

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of the Odisha Crime Branch has arrested Asutosh Acharya, deputy manager of State Bank of India's Phulbani Branch, over his alleged involvement in a loan fraud of more than Rs 8 crore.He has been apprehended under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120B of the IPC, and Section 66 (C) of the IT Act. He will be produced before the non-pensioners. It is Court of SDJM, Phulbani.

According to official sources, the case against Acharya was registered on the basis of a complaint filed by the Regional Manager of the SBI, RBO, Phulbani. He is accused of illegally recommending and September 2022, during

Since time immemorial, each age has contributed in the formation of literary theories. Neo criticism which flowered in the 1940s marked its significance by breaking off from the then existing compartmentalized departments. It spreads it's roots and gives birth to Cultural studies which penetrates deeper into the ellipsis and gives birth to the Gender studies. The word 'gender' echoes the conventional roles prescribed to an individual by the society which is designed by the essence of patriarchy. Patriarchy justifies it's illogical and dominant functioning by deriving the definition of gender from culturally inferring of the term 'sex.' René Descartes coined the existence and the functioning of the binaries of the mind and the body.

Following his footsteps, patriarchy consciously corrupted the mind to establish the secondary position of the woman in relation to the man as a glorified position to sustain the dichotomy. Culturally and socially the subordinate position of a woman has been glorified to the extend that she is reduced to a body which is to be owned by the mind of the man. However with Simone de Beauvoir's words, "One is not born a woman, but becomes one" the notion of the existing and breathing concept of gender gets destabilized. Government Unveils Key Amendments To Online Gaming Rules: Here Are The Changes

of Electronics and IT (MeitY) on Thursday released new rules for online gaming that prohibit any game that involves betting and wagering, and entail a framework of multiple self-regulatory organisations (SROs).

"The moment online gaming trespasses into involving betting and wagering regardless of the core content of the game, then it comes into conflict with these new rules". Minister of State for IT Rajeev Chandrasekhar told reporters.

"We are dealing with a framework that allows for all online gaming to be multiple stakeholders: determined as permissible 1: As per the amended there will be multiple SROs,"

Chandrasekhar said. According to a news release, the aim of these amendments is to enforce greater due diligence by online gaming and social media intermediaries with respect to online games and fake or falsely misleading information related to government business.

Elaborating on the new rules at a press conference, the Union Minister said, "It is Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision Indians get every opportunity possible to create startups and innovate for the world. Online gaming is certainly a huge opportunity for India and young Indians. We see the Indian online gaming ecosystem expanding and growing into a multi-billion dollar industry and being an important catalyst for India's one trillion dollar digital economy goal by 2025-26, with very clear


