Muslim brothers and sisters make us the country with the second largest population of




Man Shot Dead, Daughter Hurt Over Land Dispute In

The deceased has been identified as Bijay Kumar Behera of Kumunda village under Khallikot police limits, sources said.

Bijay's daughter Gayatri Behera sustained injuries in the incident, they added.According to sources, the in-laws of Gayatri were engaged in a land dispute with one of their close relatives for the last few days. Gayatri had invited Bijay to mediate between the two quarreling parties to solve the dispute. However, Prashant Kumar Behera, a member of the rival family, opened fire on Bijay, sources said.

### **Odisha: Capital Hospital To Provide 24-Hour Surgery Facilities**

Bhubaneswar(KCN): The Capital Hospital will soon provide round-theclock surgery facilities to needy patients and people injured in accidents.The emergency operation theatre (OT) of the health institute will remain open for 24 hours, said Director Laxmidhar Sahu.

"We have taken steps to provide round-the-clock surgery facilities to needy

injured in mishaps. Henceforth, no such patient will be referred to other hospitals," Sahu added.A special OT has been set up at Capital Hospital to provide 24hour surgery facilities. "Now, around 200 doctors are working in Capital Hospital. staffers will be deployed Quality in three shifts to provide Standards

surgery facilities," he said.Earlier, there was no such arrangement to provide surgery facilities at Capital Hospital at night. As a result, people injured in mishaps and needy patients were referred to other hospitals, sources said. In a related development, Doctors and health a team from the National Assurance NQAS

Full member boards have previously claimed that these leagues are causing a drain of talent from their member countries. It is understood that the discussion on this contentious issue will continue.

Sources from Durban have stated that there is a need to regulate the leagues, but the specific form of regulation will be determined during the board meeting.
