No Respite From Heat Wave

Putting normal life out of gear, entire Odisha is reeling under severe heat wave conditions for the past several days. At least three places have recorded a maximum temperature of above 45 degrees Celsius on Friday.

With 45.6 degrees Celsius, Sonepur became the hottest place of the State for the day while another two Western Odisha towns Jharsuguda and Bolangir sizzled with temperature of 45.4 and respectively.

Apart from the above three places, 28 other places recorded a maximum temperature of 40 degrees Celsius or above.

Sambalpur registered a day temperature of 44.8 degrees Celsius, followed by Angul (44.7), Hirakud (44.6),

(44.2), Rourkela (44) and Bargarh (44).

Similarly, Nayagarh, Titlagarh & Dhenkanal tows registered 43.5 degrees each whereas it was 43.2 degrees at Baripada, 43 at Berhampur, Bhawanipatna, Khurda &Nuapada, 42.4 at Malkangiri, 42.2 at Cuttack and 42 degrees at Deogarh.

The other places recorded a maximum temperature of 40 degrees Celsius or above are—Kendrapara, 45.3 degrees Celsius, P h u l b a n i, Paralakhemundi, Keonihar, Jagatsinghpur, Bhadrak, Chandbali and Jajpur.

The Meteorological Department (IMD) said that there will be no respite from the prevailing heatwave as temperature is likely to remain the same during Bhubaneswar (44.6), next four days. After four Sundergarh (44.5), days, the temperature is Saturday.

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Talcher (44.4), Boudh likely to come down slightly, it said.

It is likely to be above normal by 4-7 degrees Celsius at a few places over the districts of Odisha during next 4 days; Consequently, hot and discomfort weather is likely during next 4-5 days, the IMD said.

People are advised to take precautionary measures while going outside between 11 AM to 3 PM.

The Met Department has issued an 'orange and yellow' warning for heatwaves in different districts of Odisha.







Jaswant Singh Khalra Biopic: Makers Move **Bombay High Court For Censor Clearance**



The biopic based on the life of prominent human rights activist, Jaswant Singh Khalra has been subjected to delays owing to the clearance for the censor certificate. The makers of the film moved the Bombay High Court and asked for legal intervention.

The yet-to-be-titled film, which is directed by Honey Trehan, and headlined by actor-singer Diljit Dosanjh, has hit a roadblock and the makers have sought legal help from the court.

Following Operation Star, Blue assassination of Indira Gandhi, and the 1984 Anti-Sikh Riots, the police were empowered to detain anyone as suspected terrorists. The killing unarmed suspects in staged shootouts, and burning thousands of dead bodies to cover up the murders. Jaswant Singh Khalra

was the director of a bank in Amritsar during the militancy period in Punjab. He found the evidence of abduction, elimination cremation of thousands of unidentified bodies by the police. They reportedly even killed 2,000 of their own officers who refused to collaborate in these extra judicial operations.

was Khalra's investigation sparked worldwide protests and led to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) concluding that the police were accused of Punjab police had

unlawfully cremated 2,097 people in the Tarn Taran district of Punjab alone. The Supreme Court of India and the National Human Rights Commission certified the validity of his data.

On September 6, 1995, Khalra disappeared and case of murder. abduction and criminal conspiracy registered on the complaint of his wife, Paramjit Kaur.

Taking strong note of the "heinous crime" committed by four police officers in "eliminating" human rights activist Jaswant Singh Khalra, active in bringing to light extrajudicial killings in the districts of Tarn Taran and Amritsar, the Punjab and Haryana Court, on October 16, Bombay High Court."

2007, changed the sentences of the four accused, former head constable Prithipal Singh former inspectors Satnam Singh, Surinder Pal Singh and Jasbir Singh from seven to life imprisonment.

The source added that RSVP applied for the censor certificate in December 2022, and it was sent ahead to the review committee. The team shared all the necessary paperwork that was requested and went about the process with complete diligence, but with no solution forthcoming from the CBFC, they

The draft UNGA resolution establishing the International Day of Yoga was proposed by India and endorsed by a

record 175 member states.

The proposal was first introduced by Prime Minister Modi in his address during the opening of the 69th session of the General Assembly, in which he said: "Yoga is an invaluable gift from our ancient tradition. Yoga embodies unity of mind and body, thought and action ... a holistic approach (that) is valuable to our health and our well-being. Yoga is not just about exercise; it is a way to discover the sense of oneness with yourself, the world and nature." The resolution notes "the importance of individuals populations making

healthier choices and following lifestyle patterns that foster good health." On this, the World Health Organisation has also urged its member states to help their citizens

Rabi procurement woes of Koraput farmers in Odisha spill to choke kharif plan



JEYPORE: Citing poor quality paddy, millers in different mandis in Kundra, Borrigumma and Kotpad areas are reluctant to lift produce from farmers in the area even though the procurement process began four days back. So far, only 33,000 quintal paddy have been lifted from the mandis.

Sources said while millers are demanding FAQ standard paddy from farmers in the mandis as per the norms or give extra 6 kg paddy per quintal procured to compensate for the loss to maintain the FAQ during custom milling,

millers are unnecessarily creating hurdles in procurement process due to vested interests.

Farmers are reportedly been procured so far. offering only 3 kg per quintal to millers to compensate for poor quality paddy, sources convenor Narendra added.
