Bhubaneswar(KCN): Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik today urged Railway Minister Suresh Prabhu to introduce a Daily AC Express train service between Mumbai and Puri/Khurda Road via Sambalpur.

And he has also urged to increase the frequency of the existing weekly trains so as to cover all days of the week as demand is growing and people needs more train services between Odisha and Mumbai.

Chief Minister also referred to an earlier missive, in which he had sought a Humsafar type AC Express train from Khurda Road to Mumbai in the name of 'Buxi Jagabandhu' as a tribute to the legendary freedom fighter who had led the Paika rebellion of 1817. Mr.Patnaik said that Mumbai is not well connected by trains with Odisha. "As you know, Odisha

is famous as epicentre of cultural heritage with Puri being one of the celebrated pilgrimage centres, whereas

different sectors in Mumbai depend on the railways for their journey, a large number of visitors from



Mumbai is the commercial capital of the country." There are enough reasons for both the places to connect with each other socially, economically and spiritually, Chief Minister said. While scores of people from Odisha who work in

Maharashtra visit Odisha regularly, he said. "Hence, there is need for improving the train connectivity between the two states to ameliorate the hardship and inconvenience being faced by the public," Chief Minister urged.

DoRD has adopted new technology in Rural Road Sector. 525 KM of such roads have been constructed using new technology over the last three years.

NDA @ 3 BJP Gains

Bhubaneswar (KCN): As Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated India's longest bridge over the Brahmaputra in Assam, saffron lawmaker Dillip Ray is at a loss as to why the second bridge over River Brahmani, which Mr.Modi had promised, is not taking off.

As the NDA Government completed three years in office on May 26, the saffron leader raises voice against the Central Bureaucracy, which is coming as a stumbling block for Odisha.

When Ministry of Road Transport and Highways com-

pleted the massive bridge in Assam in a stipulated time frame, how come the same Ministry is failing to take up the bridge after three years, asked Mr.Ray.

While the saffron brigade is propagating NDA Government's achievements, the people in Odisha are confused whether they really get benefit from the Centre.

It is a fact that people in other parts of the country are getting more benefits than the people in Odisha.

However, Union Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas, Dharmendra

Pradhan reels out stats with a long list of benefits reaching the people of Odisha.

But political observers opine that the NDA Government does not accord any "Special Attention" towards the State.

Mr.Modi, while addressing election rallies in far flung areas of Uttar Pradesh highlighted Odisha's poverty and his party's gain in the State in the recently concluded rural elections.

The Prime Minister said poverty, illiteracy and all odd things are seen in Odisha and therefore, he declared to make it as the "Laboratory of

the NDA Government's welfare schemes".

Mr.Pradhan, listing out NDA Government's achievements, said that Odisha got an allocation of Rs 5102 crore for rail infrastructure development in 2017-18. The State got Rs 14,903 crore for railway development in four years. But what the Union Minister did not mention was that the State Government too has started becoming a partner in the rail projects.



MUMBAI(KCN): Stocks defied gravity for the second straight session today, propelling the Sensex past the 31,000-mark for the first time ever

The BSE Sensex has risen 25.53 per cent, while the NSE Nifty has gained 30.38 per cent since the BJP-led NDA government came to power in May 2014.

Creation of new positions by participants following the beginning of the June futures and options

crossed the landmark 31,000-level to hit a lifetime high of 31,074.07.

After paring some gains, the 30-share index settled at 31,028.21, up 278.18 points, or 0.90 per cent. It surpassed the earlier record closing of 30,750.03 hit yesterday.

It was the third straight week of gains for the key indices. The Sensex rose by 563.29 points, or 1.84 per cent, while the Nifty finished the week 167.20 points, or 1.77 per cent higher.

caps outperformed as recent correction scaled down the valuation gap with large caps, which gave an entry point for those who missed the opportunity," said Vinod Nair, Head of Research, Geojit Financial Services.

Foreign institutional investors bought shares worth a net Rs 589.11 crore on Thursday, which added to the upbeat sentiment. Tata Steel soared 5.46 per cent to emerge as the biggest Sensex gainer, followed by ITC Ltd at 2.99 per cent on encouraging fourth quarterly earnings.

Other big gainers were Power Grid (2.57 per cent), Reliance Industries (2.53

Bharti Airtel (1.12 per cent), Tata Motors (1.11 per cent), M&M (1.11 per cent), L&T (1.05 per cent), Axis Bank (1 per cent), ONGC (0.95 per cent) and Coal India (0.90 per cent).

However, pharma counters continued their slide on persistent selling pressure largely on muted earnings. Sun Pharma fell 3.93 per cent, Cipla lost 2.48 per cent, Lupin shed 2.29 per cent and Dr Reddy's 0.64 per cent.

Sectorwise, BSE metal index gained the most by rising 3.40 per cent, followed by oil&gas 2.08 per cent, FMCG 1.77 per cent, power

cent.

Buying activity in the broader markets also gathered momentum, with the mid-cap index surging 2.06 per cent and small-cap index gaining 1.60 per cent.

Globally, in rest of Asia, Hong Kong's Hang Seng rose 0.03 per cent, while Shanghai Composite Index was up 0.07 per cent. Japan's Nikkei fell 0.64 per cent. European markets were in the red in their early deals. Paris CAC 30 fell 0.70 per cent and Frankfurt's DAX lost 0.41 per cent. London's FTSE, however, was marginally up by 0.10 per cent.

Modi Government sanctioned 4743 kilometers of NH while the State since Independence could get only 4639 km. This included 450-kilometre long Coastal Highway project for which little has been done.

Union Government sanctioned five medical colleges for Odisha in which the Centre's contribution is 60 per cent. This apart, two public sector undertakings also planned to set up two more Medical Colleges.

As many as 11.46 lakh poor women have been allocated LPG gas under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana and 1.14 crore people have opened bank account under Jan Dhan Yojana, Pradhan said. However, all these benefits are considered "No Special". They got it as people in rich states like Gujarat, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu and Punjab availed.

While Odisha's poverty is highlighted in an election rally in Uttar Pradesh, there was no "Special Provision" for the people of the State even though the Central Government allocated Rs 1,000 crore for Bihar ahead of the Assembly elections

ing Odisha has decreased.

Accepting recommendations of the FFC, the PMO wrote to all State Governments saying that the Centre has decided to devolve maximum money to States and allow them the required freedom to plan the course of states' development.

Odisha has not got the benefit of the revenue deficit grants. The FFC desist from awarding sector/state specific grants-having much bearing on the social sectors. The Union Budget has re-categorized 66 central sponsored schemes (CSSs) based on the recommendation. However, 33 out of 66 CSSs are to be run under the changed sharing pattern. National Health Mission, Sarva Siksha Abhiyan, Rashtriya Madhyamik Siksha Abhiyan, National Livelihood Mission, ICDS etc. would be changed to 50:50. This indicates an additional financial burden on State. Odisha is set to lose Rs 4,260.13 crore in this fiscal in the wake of reduced Central Assistance.

As per the recommendations of the 14th Finance Commission, the share of states in central taxes would go up from 32 per cent to 42 per cent.

For Odisha, the incremental revenue gain is worked out to be Rs 5,888.43 crore. However, the

The Special Scheme for the most backward KBK region faced big hurdles as the Union Government stopped eight Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSSs).

The State of Odisha has been losing Rs 1854 crore per annum. This has severely affected developmental activities in 18 districts including KBK's eight districts.

Union Government stopped schemes such as Backward Region Grant Fund (BRGF), Integrated Action Plan, National Scheme for Modernisation of Police and other forces, Rajiv Gandhi Panchayat Sasaktikaran Abhiyan, Assistance to States for Infrastructure Development for Exports, Scheme for Setting up of 6000 model schools at block level as benchmark of excellence, National Mission on Food Processing and Tourism Infrastructure. Central action has seriously challenged the progress of social sector in Odisha after the changed Centre-State funding pattern on CSSs.

Fourteenth Finance Commission's Recommendation has sharply enhanced the State share in the central divisible pool from 32 per cent to 42 per cent. The share of nine States includ-

revenue gain is countered by the projected loss in central assistance at Rs 8,037.26 crore. This translates into a net loss of Rs 2,148 crore in Central Assistance, according to a written reply to the State Legislative Assembly by Minister Finance.

Besides, because of restructured CSS, the State is set to lose Rs 1,190.91 crore owing to withdrawal of various sector-specific and state-specific grants as a result of the 14th Finance Commission's recommendations. This apart, the decision to lift normal Central assistance is set to cause loss of Rs 732.17 crore.

While there is little tangible benefit for the people of Odisha at large, BJP as a political party has certainly gained much.

BJP candidates could increase their stake and secured 297 Zilla Parishad seats in 2017 panchayat polls from just 36 seats in 2012 rural polls.

During the three years of NDA regime, BJP has benefited politically and the party which was at the third position in the State politics has been elevated to the second. While the saffron brigade is upbeat over their political success, social activists and economists are not enthused over the development.


