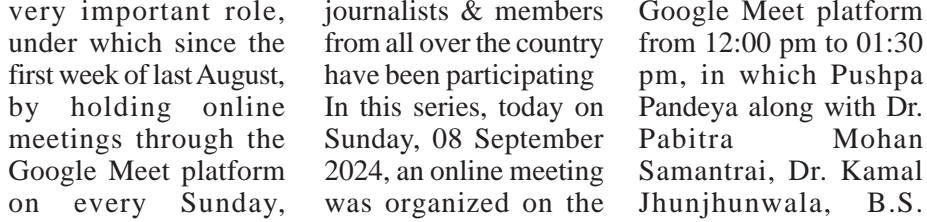

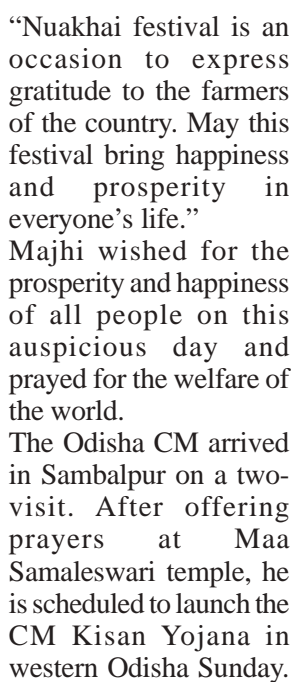

AIP Slams National Conference for Hypocrisy, Releases Election Manifesto

Srinagar (Aasif Malik):Awami Itihaad Party (AIP), under the leadership of jailed leader Engineer Rashid, launched a fierce verbal offensive against the National Conference (NC) today, condemning it for hypocrisy and failing the people of Jammu and Kashmir. In a highly charged press conference, AIP Chief Spokesman Inam Un Nabi, alongside prominent leaders such as Sheikh Ashiq, former J&K Chamber and Commerce leader, Gazanfar Ali, ex-DC Shopian, and Former High Court Bar Association General Secretary Advocate GN Shaheen, took aim at NC's so-called "double standards" and lack of genuine leadership. Inam Un Nabi denounced NC's Omar Abdullah, accusing him of living in a bubble of comfort while Engineer Rashid and countless

others suffer in jail. "Soon after the abrogation of Article 370, Omar Abdullah was in safe custody, treated with five-star luxuries, while true leaders like Engineer Rashid have been subjected to real hardship for the last five years," Inam declared. He accused Abdullah of distorting the truth and twisting facts to deceive the public. "It is outrageous that Abdullah accuses 'Kuch Shakhas' (some people) of plotting against him from jail—this is not just a lie, it's a blatant insult to all those Kashmiris languishing in jails across the country," he added. Inam went on to expose the stark difference between Engineer Rashid's service as MLA for Langate and the deep-rooted corruption and misgovernance in NC-dominated constituencies, which he described as "black holes of development."



According to him, "Langate stood as a beacon of pro-people politics under Rashid, while NC constituencies were buried under incompetence and nepotism." Taking a strong swipe at Omar Abdullah's campaign antics, Inam condemned his theatrics as undignified, particularly his act of removing his cap to ask for votes. "This is a cheap political stunt from someone who has lost touch with the ground realities," he remarked. AIP also unveiled its much-awaited manifesto during the press conference,

vowing to fight for the restoration of Article 370, secure job and land rights for J&K's people, and ensure the holistic development of all regions. The manifesto lays out plans to combat unemployment, drug addiction, and address the welfare of daily wage workers, while promising to turn Kashmir into a "jail-free" state. Among its key pledges are the rehabilitation of divided families across borders, improving healthcare access, and

making education more inclusive. The party also stressed its commitment to reviewing the wrongful termination of government employees and fighting for the restoration of the University of Kashmir's autonomy. The manifesto calls for

the immediate and unconditional release of all prisoners, including those held under the draconian Public Safety Act (PSA) and Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA). It also promises to reintroduce the Darbar Move, which was scrapped by the current administration, and place a complete ban on the sale of liquor. "The people of Jammu and Kashmir are awake now, and NC's days of fooling them are over," Inam asserted, expressing confidence that AIP will lead the charge against the anti-people politics of parties like NC. Despite Engineer Rashid's imprisonment,

the AIP remains determined to contest the upcoming elections, vowing to bring about real change and represent the true voice of the people. Meanwhile, AIP announced a fresh list of seven candidates from North Kashmir for the forthcoming assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir. AIP's Political Affairs Committee (PAC) has recommended and approved the mandate of Er. Muneer Khan for Uri Constituency, Mohammad Muzaffar Dar for Rafiabad Constituency, Adv. Mursaleen for Sopore Constituency, Peerzada

Firdous for Kupwara Constituency, Adil Nazir Khan for Gulmarg Constituency, Khursheed Ahmad Sheikh for Langate Constituency, Abdul Majid Bandy for Handwara Constituency, Ashok Kumar Raina for Chamb (Jammu) Constituency. Meanwhile Prominent Activist from Khansahib Er. Sheikh Jehangeer joined AIP and will be AIP candidate from Khansahib. Another candidate Mohammad Shafi Kankashi from Assembly Constituency Khanyar joined AIP and withdraw his nomination in favour of AIP candidate Parveez Jamwal

CM's response renews hope of Police Commissionerate in Rourkela

Rourkela(KCN): The possibility of Rourkela getting a Police Commissionerate system has become stronger as Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi, who holds the Home portfolio, has said in the Assembly that the government is actively considering the proposal. The Chief Minister was replying to a question posed by Rourkela MLA Sarada Nayak Monday. Nayak also wanted to know the timeline of its implementation along with appointment of a police commissioner. Majhi said, "This proposal is under active consideration." The CM's answer in the House has rekindled the hope of a Commissionerate system in the Steel City – a long standing demand. However, this proposal and the subsequent promise by the successive governments is nothing new. In the last 24 years of BJD rule, it had come up for discussion several



times but there was hardly any decision. Many are of the opinion that an opportunity was lost as the BJD government's tenure ended, though it remained as a matter of discussion only. The issue was put in the back burner until the Rourkela MLA raised the question September 2. Earlier, the proposal came under consideration of the Congress regime when JB Pattnaik was the CM. Then Rourkela MLA late Gurupada

Nanda had raised the issue, taking a cue from an article by Rabi Kanungo, renowned columnist and former editor of an Odia daily. Since then, the issue was being raked up by elected representatives but it continued to remain at discussion level only. There are many arguments that favour a Commissionerate system in Rourkela. First, the city has an independent administrative circle for which it has an additional district magistrate and an SP. Besides, the western

range DIG is stationed here. Also, it is an independent telecom circle. Similarly, many Central and state organisations regard it as an independent circle for better administration. Another important factor is that Rourkela is a sensitive bordering area. Many of the retired officials argue in favour of a Police Commissionerate system in steel city. Suman Dutta, a former police official, said, "It had always been a proposal only but now it may be a reality." Likewise, Bimal Bisi, former SEFI secretary, said, "There is no better news than this for Rourkela; we are waiting for it to happen." Former president of RCCI Subha Pattnaik said, "This is a long standing demand and I am hopeful that it will be fulfilled this time."

Odisha: Sarpanch's kin booked for hurling casteist slurs at PEO

Keonjhar (KCN): Nandipada police Saturday registered an FIR against the elder brother-in-law of Pandado Gram Panchayat sarpanch, under this block in Keonjhar district, for allegedly threatening the Panchayat Executive Officer (PEO), a woman belonging to a Scheduled Tribe (ST), and using casteist slurs. Police said Sasmita Ojha serves as the sarpanch of Pandalo Gram Panchayat where Urmila Murmu works as the PEO. As per Murmu's allegations, Ojha never showed up at the Panchayat office ever



since she was elected, and, instead, conducted all official work from her house. Murmu said when she was returning from Ojha's house, where she had gone for some official work September 4, 2024, the latter's elder brother-in-law, Nikunja

Bihari Ojha, stopped her near a canal. He abused her using casteist slurs and even issued threats for visiting the sarpanch's residence despite being a member of a tribal community. "He also forcibly took away the government files I was carrying," Murmu alleged in the

FIR. She said Nikunja, along with one Surendra Raut, barged into her house and repeated the threats and abuses. Following this, Murmu, along with other members of the Hatadihi PEO association, made a written complaint to the Block Development Officer (BDO), Soumyashree Panigrahi, and also warned to go on a 'pendown' strike if the accused was not arrested immediately. Panigrahi thereafter asked the Nandipada police station to file an FIR and initiate action, September 6.

Producer Ronnie Screwvala on re-releasing 'Swades': It needs its second time around

15. Actions by department: In order to create a credible deterrence a "Whole of Government Approach" will be adopted through co-ordinated efforts and by leveraging technology. It has also been decided that appropriate red flag indicators would be used for identifying shell companies, and a data base of such companies and their Directors would be built by pulling in information from various agencies. The data base will also capture Aadhar number of individual Directors in the companies. It is learnt that a Task Force has been set-up under the Co-chairmanship of the Revenue Secretary and Corporate Affairs Secretary with members from various regulatory Ministries and Enforcement Agencies to monitor the actions taken against deviant shell companies by various agencies. The department has formed a special unit called

Benami Properties Unit (BPU) to identify and probe such assets. 16. Ganpati Dealcom Pvt. Ltd. [2022] 141 taxmann.com 389/289 Taxman 17. Also refer ACIT (Initiating Officer) v. Neopride Pharmaceuticals Ltd [2023] 454 ITR 580 (SC); Banamali Das v. DCIT [2023] 147 taxmann.com 278 (Gauhati); Assistant Commissioner of Income-tax v. Nexus Feeds Ltd. [2023] 147 taxmann.com 176 (SC); Golla Jagadishwar Narendra v. attachment notice as such his act is beyond jurisdiction - Cascade Energy Pte Ltd. v. UOI [2018] 90 taxmann.com 28 (Madras). 18. Important amendments made by the Finance (No.2) Act, 2019 in Prohibition of Benami Property Transactions Act, 1988: These amendments are summarised hereunder: a) Amendment of section 23 to provide that the prior approval of Approving Authority shall not be required where the Initiating Officer has already initiated proceedings by issuing notice u/s 24(1). b) Amendment of section 24 to provide that the period of 90 days in respect of provisional attachment of the property u/s 24(3) and passing of order u/s 24(4) shall be reckoned from the end of the month in which the notice u/s 24(1) is issued. c) Amendment of section 24 and section 26 to provide for exclusion of the period during which the proceedings are stayed by the Court and allowing adequate time to pass the order or make the reference. d) Amendment of section 46 to provide for appeal before the Appellate Tribunal against the order passed by the authority u/s 54A, within

a period of 45 days from the date of order. e) Amendment of section 47 to provide for rectification of any mistake apparent on the face of the record by the Appellate Tribunal or any authority within a period of one year from the end of the month in which such order was passed. f) Insertion of section 54A to provide for to provide for levy of penalty of Rs.25,000 for failure to comply with the summons issued or to furnish information u/s 19 or section 21 respectively of the PBPT Act. g) Insertion of section 54B to provide for proof of entries in records/documents in any proceedings for the prosecution either by production of the records or other documents in the custody of the authority containing such entries or by the production of copy of the entries certified by the authority having custody of the record or other documents under its signature stating that it is a true copy of the original entries and that such original entries are contained in the records or other documents in its custody. h) Amendment of section 55 to provide for no prosecution shall be instituted against any person in respect of any offence without the previous sanction of the competent authority. 19. Onus to establish that a transaction is

benami: Apex Court in the case of Fair Communication & Consultants v. Surendra Kardile [2020] 113 taxmann.com 377 (SC) held that onus of establishing that a transaction is benami is upon one who asserts it. 20. Adjudicating Authority: The Finance Act, 2021 has substituted section 7 to prescribe that the competent authority authorized u/s 5(1) of the Smugglers and Foreign Exchange Manipulators (Forfeiture of Property) Act, 1976 shall be the Adjudicating Authority to exercise jurisdiction, powers and authority conferred by or under the PBPT Act, 1988. 21. Whether proceedings under Benami transactions can be initiated after 10 years of acquisition of property: In the case of Kalyan Buildmart (P.) Ltd. v. Initiating Officer [2021] 131 taxmann.com 99 (Rajasthan) [06-10-2021] it was held that the proceedings initiated after 10 years of the purchase of the property are highly belated. Ordinarily, any proceeding relating to benami transactions ought to be taken up immediately or at least within reasonable period of limitation of 3 years as generally provided under the Limitation Act, 1963.

22. Whether a company can be treated as Benamidar of its shareholder where it has purchased the property in its own name: Purchase of property by a company in its own name with share capital money cannot be said to be a benami transaction on the basis that it is a purchase of property in company's name with consideration provided by others (shareholders) since share capital contributions received by a company from its shareholders are company's own funds and assets; hence company cannot be treated as benamidar of its shareholders in respect of property held in its name. The benami transaction would require one transaction made by one person in the name of another person where the funds are owned and paid by the first person to the seller while seller gets registered sale deed executed in favour of the second person i.e. from account of 'A', the amount is paid to 'C' who sells the property to 'B' and a registered sale deed is executed in favour of 'B'. Purchase of property by a company in its own name would not come within the purview of benami transaction because the funds of the company are its own assets. If promoters of the company namely, the

shareholders, their relatives or individuals who invest in the company by way of gift or in any other manner, then such amounts/monies received, would be part of the net worth of the company and the company would be entitled to invest in any sector for which it has been formed. The transactions of the company are independent transactions which are only for the purpose of benefit of the company alone. It is a different aspect altogether that on account of benefit accruing to the company, the shareholders would also receive benefit and they may be beneficiaries to a certain extent. This would however not make shareholders as beneficial owners in terms of the definition as provided under Section 2(12) of the Benami Act, 1988. 'Company' as defined under the Companies Act, 1956 and incorporated thereunder, therefore, cannot be treated as benamidar as defined under the Benami Act, 1988 - Kalyan Buildmart (P.) Ltd. v. Initiating Officer [2021] 131 taxmann.com 99 (Rajasthan) [06-10-2021].

Pastor, Wanted In US For Child Sex Trafficking, Arrested In Philippines

Manila (KCN): The Philippines said Sunday it had arrested a pastor wanted in the United States for child sex trafficking, two weeks into a massive police manhunt for the self-proclaimed “Appointed Son of God”. Apollo Quiboloy, who has close relations with former president Rodrigo Duterte, is the founder of the Philippines-based Kingdom of Jesus Christ (KOJC) church that claims millions of members. He was charged by the US Justice Department in 2021 with sex trafficking of girls and women between the ages of 12 and 25 to work as personal assistants, or “pastorals”, who were allegedly required to have sex with him. “Apollo Quiboloy has been arrested,” Interior Secretary Benjamin Abalos said on his official Facebook page. Quiboloy is also sought for cash smuggling and a scheme that brought church members to the US using fraudulently obtained visas. They were then forced to



solicit donations for a bogus charity, raising funds that were instead used to finance church operations and the lavish lifestyles of its leaders, according to the FBI. It is not known if the US has sought extradition for Quiboloy, aged at least 74 according to the US Federal Bureau of Investigation. A US embassy spokesman referred media queries to the Philippine authorities. The politically connected pastor has also been charged with human trafficking in a Philippine court. - ‘Concerted effort’ - Brigadier-General Nicolas Torre, the regional police

chief who led the manhunt, confirmed the arrest at a news conference, but did not provide additional details. “This is a concerted effort of everyone involved,” Torre told reporters. “Let’s be proud. We did our job today.” During his months-long flight from justice, Quiboloy demanded a written guarantee from Manila that he would not be subject to “extraordinary rendition” as a condition for his surrender. The term refers to a US government practice of sending detained suspected members of terror organisations to another country for

imprisonment and interrogation. Some 2,000 police were deployed at the KOJC headquarters in the southern city of Davao on August 24 to serve an arrest warrant against Quiboloy. Duterte and his daughter -- incumbent Vice President Sara Duterte who has had a falling out with President Ferdinand Marcos -- had publicly criticised the police raid of the sect’s 30-hectare (70-acre) property as they searched for Quiboloy. Minutes after Quiboloy’s arrest was announced, SMNI, a Philippine television station run by his sect, posted on its Facebook page pictures of members embracing uniformed police officers. “After all the pains and struggles, it is evident that the KOJC missionaries have embraced Pastor Apollo Quiboloy’s teaching to love not only their neighbours but even their enemies,” it said in a message accompanying the photos.

Senior BJD leader calls for introspection in party after two party MPs quit party to join BJP

Bhubaneswar(KCN): With two Rajya Sabha MPs of opposition Biju Janata Dal quitting the party within one month and joining the BJP, a leader of the regional outfit called for introspection in the party while others claimed that it will have no impact on the BJD. The resignation of Mamata Mohanta and Sujeet Kumar from the BJD and joining the BJP, has come as a major blow for the regional outfit which ruled Odisha for 24-years. With the resignation of Mohanata and Kumar, BJD — which has no member in the Lok Sabha

for the first time since its inception in 1997 — now has seven MPs in the Rajya Sabha. Odisha has 10 Raja Sabha seats of which earlier 9 were with BJD and one BJP's Ashwini Vaishnaw was elected to the Upper House of Parliament with the support of the BJD. The seven BJD Rajya Sabha MPs are — Sulata Deo, Sasmit Patra, Manas Mangaraj, Niranjana Bishi, Munna Khan, Debasish Samantray and Subhashish Khuntia. Senior BJD leader and former minister Amar Satpathy called for introspection in the party following the resignation of the two MPs.



"If any ordinary member quits the party, it may not have any impact, If an MP quits, it changes the situation. Therefore, we need an introspection and take measures

accordingly," Satpathy said. With speculation rife that more BJD MPs may join the BJP, BJD Raja Sabha MP Manas Mangaraj claimed that

all BJD MPs are behind Naveen Patnaik. "... We will always stand by Naveen Patnaik and BJD through thick and thin. At the same time, people will never accept

the way @BJP4India is undemocratically poaching elected lawmakers of other parties to boost its own numbers. This is sheer murder of democracy", Mangaraj posed on X. Mangaraj described Kumar's resignation as "unfortunate and betrayal of trust". "You (Kumar) only know how much trust our beloved leader Naveen Patnaik reposed in you. You got everything from him. BJD honoured and rewarded you always. But, the way you deserted the party at this crucial juncture and joined another, really pained us. We, at BJD as well as the

people of Kalahandi feel let down," Mangaraj said. "The BJP has already taken two wickets in a span of one month. One should not be surprised if it attracts more Rajya Sabha MPs from the BJD," said political analyst Braja Kishore Mishra. Asked whether the BJP has contacted him, Niranjana Bishi said: "I am not in touch with any BJP leader. The people who have quit the BJD, have gone for their self-interest." BJD MP Sulata Deo also claimed that the BJD's Parliamentary Party is intact. Meanwhile, Mohanta

Saturday claimed that there was possibility of further influx from BJD as there are many disgruntled elements in the Naveen Patnaik-led regional party. Mohanta recently quit the BJD and subsequently became a Rajya Sabha member of the BJP. "There are many leaders feeling suffocated in the BJD and some of them may quit the regional party like me and Sujeet Kumar in the future," Mohanta said. BJD's Chief Whip in the Assembly Pramila Mallik claimed that Kumar and Mohanta's resignation will have no impact on the BJD.

Keonjhar: Row over salary advance to DMF casual workers



Keonjhar(KCN): Despite repeated complaints of irregularities, the alleged misappropriation of District Mineral Foundation (DMF) funds in Keonjhar district continues unabated, a source said. The ruling as well as Opposition parties have expressed concern over the state of affairs and lack of action in this regard. In the latest instance, ₹1.70 crore has allegedly been paid towards salary advance to DMF casual employees in the district in gross violation of established norms, a report said. According to reports, casual workers from outside of the district are being hired by the DMF to manage its day to day affairs. Moreover, the salary advance to them has sparked resentment in the district. The matter came to the fore in a reply received under the Right to Information Act (RTI) in response to an application filed by activist Subhakanta Nayak. What came as a

surprise was the fact that these casual employees had been paid advance salary for three years totaling ₹1, 70, 55,720, though they draw high salary from DMF. Sources said that the DMF operates out of a government building as it does not have its own office (project management unit (PMU)) in the district. The foundation has outsourced its hiring to a private agency. It is alleged that work/business transactions worth of thousands of crores are being made through the casual workers without any pre-conditions or guarantee. As many as 12 workers are posted at the PMU, while over 400 are posted in various blocks as well as departments for the DMF fund works. These workers are paid ₹17, 59,500 cumulatively towards their salary every month. Notably, five more persons were engaged at the PMU and the monthly salary allegedly increased to around ₹50 lakh. However, all the staff

was paid the salary advance. However, the government employees posted at the PMU work with less salary though they are made accountable for their performance. The disparity makes the government staff feel let down. The casual employees are appointed by an outsourcing agency. They do not abide by any service condition and, thereby, lack any accountability. It is alleged that the 'outside' recruits often facilitate the appointment of their kin, or known persons, while neglecting local youths. It is also alleged that the son of a former official has got an appointment in DMF in Sundargarh district at a high salary. Sources meanwhile, said that a small proportion of their advanced salary is debited from their salary every month. The payment of advanced salary is a blatant misutilisation of DMF funds for which the DMF has been loses interest which it gets

from its deposits in banks. Under these circumstances, questions have also been raised about the compensation to DMF in the event any casual worker, who has received advance salary, quits job and joins elsewhere. Nayak meanwhile, has demanded a thorough probe into and action against the irregularities and recovery of the bank interest which the DMF has lost so far. The RTI activist has also written to the chief minister and chief secretary, demanding an impartial probe into these irregularities. When contacted, chief development officer, Zilla Parishad cum-chief executive officer, DMF Nagbhushan Mishra said he is not aware of the salary advance to casual employees, "but regular audit of the funds is being carried out". "It is true that outsourcing agencies, and not employment exchange, hire candidates for appointment as field staff," he added.



Odisha: Sarpanch's kin booked for hurling casteist slurs at PEO

Keonjhar(KCN): Nandipada police Saturday registered an FIR against the elder brother-in-law of Pandado Gram Panchayat sarpanch, under this block in Keonjhar district, for allegedly threatening the Panchayat Executive Officer (PEO), a woman belonging to a Scheduled Tribe (ST), and using casteist slurs. Police said Sasmita Ojha serves as the sarpanch of

Pandalo Gram Panchayat where Urmila Murmu works as the PEO. As per Murmu's allegations, Ojha never showed up at the Panchayat office ever since she was elected, and, instead, conducted all official work from her house. Murmu said when she was returning from Ojha's house, where she had gone for some official work September 4, 2024, the latter's elder brother-in-law, Nikunja Bihari Ojha,

stopped her near a canal. He abused her using casteist slurs and even issued threats for visiting the sarpanch's residence despite being a member of a tribal community. "He also forcibly took away the government files I was carrying," Murmu alleged in the FIR. She said Nikunja, along with one Surendra Raut, barged into her house and repeated the threats and abuses.

Following this, Murmu, along with other members of the Hatadihi PEO association, made a written complaint to the Block Development Officer (BDO), Soumyashree Panigrahi, and also warned to go on a 'pendown' strike if the accused was not arrested immediately. Panigrahi thereafter asked the Nandipada police station to file an FIR and initiate action, September 6.
