





Eutrophication is a ailment of the ecosystem, response to the addition of artificial or natural nutrients such as nitrates, potassium and phosphates through fertilizer (sewage, industrial wastes etc) that fertilize the aquatic ecosystem. It is predominantly caused by the leaching of phosphate and nitrates containing fertilizers from agricultural lands and industries into lakes or rivers. 
# States violating UGC norms in appointment of Vice chancellors

The appointm ent process and the politic ization of positions have sparked concerns, leading to a call for qualified VCs and a change in attitude towards university development. Will this mark the beginning of a common man's revolt against political interference in higher education? Last year, a public interest litigation was filed in the Calcutta High Court challenging the appointment of vicechancellors of various universities in the state of West Bengal. The litigation, which included the state government as respondents, alleged that the appointments were made in violation of UGC-2010 and 2018 regulations. After a year of arguments, Calcutta High Court Chief Justice Prakash Srivastava and Justice Rajarshi dismissed 29 vicechancellors in contravention of UGC norms, lacking minimum qualifications, in a 46page judgment by the Bharad waj-led bench Following the

This has resulted in the appointment of 29 vicechancellors who do not meet the minimum qualifications. Seven petitions were filed in the state high court last year seeking the removal of these VCs, including a case filed by retired Nizamabad principal Dr Vidyasagar Reddy, who argued that the appointment of the state's second-largest university's vicechancellor was invalid due to insufficient experience as professor.
