Business Tycoon Mukesh Ambani Receives Death Threat Through Email

Mumbai(KCN): Reliance Industries Chairman Mukesh Ambani received an extortion-cum-death threat, warning to shoot him if he filed to pay Rs 20 crore, Mumbai police said on Saturday. The industrialist received email regarding the threat at 8:51 pm on Friday, October 27.



Mumbai police has registered an FIR against an unknown person in the matter. "The email regarding the threat was received on Friday, October 27. Soon after the matter came to light, a case was registered under sections 387 and 506 (2) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) in Gamdevi PS of Mumbai," police said in a statement. According to the FIR, the copy of which is accessed by News18, the miscreant claimed said in the mail that "If you (Ambani) don't give is Rs 20 crore, we will kill you. We have the best shooters in the India." No arrests have been made in the case so far. Further investigation is underway, said police.

5T And Nabin Odisha Chairman VK Pandian Reviews Srimandir Parikrama Project In Puri

Puri(KCN): The 5T and Nabin Odisha chairman VK Pandian on Saturday reviewed the Srimandir Parikrama project in Puri and directed the authorities to complete the work by December 15. On the instruction of Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik, Pandian visited the holy town in the wee hours of Saturday and reviewed the progress of the Parikrama project in the presence of Puri Collector, SP and senior officials of executing agencies. This was the first review of Pandian after assuming charge as the 5T and Nabin Odisha chairman. for parking of two-wheelers for the convenience of local people. In addition, he stressed the importance of shifting various utilities from the 'Meghanad Prachir', completing of electricity work within the scheduled time. Pandian reviewed the

progress of Jagannath Ballav parking works, development of various amenities for commuters, Pramod Udyan, and Sri Setu work and directed to complete the work on schedule. He also suggested to employ more people for this project.

Gajalaxmi Puja Celebrated With Fervour In Odisha

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Continuing the festive season, Odisha celebrates Gajalaxmi Puja today where Goddess Laxmi – the Goddess of wealth is worshipped. The puja incepts on Kumar Purnima, which is the full-moon day (Sharad Purnima) on the Odia month of Aswina (Sept-Oct) Gajalaxmi Puja celebrations in Dhenkanal is almost a century-old tradition. Every year, Goddess Laxmi is worshipped here for 11 days from the day of Kumar Purnima. This is followed by Visarjan Utsav with a huge street carnival. Kendrapara has also geared up for the GajaLaxmi Puja today. Gajalaxmi Puja traces its origin to Kumar Purnima which is also observed on this day – the last day of Ashwina month, marking the beginning of Kartika



as per the Odia calendar. Kumar Purnima is mostly dedicated to all unmarried girls. Lakshmi Puja represents a fresh start for the Goddess's devotees and on the eve of the festival, devotees light up their homes with earthen lamps and leave their doors and windows open to invite her in. Moreover, farmers worship Goddess Lakshmi on this day for a good harvest. Devotees worship Lord Shiva and Goddess Lakshmi on Sharad

Purnima and unmarried girls observe fast on this day in various parts of the country to please Lord Vishnu in order to find a right lifestyle for themselves. Coming close at the heels of Durga Puja, Kojagari Lakshmi Puja is one of the most significant festivals celebrated in the eastern part of India, across West Bengal, Assam, and Odisha. Devotees worship Goddess Lakshmi on this day and the puja falls on the full moon day in the lunar month of Ashwin.

Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan Flags Off 'Amrit Kalash Yatra' Train From Bhubaneswar

Bhubaneswar(KCN): Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, in the presence of Odisha BJP president Manmohan Samal, flagged off the 'Amrit Kalash Yatra' train at Odisha's Bhubaneswar railway station on Saturday. Amrit Kalash Yatra is a special train under the 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' campaign. The flagging-off ceremony was graced by the presence of BJP MPs Aparajita Sarangi and Pratap Sarangi and several party MLAs and other senior leaders along with railway officials. Dharmendra Pradhan, on

the occasion, while speaking to media personnel said, "Today is a fortunate day. At the call of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the campaign of collecting soil from the villages, cities and panchayats of bravehearts, is reaching towards its conclusion." He further said, "The soil has been gathered from 13250 villages of Odisha as we reached the villages of all those who have sacrificed their lives from independence till now. Today, 1400 representatives have left for Delhi and at the completion of the Amrit Mahotsav, an Amrut Vatika would be built." Around 1400 members



from all the 314 blocks across Odisha boarded on special train, who have collected sacred soil from houses in the state and brought Amrit Kalash to state party headquarters. Earlier, Dharmendra

Pradhan along with Odisha BJP leader Manmohan Samal participated in padayatra under Amrit Kalash Yatra, started from state party headquarters and ended at Bhubaneswar railway

station. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will address the final event of the 'Meri Maati Mera Desh' campaign in the national capital on October 31. As the culminating

campaign of two-year-long Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, "Meri Maati Mera Desh- Maati Ko Naman Veeron ka Vandan" is the unified celebration of India's soil and valour. It has witnessed tremendous Jan Bhagidari (public participation) with more than 7000 blocks from 766 districts of the country. In its first phase, the campaign became a massive success, with over 2.33 lakh Shilaphalakams built in 36 States and UTs, nearly 4 crore Panch Pran pledge selfies uploaded, and over 2 lakh Veeron ka Vandan programs nationwide.

Additionally, more than 2.36 crore indigenous saplings have been planted, and 2.63 lakh Amrit Vatikas created under the Vasudha Vandan theme. In the second phase of Meri Maati Mera Desh, Amrit Kalash Yatras were planned to touch every household in the country. Soil and rice grains were collected from over 6 lakh villages in rural areas and from wards in urban areas across India. Collected soil from each village was mixed at the block level and then brought to the state capital, and with a ceremonial send-off, sent to the national capital with thousands of Amrit Kalash Yatris.

World Stroke Day: Balanced Lifestyle & Little Alert Can Help You, Says KIMS Expert

Bhubaneswar, (KCN): A little neglect can lead to tragic situation resulting in brain stroke or simply stroke. It occurs following a blockage of blood supply to brain and is very crucial to take the patient within 4.5 hours of the stroke to the nearest hospital to save his/her life. W e l l - k n o w n Neurologist and HoD of Department of Neurology at Kalinga Institute of Medical Sciences (KIMS) Dr Santosh Kumar Dash says "October 29th is celebrated as World Stroke Day and aims at creating awareness on the condition and on the rising incidence of



stroke across India." Terming it a common neurological disorder, Dr Dash said in India brain stroke is now on a rising trend and in a population of 1 lakh, 100 to 150 persons are diagnosed with it. It is easily recognized with a drooping of the face, weakness in arms and slurred speech. "However, the most

important thing regarding a stroke patient is to get him/her for treatment as soon as possible so that the intervention could be possible and the life could be saved," he added. This condition develops within some minutes and results in a painful situation leading to acute stroke and damaging the brain. If not treated within the 4.5 hours' Window Period then the situation might become irreversible and ultimately the patient would die. This year the World Stroke Day Theme is "Together we are #Greater Than Stroke."

It tries to emphasize the prevention of risk factors such as hypertension, irregular heartbeat, smoking, diet and exercise, as nearly 90 percent of strokes can be prevented by addressing the risk factors. Suggesting a healthy lifestyle, Dr Dash said avoiding smoking, alcohol intake and restricting use of common salt in diet and less consumption of red meat and sugar would help an individual immensely in managing risks for stroke. Regular physical activities and also health check-up could also help a lot in keeping stroke away.

World Stroke Day is an opportunity to raise awareness of the serious nature and high rates of stroke and talk about ways in which we can reduce the burden of stroke through better public awareness of the risk factors and signs of stroke. It is also an opportunity to advocate for action by decision makers at global, regional and national levels that are essential to improve stroke prevention, access to

acute treatment and support for survivors and caregivers.

A stroke happens when there is a loss of blood flow to part of the brain. Your brain cells cannot get the oxygen and nutrients they need from blood, and they start to die within a few minutes. This can cause lasting brain damage, long-term disability, or even death.

The most common type of stroke is ischemic stroke that happens when the brain's blood vessels become blocked or narrow, restricting blood flow. The clogged blood vessels are caused by fatty deposits that build up in the vessels or by blood clots that move towards the blood vessel in the brain through the bloodstream. When the

blood vessel in the brain ruptures or leaks due to certain healthcare conditions, haemorrhagic stroke occurs. These conditions include uncontrolled high blood pressure, trauma, protein deposits in blood vessel walls, ischemic stroke leading to haemorrhage, overtreatment with blood thinners and bulges at weak spots in the blood vessel walls. Transient ischemic attack occurs when a debris or clot reduces blood flow to part of the nervous system and lasts as little as five minutes.

Types of Stroke are Ischemic Stroke, Transient Ischemic Attack or Mini-Stroke, Hemorrhagic Stroke, Brain Stem Stroke. High blood pressure is the leading cause of

stroke and is the main cause for increased risk of stroke among people with diabetes. Talk to your doctor about ways to keep diabetes under control.

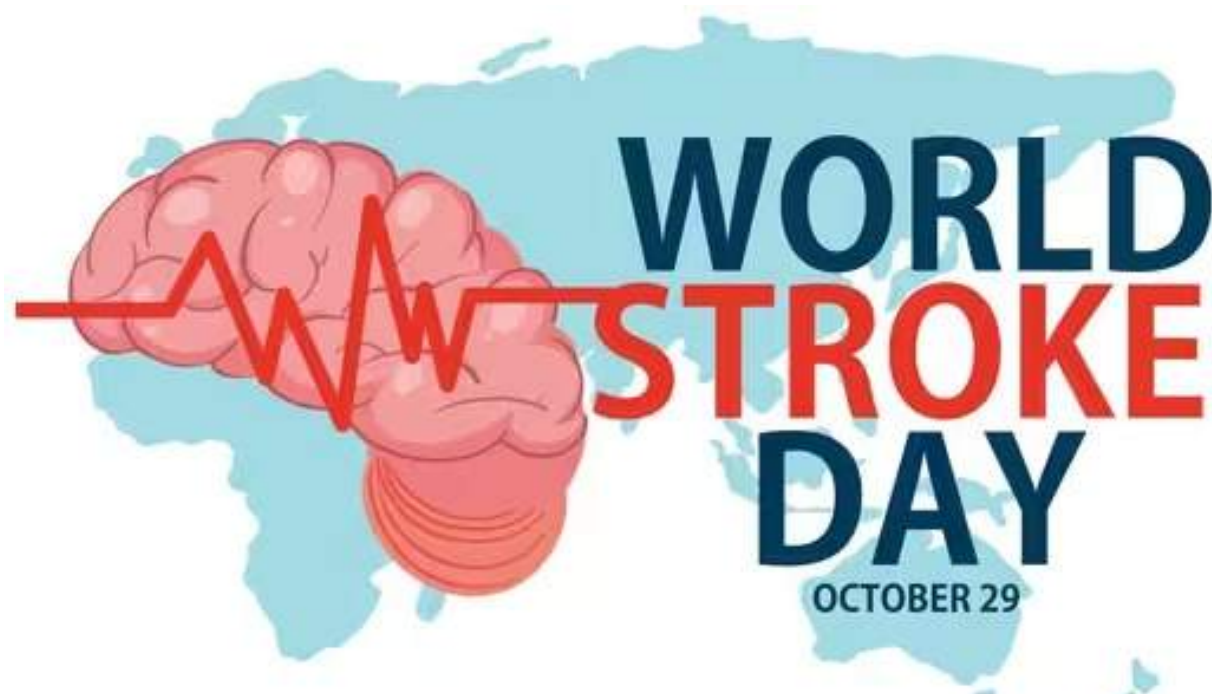
Three main causes of strokes are High blood pressure. Your doctor may call it hypertension, Tobacco.

Smoking or chewing it raises your odds of a stroke, Heart disease. This condition includes defective heart valves as well as atrial fibrillation, or irregular heartbeat, which causes a quarter of all strokes among the very elderly, Diabetes.

An IV injection

of recombinant tissue plasminogen activator (TPA) — also called alteplase (Activase) or tenecteplase (TNKase) — is the gold standard treatment for ischemic stroke. An injection of TPA is usually given through a vein in the arm within the first three hours.

A Mediterranean diet, or a diet high in fruits and vegetables, reduces the risk of stroke. Body weight and obesity are risk factors for stroke, although the specific ways in which they increase stroke risk continue to be debated. Obesity is related to



stroke risk factors such as hypertension and diabetes. Foods high in potassium, such as sweet and white potatoes, bananas, tomatoes, prunes, melon and soybeans, can help you maintain a healthy blood pressure — the leading risk factor of stroke. Magnesium-rich foods, such as spinach, are also linked to a lower risk of stroke. Recovery time after a stroke is different for everyone—it can take weeks, months, or even years. Some people recover fully, but others have long-term or lifelong disabilities.

"Free Education From KG To PG If Congress Is Re-Elected In Chhattisgarh": Rahul Gandhi

Raipur(KCN): Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Saturday promised free education in government schools and colleges in Chhattisgarh and ₹ 4,000 a year for 'tendu' leaf collectors if his party retains power in the state. Addressing an election rally in the Bhanupratappur assembly constituency in Kanker district, Mr Gandhi asked that if Prime Minister Narendra Modi brings up 'OBC' (other backward classes) in his speeches, why was he scared of a caste census. A caste census will be conducted in the country if the Congress is voted to power, he added. Bhanupratappur is



among the 20 constituencies that will see polling on November 7 in the first phase of the Chhattisgarh elections. The second phase will be held on November 17. "We are going to take a major step for you which we call 'KG to PG'. From KG

(kindergarten) to PG (post-graduation), free education will be provided in government institutions to students (if Congress retains power in state). They will not have to pay a single penny," Mr Gandhi said. Mr Gandhi promised that if the Congress forms the government in

the state after polls, tendu leaf collectors will be given ₹ 4,000 per year under the Rajiv Gandhi Protsahan Yojana. This is being seen as a major announcement from the Bhanupratappur seat, which is a part of the tribal-dominated Bastar region. Pitching for a caste census, he said, "Narendra Modi ji uses the 'OBC' word in every speech but why is he scared of the caste census... OBCs have to become aware as they are being ditched." Mr Gandhi also announced that the Congress would conduct a caste census in the country if it is voted to power in Delhi (at the Centre). "We

have already made this promise for Chhattisgarh," he said. Key promises made by the Congress ahead of the last assembly polls have been fulfilled in Chhattisgarh, Mr Gandhi claimed. Objecting to the use of 'vanvasi' in place of 'Adivasi' for tribals, he said its use by the BJP is an insult to Adivasis and an attack on their culture, history and language. During his speech, Mr Gandhi stopped briefly and walked to the other corner of the stage carrying a bottle of water apparently after someone fainted on the ground. He returned to the dais and asked if the person was alright.

Make Laxmanananda murder probe report public: BJP, VHP to Odisha govt

BHUBANESWAR(KCN): The state unit of the Vishva Hindu Parishad and BJP on Wednesday came down heavily on the state government for not making public the interim and final reports submitted by the judicial commission that probed the gruesome murder of Swami Laxmanananda Saraswati and four of his disciples at Jalespeta in Kandhamal district on August 23, 2008.

Almost 15 years have passed, but the state government is yet to make the interim report submitted by Justice (ret'd) Sarat Mohapatra and the final report by Justice (ret'd) AS Naidu public, state VHP general secretary Mahesh Sahu told mediapersons. "We have been



demanding the government to make the inquiry reports public so that people will know who are the conspirators and what was their motive. Surprisingly, the government is silent. We fail to understand why it had set up the judicial inquiry," Sahu said. The interim report of Justice Mohapatra had said that conversion by Christian missionaries

was the primary motive behind the murder. In a bid to keep its secular credential intact, the state government took all possible steps to save the missionaries by calling the massacre a handiwork of Maoists, he alleged. Coming out in support of the VHP demand, state BJP general secretary Jatin Mohanty said the BJD

government is doing appeasement politics. "It is the state government which set up the judicial commission of inquiry. Why it is reluctant to table the report of judicial commission in the Assembly," he questioned. The BJP urged the government to make it public during the monsoon session of the Assembly.

However, their present performance in the global tournament does not guarantee that it will an easy cake walk more so after Netherlands brought down high-flying South Africa in the tournament earlier and

coupled by the fact that are drowned by the expectations, it will be even more difficult for Shakib and co who are eagerly looking to change their fortunes. "Look if we lose the match everything is tricky but definitely in this kind of match the pressure is much more because of the expectation because everyone feels that we have to win," Taskin told reporters ahead of game against Netherlands at the Eden Gardens on Friday. "We want to win every game and the thing is that we have to win by following a process and doing the right thing. We should focus on the next match and if we can win I think we should go match by match and if we can play our best cricket we will be able to win," he said adding that he doesn't feel everything is over for them.



"It's not finished yet (hope of reaching the semi-final). Still four more games to go. If we can win those four, anything can happen because there are some run rates issues and also like a lot of teams like England Afghanistan beat England they lost against Sri Lanka. "So, if we can win four there will be a different story maybe but at the

moment we are planning to go match by match. Yes, we didn't play well enough as we expected from both units, batting, and bowling, but four games to go. So, we are looking forward to do well," he said. "Our fielding was pretty good so far in this tournament but batting and bowling I think as we expected we haven't done enough well so

there are a lot more improvements. But also, we know also that we are better than that. And we are capable. But yeah, we haven't done great. So, hoping to do well in the next four matches," he said.Taskin, who joined the nets on Thursday after having a break to recover from his shoulder injury, said that he will have to manage his shoulder and play. Bangladesh received a huge blow earlier when Taskin missed the game against India and South Africa as a result of his recurring shoulder injury. Taskin sustained the shoulder injury during their tour of South Africa in 2022, when he failed to complete the opening Test and it was advised that he needs an operation but the team management opted not to go for the surgery, with an eye on the 2022 T20 World Cup.

"I had this shoulder (issue) for the first time in South Africa that was two years back. I have a tear in my tendon for long time and I am playing by managing it even in the Asia Cup and World Cup I am playing with it and suddenly it got increased and the doctor and physio did MRI and it was found out that it was swollen and so took rest for couple of days and now I am feeling better. I am personally in a good shape and after playing I can understand where I stand. "As a player I want to play all the time. After the injury, I was sent to UK for assessment. There I was told by the surgeon that if I undergo surgery there is no guarantee that it will be cured and it will take couple of years to recover while there was another option that is rehabilitation and after doing the rehab for one and a half months till now I played and now it

increased (injury) and after the tournament probably board will make a plan after having discussion with a shoulder specialist regarding what to do next and how to proceed. The surgery is the last option and I want to do rehab and play by managing it. When the pain increases it becomes difficult for me as a fast bowler." Taskin added that they fully backed ODI skipper Shakib Al Hasan for his individual training session in Dhaka leaving the team hotel in the midst of the World Cup. Shakib did not travel with the team from Mumbai and instead moved to Dhaka for batting sessions with his childhood mentor Nazmul Abedin following his dismal performances with the willow in the tournament so far making 14, 1, 40 and 1 in the four matches while he missed the

game against India due to injury. Shakib was expected to arrive on October 27 evening as per his schedule but had to cut short his trip and returned on October 26 after the BCB asked him to change his plans as many felt being a leader of the team leaving the team hotel might have a negative impact on the team, though Taskin begs to differ. "I don't think it (his absence from the team hotel) had any impact and when he returned we had a good time. Basically he went there to make individual improvement by doing specific training so that he can do well for us because he is not batting as per his expectation," said Taskin. "I feel we should appreciate it. He went there after talking with management and BCB and we had a rested.

NewDelhi:Punjab's top-three were in blistering form as they took down Arunachal Pradesh's lowly 116/5 inside just nine overs to consolidate the team's top-spot with a sixth straight win of the season. Abhishek Sharma fell early after a 11-ball cameo of 23, in a 73-run opening stand that was otherwise dominated by Prabhsimran Singh, who hacked four sixes and five boundaries in his unbeaten 50 off 29 deliveries. The star of the show, however, was Ramandeep Singh who launched a flurry of sixes. He hit five of them in his 12-ball unbeaten 42, helping Punjab over the line in just 8.4 overs for a massive NRR boost as well. With the platform laid down by Tushar Deshpande's hat-trick, Yashasvi Jaiswal further boosted

Mumbai's NRR with his 22-ball 46 not out to help his team overhaul a paltry target of 77 in just six overs. The win ensured Mumbai's NRR of +1.983 was superior to Hyderabad's +1.371 despite their equal points, for a direct entry into the knockouts. It was courtesy another Riyan Parag special that Assam survived a late wobble to overhaul Kerala's 127/6 by two wickets, handing the Group B table-toppers their only defeat of the group stages in the last round. Parag hit an unbeaten 57 off just 33 balls, laced with half a dozen sixes but the win was ultimately all in vain with Assam finishing third. Himachal Pradesh had a scintillating knock of 73* from Nikhil Gangta to thank for their second-place finish in Group B standings, giving them a shot at pre-quarters. Ganta

smacked six sixes, and another four boundaries, in his 30-ball assault on the Sikkim bowling attack. The base for HP's commanding total of 234/4 was also set by opener Prashant Chopra's 66 that came in just 47 deliveries. Saurav Chauhan's 28-ball 50 was the highlight of Gujarat's six-wicket win over Manipur but couldn't help the team into top-two spot. Saurav knock was aided by an equally aggressive 48* from Chirag Gandhi, who smashed four sixes and boundaries each in his unbeaten 19-ball effort. A brilliant 46-ball 73 from skipper Shubham Khajuria, supported ably by his opening partner Qamran Iqbal's 24-ball 50, set the base for J&K's match-winning total of 185. Iqbal fell after leading the charge in the opening stand of 66,



while the captain went on to bat until the 19th over, to help their side to a commanding score in a futile win. Wicketkeeper-bat Harvik Desai's attacking 61 helped Saurashtra to a four-wicket win over Goa, taking them to the all-important second-place

finish in the Group C standings, behind Punjab. The opener hit eight fours and a couple of sixes in his 39-ball knock, leading the way in the Powerplay to set up the win. Avneesh Sudha's unbeaten 72 helped Uttarakhand help the season on a high with a

comprehensive 9-wicket win over Puducherry. The opener dictated terms in the 64-run opening stand with Yuvraj Chaudhary, and hit three sixes in his 53-ball unbeaten knock to take his side over the line in the 17th over itself. Rajat Patidar's 68 was

enough to script a four-wicket win for Madhya Pradesh over Uttar Pradesh but couldn't provide the NRR boost his side needed to topple them in the points table for the second-place finish. However, with just 14 points, both teams are unlikely to make it to the knockouts. Mahipal Lomror's berserk 23-ball half-century laid the platform for Rajasthan's massive 53-run consolation win to end the season on a positive note. Lomror hit three sixes and as many boundaries more to amp up his team's scoring in death overs, propelling them to a strong 181/4 from their 20. Tushar Deshpande was the star in Mumbai's top-place finish as his 4-13 helped decimate Mizoram for a paltry 76. Deshpande registered a hat-trick by

dismissing three of Mizoram's top-four in his very first over, a blow they could never recover from. Skipper Chintan Gaja (3-23) and Arzan Nagwaswalla (3-18) starred in a late collapse in Manipur's innings to set up Gujarat's convincing six-wicket win. The duo picked up three apiece as Manipur crashed to 137 all out inside 18 overs despite being in proper control of proceedings at 94/1 in the 12th over. Despite the win though, Gujarat finished third. Rasikh Dar Salam ended the season on a high, picking up 6-31 to aid Jammu and Kashmir's 35-run victory over Chhattishgarh. He picked up two inside the powerplay to dent the chase early before bagging four more in his two overs at death.
