

As BJD has 29 MPs -- 20 in Lok Sabha and 9 in Rajya Sabha -- besides 117 MLAs in the Odisha Assembly, Naveen holds a key to the outcome of the Presidential election.

However, there is another option. As in the last time, BJD may field a candidate who may be supported by all non-BJP parties including Congress.

Naveen, insiders say, does not agree to support the Congress candidate directly. If this happens, BJP will go on saying that Naveen joined hands with Congress. However, if Congress joins hands with Naveen, BJD will have an opportunity to tell people that Naveen did not support Congress, but Congress supported the candidate fielded by BJD.

However, now all eyes are set on the next move of Naveen. The Odisha Chief Minister is on a five-day tour to the national capital. During the time, he may take a decision on what to do in regard to the Presidential elections. But, like others, he also feels that BJP's march needs to be stopped.

Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar has meanwhile met Congress President Sonia Gandhi. Dilli Durbar is presently active over the Presidential elections. Therefore, Naveen's second visit to Delhi in a month sparks speculations in media and political circles. He may take a decision.

During his previous tour, Naveen had told media at Delhi that he would take a decision after BJP announces a candidate for the Presidential elections as to who will occupy Raisina Hills. However, it appears that all eyes are on Naveen's next move.

stances, Naveen has a specific problem which neither Mamata nor Nitish Kumar has. The Odisha Chief Minister since 2009 has been claiming to have maintained equal distance from both Congress and BJP. "The drone hit next to the room where al-Zawahiri was staying. The shared wall collapsed, and debris from the explosion showered on him and broke his glasses, but luckily he was safe," the unnamed man told the magazine.

The man added that "four of al-Zawahiri's security guards were killed on the spot and one was injured but died later." He said al-Zawahiri had "left the targeted room to

This has also resulted in increased FDI into India. Recent restrictions on foreign portfolio investment, which came into effect from April 1, 2017, may also force foreign investors to eye the FDI route," said V K Vijayakumar, chief investment strategist, Geojit Financial Services.

"It is easy to impressive strides in terms of economic growth and poverty reduction.

**H-1B visa issue: Arun Jaitley may take it up with US authorities**

**New Delhi (KCN):** India may take up the work visa issue with US authorities during the visit of finance minister Arun Jaitley to the US. Jaitley on Wednesday indicated that he would take up the visa issue with the US authorities during his visit. "These (IT industry issues) are matters of discussion with the appropriate authorities there. Once I do discuss and get an opportunity, I will let you know," he told reporters when asked whether he would take up the concerns of the Indian IT sector with the US administration.

The Indian IT industry has expressed concerns over the US government's clampdown on the rules for H-1B visa, which is primarily used by domestic IT professionals for short-term work. US President Donald Trump has signed an executive order for tightening the rules of the H-1B visa programme to stop its "abuse" and ensure that the visas are given to the "most-skilled or highest paid" petitioners.

Jaitley was scheduled to leave on a five-day visit to the United States on Wednesday night to attend the Spring Meetings of the World Bank and IMF as well as deliberations of G20 nations. During his stay in Washington and New York, he will hold meetings with American CEOs and institutional and pension fund investors, where he will pitch India as a favourable investment destination. The finance minister is also slated to hold a meeting with the US Treasury Secretary.

Industry body Nasscom warned that the US' move to replace the lottery system for issuing H-1B work visas with a merit-based approach could have "unintended consequences" even as it sought to downplay any immediate impact on IT companies this year. "No new changes are being implemented immediately... Nothing is being proposed that would impact or change the FY18 H-1B lottery that is currently underway," Nasscom said in a statement on Wednesday. The proposed changes are forward-looking and non-specific, it contended.
