Reports said, the versatile cine actor is being shifted to Hyderabad's Yasoda Hospital due to the unavailability of donors in New Delhi's Institute of Liver and Biliary Sciences (ILBS), where he was undergoing treatment, said family sources.

Speaking to OTV, actor Sritam Das said, "He was first taken to ILBS Hospital in New Delhi. A family member was supposed to donate liver to Pintu, but that could not materialize due to mismatching of blood group and various other reasons."



The actor further said that as per the government's rule, one cannot get organs from a living person. 





Londan: As England's dominance in the second Test against New Zealand continued on Saturday (February 25), Joe Root was pleased to make a contribution towards that cause and also praised his batting partner Harry Brook saying he had the best seat in the house watching the youngster bat. Having gone without a century since his 142 not out in the Birmingham Test against India in July 2022, Root registered his 14th 150plus score and was involved in a record 302run partnership for the fourth wicket with Brook.

"I felt like I owed that to the group. It's been a while since I made a solid contribution. To be part of such a big partnership was really pleasing and I think the best thing was I had the best seat in the house to watch Harry go about his business. It's a joy to watch him play at the minute. He certainly made my life a lot easier out there, the way he manages to wrestle
