

# Stalemate Over Banaklagi Ladies First In Bus

**Puri(KCN):** The ongoing stalemate over the Banakalagi ritual of Lord Jagannath and his siblings continued as it could not be resolved at Srimandir Niti Sub-Committee meeting held today.

It has been 28 days that Banakalagi ritual of deities has not been performed since Niladri Bije. It was delayed due to rigid stands taken by both the Duttamahapatra Nijog, the servitor body and the Sri Jagannath Temple Administration. Now, all eyes are now at the Managing Committee meeting scheduled to be held on August 1. Briefing media persons after the meeting, Shree Jagannath Temple Administration (SJTA) Chief Administrator Ranjan Kumar Das said, "The



topic was thoroughly discussed in the meeting, and we heard several opinions on it. Since the temple managing committee is the highest decision-making body, these will be presented during its meeting on August 1," said Shri Das. The SJTA attempted

to persuade the Duttamahapatra Nijog by referencing the laws and the Record of Rights. In order to put an end to this interference with the Lords' ritual, he remarked, "We are still open to discussions and are hopeful that the servitors would

cooperate with the administration." He continued by saying that Wednesday is supported by the justifications offered thus far and the Record of Rights. If Ekadasi or other rites fall on Wednesday, they can be moved to Thursday. However, the temple management must also make this decision, he added. The administration had asked the Duttamahapatra servitors to perform the ritual on every Wednesday of the week while the servitor body insisted upon continuing the ongoing practice to render their services on Thursday. The Duttamahapatra servitors were issued notices twice asking them to perform it on

every Wednesday but they did not carry it. Shri Das hoped that things would be resolved at the Temple Managing Committee meeting. On the other hand, Madan Dutta Mahapatra, the President of Duttamahapatra Nijog said they went to the temple to perform Banakalagi seva but were prevented by officials. He said as per records and practice Banakalagi seva could be performed on Wednesday or on Thursday and questioned why the Administration is rigid for Wednesday. Instead of asking us to perform the seva on only Wednesday they should consider both Wednesday and Thursday, he said.

**Cuttack (KCN):** Following an instruction from the State Commission for Women (SCW), the State Transport Authority (STA) today asked all RTOs to ensure allowing women as the first passenger to enter into buses. The STA Secretary has written a letter to all RTOs in this regard on Friday. A social activist Ghasiram Panda had filed a petition before Odisha State Commission for Women alleging that women as first passengers are not allowed to enter buses. Panda, in his petition, alleged that a woman faced discrimination as she was prevented from boarding a bus as a first passenger at Baramunda bus stand in Bhubaneswar. Acting on the petition, the Commission yesterday directed the State Transport Commissioner to ensure that the women passengers are not prevented from boarding a bus as first passengers. In this background, the STA said permits are granted by STA/ RTA to stage carriages on different routes to carry passengers on payment of bus fare as notified by this office. So, the owner or conductor of a stage carriage cannot deny any women as first passengers to enter into buses, the Secretary said. "Any deviation shall amount to violation of permit conditions and punishable under Section 192A of M.V. Act, 1988," he warned. The RTOs have been asked to check stage carriages regularly and whenever it was detected that the owner/conductor of stage carriage denying women as first passenger to enter into the bus, e-challan will be drawn against the owner of said vehicle under Section 192A of M.V. Act, 1988 and report compliance.



## Gopal Das killed Naba Das as he feared threat to own life: Polygraph report



**Bhubaneswar,(KCN):** Dismissed Assistant Sub-Inspector (ASI), Gopal Das killed health minister Naba Das as he feared a threat to his life from the latter, revealed the polygraph report of the accused.

During the polygraph test, accused Gopal Das revealed many important facts pertaining to the sensational murder of the health minister. During the test, he had said a person named Manoj Bariya had told him that Naba Das had been angry with him. "Manoj told him that Naba Das might be angry with him for stopping his vehicle and reprimanding his supporters. Fearing a threat to his life from Naba Das, he started planning to eliminate the health minister," the Polygraph report revealed.

Gopal revealed that if he had not killed Naba Das, then the latter would have eliminated him. Gopal also

Additionally, the miscreants also vandalized four vehicles belonging to the officials that were parked in the forest. Upon receiving information about the incident, Khuntuni police rushed to the spot and initiated an investigation into the matter.

**Bhubaneswar,(KCN):** A well-known Odia actress has brought serious allegations against an Ollywood producer. The actress accused the producer who happens to be her friend, of making their intimate videos and pictures viral.

The actress has lodged a police complaint at Laxmisagar police station in this connection following which a case has been registered.

The actress alleged that the videos were shot during the time when they shared a good relationship. But once their relationship soured, the producer allegedly made all those videos viral on social media in order to defame her. Earlier, the actress had lodged a complaint with the Orissa High Court in this connection too. In the complaint, the actress mentioned they (The accused

producer and the actress) became emotionally close and being unaware of his real motives and intention started trusting him and became each other's confidants and companions. The complaint further stated that later the accused compelled the actress to reject offers from other producers and did not pay her for the projects she had done earlier with him. And when she denied to tow the line, the accused began a social media campaign to defame her and tarnish her image in the industry. Speaking to OTV, Soumyajit Biswal, the lawyer of the actress said, "They both developed feelings for each other after working together for some time. However, when she started doing other projects with other producers, he objected. He wanted to use my client's goodwill for his benefit and establish himself as a director in the industry. When she denied to obey him, he started to harass her and continued it for more than two years."

## BJP, Congress corner BJD on demand for women's reservation bill

**Bhubaneswar, (KCN):** The Opposition Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and the Congress on Friday targeted the ruling Biju Janata Dal (BJD) over its demand for the passage of the women's reservation bill in the Parliament, accusing it of playing the women card to woo voters in the state.

Acting on the direction of the BJD supremo, Naveen Patnaik, MP Sasmit Patra intensified the demand for 50 percent reservation for women in both Parliament and state assemblies through a special mention in the Rajya Sabha.

However, the state units of the BJP and Congress took a swipe at the BJD for the ruling party's yet another attempt to play the women card.

The Congress asked the



BJD to support the no-confidence motion brought by the opposition INDIA block against the BJD government. "If they (the BJD) are saying that the demand for the passage of the women's reservation bill is their big demand then they should also tell the BJD that if the bill is not passed we won't be with you in the

no-confidence motion," said senior Congress leader, Jayadev Jena. On the other hand, the BJD asked the BJD to pass the bill in the State cabinet first. "Whenever an election approaches, the BJD always comes with a tactic to woo votes. They should first get the bill passed in their own cabinet," said the president of the State

BJP Mahila Morcha, Smruti Pattanayak. In its response, the BJD said the Chief Minister has created a record in giving reservation to women candidates during the Panchayat and Municipal elections. ## India's electronics manufacturing jumps from \$30 bn to \$100 bn: PM Modi

**New Delhi:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday revealed that India's electronic manufacturing has exceeded \$100 billion from \$30 billion in 2014. He made the revelation after officially opening the SemiconIndia 2023 here.

The conference, under the theme 'Catalysing India's Semiconductor Ecosystem', will showcase India's ambitious strategy and policy in becoming a global nucleus for semiconductor design, manufacturing, and technology development.

In his address, Prime Minister Modi drew parallels between Moore's Law, which predicts the exponential growth of technology, and India's digital and electronic manufacturing sectors. He informed the audience that India's share in global electronic manufacturing has surged dramatically.

"In 2014, India's electronic manufacturing was less than \$30 billion, which has now exceeded \$100



billion," Modi revealed. He also shared that the export of electronics and mobile devices had doubled in the last two years, while stressing the importance of gatherings like SemiconIndia as platforms where industry leaders and experts converge to exchange insights and updates. "It is crucial for the synchronisation of our relationship," Modi explained. He expressed delight at the exhibition's innovative displays and the sector's vibrant energy, urging all attendees, particularly the youth, to explore the exhibition and understand the potential

of new technology. Reflecting on last year's Semicon event, the Prime Minister remarked on the shift in the investment climate within a single year, from 'Why invest in India' to 'Why not invest in India'.

"This directional change is the result of the industry leaders' efforts," Modi praised, as he commended their belief in India's potential. He lauded the industry leaders for aligning India's aspirations and capabilities with their own future goals and dreams. "India does not disappoint," he declared. # India Has Recorded 110% Rise In MBBS Seats Since 2014, Parliament Informed

**New Delhi:** There has been an 82-per cent increase in the number of medical colleges in the country, from 387 before 2014 to 704 now, and a 110-per cent increase in the number of MBBS seats, from 51,348 to 1,07,948, in the same period, Parliament was informed today.

In a written response to a question in the Lok Sabha, Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya said there has also been an increase of 117 per cent in the number of post-graduate (PG) medical seats in the country -- from 31,185 before 2014 to 67,802 as of now.

Mr Mandaviya said 101 medical colleges have been approved in the last five years under a centrally-sponsored scheme (CSS) for the "establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals", including one in Assam.

"The government has increased the number of medical colleges and subsequently, increased the MBBS seats," he said.

"There is an increase of 82 per cent in medical colleges, from 387 before 2014 to 704 as of now. Further, there is an increase of 110 per cent in MBBS seats, from 51,348 before 2014 to 1,07,948 as of now. There is also an increase



of 117 per cent in PG seats from 31,185 before 2014 to 67,802 as of now," Mr Mandaviya said.

The Union health ministry administers the CSS with a preference given to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no government or private medical college, with fund-sharing between the Centre and state governments in the ratio of 90:10 for the northeastern and special category states and 60:40 for the other states. A total of 157 government medical colleges have been approved under the scheme in three phases, including five in Assam, Mr Mandaviya said. Some of the measures and steps taken by the government to augment the medical education facilities and improve the medical standards in the country include the CSS

for the establishment of new medical colleges by upgrading district/referral hospitals under which 157 new medical colleges have been approved and 107 of those are already functional, he added. The CSS was implemented for strengthening and upgrading the existing state government or Centre-run medical colleges to increase the number of MBBS (both UG and PG) seats. Support has been provided to add 4,677 MBBS seats in 77 colleges with an approved cost of ₹ 5,612.25 crore, 4,058 PG seats in the first phase in 72 colleges with an approved cost of ₹ 1,498.43 crore and 3,957 PG seats in the second phase in 62 colleges with an approved cost of ₹ 4,461.44 crore. Under "upgradation of government medical

colleges by construction of super-specialty blocks" of the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), a total of 75 projects have been approved, of which 62 are complete, the minister said. Under the CSS for setting up new all India institute of medical sciences, 22 such institutes have been approved, he added. The National Medical Commission Act, 2019 provides for a medical education system that improves access to quality and affordable medical education and ensures the availability of adequate and high-quality medical professionals in all parts of the country. The NMC has also taken several steps to improve the quality and affordability of medical education in the country. The qualification

awarded by the Diplomate of National Board (DNB) through the National Board of Examinations (NBE) has been recognised for appointment as faculty members to take care of a shortage of faculty.

There has been an enhancement of the age limit for appointments, extensions and re-employment against the posts of teachers, deans, principals and directors in medical colleges up to 70 years, the minister pointed out.

The teacher-student ratio has been rationalised to increase the number of postgraduate medical seats in the country, he noted.

The norms for setting up medical colleges in terms of requirements of faculty staff, bed strength and other infrastructure have been relaxed, Mr Mandaviya said.

The NMC Act also provides for the framing of guidelines for the determination of fees and all other charges in respect of 50 per cent seats in private medical institutions and deemed-to-be universities, which are governed under the provisions of the Act.

Accordingly, the National Medical Commission (NMC) has framed the guidelines and the same were issued on February 3, 2022, the minister said.

assault have been handed over to the CBI.

Reacting to the arrest of people in the viral video case, spokesperson of the Indigenous Tribal Leaders Forum (ITLF) Ginz Vualzong termed it "too little, too late".

"I would have appreciated it if the culprits were arrested before the video went viral. The FIR was registered on May 18. There are many more such

cases. Having said that, I would also like to clarify that arresting people would not solve the larger issues of the state which has been witnessing ethnic clashes," Mr Vualzong said.

"I request the Centre to take the Manipur issue seriously and take steps to end the violence and come up with a solution," he added.

Police have arrested seven people, including a juvenile,

in connection with the case

so far.

Police had registered a case of abduction, gangrape and murder at Nongpok Sekmai police station in Thoubal district against unknown armed persons.

The video which drew wide spread condemnation shows men molesting the two helpless women, who cry and plead with their captors to spare them.

## ASI Digs 5 Sites

**New Delhi:** The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has conducted five excavations in between the years 2018-19 and 2022-23 in Odisha, Union Culture and Tourism Minister G Kishan Reddy said on Thursday.

While replying to a question asked by BJD MPs Sulata Deo and Niranjan Bishi, the Culture Minister said the ASI has conducted excavations at Asurgarh in Kalahandi district during 2018-19, Langudi hill in Jajpur (2019-20 and 2020-21), Adjacent area of Sari Deul, Bhubaneswar (2021-22), Naara Huda, Tirimal in Khordha (2021-22 and 2022-23) and Parabhadi hillock in Jajpur (2022-23).

During the excavation of Asurgarh, the ASI found 417 antiquities including beads, circular discs, fragmented terracotta animal figurines, sling



balls, bangle fragments, terracotta hukka, disc, wheel, crucible, gamesman, ear-stud, finger ring, toe ring, pendants, arrowhead, knife, chisel, cog wheel, nails and clamps etc. Remains of brick and mud structures, a road made up of stone pebbles, a terracotta ring well are also noticed, he said. Remains of a stupa, group of rock-cut stupas, rock-cut images of Buddhist pantheon and a partially exposed monastery, terracotta objects including votive stupas, images of buddha, bodhisattvas, tara, railings and parasol, ear studs, beads and bangles bone have been retrieved from the archaeological excavation at Langudi Hill.

A total of 50 antiquities including terracotta sling ball, pendant, pottery hopscotch, dabber, chisel, image of Ganesha, stone medallion, etc. also found from the site. Similarly, during the excavation at the adjacent area of Sari Deul, bases and lower portions of 6 earlier temples, one dilapidated Mahishamardini temple, sculptures of deities and

# Kuldeep Yadav revels in the 'process' on helpful Bridgetown surface

New Delhi: Kuldeep Yadav, the left-arm wrist-spinner, starred with the ball in the first ODI in Bridgetown, Barbados on Thursday (July 27). He along with Ravindra Jadeja picked up seven of the 10 wickets as West Indies got bundled out for 114 in 23 overs. India registered a five-wicket win to go 1-0 up in the three-match series.

Kuldeep was introduced into the attack in the 19th over after the hosts had already been reduced to 97 for six, with Ravindra Jadeja picking three wickets. The former wasted little time getting off the blocks. He trapped Dominic Drakes leg before with a googly off just his third ball and then backed it up by removing Yannic Cariah in his next over in a similar fashion. Kuldeep went one step further in his third over where he snaffled top-scorer Shai Hope and the No. 11

Jayden Seales in the same over to wrap up the WI innings and finish with impressive bowling figures of 4/6 in just three overs which also comprised two maidens. Kuldeep, who was named the Player of the Match, credited his success to the process and stressed that lengths are crucial for the tweakers.

"I don't think too much about taking wickets. I focus on the process - where to bowl and what lengths to be targeting. Process is more important than performance," he said. "Since my return from injury last year, I've been trying to consistently bowl the right lengths. Sometimes you get wickets, sometimes you don't even when you bowl well, but length is very crucial especially for the spinners. When the opposition loses a few wickets, then I try



my variations for wickets. Happy with the way I started in the first ODI."

The 22-yard strip used for the opening ODI at the Kensington Oval wasn't batting-friendly. There was some extra bounce on offer, the seamers got the ball to nip off the deck and there was bite for the spinners. India picked two

spinners and both the left-arm spinners did the bulk of the damage. Even for the Caribbean side, the two spinners - Gudakesh Motie and Yannic Cariah - scalped three wickets between them as the visitors crossed the line with 27.1 overs to spare.

"It was a good wicket for the seamers. The fast bowlers bowled really

well. When Jadeja was bowling, it was gripping and turning at the same time. When I started from that end, I was getting the drift as well as the turn. In the second innings, you saw the spell from their spinners - they bowled really well. They were getting the turn and the bounce. It was a good wicket for spinners as well," said

Kuldeep. India, after restricting their opponents to a meager total, experimented a bit with the bat. Neither Rohit Sharma opened the innings nor did Virat Kohli bat at three. Ishan Kishan notched up a breezy fifty at the top of the order but none of the other Indians capitalized on their batting promotion. In fact, the Indian captain was forced to come in at seven and hit the winning runs as India romped home with five wickets in hand.

Kuldeep agreed that his team could have been more clinical in the chase but he expected India to show their might in the next encounter and seal the series in the process. "We could have chased it down with just one or two wickets down. But they bowled really well. The new guy was very good and the left-arm as well. You want to give

opportunities to the younger boys, we did that. In the next game, you'll probably see the full side batting and hopefully we can win the second one and win the series."

Kuldeep is now a regular in the playing XI for India in the 50-over format, however he's been in and out of the team in the other formats despite strong performances. The wrist-spinner, however, is unfazed by that and focuses on the controllables.

"On a lot of occasions, the situation and due to the combination, I have to sit out. It's pretty normal for me as I've been playing international cricket for close to six years. I keep myself relaxed when I'm not playing. When you're playing, there's pressure to perform well."

Every ODI is a preparation for the 2023

World Cup which is less than three months away. With a lot of players vying for spots for the mega tournament, one of those could potentially come down to Kuldeep Yadav versus Yuzvendra Chahal. Both the wrist-spinners were part of the 2019 World Cup held in England but the pair was separated after they were hammered by England in one of the group stage matches. Since then, they've played only a handful of games together but they continue to enjoy each others' success.

"We (Kuldeep and Chahal) both know the importance of combination. We have a great understanding. He helps me a lot when I'm playing - what to do, what to change. I replicate the same when he plays. That's why the KulChah pair has been so good over the years. We support and back each other."

## Bumrah fully fit, set to be picked for Ireland series - Jay Shah



New Delhi: Jay Shah, secretary of the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI), revealed that Jasprit Bumrah is fully fit and should be included in the squad for the upcoming Ireland series. "Bumrah is completely fit, and he may be part of the Ireland series," Shah stated. This website had reported on June 24 that the BCCI and the team management were

targeting the Ireland series for Bumrah's return, and he is expected to play in the three T20Is in Dublin on August 18, 20, and 23. Shah further said that the Cricket Advisory Committee (CAC) has expressed the need for dedicated bowling and fielding coaches for the women's team and he mentioned that all coaching appointments, including the head coach, will be

announced together. "The CAC has already conducted interviews for the head coach position and is also looking for specialized coaches for fielding and bowling. The process for these appointments will be initiated soon," he added.

Shah also addressed the prolonged delay in releasing the media rights tender for India's bilateral games, which has become a major topic of discussion in the broadcast industry. However, Shah did not provide a specific timeline for when the tender will be released. "Ernst & Young has been appointed, and they will be submitting a report. The tender will be out shortly," Shah informed reporters in New Delhi. Cricbuzz recently reported that the tender would be released early this week, but later it emerged that the tender will be delayed until later

in the week. So far, however, it has not happened. The industry executives are concerned that there might not be enough time for the new broadcasters to plan and execute marketing strategies for the three-ODI series against Australia -- the first series in the new broadcast cycle - in the last week of September. It is learnt that the BCCI is currently undecided on two crucial factors -- first, whether to opt for an online auction or closed bidding, and second, whether to offer a composite bid package in the tender.

Ernst & Young has reportedly presented all the available options, but the BCCI is yet to make a final decision. "We have not yet decided whether to go for an e-auction or closed bidding; the decision is still pending," the BCCI secretary clarified.

## 'Make Team Virat Vs Team Rohit', Fans Troll Team India Despite Win In 1st ODI Against West Indies



New Delhi: India beat West Indies by 5 wickets in first ODI to start the three-match series on a positive note. However, the Indian fans were left frustrated by the quality of cricket on offer as well as the margin of victory. Chasing just 115 runs to win the match, India completed the task in 22.5 overs. But they ended up losing five wickets. India captain Rohit Sharma demoted himself to number 7 while Virat Kohli did not even get a chance to bat as management wanted to give the likes of Ishan Kishan, Shubman Gill and Suryakumar Yadav the opportunity to have more balls in the middle. The decision backfired as India lost five wickets while chasing 115. Kishan scored a fifty before he departed. But Gill had a poor outing with the score of 7 off 16 balls. Suryakumar Yadav,

batting at No 3, showed glimpses of brilliance as he scored 19 off 25 balls that included 3 fours and 1 six but perished soon. Hardik Pandya was run out for just 5 while Shardul Thakur scored 1 off 4 balls. In the end, Ravindra Jadeja (16 off 21) and Rohit (12 off 19) guided India to a win. The fans were upset for several reasons. Firstly, there was Sanju Samson missing in the playing XI.

He averages 66 in ODIs yet was not considered for selection as fans alleged that Samson is a victim of 'politics' and 'favouritism' in Indian team. Secondly, India did not close out the match in a dominant way, losing five wickets by changing the batting order. Thirdly, it turned out to be a boring match for the spectators. Some suggested that BCCI could earn more viewers and give better

practice to Men in Blue by playing and inter-squad game. One Twitter user even suggested that BCCI should have played a Team Rohit vs Team Virat contest to prepare for the big tournaments ahead as Windies displayed poor cricket. India will play the 2nd ODI vs West Indies on Saturday, July 29, with an aim to seal the series 2-0.

## BCCI hints at World Cup schedule adjustments

New Delhi: The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) has indicated that the World Cup schedule will undergo some adjustments, and the official changes will be announced within the next few days. BCCI Secretary Jay Shah revealed that certain member boards of the International Cricket Council (ICC) have requested modifications to the schedule, and these amendments are currently being finalized and will be communicated shortly. Regarding the India-Pakistan game which has been subject of discussion lately, the

BCCI secretary did not confirm any change of venue, which was announced as Ahmedabad earlier. Shah mentioned that consultations with the ICC are ongoing to determine the final changes. He strove to avoid a direct query the India-Pakistan game will be advanced to October 14, as has been reported. Shah addressed reporters after a meeting of the World Cup host associations in New Delhi on Thursday (July 27). The meeting primarily focused on the ticket manifest and infrastructure


development, based on recommendations from Grant Thornton, an external agency tasked with suggesting ways to enhance the facilities at stadiums in India. Representatives from all 12 associations, which will host the World Cup matches and warm-up games, attended the meeting. As of now, no specific timeframe has been mentioned for when the tickets will go on sale. The BCCI has requested for plans from the state associations outlining how they will manage ticket sales for each game.

This includes details about pricing, the number of tickets available for sale, the different types of tickets, and pricing for corporate boxes and complementary tickets. The BCCI has also informed each hosting association of the ticket quota they need to allocate to both the BCCI and the ICC for each match. Notably, ticket

pricing will not be the same at every venue, and the individual centers have the freedom to set their prices. So much so, the ticket prices may vary from match to match. The state associations are required to submit their plans to the BCCI by early next week, specifically before Tuesday. Once the plans are compiled by the BCCI, they will be forwarded to the ICC for approval. Ticket sales will commence once the entire process has been followed, although the state units have not yet been informed.

of the exact date when they can start selling tickets. Shah also noted that there is no possibility of using e-tickets during the World Cup. "We will make arrangements so that the physical tickets can be collected at seven-eight places before one week of the match. We will make it hassle-free. We will start the e-ticket system in bilateral games first." The state units have also been provided with guidelines on how to implement the stadium development recommendations from Grant Thornton. The agency has

already inspected six grounds, Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Pune, Hyderabad, Kolkata, and Delhi. Each hosting association has been allocated Rs 50 crore for stadium development, with a primary focus on improving basic amenities and hygiene in the grounds. Shah said the stadium development is a two-phase project with work undertaken before and after the World Cup. The state associations have been introduced to the GT executives and the pre-World Cup work will be completed in the next 45 days.
