The SEC must act against the perpetrators of violence," Pradhan wrote in a series of tweets. "Violence should not mar the festival of democracy. Pre-poll violence was also seen in many places," he wrote.

Responding to Dharmendra, Pranab Prakash said the BJD always believes in practising non-violence. "It is the principal opposition BJP which has been sponsoring violence, fearing defeat. BJP MLA Jayanrayan Mishra has been threatening government employees. BJP leaders and workers have attacked BJD Zilla Parishad members in Gajapati and Pipili. NCW favors CBI Probe

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Chairperson of the National Commission for Women (NCW) Rekha Sharma on Thursday sought a Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) probe into the sensational Kalahandi woman teacher Mamita Meher murder case. Ms.Sharma, who held a discussion with Odisha DGP Sunil Bansal, however, suggested the him to recommend the State government for a high level probe by the CBI into the murder case of the lady teacher from Mahaling school in western Odisha. "The charge sheet filed in the court in connection with the lady teacher murder case can be sufficed by the ad- dition of new evidence. So I have asked the DGP to add anyone into the purview of the investigation who has not been included so far. A relook is necessary into the charge sheet and if it is felt the probe is insufficient, CBI can be roped in to take charge of investigation of the case," said Ms.Sharma told reporters after meeting with the DGP. Speaking on the alleged link of Minister Dibyashankar Mishra in the murder case, Sharma said the name of the State Minister of State (MoS) Home is not mentioned in the charge sheet. "As the police come under the jurisdiction of the Home department, the Minister in charge of the portfolio should have been questioned by now. But surprisingly, the DGP's office is not even aware whether the Minister has been questioned in connection with the case or not," said Ms.Sharma.

Boudh Records Highest Polling

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Boudh district has recorded highest voters' turnout of 84.7 per cent while lowest 64.96 per cent in Deogarh, (77.25), Subarnapur (81.56) and Sundargarh (72.69). The election was held at 22,379 booths in 1,669



cent polling recorded in Ganjam district during the first phase of voting for the election to Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) held on 16 February. The State Election Commission (SEC) has released the final polling data on Thursday. As per the data, 77.2 per cent out of 67.51 lakh voters have turned out to the booths in this phase. Angul district has recorded 82.6 per cent polling while it was 76.58 per cent in Balasore, 70.24 per cent in Balangir, 78.94 per cent in Dhenkanal, 79.57 per cent in Gajapati, 77.57 per cent in Jagatsinghpur and 74.5 per cent in Jajpur district. The polling percentage of other districts—Jharsuguda (82.1), Kalahandi (81.12), Kandhamal (76.33), Kendrapada (71.76), Keonjhar (78.43), Khurda (71), Koraput (80.2), Malkangiri (77.86), Mayurbhanj (78.42), Nabarangpur (80.54), Nayagarh (73.63), Nuapada (75.57), Puri (76.32), Rayagada (76.95), Sambalpur Panchayats in 71 Blocks of the State. Meanwhile, the poll for 13 ward members, 6 Sarpanches, three Panchayat Samiti Members and one ZP member was countermanded due to death of contesting candidates. Notably, the voter turnout in the 2017 Panchayat poll was around 78 per cent while there was 76.65 per cent polling in the first phase. The SEC has made all elaborate arrangements for the second phase polling to be held to- morrow. In the second phase, polling will be held for 186 Zilla Parishad zones in 68 blocks across the State. A total of 20,436 booths will be set up in 1,514 Panchayats and 62,10,938 voters will cast their vote. The campaigning for the second phase election ended on Wednesday evening. As violence has been reported in some booths in the first phase, the Commission has issued strict instructions to the DGP to ensure law and order conditions during the next four phases of Panchayat polls. The DGP has also been directed to take strong action against the law violators.

SC grants Ekta Kapoor interim protection from arrest in FIR over web series

NEW DELHI (KCN): The Supreme Court on Thursday granted interim protection from arrest to TV producer Ekta Kapoor in an FIR



against her for alleged objectionable content in her web series "XXX season 2". A bench headed by Chief Justice SA Bobde granted interim protection to Kapoor. She had moved the apex court after the Indore bench of the Madhya Pradesh High Court, in November this year, dismissed her petition seeking that a case filed against her for alleged objectionable content in web series "XXX season 2" be quashed. The High Court had dismissed a petition of Kapoor seeking quashing of a case registered against her for alleged obscenity in a web series produced by her. The complainant had alleged an episode of the series 'XXX uncensored' was obscene and caused annoyance to him, hurt his religious feelings and dishonored the Army. The case was registered at the Annapurna police station, Indore, under Sections 294 (Obscene acts and songs), 298 and 34 (Acts done by several persons in furtherance of common intention) of the India Penal Code and various relevant sections of the IT Act and the State Emblem Act.

Here are some home remedies:

Mix sandalwood with a little rose water and apply on the face. Wash off with plain water after 20 to 30 minutes.

Simmer a handful of neem leaves on a very low fire in 4 cups of water for one hour. Leave it overnight. Next morning, strain the water and make a paste of the leaves. Apply it on inflamed and rashy areas. The water can be used for rinsing the area. Neem contains organic sulphur compounds, with versatile healing actions that are of particular benefit to the skin.

Add a pinch of turmeric to milk and apply on the face. Wash off after 15 minutes.

Clays like fuller's earth (multani mitti) have a cooling and soothing effect. Mix one tablespoon Fuller's Earth with rose water. Apply the paste on affected areas and wash it off after 15 to 20 minutes.

conditioner and put it in a spray bottle. Spray the mixture on the hair. Then comb the hair, so that it spreads through the hair.

Here are some home remedies for dry hair:

Take two teaspoons of pure glycerine, one tablespoon sesame seed (til) oil and one egg yolk. Mix together and apply on the scalp and hair. Apply on the ends too. Wear a plastic shower cap and leave on for an hour before washing the hair.

Curd or egg yolk can be applied on the hair for conditioning dry hair. Apply and leave it on for half an hour, before washing the hair.

Spring Make-up

In keeping with the spring season, the make-up should be one that is fresh and youthful. Try to achieve a more natural look. Yellow and green are the main colours of spring. For clothes, colours like leaf green, olive green, lime green, lemon, yellow, cream, light brown, pink, mauve, turquoise blue, light blue would be suitable. Floral prints, checks and dots look pretty, or you can use lace or light embroidery on your clothes.

For make up, leave out foundation, if the skin is clear. Apply a light liquid moisturizer and a touch of baby powder for a translucent look. Or, use compact powder. For the night, a light, liquid foundation would be appropriate. If the skin is too dry, use a creamy one.

When you apply make-up, remember not to smear too much or rub it. Whether it is foundation or blusher, it is best to dot it with a light touch, using a finger tip, or an applicator. It can also be applied lightly and evenly with a damp sponge.

If you wish to cover a pimple or spot, it should be done before applying foundation or powder. Concealing sticks are available for this. Using a thin brush, paint over the spot with a little concealer, or a shade lighter you're your normal foundation. Then, apply a little powder.

For the natural look, use lip gloss, instead of lipstick, during the day. At night, you need more colour. Applying lipstick with a lip brush helps it to last longer. The lip colours for spring can be light brown, rose, mauve and pink for the day, while bronze, coral, copper, burgundy and even red would look good for the night.

Apply a hint of lip gloss after applying lipstick. This gives a fresh and youthful look.

A hint of blusher should be used on the cheeks. A powder blusher is easier to apply. Use it after you have applied powder and at the end of your make-up. Apply on the cheekbones and blend it outwards and slightly upwards.

Exercising regularly is great for your overall health and skin. It gets the blood circulation going and helps flush out the toxins ruining your plans of getting beautiful skin. When you sweat, you expel dirt and grime from our pores, making the skin moist and hydrated.

Applying eye cream at night is investing for future good skin. The skin under the eyes is extremely thin and your regular moisturizer might not work. Use an eye cream to hydrate the skin under your eyes and promote younger-looking skin.

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) is making the same mistake time and again of taking on Mamata Banerjee through not-so-political means. The

Tweets from the governor or former governor of two neighboring states. Nor can she be fought with uncouth, verbal diarrhea of a former state party president. The strategy of making fun out of her apparently simpleton gestures and postures by the Prime Minister, Home Minister or other top leaders of the Saffron Brigade does not work against her. She cannot be taken on with the snooty urban apathy towards so-called unsophisticated and unpolished vocabulary or sentence construction. The more these things are tried out against her, the stronger she

emerges. The results of the last

state assembly polls followed by Kolkata Municipal Corporation polls and then the civic body polls in different parts of the state, one by one, are cases in point. The recent reported and projected feud within the party notwithstanding, Mamata Banerjee and her party have gone increasingly stronger (in electoral politics, at least) by the day. You like it or not, this is a fact, in black and white. Mamata Banerjee's Trinamul Congress has regained (or started to regain) its lost ground in north Bengal as well, much to the worries of the Saffron Brigade.

Much more matured and an astute politician now, the once fire-brand opposition leader and now the third time chief minister knows exactly when, where and how to intervene in party affairs. She also knows how to put a spoke into the wheels of over

ambitious leaders. She does not even mind doing the same thing, if some over ambition gets reflected on her own parts as well.

Consider how she did not let her party contest the UP polls after the initial gung-ho, and eventually decided to extend support to Akhilesh Yadav-led political front. Similarly, after giving a long rope to the party's youth and youthful brigade, on the day of the Goa polls, she made it clear that they were not expecting to win Goa (although she said her party would do much better than it is expected), they were keen on reaching out to every homes in Goa and build party organisation in that state. In Tripura also, the party is suddenly going slow. Unlike some of the top BJP leaders, including the Prime Minister, Home Minister, their national party president, who had virtually camped in Bengal before the

polls and toured & campaigned across the length and breadth of the state, Mamata did not do anything of that sort, so that she can be blamed in the eventuality of a poll debacle.

She has somehow realised that she would not have to branch out physically, thereby running the risk of loss of face in some cases, to come up as a strong contender for the most coveted post, or the strongest challenger to Modi-Shah's leadership. She can jolly well do that by virtue of her party's electoral performances within the state and her government's performance within its jurisdiction.

The Saffron mandarins, therefore, need to tweak and re-work their strategies, politically, in case they are serious about taking her on, on her home turf.

“We will ensure that the remaining four phases of Panchayat polls are barred from any form of untoward incidents. We have taken steps to arrest people involved in violence which took place in some parts of the State yesterday,” assured Mr. Bansal.

Stating the first phase of election was largely peaceful barring a few incidents of violence, he said, “The elections will be free and fair and we will ensure that strict action is taken against anyone involved in disrupting the polls.” He said a total of 240 platoons of force, 1753 mobile patrolling parties along with district police officers have been deployed all over the state for smooth conduct of the second phase of elections. The police have arrested 36 persons in three districts for resorting to violence during the first phase poll. While 16 people have been arrested in Puri district, 14 arrested in Jajpur and 6

in Dhenkanal district in connection with poll disruption incidents during the first phase. The police has also seized 3,87,177 litres of liquor, 38 illegal arms, 2216.56 grams of narcotic drugs, registered 4966 excise cases and executed 1903 pending warrants during the election process, so far. SEC Secretary RN Sahu said that the Commission has received proposals for re-polling at 25 places in four districts from the concerned district Collectors. Those include 11 booths in Jajpur district, five booths each in Puri and Bhadrak districts and four booths in Dhenkanal district, Sahu said. “We have received proposals for re-poll at 25 places in four districts. The State Election Commission is reviewing such proposals and a decision will be taken in this regard soon,” he added.

The police have engaged a woman councilor-cum-advocate to reach out to the victims and collect further information about Swain. One more case has been registered against Swain for staying on rent under Khandagiri police limits by submitting fake documents. Another case will be registered against him for collecting `18 lakh from a person on the promise of providing an MBBS seat to his son. The victim has contacted the police to lodge a formal complaint. Two PAN cards have been seized from the accused and police will write to the RBI to locate Swain's bank accounts linked with the cards.

ROURKELA: The demand for stoppages of two Duronto Express trains at Rourkela on the Howrah-Mumbai mainline of South Eastern Railway (SER) continues to remain unfulfilled drawing criticism from various fora. The express train however will have an additional



stoppage at Raipur in Chhattisgarh. Sources said, Raipur is the latest addition to commercial stoppages of 12221/12222 Howrah-Pune Duronto Express and 12261/12262 Howrah-Mumbai Duronto Express. In 2019, the then Railway Minister Piyush Goyal replying to Sundargarh Lok Sabha MP and Chairman of Parliamentary Standing Committee on Defence Jual Oram on December 11 denied the proposal for stoppage of 12221/12222 Howrah-Pune Duronto Express at Rourkela. Goyal went on to state, “Duronto Express trains are long-distance fast moving prestigious trains with very limited stoppages

enroute. Proliferation of stoppages is not operationally expedient. However, Rourkela is well-connected to both Kolkata and Pune.”

In this connection, general secretary of UDBHAV, a forum for integrated development and mass awareness, VP Tiwari sent a letter

to SECR on Monday reiterating demand for stoppages of both trains at Rourkela. “The Railway Board quickly approved the proposal allowing stoppage of both trains at Raipur which is just 108 kms from Bilaspur but ignored Rourkela and the 200-km SER line passing through tribal areas. This just highlights the step-motherly treatment of the Railway Ministry towards Odisha,” added Tiwari. Tiwari further sought the intervention of Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik and Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnav to look into the matter as Rourkela is a bulk contributor to SER.

Polls in Odisha's Maoist pockets peaceful

Bhubaneswar : Unlike the coastal districts which reported poll-related violence, the first phase voting passed off peacefully in Maoist-hit pockets of Odisha on Wednesday. In Malkangiri, the administration heaved a sigh of relief as no untoward incident was reported from any of the 264 polling booths on the day. The highest polling percentage of 84.91 was reported from Tandki panchayat bordering Chhattisgarh where Maoist fear loomed large a year back. There were 88 sensitive booths including 15

in four panchayats bordering Chhattisgarh in Malkangiri block. Official sources said women turned out in greater numbers to vote this time compared to their male counterparts. In the first phase, 49,797 women exercised their franchise against 46,896 men. Similarly, the first phase polling in tribal areas of Koraput district was peaceful. In Maoist-hit Bandhugaon block, no untoward incident was reported amid tight security arrangement by both the State police and Border Security Force (BSF). Ahead of the poll-

ing, combing operation was carried out in the block. A police check post was also functional at Bandhugaon border to monitor activities of outsiders. Sources said tribals in large numbers came out to vote in Borigumma, Kamta, Kumuli, Padapadar, Kathorgada, Semiliguda, Almonda, and Bandhugaon. In the first phase, poll was held in seven zilla parishad zones under Borigumma, Semiliguda and Bandhugaon. Similarly, polling remained incident-free in Sundargarh, Kalahandi and Balangir. In Kalahandi, Junagarh and

Golamunda blocks went to the polls in the first phase. All eyes were on Junagarh as the Assembly constituency is represented by Minister Dibya Shankar Mishra who is facing heat over his alleged links with the main accused in lady teacher Mamita Meher murder case. In Balangir, combing operation was carried out in Maoist-affected areas before voting started on the day. At least 33 mobile patrolling squads, six striking teams led by three DSPs and four inspectors were engaged for polling.

Senior Congress leader and former chief minister of Madhya Pradesh Digvijaya Singh tweeted, "This is the difference between Lee Hsien Loong and Narendra Modi. Lee is leading Singapore to new heights of development and Modi is taking our country for a ride on false promises. No matter how hard Modi tries, Pt Nehru shall remain immortal, builder of Modern India." Lee invoked Nehru while arguing how democracy should work in the city-state during a passionate debate in Parliament. "Most countries are founded and start off on the basis of high ideals and noble values. But more often than not, beyond the founding leaders and the pioneer generation, over decades and generations, gradually things change," he said on Tuesday.

"Things start off with passionate intensity. The leaders, who fought for and won independence, are often exceptional individuals of great courage, immense culture, and outstanding ability. They came through the crucible of fire and emerged as leaders of men and nations. They are the David Ben-Gurions, the Jawaharlal Nehrus, and we have our own too," he said.

Imbued with enormous personal prestige, they strive to meet the high expectations of their peoples to build a brave new world, and shape a new future for their peoples, and for their countries.

But beyond that initial fervour, succeeding generations often find it hard to sustain this momentum and drive, Lee said. The texture of politics changes, respect for politicians declines. After a while, the electorate comes to think this is the norm. So, standards get debased, trust is eroded, and the country declines further, he said.

uncertainty, Widodo said, warning against antagonisms at this time. "It is not the time to create new tensions that could affect global recovery, let alone jeopardize the world peace as we've currently seen in Ukraine," he said. "It is necessary that every party puts an end to rivalry and frictions."

Officials were attending the meetings both in-person and online, given troubles with travel and quarantines due to outbreaks, mostly of the omicron variant of coronavirus, that are plaguing many countries.

Host Indonesia is among many countries in Southeast Asia that have endured severe waves of infections, though vaccinations have helped quell the worst of outbreaks. The fourth most populous nation with 274 million people, it has reported nearly 5 million cases and 145,622 deaths. In the past month, 690,518 new cases have been reported.

Indonesia is the world's 10th largest economy and is located in the fastest-growing region — at least before the pandemic swept the world, disrupting business and travel while killing nearly 6 million people.

Surging prices for food and energy are among the challenges the financial leaders confront as they discuss how to best nurture a global economic recovery, Indonesian Finance Minister Sri Mulyani Indrawati told G-20 participants.

"Inflation risk remains skewed to the upside, driven by supply chain disruption, labor market mismatches, wage pressure, and higher energy prices," she said, adding that such problems have been more persistent than previously expected.

The International Monetary Fund has forecast that world economic growth will slow to 4.4 per cent in 2022 from 5.9 per cent in 2021, following a 3.3 per cent contraction in 2020. Mulyani emphasised the need for coordination between countries in different stages of recovery.

The US Federal Reserve is pulling back on massive support for markets and businesses, preparing to raise interest rates as soon as next month to cool inflation that jumped to 7.5 per cent in January — the highest rate in 40 years. Consumer prices rose to a record 5.1 per cent in the 19 countries that use the euro last month and to a nearly 30-year high in the United Kingdom. Indonesia's central bank has also moved to curb inflation. But some other economies have yet to bounce back from the havoc caused by the pandemic.

"Countries' domestic macroeconomic policy may also cause adverse impacts for other economies," Mulyani said. "In this regard, global coordination, including a discussion on exit strategy will be critical."

Meanwhile, she noted that ensuring countries have equitable access to vaccines remains an urgent priority for limiting new virus variants and ending the pandemic.

FM pitches for expeditious, equitable distribution of vaccines to aid global recovery

NEW DELHI: Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Thursday pitched for expeditious and equitable distribution of vaccines to aid global recovery.

She shared insights on India's policy response to the pandemic and suggested that recovery measures have to be built around a long-term vision.

Participating in the first G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors meeting under the G20 Indonesia presidency, Sitharaman stressed that it is crucial to address the gaps in global pandemic preparedness and the work of the G20 Joint Finance and Health Task Force should progress in this direction.

"In the first session today, FM talked about the global economic outlook and risks including #inflation, #supply disruptions and new variants of the virus and called for #expeditious and #equitable distribution of vaccines to aid #recovery," a tweet by the Finance Ministry said. She emphasised addressing structural bottlenecks to reduce the pandemic's scarring effects and build resilience.

I-T department raids premises of former NSE MD Chitra Ramkrishna, colleague in Mumbai, Chennai

NEW DELHI: Troubles grew for Chitra Ramkrishna, former MD of the NSE, and Anand Subramanian, her col-

league, as the Income Tax department raided their premises in Mumbai and Chennai, IT sources confirmed. Ramkrishna has been in the eye of a storm ever since Sebi on February 11 showed her and her former advisor for sharing sensitive information on the ex-

change with an unknown person. The Mumbai wing of the IT department is heading the searches, it is learnt, that hap-

pened across Mumbai and Chennai and come in the wake of the Sebi order. The Mumbai searches pertain to Ramkrishna's residence and the Chennai one to Subramanian's premises, as per sources. The searches began this morning. Ramkrishna described

the unknown person as a yogi dwelling in the Himalayan ranges. The information was shared over her official email and the un-

known person responded likewise with her. Sebi said the hiring of Subramanian on an incommensurately large salary of over one crore from a subsidiary of Balmer Laurie where he last drew Rs 15 lakh was allegedly at the instance of the yogi.

Some of the information shared was of financial projections of the IPO bound NSE, which has been barred from introducing any confidential information Apart from this, the order said Ramkrishna had shared certain internal confidential information, including financial and business plans of NSE, dividend scenario and financial results, with the yogi and even consulted him over the performance appraisals of the exchange's employees. Ramkrishna was MD and CEO of NSE from April 2013 to December 2016. Sebi levied a fine of Rs 3 crore on Ramkrishna, Rs 2 crore each on the National Stock Exchange (NSE), Subramanian, former NSE MD and CEO Ravi Narain, and Rs 6 lakh on V R Narasimhan, who was the chief regulatory officer and compliance officer. Ramkrishna and Subramanian have been restrained from associating with any market infrastructure

institution or any intermediary registered with Sebi for three years, while the same for Narain is two years. Sebi also directed NSE to forfeit the excess leave encashment of Rs 1.54 crore and the deferred bonus of Rs 2.83 crore, of Ramkrishna. In addition, Sebi barred NSE from launching any new product for six months. Following these revelations, the Congress party had demanded that the government bring a white paper on the functioning of the NSE. "The finance ministry and the prime minister should come out with a white paper on the state of affairs of National Stock Exchange and on the shocking activities of an 'invisible Baba' who was dictating terms to the former CEO of the exchange," Congress spokesperson Gourav Vallabh told reporters two days back.

Raina was released by CSK ahead of the IPL Mega Auction, while the franchise decided to retain skipper MS Dhoni, Ravindra Jadeja, Moeen Ali and Ruturaj Gaikwad.

franchises despite his success and records in the cash-rich league. It must be noted that Raina flew down to India from UAE during IPL 2020 after the CSK camp was hit with COVID-19. Though he was retained by CSK for IPL 2021, Raina missed the last few games of the tournament due to

a knee injury. Devoid of proper competitive cricket in the last few years might also be one of the main reasons for Raina going unsold in the Mega Auction. 'Mr. IPL' Raina is one of the very few players to have scored over 5000 runs in the IPL. He has amassed 5528

runs in 205 matches, which include one century and 39 half-centuries. Raina is also a handy part-time bowler and has claimed 25 IPL wickets. Meanwhile, CSK CEO Kasi Viswanathan stated that Raina's 'current form' was the reason behind the latter not being picked up by the

club this season. Viswanathan said that the team combination and form meant the left-handed batter could not fit into the team. "Missing out on Raina...He has been a great asset for the side earlier. Considering the current form, he did not fit into the side," Viswanathan.
