Know where you can catch glimpse of men's hockey world cup trophy

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The FIH Men's Hockey World Cup-2023 trophy is all set to return to Odisha tomorrow (December 25) after travelling across 13 states and one Union Territory in the country.

The Trophy Tour of the Men's Hockey World Cup-2023 had been kicked off in the city here on December 5. Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik had handed over the trophy to Hockey India President Dillip Tirkey on the occasion. The trophy will arrive at Biju Patnaik International Airport (BPIA) here at 11.30 am on Sunday. Sports and Youth Services Minister Tusharkanti Behera, Hockey India President Dillip Tirkey, Mayor Sulochana Das and senior officials of the Sports department will receive the trophy at the airport, said an official.

The trophy will be displayed at Biju Patnaik Square near the airport from 12 noon to 12.30 pm. Then, the trophy would be taken to Lingaraj Temple via New Airport Square, Sishu Bhawan Square, Mausima Flyover and

"The trophy will reach Lingaraj Temple at 12.50 pm and leave the shrine premises at 1.20 pm. A group of priests from Puri will recite Vedic hymns at the shrine during the arrival of the hockey world cup trophy," he

The trophy will be displayed at SOA campus from 2.50 pm to 3.20 pm, said the official.

Washington:Residents of Kentucky counties where tornadoes killed dozens of people could be without heat, water or electricity in frigid temperatures for weeks or longer, state officials warned Monday, as the toll of damage and deaths came into clearer focus in five states slammed by the swarm of twisters.Kentucky authorities said the sheer level of destruction was hindering their ability to tally the damage from Friday night's storms. At least 88 people — 74 in including Kentucky — were killed by the tornado outbreak damaged an Amazon utilities.

The updates come as COVID-19 cases, deaths and hospitalization are all rising again and the U.S. hovers around pandemic deaths. The latest surge, driven by the delta variant, is accelerating due to colder weather of its drug's benefit after

"That was the point.

They tried to discourage them from participating in foreign leagues. They understood those who are already there. But they tried to dissuade us from taking such steps in the future," said an official of a team who was present at the meeting.

At this point, three IPL teams - Mumbai Indians, Kolkata Knight Riders

and Delhi Capitals - are part of the UAE league (ILT20) and six teams -Chennai Super Kings, Mumbai Indians, SunRisers Hyderabad, Lucknow Super Giants, Delhi Capitals and Rajasthan Royals - are part of the league in South Africa (SA20). In fact, all six teams in IPL

being seen as a mini-IPL. Besides, the in Caribbean Premier League (CPL), two IPL franchises - Kolkata Knight Riders and Punjab Kings - are participating. The BCCI did not

exactly object to the IPL franchises' presence in foreign leagues but was amused. "They were suggesting that our presence in foreign leagues could dilute the value of the IPL," said the official. Among those present at the meeting were BCCI secretary Jay Shah and IPL chairman

Arun Singh Dhumal. When asked about it, Dhumal played it safe

and gave a rather politically correct answer. "Not really. Other boards have all the right to start their leagues. But we have seen that the IPL is way ahead. A few of them (franchise owners) have interests in other leagues. They have to look after their business interests. We can't stop them. They have money in their kitty, so it is their choice," Dhumal said.

Among other issues at the meeting, the BCCI brought up the matter of centralised merchandising. The suggestion was that both the BCCI/IPL and the franchises collaborate and get involved in merchandising which could benefit all parties, including the fans. The BCCI also promised the upgradation infrastructure to the teams at the IPL venues.
