Earlier on April 13, the lawyers had lodged a complaint with Simhadwar police. They urged the police to register a case and investigate the matter but in vain.

The aggrieved lawyers then filed a complain case in the SDJM court alleging that police did not accept their complaint. They prayed the court to direct the police to register a case or conduct hearing in the case.

Big Challenges for European security

The war of Russia & Ukraine gives no signs of coming to an end even after two



and half months of deaths and destruction. So far Russia couldn't a d v a n c e considerably inside Ukraine as it has expected, due to

fierce resistance from the Ukrainians and strong Western support. Having failed to achieve its objectives of a blitzkrieg victory in the early days of its invasion, Russian military now appears to be settling in for much longer war, " a deliberate, cynical strategy to besiege Ukraine cut them off, bomb them and starve them in to submission" immediately. Anything but victory could be perceived by Putin as an existential threat. That is why it is quite probable he'd claim victory over Ukraine during the victory day celebration to commemorate the victory over Germany

in World War ii. As Vladimir Putin is

determined to win, so are Ukrainians. Having failed to achieve instant victory Putin showed his willingness to deploy scorched earth tactic in Ukraine like he did in Syria and Chechnya beforehand. Both in Washington DC and Moscow there is a common acknowledgement that this war is far more than Ukraine and may be opening engagement in a prolonged and wider geopolitical struggle; one that extends far beyond the grounds of Donabs and could define Europe's Landscape well in to future. From warning of going nuclear to stocking energy crises and perhaps still fresh territories to invade. Russia has ramped up threats recently; but so has the West. The US and NATO are readying huge shipments of heavy weapons and military equipment to help the Ukrainian forces on the ground. An aid package of 33 billion dollars for Ukraine is proposed and going to pass in the US Congress. This aid would help

Russian aggression that followed a remark by Defence Secretary- Lioyd J. Austin this week. US wants to see Russia weakened to the extent that it could not do the kind of things that it has done in invading Ukraine. Russia's Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrovs warning that western arms shipment in Ukraine are a 'legitimate target', raising the prospect of a direct conflict between Russia and NATO members. Russia, under Putin, believes quite rightly that threats often work to compel their foes towards inhibition and limit their decisionmaking. It worked before for Moscow in 1999 after the NATO bombing Yugoslavia during the 2008 Georgia war and most recently when Denmark tried to join NATO's missile shield.

The US and NATO are under no illusion that Putin was evaluating the possibility of widening the war. In addition to redoubled US support to Ukraine and more stringent economic sanction on Russia, E.U countries- notably Germany appear to have overcome the initial reluctance and hesitation to provide Ukraine with lethal military weapons even after Lavrov's nuclear warning, to cope up with the war's changing dynamics. The war is in a different phase now than it waslate February to early April. After shooting international stardom for his response to the invasion. Ukrainian President VolodymyrZeleneskyy was unlikely to accept any settlement that would allow Russia to keep the territory it has seized. Nor is Putin likely to accept any demand to return it specially the Donbas area. The best case scenario might involve a ceasefire and a protracted line of control, where areas under Russia's top brass also recognise the fallout of the Ukrainian war. Russian general Minnekaev recently commented – ' Now we are at war with the whole world'. But The entire world is watching its outcome wearily with peaceful ending.

Odisha Urges Subsidy Release State warns NHA

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Food Supplies & Consumer Welfare Minister Ranendra Pratap Swain on Wednesday urged Union Minister Piyush Goyal to release food subsidy of Rs 10,334 crore due till April, 2022.

Writing a letter to the Union Minister for Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Mr.Swain also requested to resolve issues regarding evacuation of surplus rice, lifting of

wheat from FCI and allocation of 100 percent rice under public distribution system. his letter, In Mr.Swain raised concern over delayed release of food subsidy by the Government of India.

As per MoU with Government of India, there has to be zero financial liability on the State Procuring Agency with regard to permissible items of cost for procurement of rice to be borne by Government of India.

Odisha State Civil **Supplies Corporation** (OSCSC), the major

procuring agency of the State Government is to receive Rs.7931.90 crore as provisional subsidy and advance subsidy of Rs.2402.19 crore. So, the total subsidy claim standing at about Rs.10334 crore by the end of April, 2022, he pointed out.

The additional interest incurred till March, 2022 because of delay in release and short release of subsidy comes to around Rs.5454.67 crore which remains un-recouped and should be paid by Government of India, wrote Mr.Swain.

In the ensuing Kharif Marketing Season 2021-22, out of 52 lakh MT of estimated procurement of rice, Odisha's own consumption is about 39 lakh MT under PDS and other welfare schemes and the State is likely to have a surplus of 13 lakhs MT of rice which should be lifted immediately for smooth procurement operation.

In addition to this, the State Government has

taken all necessary steps to deliver 5 lakh MT of fortified parboiled rice to FCI as per target given by the Department of Food and Public Distribution. Government of India.

He further said that the State is in a position to deliver a higher quantity of fortified parboiled rice and the Central Department has been requested to give additional targets of fortified parboiled rice during KMS 2021-22. Minister Mr.Swain also requested Union Minister Mr.Goyal to

make available the required wheat stocks for Puri, Khordha and Nayagarh districts at FCI Depot at Jagatpur, Cuttack.

Besides, the Minister also requested for allocation of 100 percent rice to Odisha under NFSA/PMGKAY for distribution to the beneficiaries as is done in case of Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Goa and Telangana. Mr.Swain sought personal intervention of Union Minister for early resolution of the pending issues of Odisha.

Worried over the rising inflation, the RBI in a surprise move raised the repo rate by 40 basis points to 4.40 per cent last week. Inflation has remained above the RBI's comfort zone of 6 per cent for four months in a row mainly due to the Russia-Ukraine war which has impacted the prices of commodities across the globe.



The previous high in the consumer price index (CPI)-based retail inflation was recorded at 8.33 per cent in May 2014. CPI inflation was 6.95 per cent in March this year and 4.23 per cent in April 2021.

Inflation in the food basket rose to 8.38 per cent in April from 7.68 per cent in the preceding month and 1.96 per cent in the year-ago month, showed the data released by National Statistical Office (NSO) on Thursday.

The rate of price rise in 'fuel and light' category in the retail inflation basket quickened to 10.80 per cent in April this year from 7.52 per cent in the preceding month. In the 'oils and fats' category, inflation remained at an elevated level of 17.28 per cent (18.79 per cent in March 2022) during the month, as Ukraine is one of the major sunflower oil producers in the world and India imports a major portion of the commodity from the war-ravaged country.

inflation print of 15.41 per cent during the month as against 11.64 per cent in March, the data showed.

Notably, retail inflation has remained above 6 per cent since January 2022. The Reserve Bank of India has been mandated by the government to ensure that inflation remains at 4 per cent with a margin of 2 per cent on either side.

After the off-cycle Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting of RBI last week, RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das had said the adverse effects of the unprecedented high global food prices due to the ongoing geopolitical situation are reflected in the domestic market as well, and going forward inflationary pressures are likely to continue.

Meanwhile, according to sources, the cen-

tral bank is likely to raise inflation projections in the MPC meeting due next month. It may also consider a rate hike to tame inflation which is above its comfort level.

Earlier this month, the MPC raised the key policy rate (repo) by 40 basis points with an aim to tame the rising inflation. It was the first rate hike after August 2018.

"The surge in the CPI inflation has clearly justified the off-cycle

rate hike last week, and significantly raised the likelihood of a back-to-back rate increase in June 2022.

"We see a higher base softening the May 2022 CPI inflation print, although it will remain above 6.5 per cent," Aditi Nayar, Chief Economist, ICRA said.

'Fiery' Psaki ending tenure as a top White House messenger

WASHINGTON: Jen Psaki had been White House press secretary less than two weeks when a reporter asked whether Twitter's ban of Donald Trump had made President Joe Biden's life easier.

"We don't spend a lot of time talking about or thinking about President Trump here," she responded, then added for emphasis: "Former President Trump." It was an early indication of what was to come with this press secretary. Her briefings were professional and typically congenial but could turn pointed in a hurry. The sessions were informative but generally lacked the drama to draw big ratings on cable tele-

Psaki, whose last day on the job is Friday, has answered reporters' questions nearly every weekday of the almost 500 days that Biden has been in office. That makes her a top White House communicator and perhaps the administration's most public face after only the president and Vice President Kamala Harris. Her departure could complicate how Biden's message gets out at a critical time for him, at least in the short term.

"Anybody with a brain would want her to stay because she's so good," said Martha Joynt Kumar, a political science professor emerita at Towson University and director of the White House Transition Project, a nonpartisan group that tries to help streamline the transfer of power from one administration to the next.

Succeeding Psaki is Karine Jean-Pierre, the first Black woman and openly LGBTQ person to be White House press secretary. She takes over as the administration is navigating inflation and Russia's war with Ukraine, and as the Democratic Party is bracing for November election losses that could erase its control of Congress.

The White House says Jean-Pierre, who has been Psaki's chief deputy, will bring strong personal expertise and personality to the briefing room. She knows Biden well and has been a longtime adviser. "I've had the honor of working with many White House press secretaries and no one has done the job as well as Jen Psaki," White House chief of staff Ron Klain, a veteran of the Obama and Clinton administrations, said in a statement. "I will miss her terribly as a colleague and friend, but I know we are in great hands with Karine following her lead."

Psaki has not denied reports she is heading to MSNBC, where on-air personalities are mostly sympathetic to Biden and where Jean-Pierre herself is a former analyst. Such a move will do little to alter perceptions of Psaki on the left or right. Democrats see her as a champion of their causes; conservatives says she is standoffish.

Groups cheering Psaki are common across social media, including #Psakibomb, which has more than 22 million views on TikTok. Psaki's sisters wore sweatshirts with the slogan during family Zoom calls, though it was more about gently poking fun at their sibling than making a political statement But Psaki angered Republicans by likening the

party's supporters who adhere to Trump's fabrications about the 2020 election to "silent lemmings." When she quipped early in her tenure that she did

not know who at the White House could answer questions about Space Force, House Republicans said she was belittling a new branch of the armed services that is working to counter Chinese threats. More recently, Sarah Huckabee Sanders, a former Trump press secretary now running for Arkansas governor, said Psaki's failure to urge people to stop protesting outside the homes of judges represented "mind-boggling hypocrisy." A New York Post columnist called Psaki "the condescending face of the Biden administration.'

Colleagues say Psaki is an encouraging and selfless office leader who digs deep into policy, seeking an understanding that goes far beyond talking points. Psaki begins her mornings writing long, sometimes predawn emails to her staff, laying out what news is likely to drive the day. She later holds pre-briefing prep sessions, which are often long enough to be interrupted by other meetings, where White House press staffers assigned to track different issues talk about major themes in their areas.

"At the end of the day, she is a policy wonk," said

Jeff Zients, Biden's former COVID-19 response coordinator. He called her a "once in a generation talent" adept in both policy and communication.

"She is intellectually curious, she asks the right questions and doesn't stop asking questions until she's satisfied that she's gotten to the bottom of the issue," he said.

A 43-year-old native of Stamford, Connecticut, Psaki is the mother of children ages 6 and 4. She served as State Department spokesperson as well as deputy press secretary and White House communications director for President Barack Obama. Facing reporters mere hours after Biden was sworn in on Jan. 20, 2021, Psaki stressed the importance of "bringing truth and transparency back to the briefing room.' Trump went through four press secretaries, including Stephanie Grisham who never held a briefing, and her successor, Kayleigh McEnany, who was fond of lecturing the media and simultaneously served as a campaign adviser. Trump preferred to engage directly with the public, through rallies and tweets before he was banned from that social media platform. He also sometimes held his own briefings and routinely spread falsehoods while openly antagonizing reporters.

Kathleen Hall Jamieson, director of the Annenberg Public Policy Center at the University of Pennsylvania, said the job of press secretary has "been done well both on the right and the left" and requires respecting the media while answering questions in ways that provide real information.

She said Psaki had a "facticity to her work that is characteristic of good press secretaries and it presupposes confidence. It presupposes access to the president. It presupposes an understanding of what the administration's position is that proves to be true." Psaki, who got COVID-19 twice while on the job, showed that striking a balance between transparency and advancing the administration's message could sometimes mean literally keeping her balance. While aboard Air Force One, she sometimes stood in the aisle taking reporters' questions right through landing.

COLOMBO: Opposition leader and former premier Ranil Wickremesinghe was sworn-in as Sri Lanka's 26th prime minister on Thursday to stabilise the country's debt-ridden economy and end the political turmoil, a development welcomed by India which said it looks forward to working with the new government and reatfirmed its commitment to the Sri Lankan people. Wickremesinghe was sworn-in as prime minister by President Gotabaya Rajapaksa, days after his predecessor Mahinda Rajapaksa was forced to resign following violent protests over the worst economic crisis in the island nation. The 73-year-old United National Party (UNP) leader took over as the prime minister as the country was without a government since Monday when Gotabaya Rajapaksa's elder brother and prime minister Mahinda Rajapaksa resigned after violence erupted following an attack on the anti-government protesters by his supporters. The attack triggered widespread violence against Rajapaksa loyalists, leaving nine people dead and wounding over 200 others. IPL gives India more finishing options in Dinesh Karthik and Rahul Tewatia

NEW DELHI: IPL form can't be the sole criteria for a national call-up but Dinesh Karthik and Rahul Tewatia with their stellar shows as finishers for their respective franchises have certainly made a strong case for themselves in the coming months leading up to the T20 World Cup. The ICC event in Australia is still more than four months away but the selectors and team management will soon have to decide on their core group of players, starting with the five match home series against South Africa next month.

The finisher's job is only gaining significance in the power-packed modern game and the Indian team is definitely in need of players who can go ballistic from ball one.

In the absence of Hardik Pandya due to fitness issues, the Indian team management tried out Deepak Hooda and Venkatesh Iyer in the middle-order post World Cup debacle last year but they haven't yet found closure as far as their search is concerned.

Hardik, who has done well in the IPL in what has been his comeback competition, too has thrown himself back into national contention. However, Hooda and Hardik have been batting higher up in the order for their respective IPL teams but are expected to play lower down for the national team.

Venkatesh has had a tough second year in the IPL and has gone down in the pecking order of finishers.

With Ravindra Jadeja being the only established finisher in the Indian team, IPL performers like Karthik and Tewatia sensed an opportunity and have made full use of it.

Tewatia has built a reputation of winning games from improbable situations while Karthik, who had made his India debut way back in 2004, has shown insatiable hunger to make another comeback.

Former India chief selector MSK Prasad feels both Karthik and Tewatia must be tried in the series against South Africa beginning on June 9 besides calling for Hardik's return. "Hardik, Jaddu, Karthik and Tewatia are my top four for the finisher's role. DK and Tewatia has been brilliant in this IPL and Hardik has made a good comeback. The World Cup is still some time away but the likes of DK and Tewatia should get their opportunity. "If you look at DK, he has consistently done

well for India in the T20 format, Nidahas Trophy being the highlight," Prasad told PTI. On Hardik, he said: "He will be one of your main players in Australia where the T20 World Cup is. But I also want to see him bowling regularly. We will need his all-round skills Down Under." Hardik has not been bowling for Gujarat Titans in every game but has bowled closed to 20 overs during the course of the season besides getting crucial runs at number four.

Prasad's former colleague in the erstwhile selection committee, Sarandeep Singh, said the Baroda all-rounder has to bowl regularly to be in the scheme of things.

"He can't just play as a batter in the side. You lose out on a crucial bowling option that way. DK can be given a go but can he play only as a batter with Rishabh donning the gloves, I am not so sure about it. But he has certainly made a case and he has got all the experience.

"He also has the ability to change his role if wickets fall in a heap. Tewatia too has done well in the IPL but I doubt if he could replicate his form in Indian conditions in Australia. The bowlers are likely to bounce him out I feel," said the former India spinner.

Tewatia had received an India call up last year but failed a fitness test.

He added that Venkatesh should be persisted even if he is having an ordinary IPL.

Among other players who should be tried in other roles against South Africa including young pacer Umran Malik, reckons Prasad.

Shami and Bumrah are your frontline pacers but you also need a bowler who can regularly clock 150 kmph. Umran has been doing that. It is also heartening to see Kuldeep and Chahal doing well for their IPL and should be back bowling together for India," said Prasad.
