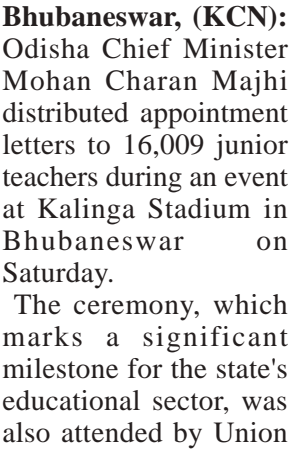


Odisha CM distributes appointment letters to 16009 teachers

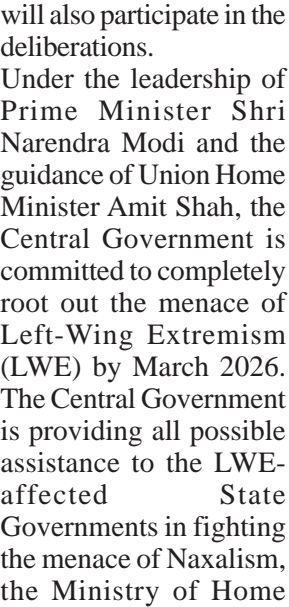

SRK discusses adventure film with Amar Kaushik after King and Pathaan 2: Report

Actor Shah Rukh Khan reportedly wants to squeeze a new-age commercial entertainer into his pipeline between high-octane action movies King and Pathaan 2. He might have just discussed a film with Stree director Amar Kaushik.

Actor Shah Rukh Khan is busy with King and Pathaan 2, two mega action entertainers in his pipeline. Now, a new report suggests that the superstar might just be looking at finalising a rather light-hearted film to squeeze in his lineup between the two biggies. And this new film could just be the one with Stree 2 director Amar Kaushik.

As per a report published in Pinkvilla, the actor has been in talks with the director

and Dinesh Vijan of Maddock Films for an adventure film. While nothing is confirmed yet, the report mentioned that three rounds of discussion have already been done between the two parties.

The report quoted a source close to the actor informing, "Shah Rukh Khan has met almost every filmmaker in the last few months, and heard the ideas they had for him. But nothing really excited him. Now, Shah Rukh Khan is in talks with the Stree 2 team of Amar Kaushik and Dinesh Vijan."

It is believed that Amar and Dinesh are trying to build another successful franchise, this time an adventure-based one. While SRK has not taken a decision yet, more meetings are



expected to take place between him and the film's team. "Amar and Dino have a big-ticket adventure film for SRK, and are exploring the possibilities of a collaboration. It would not be a part of the Stree Universe, but mark the beginning of a new one.

Two to three meetings have taken place, and Shah Rukh Khan is yet to take-a-decision on the same. More discussions are expected to take place in the months to come by, before he takes a call on doing or not doing the film," the source further

said. The report also mentioned that SRK is having a separate discussion with Raj and DK about a comic-action thriller. He reportedly has now got two choices for the film that he's eager to do after wrapping up King and

before beginning Pathaan 2. The superstar was also rumoured to have been in talks with a few South filmmakers for action-based films. However, the bigger emphasis is on having a new-age commercial entertainer. He is expected to make up his mind by the end of this year.

Meanwhile, King, also featuring Suhana Khan and Abhishek Bachchan, is scheduled to go on the floor in January next year, and will wrap up its shooting by mid-2025. He is likely to begin Pathaan 2 by the end of the next year or early 2026. Neither the makers nor the superstar has released any official statement on the news yet.

mean the typical Bollywood masala film rowdy. He is intelligent, witty, knows when to say no, can get things done, disobeys seniors by standing firm on his grit and is unabashedly himself. He surely takes the bigger piece of the cake. Nawazuddin's comic timing, dialogue delivery, and demeanour have always taken him places. Thankfully, that continues in 'Rautu Ka Raaz' too. The film shines, thanks to its stellar star cast.

Grandeur & Glory of Mysore Dasara

Mysore, a name synonymous with the grandeur of Dussehra (locally called Dasara), holds the essence of the festival's rich history. The city, which served as the capital of the erstwhile Kingdom of Mysore from 1399 to 1956, was originally known by its non-Anglicized name, Mysuru—a derivative of "Mahishasurana Uru," meaning the town of Mahishasura. In 2024, Mysore Dasara will mark its 414th anniversary. This 10-day celebration, renowned for its magnificence, attracts tourists from across the globe, making it one of India's most extravagantly celebrated festivals. According to the Hindu calendar, Dasara is observed in the month of Ashvin, which typically falls between mid-September and mid-October in the Gregorian calendar. The festivities commence with Navratri, a nine-night celebration, and culminate on Vijayadashami, the tenth day, with a grand procession. This finale features horses, dancers, displays of swordsmanship, and the idol of Goddess Chamundeshwari (a form of Shakti) carried atop an elephant in a

temple-like structure adorned with 750 kg of gold. Behind the vibrant lights and festivities of Mysore Dasara lies a deep connection to mythology and history, interwoven with tales of a coup and a curse. According to Hindu mythology, the demon king Mahishasura waged war against the gods, empowered by a boon of near-immortality. Unable to defeat him, the gods invoked Goddess Durga (locally known as Chamundeshwari), who rode into battle atop a tiger. After nine days of fierce combat, she ultimately vanquished Mahishasura on the tenth day, a victory celebrated as Vijayadashami. To commemorate the symbolic victory of good over evil, the city of Mysuru has hosted grand Dasara celebrations for over four centuries. The origins of these festivities can be traced back to the 15th century, as detailed in the travelogue of the Italian explorer Niccolò de Conti, who visited Vijayanagara prior to 1420. He described the grandeur of the Dasara celebrations, highlighting the religious and cultural displays, charitable public activities, and even a military parade. However, with the decline of the Vijayanagara Empire and the rise of the Deccan Sultanate, these celebrations temporarily ceased. The revival of the grand Mysore Dasara was marked by the

resurgence of the Wodeyar royal family in 1565. Once securely in power, Raja Wodeyar I reinstated the tradition by organizing grand Dasara celebrations at Srirangapatna, laying the foundation for the rich legacy of Mysore Dasara that continues to this day. The fall of the Vijayanagara Empire paved the way for the Wodeyars' rise to prominence. However, Raja Wodeyar I, intoxicated by power, overthrew the weak Vijayanagara viceroy Tirumalaraja and seized the jewels of his wife,

Alamelamma. In despair, Alamelamma leapt to her death from a cliff overlooking the River Kaveri. Before her death, she cursed the land of Talakadu to become barren, the village of Malangi to be consumed by a whirlpool, and the Wodeyars to be childless. This curse would go on to haunt the Wodeyar dynasty for generations. Two of Alamelamma's curses have materialized. Talakadu, now a revered pilgrimage site, features temples buried under layers of sand. Once in a

bustling city, it now lies completely submerged beneath a vast mound of sand. Furthermore, the Wodeyars have long been affected by her curse, with each alternate generation of the royal family being unable to produce male heirs. The curse's first toll on the dynasty occurred when Raja Wodeyar I lost his only son, Narsaraja. As an act of penance, the grieving king installed a statue of Alamelamma, adorned with her jewels. Each year during Dasara, the Mysore royalty would pray before the statue, seeking forgiveness for

their ancestors. However, the supposed curse was broken when the current rulers of Mysore, Y a d u v e e r KrishnadattaChamaraja Wodeyar and Trishika Kumari, welcomed the birth of a baby boy on December 7, 2017. Mysuru has a long-standing tradition of celebrating the Dasara festival with grandeur and splendor, marking it as Karnataka's state festival, locally referred to as 'Nadahabba.' This 10-day event attracts tourists from around the globe, featuring royal elephant processions, cultural

events, fairs, and other elaborate festivities. During Dasara, the Mysore Palace, the residence of the royal family and the official seat of the Wodeyar dynasty, is illuminated with over 100,000 light bulbs. One of the highlights is the "JambooSavari," an elephant procession where a gilded idol of Goddess Chamundeshwari is paraded through the main streets of Mysore. This is followed by the Torchlight Parade, an awe-inspiring spectacle featuring daring stunts by bikers, artists, and performers, captivating the audience at the Bannimantap Parade Grounds. Another popular attraction is the Dussehra Exhibition, held on the grounds opposite the Royal Palace. The exhibition features stalls offering local delicacies, cosmetics, clothes, and accessories, providing visitors with a taste of the region's vibrant culture. The Mysuru tradition of Dasara celebrates the valiant spirit of warriors and the state's commitment to righteousness. This festival involves the ritualistic worship and ceremonial display of the state sword, weapons, elephants, and horses, alongside the goddess in her warrior form and the avatar of Vishnu, Rama. The ceremonies, including a grand procession, are traditionally presided over by the Maharaja of Mysuru. Durga, often referred to as

Chamundeshwari in local texts, is venerated as the warrior goddess. The festivities historically featured athletic competitions, singing and dancing, fireworks, military parades, and charitable acts of public giving. A key highlight of the celebrations is the special durbar (royal assembly). This tradition was initiated by Krishnaraja Wodeyar III in 1805, when he introduced the practice of holding a durbar at the Mysore Palace during Dasara. The assembly was attended by members of the royal family, special invitees, officials, and the public. Following the passing of Srikanta Wadiyar in December 2013, the 2014 Dasara celebrations were held with the "Pattada Katti" (royal sword) placed on the golden throne. However, since Maharaja Yaduveer KrishnadattaChamaraja Wadiyar's accession to the throne in 2015, he has personally presided over the Dasara celebrations and the royal durbar. On the ninth day of Dasara, known as Mahanavami, the royal sword is worshipped and carried in a grand procession that includes elephants, camels, and horses, symbolizing the royal heritage and martial valor of the kingdom.

Poverty eradication in India

- Rapid growth in population puts pressure on available resources and makes it challenging to achieve sustainable development. As a result, high levels of unemployment and limited access to essential services contribute to high poverty rates.

Recently, Prime Minister Narendra Modi mentioned poverty in his address to the United Nations. He said that in the ten-year tenure of our government, about 25 crore people have come out of the poverty line, which has improved their lives. After this statement of PM Modi, discussion has once again started on poverty in India and the world. Actually, there is a need to understand poverty and its causes in detail. Only after this can poverty removal measures be made effective. Poverty in India is a complex and multidimensional issue, which is influenced by a combination of historical, economic, social and political factors. According to the GDP of Indian states in the year 2023-24, Maharashtra is the richest state. At the same time, Bihar is

considered the poorest state. According to the latest report of NITI Aayog, about 24.82 crore Indians have come out of multidimensional poverty in the last nine years. Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan recorded the largest decline in multidimensional poverty, claiming to lift about 13.88 crore people out of poverty. The report points to a 17.89 per cent decline in multidimensional poverty over the last nine years, as the number of people living in this condition rose from 29.17 per cent in 2013-14 to 11.28 per cent (about 15.5 crore Indians) in 2022-23. The global Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) uses three broad dimensions: health, education and standard of living to measure the level and intensity of poverty. The United Nations Development Programme has used this methodology to determine poverty levels in more than 100 developing countries. India has added two new parameters maternal health and bank accounts

under the dimensions of health and standard of living in its national MPI. Every household in India is scored based on these 12 parameters. If the deprivation score of a household is more than 33 percent, it is identified as multidimensional poor. The NITI Aayog report shows that India is likely to achieve target 1.2 of its Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which aims to halve multidimensional poverty by the year 2030. The report emphasizes that government programs such as Poshan Abhiyaan, Ujjwala Yojana, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana have contributed significantly to reducing multidimensional poverty. According to research by the State Bank of India released in February 2024, the poverty rate in the country fell to 4.5-5 percent in 2022-23. Based on data from the Household research has attributed this decline to government programs launched for the bottom of the pyramid. Data from the Household Consumption Expenditure Survey shows that rural poverty has declined from 25.7 percent in 2011-12 to

7.2 percent and urban poverty has come down by 4.6 percent from a decade ago. According to SBI researchers, the new poverty lines were Rs 1,622 and Rs 1,929 for rural and urban areas, respectively. These figures were calculated based on the recommendations of a group of experts headed by Suresh Tendulkar, who had set the poverty line in 2011-12. The Multidimensional Poverty Index 2023 report says that more than a third of all poor people in the world live in South Asia, which is about 389 million people. India contributes significantly to this number, accounting for about 70 percent of the increase in extreme poverty. The World Bank defines poverty based on the international poverty line, according to which extreme poverty is set at \$2.15 per person per day, while \$3.65 falls in the lower-middle income category and \$6.85 is classified in the upper-middle income category. Considering the poverty line set at \$3.65, India's contribution is equivalent to 40 per cent with a

marginal increase in the global poverty rate from 23.6 per cent to 24.1 percent. If we talk on the basis of historical facts, the British economic policy in India had a profound negative impact on the Indian economy, which was one of the major reasons behind the high rate of poverty in India. Many scholars have discussed the economic exploitation or plunder of India during the British colonial rule. They point to various mechanisms through which India's wealth was extracted, including heavy taxation, discriminatory trade policies, and extraction of resources. Dadabhai Naoroji, a strong critic of British economic policy in India, explained the financial exploitation of India under British colonial rule through the Drain Theory. According to Naoroji, the economic surplus generated in India was sent to Britain, impoverishing the Indian economy. This drain took various forms, including remittance of profits to Britain, high salaries for British officials in India, and payments for goods and services imported

from Britain. Many renowned economists and leaders have elaborated on the root causes of the high poverty rate in the country. Nobel Prize-winning economist Amartya Sen has stressed the importance of eliminating social inequalities and investing in education and healthcare to tackle poverty and sustain economic growth in India. Experts believe that the Indian economy is heavily dependent on the export of primary commodities, which is a legacy of the colonial economic structure. This makes the economy vulnerable to external market fluctuations. At the same time, social inequalities, which are often exacerbated by historical factors such as the caste system or ethnic divisions, cause persistent poverty in India. Discrimination limits access to education, employment and other opportunities for marginalized groups. Rapid growth in population puts pressure on available resources and makes it challenging to achieve sustainable development. This results

in high levels of unemployment and limited access to essential services, which contribute to high poverty rates in India. It is worth mentioning that like China, India is also one of the most populous countries in the world. Some experts also believe that the reasons for increasing poverty in India also include global economic dynamics including trade imbalance and debt burden. Unfavourable terms of trade and economic policies implemented by powerful countries hinder local development efforts. This affects the country's economic system, which proves helpful in increasing poverty. The causes of poverty in India also include high population density, low literacy rate, inadequate infrastructure, ineffective governance and limited industrial development. The government has assessed the improvement in poverty on the basis of criteria such as better education, health and lifestyle. This also includes facts like child nutrition, mortality rate, maternal health, schooling, school

attendance, cooking fuel, sanitation, drinking water, electricity, house, property and bank account. Certainly, work has been done to remove poverty in every government. Whether it is Manmohan Singh's government or Narendra Modi's, the country has played an important role in removing people from poverty and improving their standard of living. However, these efforts cannot be called completely successful, because efforts are still needed on a very large scale. For this, along with the government, social organizations, NGOs and even the common man need to work towards poverty eradication at their own level. Only with the continuous efforts of everyone will we be able to eradicate poverty from the country and achieve the goal of a developed India.

Training Program to Improve Skills of Fish Farmers of Patna District, Bihar



KOLKATA, (KCN): ICAR-Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute (CIFRI) in Barrackpore conducted a seven-day training program from 26 September to 02 October 2024, on "Inland Fisheries Management" to improve the skills and competencies of 30 fish farmers from Patna district, Bihar. The training program aimed to deepen their understanding of various aspects of inland fisheries management to promote sustainable fish production and livelihoods. During interaction, Dr. B. K. Das, Director of the Institute encouraged participants to expand their knowledge to ensure sustainable practices. He urged the farmers to apply scientific insights to explore the potential of inland water resources

for increased productivity. The training included sessions on water quality management, construction and management of nursery and rearing ponds, enclosure culture for livelihood enhancement, induced breeding, hatchery management, transportation of live fish seed, ornamental fish rearing, and economic analysis of various rearing systems. 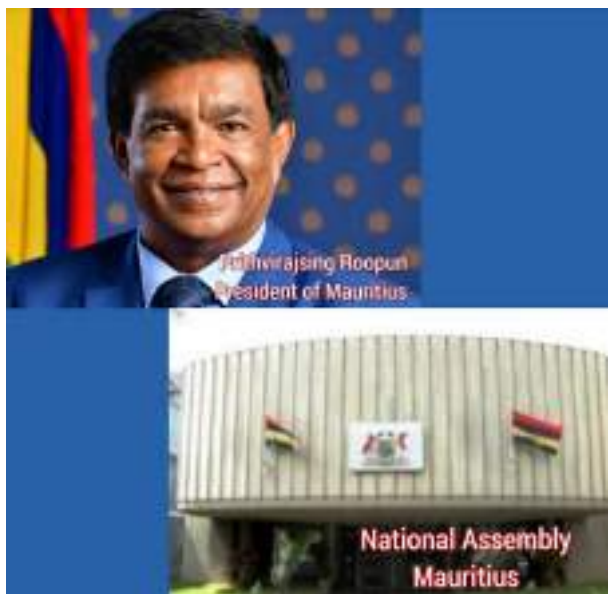

Disposal of Plastic waste is critical problem in Waste Management & seriously affecting human lives

Kolkata, (PARTHA ROY): Plastic waste management is emerging as global challenge in socio-economic evolution of humanity on the planet Earth. Single-use plastics, designed for convenience and temporary use, have become a major contributor to the world's plastic pollution crisis. These non-biodegradable items, used for mere minutes, persist in the environment for hundreds of years, harming ecosystems, wildlife, and human health. Bharat Chamber of Commerce (BCC) and Bharat Chamber Ladies Forum (BCLF) organised a Talk on "Single-use Plastic Ban and Waste Management" by Dr. Rajesh Kumar

IPS, Member Secretary, West Bengal Pollution Control Board and Principal Secretary Department of Environment, Government of West Bengal at Bharat Chamber premises in Kolkata on 4th October 2024. Single-Use Plastics is having devastating impact on Waste Management and the Environment. Single-use plastics account for 50-80% of municipal solid waste. Only 9% of plastic waste is recycled globally. Management of single-use plastics waste is one of the critical challenge for local governments. Over 8 million tons of plastic waste enter oceans annually, harming marine life. Microplastics contaminate waterways,



soil, and air. Plastic production contributes to greenhouse gas emissions and has serious impact on climate change.

Plastic waste harms animals when animals eat it as it cause ingestion and harms ecosystems. Microplastics causes soil pollution and affect

agricultural productivity and food security. Common Single-Use Plastics are: Plastic bags, Water bottles, Straws, Cutlery,

Cups, Packaging materials. Dr. Rajesh Kumar during his address stressed that disposal of single use plastic waste is critical

challenge. Dr. Kumar suggested need for developing recycling economy and business model by pricing "disposable single-use plastic waste". Dr. Kumar mentioned e-waste is another major problem in the society. Negative impacts of single-use plastic can be minimised by avoiding single use plastic, opting for reusable eco-friendly bio-degradable alternatives, inspire behavioral change, developing wide spread recycling infrastructure. Shri Rajkumar Aggarwal Vice President BCC in his welcome address mentioned about recent amendments to the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, through the Plastic Waste Management

(Amendment) Rules, 2024. These changes signify a significant effort to address plastic pollution in India including West Bengal, particularly by targeting microplastics and setting stricter criteria for biodegradable plastics. Amongst the eminent attendees present were Shri Narayan P. Jain, National President All India Federation of Tax Practitioners, Shri O. P. Jhunjhunwala, President of Concern for Calcutta. Smt Renuka Shah Chairperson (BCLF) introduced Dr. Rajesh Kumar. Smt. Shivani Binrajka member (BCLF) while delivering vote of thanks called for multi-dimensional efforts for effective single-use plastic waste management.

Controversies galore in Binayak Residential College

Bhawanipatna(KCN): A private residential college near Medinipur under this block in Kalahandi district has been in the news for all the wrong reasons, lately. Binayak Residential College grabbed headlines after a plus two second-year Arts stream student in the college was allegedly subjected to ragging at the hands of his classmates September 29.

The victim, identified as Ankesh Bag, was allegedly pushed by the rogues from the second floor of the four-storied college-cum hostel building of

the college. Ankesh was rescued in a serious condition and admitted to the district headquarters hospital for treatment. He has sustained critical injuries on his waist and legs. The incident sent shockwaves across the state. It assumed serious proportions after a video of the alleged ragging went viral on social media. According to Ankesh, he had been subjected to ragging by his classmates who would beat him up on repeated occasions in the past. On September 29 night,



nine of his classmates thrashed him before pushing him down the second floor of the college building, he said. The principal of the college,

Nalinikanta Dash, has claimed that the anti-ragging cell of the college is conducting a probe into the matter. However, action against the rogue

students is yet to be seen. Nevertheless, the college is no stranger to such controversies. The body of Saswat Mund, a plus two

second-year Science student, had been found under mysterious circumstances at a nullah near the Jaleswar temple in the

area. Questions were raised as to how the authorities allowed the student, residing in the hostel, to go out for bath in the afternoon. The deceased's family members alleged that Saswat had been done to death in a planned way and they lodged a murder complaint at the Town police station. Police questioned Mund's classmates and arrested the Managing Director and the then Principal Trilochan Mohapatra and booked him under Section 304 of Juvenile Justice Act. Mohapatra was

produced in a court and remanded to judicial custody after his bail plea was rejected.

It is alleged that such incidents continue to occur due to alleged negligence, irresponsibility and apathetic attitude of the college authorities. It is also alleged that the college authorities are charging hefty fees from the students at the time of admission, but have failed in providing security to the students as has been proved from these two incidents. Locals have demanded the state Higher Education department intervene and initiate action in this regard.

MV Blackrose sinking still a mystery even after 15 yrs



Paradip(KCN): Though the sinking of MV Blackrose completed 15 years Monday, the event and circumstances leading to the mysterious grounding of the foreign cargo ship in the anchorage area of Paradip port still remain unsolved. And in the absence of any clarity by investigating agencies, the mishap – in which a foreign sailor had died – continues to make waves in the state politics. On September 9, 2009, the China-bound ship ran aground about 6km away from the anchorage area of the Paradip port. The ship remained half-sunk and was visible till 2014. However, it later went completely underwater. The ship's mysterious sinking became an issue during successive Assembly and Lok Sabha elections in the state, with various political parties and outfits demanding a thorough probe into the incident. However, even 15 years later, the Odisha Police Crime Branch, which took over the investigation from the local police, has neither completed the probe nor has it been able to approach the owners of the ship, Se Cook, in Mongolia. According to reports, the incident occurred when iron ore was being loaded onto the ship which had anchored

at the berth of Paradip port September 9, 2009. The vessel was loaded 23,847 metric tonnes of iron ore cargo when its Captain asked to stop further loading. This was because the iron ore was soaked in rainwater, and the heavy cargo made the barge of the ship tilt to one side. However, the port authorities directed the Captain to leave the port as it was a time-consuming exercise to dry up the wet iron ore. It was said that the wet ore could have been dried up on the anchorage area if the port authorities desired so. Significantly, no paperwork was carried out before directing the ship to leave the berth. After the ship moved from its berth, it gradually tilted to one side in the anchorage area, before finally sinking by evening. On being informed, personnel from the Marine Department of Paradip port sent a tug boat which rescued 26, out of 27, sailors of the ship. However, the ship's chief engineer, Oleksandr Liyushchenko, got trapped in the cabin and his body was recovered eight days after the mishap. Ten days after the ship ran aground, 4,200 kilolitre of fuel and 920 metric tonnes of furnace oil leaked from the vessel were found floating on the surface of seawater. Alarmed over

the pollution, the port authorities called in a US-based agency to pump out the remaining fuel from the ship. The port authorities had spent over Rs 40 crore to accomplish the task. The Marine police station at Nehru Bungalow registered a case in this connection and, later, the state Crime Branch took over the probe. In the subsequent period, two petitions were filed in this connection in the Orissa High Court and Calcutta High Court. According to reports, during the Crime Branch probe, it was found that the ship was sailing without a sea-worthiness certificate and was declared unfit for operation after remaining 25- years in sea. The Mercantile Marine Department (MMD) was supposed to conduct a verification of the ship before allowing it for further operations. Questions were also raised as to how the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) allowed the ship to sail from country to country without proper documents for a prolonged period of five years. Moreover, fingers were also raised at the Paradip port authorities who allowed the ship, to

enter into the berth, which had spent over 25 years in sea and lacked fitness and proper documents. The agent of the shipping company was then blacklisted, but it is now back in operation at the port under a different name. Sources said that the iron ore loaded in this ship belonged to three export agencies, and it was headed for China. It is alleged that those export agencies had connections with some politicians of Odisha. The Paradip Port authorities recommended a CBI probe into the incident in 2018, but nothing has happened so far. Moreover, the Centre has yet to summon the owners of the ship, Se Cook, to the country for questioning. Besides, the sunken ship is yet to be retrieved from the sea despite it posing an imminent threat to other ships sailing in the route travelling in the sea. Many fishing boats had close shaves after hitting the sunken ship. Meanwhile, when contacted, Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP), Santosh Jena, said, "The matter is sub-judice. Anyways, the Crime Branch is investigating the case. I am not authorised to speak on the matter."

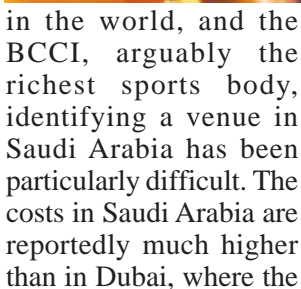

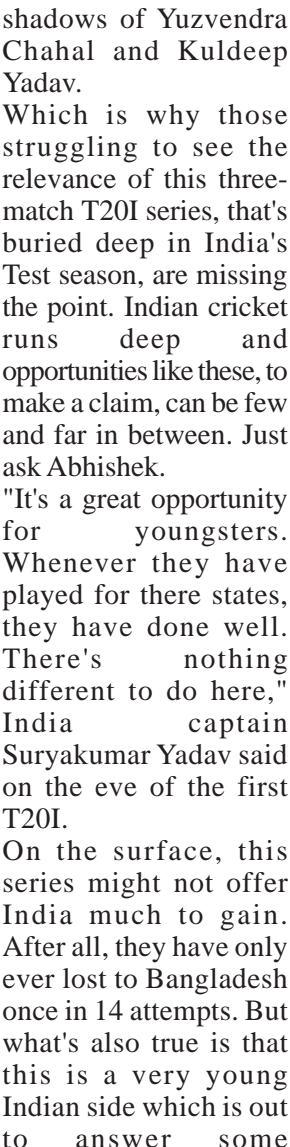

New Delhi: The much-awaited Indian Premier League (IPL) Auction for Season 18 is expected to take place in November, most likely during the third or fourth weekend of the month. The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) has indicated to IPL franchises about this possibility and that the auction will almost certainly be held overseas. Sources within the IPL have revealed to Cricbuzz that, similar to last year, the venue will likely be in the Middle East. Last year's auction took place in Dubai and it wouldn't be surprising if it were held in another Gulf city, Doha or Abu Dhabi for instance. Saudi Arabia, which has been making heavy investments in sports of late, including cricket, is also reportedly interested in hosting the auction. There is no clarity on the venue at this stage. The news has sparked a cautious reaction from IPL franchises, as they are yet

to receive the retention rules ahead of the mega auction. The BCCI has informed them of a potential delay in the announcement of these rules, leaving some franchise officials concerned about whether they will have enough time to adequately prepare for the auction. The retention rules, as recently reported by Cricbuzz, may be announced this month end, which means the teams will have two months to do the plan for the auction. The deadline for the teams to announce their retentions is expected to be around November 15. The BCCI and IPL authorities have always wanted to hold the auction overseas, though they only succeeded in doing so last year (December 2023). At different stages in previous seasons, there were plans to host the auction in London while Istanbul was also considered as a potential

venue. Meanwhile, it is understood that coaches who worked under Rahul Dravid with the Indian team are likely to find positions with various IPL franchises. Vikram Rathour, India's former batting coach, may join Dravid at Rajasthan Royals, replacing Trevor Penney, who could be assigned to the Royals CPL team, Barbados Royals. Paras Mhambrey, India's former bowling coach under Dravid, is also expected to join a franchise although nothing seems to have been finalized so far. It is learnt that these former coaches have declined commentary offers, expressing their preference for coaching roles. Additionally, Munaf Patel, former India pace and 2011 World Cup winner, is expected to take up an IPL coaching assignment this season.
