperity. In the Cooperative Republic of Guyana, the Diwali Motorcade, held on the eve of Diwali, is an essential tradition. This custom includes decorating temples and lighting diyas (earthen lamps), alongside the unique activity of spinning steel wool. The motorcade parades through main streets, showcasing small trucks adorned with lights and elaborately decorated as chariots. Young Hindu women dressed as goddesses, representing Hindu deities with traditional hand postures, are seated atop these vehicles, which journey towards a central sports complex. In the twin islands of Trinidad and Tobago, Diwali and Ramleela are central to the festival.

Diwali in Trinidad honors Mother Lakshmi, the goddess of light, beauty, wealth, and love, and celebrates Lord Rama's return from exile after defeating the demon Ravana and rescuing his wife Sita. The Diwali celebrations in Trinidad and Tobago begin with the ceremonial lighting of the first *deya* by the President, followed by thousands of flickering *deyas* illuminated across the nation by Hindus and non-Hindus alike, casting a warm glow along pathways. The most visually striking display of lights is in central Trinidad, captivating visitors from all communities. At the heart of this celebration is Divali Nagar in Chaguanas, where people of all faiths gather to honor Diwali. Here, visitors can enjoy storytelling and performances commemorating Lord Rama's victorious return to his kingdom after 14 years in exile, symbolized by the lighting of *deyas* at dusk. Stalls line the area, selling traditional clothing, art, religious items, and delicacies, while family feasts offer vegetarian dishes culminating in desserts like *barfi*, *pera*, and *rasgulla*. A key highlight of the



festivities is the Ramleela, a vibrant theatrical reenactment of episodes from the Hindu epic, the Ramayana, performed in the days leading up to Diwali. The nine-day outdoor festival showcases Rama's life story through music, dance, and colorful costumes, concluding in a dramatic finale. The largest Ramleela event is held in Couva, known for its elaborate outdoor spectacles.

In Suriname, where Diwali is a national public holiday, the celebration reflects the traditions of the Surinamese population of Indian descent. Towns such as Nickerie, Saramacca, and Wanica, with their high concentrations of Indo-Surinamese Hindus, serve as focal points for Diwali festivities each year. Over five days, people illuminate their homes with traditional *diyas*, meticulously clean and decorate their homes with

intricate *rangoli* patterns made from colored rice or sawdust, and wear new clothes to honor the festival. Diwali celebrations in Suriname also feature family feasts, fireworks, and temple visits, with households conducting rituals in worship of Goddess Lakshmi in specially prepared rooms to welcome her blessings of prosperity. In Angkor Wat, Diwali celebrations span over seven days, marking

significant historical events and adhering closely to traditional Hindu calendar practices. Each day of the festival is observed with prescribed rituals and guidelines. The main Diwali day dazzles with displays of traditional *deyas* and electric lights, while festive meals feature sweets as a central and revered component. Diwali has increasingly fostered cultural exchange, offering opportunities for political and religious leaders worldwide to show solidarity with Hindu communities and promote inclusivity. Since the mid-1990s, the Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue, initially established by Pope Paul VI as the Secretariat for non-Christians, has extended greetings and messages from the Pope to the Hindu community each Diwali. Governments around the world also support Diwali celebrations. In Singapore, the government collaborates with the Hindu Endowment Board to organize cultural events for Diwali each year. In the UK, Diwali is celebrated prominently, with cities illuminating Diwali lights, hosting cultural performances, food stalls, and workshops. Notably, since 2009, Diwali has been observed annually at 10 Downing Street, the

official residence of the British Prime Minister, and has been attended by prominent figures such as Prince Charles, who joined celebrations at the Swaminarayan Temple in Neasden, emphasizing the contributions of the Hindu community to British society. In the United States, Diwali was first celebrated at the White House by President George W. Bush in 2003, with its religious significance officially recognized by the U.S. Congress in 2007. President Barack Obama became the first to attend the White House Diwali celebration in person in 2009. On a symbolic level, Diwali also sees gestures of goodwill between Indian and Pakistani forces at the border, with soldiers exchanging sweets as a mark of respect and camaraderie. This annual act of kindness highlights the festival's universal spirit of unity and harmony.

GSI launches State-of-the-Art Meteorite Gallery Showcasing Rare Celestial Treasures

Kolkata, (KCN):The Geological Survey of India (GSI) launched a state-of-the-art National Meteorite Repository at its Central Headquarters in Kolkata, on Monday (October 28, 2024) inaugurated today by Shri Asit Saha, Director General, GSI. This newly constructed Meteorite Gallery represents a significant advancement in the preservation and exhibition of meteorites in India, offering modern infrastructure and enhanced facilities to

showcase these extraordinary specimens from space. Speaking on the occasion, Shri Asit Saha, DG, GSI, emphasised the repository's role in enhancing India's understanding of planetary science and space exploration. He noted that the collection of hundreds of meteorites from across the globe housed here provides invaluable data on the early solar system's formation and the earth's geological

history. Dr. Joyesh Bagchi, ADG, PSS in his address highlighted that the new National Meteorite Repository stands as a testament to GSI's commitment to advancing planetary science and preserving these invaluable celestial artifacts, which deepen our understanding of the universe. He added that this modern gallery not only safeguards a remarkable collection of meteorites but also opens new avenues for scientific inquiry and inspires the

next generation of geoscientists. The National Meteorite Repository houses a rare and diverse collection of 643 meteorites from around the world, meticulously curated within the Meteorite and Planetary Science Division (MPSD) under Mission-IV, Kolkata. The gallery exhibits a wide variety of meteorite types, from ordinary chondrites and carbonaceous chondrites to achondrites, including a Martian meteorite known

as Shergotty, and iron meteorites. Among this remarkable collection, 119 specimens are from meteorite falls and finds across India. The oldest meteorite in the collection is Ensisheim, an ordinary chondrite that fell in Alsace, France, on November 7, 1492 while the recent addition is the Kopargaon meteorite, an iron chondrite that fell in Maharashtra on January 24, 2023. The oldest Indian meteorite in the collection is the Krakhut meteorite, an ordinary

chondrite that fell 14 miles from Benares (Varanasi) on December 19, 1798. Since 2018, GSI has served as the Nodal Agency for the collection, preservation, and dissemination of meteorite finds and falls within Indian territory. This role supports India's scientific community and the international research community with meteorite samples for studying the origins and evolution of the solar system. In addition to

conservation, GSI undertakes independent research as well as collaborative R&D projects with various organisations to uncover insights into the evolution of the solar system and investigate potential signs of life in celestial bodies within our celestial neighbours. The new gallery is set to become a centre for public engagement, education, and research, attracting students, researchers, and meteorite enthusiasts from around the country.

Union Minister of State for Textiles and External Affairs, Shri Pabitra Margherita, Visits Central Silk Board's Muga Eri Silkworm Seed Organisation in Guwahati

Kolkata, (KCN): Union Minister of State for Textiles and External Affairs, Shri Pabitra Margherita, marked his inaugural visit to the Central Silk Board's Muga Eri Silkworm Seed Organisation (MESSO) in Guwahati, Assam, highlighting the government's commitment to the advancement of India's sericulture sector. cultivation of Muga and Eri silk, which has evolved from a traditional tribal craft into a promising industry. The Minister acknowledged the strategic efforts of the Central Silk Board, whose research and development initiatives, backed by the Government of India, have driven significant advancements. These

initiatives, he noted, have had a tangible impact on the socio-economic conditions of ethnic communities engaged in sericulture, improving their quality of life while preserving cultural heritage. Shri Margherita commended MESSO Guwahati's forward-thinking initiatives, particularly its efforts to expand Muga culture beyond Assam into cooler regions, such as Kalimpong in West Bengal and select areas of Uttarakhand. By introducing Muga culture to these zones, MESSO

aims to mitigate the adverse effects of climate change on silk production and diversify production bases to ensure a sustainable supply of quality Muga silk. 14-ft-long crocodile rescued



Kendrapara (KCN): Forest personnel from the Kanika Forest Range have rescued a 14.2-foot long male estuarine crocodile from a prawn ghery in Khunta village, located in the Rajkanika block of this coastal district. According to Sudarshan Gopinath Yadav, the Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) of Rajnagar Mangrove (Forest) and Wildlife Division, the team, experienced in rescuing estuarine crocodiles,

captured the reptile with the help of fishing nets and later released it into the Bhitarkanika river within the national park. Sukanta Kumar Biswal, a resident of Khunta, spotted the giant crocodile Saturday in his prawn ghery. He informed the Bhitarkanika National Park authorities, who promptly deployed a forest rescue team to the site. After an eight-hour-long operation, the team

successfully secured the crocodile. Crocodiles typically stray from their natural habitat into nearby rivers and water bodies during high tide, when salinity levels rise due to the influx of tidal water into the creeks and rivulets. During the severe cyclonic storm 'Dana', high tides caused tidal water to enter water bodies in Bhitarkanika National Park, which is home to 1,811 estuarine

crocodiles. It is believed that the rescued crocodile might have strayed from its natural habitat, said DFO Yadav. A few days earlier, during the cyclone, Forest personnel also rescued a cobra that had entered Alekha Ashram in Gupti. The Bhitarkanika National Park authorities have alerted locals to avoid rivers and rivulets, as estuarine crocodiles may have entered these waters.

Newborn girl rescued from bag near pond

Keonjhar: A newborn girl packed in a bag was found dumped near a pond at Khireitangiri village under this block in Keonjhar district, Monday. On being informed, Turumunga police reached the spot and rescued the seven to 10-day old baby girl from the embankment of the pond behind a school at Dhanabeni Sahi in the village. Police handed over the newborn to the District Child Welfare Committee. Later, the infant was admitted to the district headquarters



hospital in Keonjhar. The matter came to the fore when a woman identified as Gurubari Munda had gone near the pond to attend nature's call and

heard the baby crying. She rescued her from the bag and brought her back home. Another woman named Dalimba Munda nursed her and informed

the police. It is suspected that someone might have placed the baby inside the bag, zipped it up and left it there, Turumunga IIC Dharmendra Shanti said.

Mayurbhanj: 35-year-old man sentenced to 20 years in jail for raping teen


Baripada (KCN): A 35-year-old man was sentenced to 20 years in jail by a court in Odisha's Mayurbhanj district for raping a teenage girl. The fast-track court of special judge Santosh Kumar Nayak sentenced the convict to jail and also imposed a fine of Rs 50,000 on him, Special Public Prosecutor



Manoranjana Pattnaik said. The court directed the District Legal Services Authority to pay a compensation of Rs

50,000 to the victim, he said. On the night of July 8, 2017, the convict and another man forcibly took the 15-year-old girl to a nearby forest while she was sleeping with her grandmother and gang-raped her, according to the prosecution. The girl was rescued by

villagers, and the police were informed, following which a case was registered at the Bisoi police station. One of the accused was arrested, while the other remained absconding. The arrested accused was convicted on the basis of the statements of the victim, 18 witnesses and the medical report.

Taijul throws his hat in the ring for Test captaincy

New Delhi, (KCN): Bangladesh experienced left-arm spinner Taijul Islam said on Monday that he is fully prepared to take up Test captaincy after playing international cricket for 10 years. The question was raised after Cricbuzz recently revealed that current all format skipper Najmul Hossain is not willing to lead the side after the ongoing home series against South Africa. It was understandable that the team management did not send Najmul for the pre-series presser to ensure the topic doesn't come up during the course of the series. Najmul is waiting to have a conversation with BCB president Faruque Ahmed to make a final

call as he was appointed as the all format skipper for one year in February 2024 but different names are cropping as his possible replacement in different formats. Taijul, who insisted that he is not aware whether Najmul wanted to quit from his captaincy post, added his name in the list. "I haven't heard anything on this matter (regarding Najmul quitting from captaincy) It's not part of our role, I'm not fully informed on this," Taijul told reporters at the Zahur Ahmed Chowdhury Stadium on Monday. "Having played for 10 years, I'm fully prepared (for captaincy)," he added. Taijul also admitted that some

players might be affected by the outside noise when asked about the likes of Tamim Iqbal or Shakib Al Hasan deciding to quit in the middle of the series. "This is a team game. The most important thing is that the team remains in good condition. Some players may be affected by outside events, while others can continue their role with calmness," said Taijul. "Personally, I try to stay relaxed and focus on my work. But within a team, I can't say how each person reacts; everyone's mindset is different. We're not involved in management or board meetings," he said. Taijul added that batters need to take more



responsibility against South Africa in the second Test as they are looking to save the series after losing the opening game by seven wickets

in Mirpur. "Our goal remains the same: we'll play to win. As for the match conditions, we'll understand them once the game unfolds. But the

focus will be on playing as a team - whether it's batting, bowling, or fielding. We'll do our best to win," he pointed out. "Every match is an

opportunity. From that perspective, I think this is another chance for the batters. We haven't performed on the level as expected as a team, although some have had individual performances in different matches. If we can build two or three partnerships in a game, and one or two players score a century, our target will be much bigger and everyone's working hard and is fully committed." Taijul said that he can share his knowledge to other cricketers provided they are willing to take his advice while added that they have got high quality spinners in their possession. "(Being a senior player) I can implement things, but

how much someone takes from me, matters - whether as a teammate or the people of my country. I feel that when different situations arise on the field, if a spinner is bowling, for example, field positioning or how to set up a batter, the captain sometimes asks me, and I try to help. "Nayeem's record is quite good. Just because he didn't get wickets in one match doesn't mean he won't perform well in the future. This can happen in a game or two, but he's likely to deliver good performances ahead. Miraz did well against India and Pakistan, and Nayeem has also performed well previously in Chattogram and Mirpur."

New Delhi: Matthew Wade, the Australian wicketkeeper-batter, has retired from international cricket and will join the coaching staff of the national Men's team, Cricket Australia announced on Tuesday. Wade, who made his international debut in October 2011, has featured in 36 Tests, 97 ODIs and 92 T20Is, with his last appearance coming in June 2024 at the T20 World Cup. Speaking of his retirement, Wade said, "I was fully aware my international days were most likely over at the end of the last T20 World Cup. My international retirement and coaching has been a constant conversation with George (Bailey) and

Andrew (McDonald) over the past six months. "Coaching has been on my radar over the last few years and thankfully some great opportunities have come my way, for which I am very grateful and excited. "I will continue to play BBL and the odd franchise league over the summer months but around those commitments as a player I am investing heavily in my coaching. "As my international career closes, I want to thank all of my Australian team mates, staff and coaches. I enjoyed the ride as challenging as it can be at international level. Without good people around me I would have never got as much out of myself as I did.



"I also thank my family, mum, dad and sisters for the countless hours they put in over the years getting me to games and training. "Lastly to Julia and the kids. I can't thank them enough for the sacrifices they have made for me to continue to pursue my dreams. No words can explain how grateful I am to them, none of this would have happened

without their support." He will join Australia's coaching staff for the upcoming T20I series against Pakistan under Andre Borovec and be with the group for the ODI Series which starts in Melbourne next week. He will however continue playing domestic cricket for Tasmania and Hobart Hurricanes in the Big Bash League for at least the next two

summers. Nick Hockley, Cricket Australia CEO, said: "Congratulations to Matthew on what has been a wonderful international career during which his skill and versatility has made him an outstanding performer across all formats. "I'm delighted he will add to his massive contribution by coaching the next generation of stars and also continuing to light up the Big Bash with the Hobart Hurricanes." Ben Oliver, Executive General Manager, High Performance & National Teams, said: "We extend our thanks and congratulations to Matthew on an outstanding international career.

New Delhi, (KCN): Kane Williamson is set to miss the third Test against India, to be played in Mumbai, New Zealand Cricket announced on Tuesday. Williamson, who missed the first two Tests of the series, will not travel to India for the last Test in order to be fully fit for the upcoming home series against England, starting November 28. He has been kept out as a cautious approach to continue his groin injury rehabilitation. "Kane continues to show good signs, but isn't quite ready to jump on a plane and join us," Gary Stead, New Zealand's head coach said. "While things are looking promising, we think the best course of



action is for him to stay in New Zealand and focus on the final part of his rehabilitation so he'll be good to go for England. The England series is still a month away so taking the cautious approach now will ensure he is ready for the first Test in Christchurch."

New Zealand have already won the first two Tests of the ongoing series against India and would look to complete a cleansweep in order to enhance their chances of qualifying for the final of the World Test championship. The third Test begins in Mumbai on Friday.

USA secure nail-biting win over Nepal

New Delhi: After a tumultuous 48 hours which saw them being hammered by 10 wickets by Scotland, the premature exit of their coach and a social media ruckus that ensued, USA finally found something to cheer about after their nail-biting final-over win against Nepal. In pursuit of 287, Shayan Jahangir sizzled with 104 off 97 in a mammoth 161-run stand with Monank Patel (62 off 76). A cruising USA were bamboozled by Kushal Bhurtel's part-time leg spin as he triggered a collapse that saw USA crash from 179 for 2 to 197 for 6. USA were ultimately bailed out by Harmeet Singh's blitz innings of 57 off 44, sharing a 71-run seventh wicket stand with Shadley Van Schalkwyk, who remained unbeaten with a mature 29 off 37. It was eventually down to Shadley and Jasdeep Singh to take USA home after Harmeet's fall in the 48th over. Needing 16 off 11, Jasdeep smoked

Sandeep Lamichhane over deep square leg to calm USA's nerves. Shadley took USA home with an authoritative six down the ground in a statement win. USA reaped instant rewards after promoting Shayan to the top of the order to accommodate in-form Sanjay Krishnamurthy into the eleven at opener Sushant Modani's cost. Sompal Kami sent one thundering into Andries Gous' pads to draw first blood for Nepal in the second over. The early setback did not deter Shayan from moving through the gears in the powerplay. He revelled in his newfound freedom at the top of the order, carting seven boundaries around the ground in the powerplay. Shayan's aggressive route compensated for Monank's vigil, who has been out of form recently. Monank started off with a delectable straight drive off his first delivery but chose to bide his time later in an attempt to find his lost touch. Shayan

nullified 'the Sandeep' threat by attacking the leg spinner from the word go. He unsettled Sandeep by clobbering him for two sixes through the leg side within his first 2 overs. Monank sprung into action with the introduction of Gulsan Jha with a couple of crisp boundaries. Shayan followed Monank to get stuck into Jha and bludgeoned him for two maximums, a booming drive over the deep extra cover fence and a towering pull over the longer boundary. Lalit Rajbanshi finally had Monank's number after a couple of close LBW shouts, but not before the USA captain notched up a resolute half-century and put them on the drivers' seat. Shayan motored his way to his second ODI hundred with a couple of quick boundaries in his 90s. Sandeep's ineffectiveness with the ball forced Nepal to have Bhurtel tweak a few on a wicket that hadn't alarmed the batsmen yet.



Bhurtel's introduction seemingly spiced up the pitch as he deceived Shayan to hole out at deep square leg. Bhurtel's vicious turn on occasions had seemed to sow an element of doubt in the batsmen's mind. Bhurtel had two in two in the 34th over after Milind Kumar pulled one straight to mid wicket and Krishnamurthy failed to read the wrong one to have his stumps clattered. Bhurtel induced an edge off Teja Mukkamalla in the

following over and looked prime to bowl Nepal to a win from a hopeless position. Nepal captain Rohit Paudel ejected Bhurtel out of the attack after his sixth over to introduce offspin from either end against the two left-handers Harmeet and Shadley. With the offies not being as menacing off the wicket as Bhurtel, Harmeet threw caution to the winds by pummelling Dipendra Singh Airee and Paudel with a slew of boundaries

that had USA charging back in the game. Harmeet, who's built a reputation for himself to play some blitz match-winning cameos in the T20Is, showcased his temperament with the bat in the longer white-ball format. He reached his first ODI half-century off 35 deliveries. His atypical muted celebration upon reaching the landmark was almost a reflection of his sights heavily set on the endgame. Karan KC dashed Harmeet's hopes of seeing USA through the finish line as Harmeet misused one after clubbing him for a six the ball before. Earlier in the day, Nepal openers Aasif Sheikh and Anil Sah shared a 98-run opening stand enabled by the ineffectuality of the USA fast bowlers with the new ball. Aasif brought up his 13th half-century with a neat leg glance off Harmeet Singh, striking at little over run a ball. The landmark may have paid the price

of complacency after the landmark as Jasdeep had him caught behind making him chase a wide one outside off. USA's left-arm spin twins had them crawl back into the game by keeping the lid on run scoring. Sah followed Aasif's footsteps as he perished within minutes after notching his half-century off a full toss that caught the toe end of his bat. It took a moment of acrobatic brilliance from Shadley at short cover to end Bhurtel's ordeal off a Kenjige delivery that straightened a bit. Bhurtel trudged back after limping to 11 off 28 deliveries and USA. Aarif Sheikh and Paudel arrested the glut of wickets with a 56-run stand to anchor a rocky Nepal ship. Aarif looked to cut loose and made his intentions clear with an upper cut off Jasdeep that sailed over third. Kenjige came back in his second spell to bait Aarif into

switching to top gear as Aarif skied a sweep shot to deep square leg. Paudel had by now woken up from his slumber after waddling to 13 off 25. He unleashed a series of scoops and sweeps to have Nepal motor along. Kenjige cleaned up the big-hitting Airee in the 43rd over and Shadley nicked off Jha the following over to thwart Nepal surge towards the 280 mark. However, USA couldn't dodge Paudel's pyrotechnics that catapulted Nepal to 48 runs in the final 4 overs with 37 coming off the bat of Paudel. He dismantled Netravalkar with a 21-run over to canter towards his second ODI hundred but fell four agonising runs short after missing a scoop on the final delivery of the innings. A valiant batting effort from the Nepal captain may well have been undone by some of his tactical errors on the field later in the day.
